RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a seven-game homestand against the Orioles (0-4) and Cubs (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...have lost four straight games following a three-game winning streak...are 6-7 in their last 13 games on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak from May 19-25...are 6-13 in their last 19 contests after posting an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 from May 3-18...have fallen a season-high 15.0 games back in the AL East standings, their largest deficit since entering play on Aug. 3, 2022 (15.0)... the Rays are 0-4 so far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26.

Yesterday, Tampa Bay suffered its third sweep of the year, joining April 26-28 at Chicago-AL and May 20-22 vs. Boston...it marked the Rays first time being swept in a four-game series since June 17-20, 2021 at Seattle, and their first at home since June 30-July 3, 2016 vs. Detroit.

Tampa Bay has led entering the 7th inning just twice in its last 20 games, both coming from June 4-5 at Miami...the Rays have trailed by 3+ runs at some point in seven of their last eight games.

Tonight, the Rays look to avoid their second home losing streak of 5+ games this season (6G, May 12-25)...Tampa Bay has not had multiple home losing streaks of 5+ games in a season since 2018 (6G, April 30-May 15 & 5G, May 6-23).

The Rays 10-4 (.714) mark in Interleague play is second best in the majors behind the Phillies (9-2/.818).

PRETTY EFLIN GOOD—Zach Eflin has not issued a walk to his last 129 batters faced, the second-longest streak in Rays history behind Corey Kluber (150, 2022)...per Elias, his 30.2 inning walk-less streak ranks third in club history behind David Price (35.1IP, July 19-Aug. 9, 2013) and Kluber (35.1 IP, Aug. 17-Sept. 21, 2022).

Eflin has walked two batters or fewer in 45 straight starts dating to June 14, 2022, tied with SEA George Kirby for the longest active streak in the majors...42 of those starts came with the Rays...since 2010, only three starters have longer streaks: Phil Hughes (64GS), Clayton Kershaw (47GS) and Michael Pineda (46GS).

If he walks two batters or fewer tonight, Eflin will surpass Andy Sonnanstine (42GS; Aug. 5, 2007–Sept. 21, 2008) for the most consecutive starts with two walks or fewer in franchise history.

POSITIVE VIBES—Isaac Paredes' .360 (18-for-50) batting average in Interleague play is third highest in the majors (min. 50AB) behind NYY Aaron Judge (.394) and MIL Brice Turang (.373)...he has eight multi-hit efforts in 13 games against NL foes this year, adding three doubles, two home runs and 12 RBI.

Yandy Díaz has reached base safely in a season-high 13 straight games, his longest streak since Sept. 8-21, 2023 (also 13G)...he last reached base safely in 14 consecutive games from July 5-28, 2023 (14G)...he has multiple hits in a season-high-tying three straight games (also May 3-5)...he last did so in four straight contests during a career-best six-game run from Aug. 16-23, 2023.

Amed Rosario is a career .363 (33-for-91) hitter with 4 2B and 10 RBI in 23 games against the Cubs...min. 50 AB, only ATL Ozzie Albies (.391) owns a higher mark among active players.

POWER OUTAGE—The Rays have hit 4 HR through eight games in June, tied with Colorado and Milwaukee for the fewest in the majors...their 50 HR overall this season are the fewest in the majors, with the next closest being Miami and Washington (both 52HR).

Entering play on June 11, 2023, Tampa Bay's 111 HR were tied with Los Angeles-NL for the MLB lead.

The Rays 50 HR are their fourth fewest through 66 games in franchise history, ahead of the clubs from 2003 (45HR), 1998 (48HR) and 2014 (49HR).

Tampa Bay's 155 XBH are third fewest in the majors, ahead of Miami (145XBH) and Washington (153XBH).

The Rays have 1 XBH or fewer in a season-high-tying three consecutive games (also April 29–May-1)...prior to this season, Tampa Bay had not gone three straight games with 1 XBH or fewer since July 28-30, 2020 (3G)...the last time the Rays went four straight games with 1 XBH or fewer was franchise-high-tying five-game stretch from June 26–July 1, 2018.

NO HOME COOKING—The Rays are 4-13 (.235) at home since May 8, tied with the Mets for the worst mark in the majors...they have been outscored, 88-47 (-41), in those contests, going 4-3 when scoring 4+ runs compared to 0-10 with three runs or fewer...it marks their worst 16-game stretch at Tropicana Field since July 21-Aug. 19, 2017 (also 4-13).

A Tampa Bay starting pitcher has not earned a win in 14 straight home games, with Zach Littell earning the last victory on May 11 vs. New York-AL.

The Rays have allowed 2+ HR in four straight home games for the first time since May 20-23, 2023...they are one game shy of matching the franchise record of five games from July 2-6, 2019.

**TWO-OUT TROUBLES**—Tampa Bay pitching has posted a .249 opp. AVG with two outs, the third-highest mark in the majors, ahead of only Colorado (.276) and Chicago-AL (.264)...Rays starters have allowed opponents to hit .264 with two outs, third highest among MLB rotations, ahead of Colorado (.280) and Los Angeles-AL (.264)...Tampa Bay relievers have posted a .230 opp. AVG with two outs, the ninth-highest clip in the majors.

BOTTOMS UP-Opposing nine-hole hitters are batting .272 against Tampa Bay, the

highest mark in the majors, with the next closest teams being Colorado (262) and Philadelphia (248)...nine-hole hitters have homered seven times against the Rays, tied for the most in MLB with Chicago-AL, Miami, New York-AL and St. Louis.

In yesterday's series finale vs. Baltimore, nine-spot hitter C James McCann went 2-for-3 with a homer, one walk and two runs...Oriole nine-hole hitters went a combined 5-for-14 (357) with 1 2B, 1 3B and 1 HR en route to their four-game sween.

GETTING DEFENSIVE—Per Sports Info Solutions, the Rays -27 Defensive Runs Saved are second fewest in the majors, ahead of only Chicago-AL (-49)...the catching position is the only group to receive a positive mark (1 DRS).

Despite an active five-game streak without an error, Tampa Bay is 16-25 when they do not commit an error, compared to 15-10 when they have 1+ miscue.

NORTH SIDERS IN ST. PETE—Tampa Bay and Chicago kick off a three-game set tonight at Tropicana Field...the Cubs took two of three from the Rays last season at Wrigley Field from May 29-31...each game was decided by one run...RHP Marcus Stroman tossed a complete game, one-hit shutout in the series opener.

Tonight's contest marks only the 20th game between the two franchises, with Tampa Bay holding an 11-8 edge in the all-time series...the Cubs have played just two series at Tropicana Field: a two-game set from Sept. 19-20, 2017 and a three-game series from June 17-19, 2008.

Tampa Bay's 19 games played vs. Chicago are its fewest against any opponent, with the next closest being Los Angeles-NL (20G) and Cincinnati/Pittsburgh/San Francisco (all 21G).

- After showcasing a 90+mph fastball in a U-15 World Baseball Cup matchup between Mexico and the United States in 2014, Tampa Bay 3B Isaac Paredes drew the interest of scouts and was ultimately signed by the Cubs for \$850,000 in July of 2015.
- Cubs LHP Drew Smyly started 49 games for the Rays between 2014-16, pitching to a 3.95 ERA, before being traded to the Mariners for a package that featured LHP Ryan Yarbrough.
- Triple-A Durham LHP Tyler

TONIGHT'S START-Eflin will take the mound for his 12th start of the season, including his fifth at home, in tonight's series opener...marks his second start since his May 20-June 5 stint on the 15-day IL (lower back inflammation)...is 2-0 with a 0.92 ERA (19.2IP, 2ER) over his last three home starts...the Rays have won each of his last four starts after losing five of his first seven...is 15 strikeouts shy of 800 for his career...has a 30.2 IP walk-less streak

**LAST TIME OUT**—Limited to 55 pitches in his first start back from the 15-day IL, Eflin did not factor into the decision of the Rays 5-3 win in Miami on June 5 (ND, 4.0IP, 3H, 2ER, 3SO)...allowed hits to three of the first five Marlins, resulting in a pair of 1st-inning tallies...settled in to retire each of his final 10 BF following the third hit before the Rays bullpen took over in the 5th inning...six of his 12 outs were groundouts. NORTH SIDERS IN THE SOUTH—Eflin is 2-1 with a 2.63 ERA (37.2IP, 11ER) in six career starts opposite the Cubs, five of which came at Wrigley Field... has allowed 3 ER or fewer in all six outings...last season, he tossed a quality start in a 4-3 Rays win in Chicago on May 31 (6.0IP, 4H, 3ER, BB, 5SO)... since his Tampa Bay debut, he is 2-1 with a 2.76 ERA (32.2IP, 10ER) and 0.70 WHIP in five starts opposite NL Central clubs, four of which were quality.

**DOME SWEET DOME**—Since being tagged for a season-high six runs on Opening Day vs. TOR, Eflin has gone 2-0 with a 0.92 ERA (19.2IP, 2ER), 0.92 WHIP and .221/.231/.299 (17-for-77) opponent slash line over his last three home starts...he has tossed 6.0+ IP and allowed one or zero runs in each outing, the longest home streak by a Rays starter since **Tyler Glasnow** (3GS) from July 25–Sept. 6, 2023...the last longer streak belongs to **Shane McClanahan** (4GS) from June 9–July 13, 2022.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING—Eflin has walked two batters or fewer in 45 straight starts dating to June 14, 2022, tied with SEA George Kirby for the longest active streak in the majors...since 2010, only three starters have strung together longer streaks: Phil Hughes (64GS), Clayton Kershaw (47GS), Michael Pineda (46GS).

Of the 45 starts, 42 have come with the Rays, tying the franchise record set by Andy Sonnanstine from Aug. 5, 2007–Sept. 21, 2008.

Limited to 4.0 IP due to a pitch count, Eflin saw his streak of 18 consecutive 5.0+ innings starts snapped on June 5 at MIA...it was the third-longest active streak in the majors and the longest by a Ray since Chris Archer's franchise-record 51-start streak (2016-17).

He has not issued a walk to his last 129 BF, the second-longest streak in Rays history behind Corey Kluber (150, 2022)...his 30.2 IP walk-less streak ranks third (Elias):

QUALITY CONTROL—Min, 50.0 IP. Effin paces the majors in walk rate (1.5%), walks per 9.0 IP (0.57) and SO/BB ratio (11.75)...he has produced the lowest walk rate in the majors since 2020 (min. 1,750BF) at 3.8 pct., ahead of Zack Greinke (4.4%)...his 68.85 pct. strike rate since the beginning of last season ranks second in the majors (min. 200.0IP) behind SEA George Kirby (70.64%)...Eflin has walked one or zero batters in 35 of his 42 starts since the beginning of last season—only Kirby (40) has more such starts during that span that span.

IT'S A MARATHON—In innings 1-5, Eflin has posted a 3.00 ERA (54.0IP, 18ER) and held opponents to a .231 (48-for-208) average and .587 OPS... from the 6th inning on, he owns an 11.00 ERA (9.0IP, 11ER), .426 (20-for-47) opp. average and 1.279 opp. OPS.

When his pitch count resides between 1-60, opponents are 42-for-182 (.231) against him...once he surpasses the 60-pitch mark, opposing hitters are 26-for-73 (.356).

Opponents are batting a combined .209 (40-for-191) against Eflin the first two times through the order, including .174 (16-for-92) the second time through...opposing hitters have produced a 28-for-64 (.438) clip the third time through and beyond.
