AT A GLANCE: The Yankees complete their six-game road trip today with the final game a three-game series at Toronto (1-1 thus far)...are 4-1 on the road trip after sweeping a three-game series at Cleveland and splitting their first two games at Toronto...following this homestand, will return home for a six-game homestand, featuring three-game sets against Chicago-AL (Tues.-Thurs.) and Cincinnati (6/19-21).

► **Their 42-27 (.609) record is the best in the American League and the fourth-best record in the Majors.**

- Have won five of their last six games (since 6/7) and six of their last eight games (since 6/4)...are 12-5 in their last 17 games (since 5/24), 14-8 in their last 22 games (since 5/18) and 34-20 in their last 54 games (since 4/13).
- Are a season-high-tying 15G over .500 (also 15G at 41-26 on 6/10).
- The Yankees'+102 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the fourth-best in the Majors...have outscored their opponents, 98-61, over their last 17 games (since 5/24).

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees defeated the Blue Jays, 3-1, in a comeback win on Saturday at Rogers Centre...**RHP Cam Schlittler** (7.0IP, 6H, 1R/ER, 4BB, 7K, 1HR) did not record a decision despite allowing only 1R/ER in 7.0IP...**RF Jasson Dominguez** (1-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI) was reinstated from the I.L. and hit his second HR of the year with a game-tying solo shot in the fourth inning...**DH Paul Goldschmidt** (1-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit his ninth HR of the season with a go-ahead two-run shot in the ninth inning...**RHP Fernando Cruz** (1.0IP, 3BB, 1K) earned his fourth win of the year after tossing a scoreless eighth inning...**RHP David Bednar** (1.0IP, 3K) earned his 14th save of the year after tossing a perfect ninth inning.

GOOD AS GOLD: INF Paul Goldschmidt hit his ninth HR of the season with a go-ahead two-run shot in the ninth inning on Saturday at Toronto...six of his 9HR this season have given the Yankees the lead...has hit 9HR in 44 games this year after hitting 10HR in 146 games in 2025.

- **Has hit safely in 15 of his last 16 games (since 5/25), batting .328/.361/.552 (22-for-67) with 9R, 3 doubles, 4HR, 17RBI, 4BB, 1SF and 1SB over that span.**
- Has recorded 8RBI in his last six games (since 6/7) and 17RBI in his last 14 games (since 5/27).
- Has hit 4HR in his last 13 games (since 5/29).
- Is batting .315/.376/.567 (40-for-127) with 19R, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 8HR, 28RBI, 11BB, 2HP, 1SF and 1SB over his last 35 games (since 4/26).
- Has hit .397/.500/.776 (23-for-58) with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 5HR, 9BB and 3HP vs. left-handed pitching this season...ranks first in the Majors in OPS (1.276), SLG and OBP, third in BA (first in AL) and tied for seventh in XBH (11, tied for second in AL).
- As a Yankee (since 2025), has batted .353/.437/.628 (73-for-207) with 19 doubles, 1 triple, 12HR, 26BB/5IBB and 5HP vs. left-handed pitchers...ranks second in the Majors in OPS (1.065, second in AL), third in BA (second in AL) and SLG (third in AL), and fifth in OBP (third in AL).
- **Has hit .400/.525/.667 (12-for-30) with 2 doubles, 2HR, 21RBI, 7BB, 1SF and 2HP with RISP this season...**as a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .331/.422/.453 (46-for-139) with 8 doubles, 3HR, 55RBI, 21BB/5IBB, 3HP and 3SF with RISP.

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice has hit .291/.387/.603 (68-for-234) with 50R, 15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR, 45RBI, 36BB/3IBB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 64 games this season...has reached base safely in 49-of-60 starts...35 of his 68H this year have been XBH (15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR).

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have posted a 3.27 ERA (380.0IP, 138ER) and 369K in 69 starts this season...have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 56 starts this season, the most in the AL and tied for the third-most in the Majors...marks their third-most in franchise history through their first 69 games of a season, trailing only their 58 starts in 2022 and 2024.

- Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.341), rank second in ERA (3.27, first in AL), opponents' BA (.214, first in AL), opponents' OBP (.285, first in AL) and opponents' OPS (.626, first in AL), third in WHIP (1.12, second in AL) and HR/9.0IP (0.92, second in AL), fifth in strikeout rate (23.7%, second in AL), sixth in innings pitched (380.0, fourth in AL), seventh in strikeouts (369, fourth in AL), and eighth in K/BB (2.93, fourth in AL), BB/9.0IP (2.98, fourth in AL) and K/9.0IP (8.74, fourth in AL).

2026 HOPE WEEK: This upcoming week, the Yankees will celebrate the 17th edition of **HOPE Week** (Helping Others Persevere & Excel), an ambitious, week-long, multifaceted community outreach program undertaken by players, coaches and employees within the organization...the initiative is rooted in the belief that acts of goodwill provide hope and encouragement to more than just the recipient of the gesture...over each of the five days of HOPE Week, the Yankees will reach out to an individual, family or organization worthy of recognition and support, providing honorees with a day celebrating their accomplishments...this year's outreach will take place in the community and at Yankee Stadium.



SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger is hitting .291/.379/.534 (43-for-148) with 23R, 11 doubles, 2 triples, 7HR, 31RBI, 23BB, 5SB and 3SF over his last 40 games (since 4/28).

- Has recorded 13RBI in his last 16 games (since 5/25).
- Is batting .305/.370/.441 (18-for-59) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 28RBI, 9BB and 5SF with RISP this season.
- Since 5/1, is hitting .326/.396/.609 (15-for-46) with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 2HR and 6BB vs. left-handed pitching.
- As a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .325/.390/.563 (75-for-231) with 16 doubles, 3 triples, 11HR, 28BB and 1HP against left-handed pitching...ranks ninth in the Majors in BA and OPS (.952) over that span.
- According to FanGraphs, his 15 DRS are tied for the most in the Majors (most in AL)...is tied for first in the Majors in go-ahead RBI (13, tied for first in AL) and tied for seventh in game-winning RBI (seven, tied for fourth in AL).

GOOD WILL WARREN: RHP Will Warren will make his 14th start of the season today at Toronto...has gone 7-1 with a 3.41 ERA (68.2IP, 26ER) and 75K in 13 starts this season, allowing 2ER-or-fewer in 10 of his starts...is tied for fifth in the AL in wins and tied for 10th in the Majors.

- The Yankees are 11-2 in his starts...his 11 team wins are tied for the most in the Majors this season.
- Since 2025, has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 32 of his 46 starts, tied for the most in the AL and tied for the third-most in the Majors over that span.

GOT YOUR NUMBER: INF Paul Goldschmidt has hit .500/.600/1.063 (8-for-16) with 3 doubles, 2HR and 4BB in his career against Toronto's LHP Patrick Corbin...**INF/OF Cody Bellinger** has batted .423/.483/.462 (11-for-26) with 1 double and 3BB in his career against Corbin...**INF Ryan McMahon** owns a career .368/.368/.421 (7-for-19) slash line with 1 double vs. Corbin.

TO THE LEFT, TO THE LEFT: The Yankees are 16-6 when facing a left-handed starter this season...have won 14 of their last 16 games when facing a left-handed starter (since 4/18) and 15 of their last 19 games (since 4/13).

SCHLITT'S CREEK: RHP Cam Schlittler allowed only 1R/ER in 7.0IP in a no-decision on Saturday at Toronto (6H, 4BB, 7K, 1HR)...**has gone 7-3 with a 1.82 ERA (89.0IP, 18ER) and 96K in 15 starts, holding opponents to a .195/.238/.294 (63-for-323) slash line.**

- **His 1.82 ERA is the lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher through his first 15 starts of a season in the last 42 years (since 1985) and the seventh-lowest in the last 82 years (since 1945),** trailing only Allie Reynolds (1.47 ERA in 1952), Ron Guidry (1.50 ERA in 1978), Whitey Ford (2x: 1.53 ERA in 1964 and 1.66 ERA in 1958), Phil Niekro (1.71 ERA in 1984) and Spud Chandler (a lower 1.82 ERA in 1946).
- Joins Ron Guidry (1.50 ERA and 112K in first 15GS in 1978) as the only two pitchers in franchise history to post as low of an ERA and record at least 90K through their first 15 starts of a season.

- **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in 11 of his starts this season,** the most in the Majors.
- **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in nine of his last 11 starts (since 4/17), going 5-2 with a 1.60 ERA (67.1IP, 12ER) and 66K in that span.**

- According to *Elias*, **his 2.33 ERA is the third-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through their first 29 career starts** (ignoring relief appearances and excluding openers), trailing only Stan Bahnsen (2.09 ERA from 1966-68) and Bill Stafford (2.20 ERA from 1960-61)...**also marks the lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher whose first 29 career appearances were all starts and the third-lowest by any Major League pitcher since 1913 (when ER became an official stat),** trailing only Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (2.06 ERA) and Miami's José Fernández (2.17 ERA).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP WILL WARREN (7-1, 3.41 ERA)

RHP Will Warren will make his 14th start of the season in today's series finale at Toronto...the 26-year-old will pitch on extended five days' rest due to Thursday's team off day...made his 13th start of the season on Monday at Cleveland and did not record a decision after tossing 4.1IP (4H, 3R/ER, 2BB, 5K, 0HR, 1HP, 1WP)...**is 3-0 with a 3.33 ERA (27.0IP, 23H, 13R/10ER, 10BB, 22K, 1HR) over his last five starts (since 5/12)...the Yankees are 5-0 in those starts...**...is 7-1 with a 3.41 ERA (68.2IP, 62H, 34R/26ER, 21BB, 75K, 7HR) in 13 starts this season...the Yankees have won 11 of his 13 starts...**his 32 starts of 2ER-or-fewer are tied for the most in the AL and tied for the third-most in the Majors since 2025...the Yankees' 28 wins in his starts since 2025 are the most in the AL and the fourth-most in the Majors...**...last season, went 9-8 with a 4.44 ERA (162.1IP, 158H, 90R/80ER, 65BB, 171K, 22HR) in 33 starts, allowing 2ER-or-fewer in 22 of those starts...**according to Elias, his 22 starts of 2ER-or-fewer were the second-most by a Yankees rookie in a single season**, trailing only Stan Bahnsen (25GS in 1968)...is 10-4 with a 3.55 ERA (132.0IP, 124H, 68R/52ER, 39BB, 129K, 18HR) over his last 25 starts (since 7/25/25) after going 6-8 with a 5.92 ERA (121.2IP, 129H, 83R/80ER, 57BB, 146K, 16HR) over his first 27 career games (26 starts) from 7/30/24-7/19/25...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 19 of his last 25 starts...saw his first Major League action with the Yankees in 2024, going 0-3 with a 10.32 ERA (22.2IP, 33H, 27R/26ER, 10BB, 29K, 5HR) in six games (five starts) over five stints with the club (7/30, 8/7, 8/14, 8/21-31, 9/28)...was selected by the Yankees in the eighth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Southeastern Louisiana University.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his 13th start of the season on Monday at Cleveland and did not record a decision after tossing 4.1IP (4H, 3R/ER, 2BB, 5K, 0HR, 1HP, 1WP).

2026: Is 7-1 with a 3.41 ERA (68.2IP, 62H, 34R/26ER, 21BB, 75K, 7HR) in 13 starts this season...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 10 of his 13 starts...his 10 starts of 2ER-or-fewer are tied for the fourth-most in the AL.

- ★ Has allowed 2BB-or-fewer in nine of his 13 starts this season, including 1BB-or-fewer in seven of those starts...his seven starts of 1BB-or-fewer are tied for the 10th-most in the AL...has issued just 21BB to 291 batters faced.
- ★ Is tied for 10th in the Majors in wins (seven, tied for fifth in AL)...also ranks eighth in K/9.0IP (9.83) and ninth in strikeout rate (25.8%) among AL pitchers (min 60.0IP).
- ★ Is holding right-handed batters to a .220/.273/.331 (26-for-118) slash line this season.
- ★ Has recorded at least 6K in seven of his 13 starts this season.
- ★ Has allowed one-or-zero HR in 11 of his 13 starts this season, including eight starts without allowing a HR...is allowing only 0.92 HR/9.0IP.
- ★ The Yankees are 11-2 in his starts, tied for the most wins in a pitchers starts in the Majors (tied for the most in the AL).
- ★ **Is 3-0 with a 3.33 ERA (27.0IP, 23H, 13R/10ER, 10BB, 22K, 1HR) over his last five starts (since 5/12)...the Yankees are 5-0 in those starts.**
- ★ Went 4-0 with a 2.39 ERA (37.2IP, 32H, 15R/10ER, 8BB, 46K, 4HR) in his first seven starts of the season (3/28-5/1)...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in each of those seven starts...the Yankees won six of those seven starts.
- ★ Allowed 2ER-or-fewer in each of his first seven starts this season (3/28-5/1), the most in the Majors in that span (most in the AL)...was only the seventh Yankees pitcher (eighth time) in the last 66 years (since 1961) to allow 2ER-or-fewer in each of his first seven starts of a season (excluding openers), joining Max Fried (first 11GS in 2025), Michael King (first 8GS in 2023), Gerrit Cole (2x: first 8GS in 2021 and first 7GS in 2023), Nestor Cortes (first 7GS in 2022), Michael Pineda (first 9GS in 2014) and Hideki Irabu (first 7GS in 1998).
- ★ Recorded at least 6K in six straight starts (4/13-5/12), posting a 12.40 K/9.0IP (45K/32.2IP) over that span...marked a career long streak...was one of only three Yankees (fifth time) in the last seven years (since 2020) to record six-or-more strikeouts in at least six straight games, joining Cam Schlichter (9GS from 9/11/25-4/17/26) and Gerrit Cole (3x: 15GS from 8/8/20-G1-4/30/21, 11GS from 6/22-9/1/21 and 12GS from 6/14/22-8/15/22).
- ★ Made his fifth start of the season and earned his second win of the year on 4/18 vs. Kansas City after allowing only 2R/ER over 7.0 innings (5H, 0BB, 11K, 1HR, 1PO)...**his 11K tied his career high (also 11K on 6/17/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL)**...marked his third career double-digit strikeout game (also 11K on 6/17/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL and 10K on 5/20/25 vs. Texas)...marked the second time in his career he has recorded at least 10K without surrendering a walk (also 11K and 0BB 6/17/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL)...no other Yankee had done so since Warren last accomplished the feat on 6/17/25...his 7.0 innings marked the second-longest start of his career (7.1IP on 5/9/25 at the Athletics)...also marked his sixth career start with 0BB and his second this season (last on 4/3 vs. Miami).

ROAD TRIPPIN': Is making his seventh road start of the season today...**is 3-0 with a 2.78 ERA (32.1IP, 10ER) and 28K in six road starts this year...the Yankees have won each of his six road starts this season.**

- ★ Has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in five of his six road starts this season.
- ★ Each of his last three starts have been on the road (since 5/25)...has gone 1-0 with a 2.76 ERA (16.1IP, 4ER) and 13K in those starts.
- ★ Is 4-2 with a 2.89 ERA (62.1IP, 20ER) and 49K over his last 12 road starts (since 8/5/25).

VS. TORONTO/AL EAST: Will make his third career regular season start vs. the Blue Jays today...made his second career appearance vs. the Blue Jays earlier this season at Yankee Stadium on 5/19 and recorded the win (5.0IP, 6H, 3R/ER, 1BB, 3K, 0HR).

- ★ In his only career start at the Rogers Centre, tossed 4.0IP on 7/2/25 (10H, 8R/ER, 4BB, 4K, 2HR).
- ★ Tossed 4.2IP in relief at Toronto in 2025 ALDS Game 2 (4.2IP, 7H, 6R/ER, 1BB, 4K, 4HR).
- ★ Is 3-0 with a 3.18 ERA (17.0IP, 6ER) and 18K in three starts vs. the AL East this season.

2025: In his first full Major League season, went 9-8 with a 4.44 ERA (162.1IP, 158H, 90R/80ER, 65BB, 171K, 22HR)...opponents batted .250/.320/.418 (158-for-631, 22HR); LH .266/.350/.436 (91-for-342, 12HR); RH .232/.283/.398 (67-for-289, 10HR).

- ★ Was tied for second in the Majors in starts (33, tied for first in AL)...also ranked eighth in the AL in K/9.0IP (9.48).
- ★ Was just the third Yankees rookie to make at least 33 starts in a season, joining Stan Bahnsen (34GS in 1968), and Russ Ford (33GS in 1910)...was also the first Major League rookie to make at least 33 starts in a single season since 2009 (Nick Blackburn, 33GS with Minnesota in 2008)
