RAY REPORT—The Rays begin a seven-game road trip against the Red Sox (four to play) and the Blue Jays (three to play) tonight at Fenway Park...tonight marks the second time since **Kevin Cash** was hired (2015-pres.) the Rays have appeared on ESPN exclusively, following a Sunday Night Baseball appearance on Aug. 1, 2021 vs. BOS...have won six straight and 12 of their last 13 games to move to 12 games over .500, their first time being at least a dozen games over .500 since concluding the 2023 season at 99-63...marks their best 13-game stretch since April 1-14, 2023 (12-1)...have won 19 of their last 24 games and are 22-7 in their last 29 games since April 4, recording the majors' best record and ERA (3.02) in that span...are 6-0 on a stretch of 14 games in as many days (May 1-13), the final leg in a stretch of 28 games in a 30-day window (April 14-May 13)...according to Stats Perform, it is the second-most wins to open a calendar month in franchise history behind April 2023 (12G)...own MLB's fourth-best record behind the Braves (26-12/.684), Yankees (25-12/.676), and Cubs (25-12/.676)...marks the fourth-best start in franchise history (see table on the right)...are 0.5 GB the Yankees for first in the AL East, spending 23 straight days in first or second since April 14... have spent six days leading the division, 23 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

- ✦ The Rays shut out the Blue Jays, 3-0, to complete their MLB-best fifth sweep of the season and a 6-0 homestand...per Stats Perform, it marked the third time the Rays have swept a multi-series homestand along with April 7-13, 2023 (OAK, BOS) and Aug. 20-26, 2018 (KC, BOS).
- ✦ The shutout was the third spun by the Rays this season, each coming within their last eight contests...the Rays, Orioles, and Twins are the only teams in the majors that have not been shut out in 2026.
- ✦ It was also the Rays 10th win without homering, surpassing the Brewers for most in the majors...they are the only AL team and one of five MLB clubs with a winning record when hitting 0 HR (10-7).
- ✦ The Rays are the seventh team in the modern era (since 1900) to begin a season 16-2 or better in intraleague games, and the first since the 1987 Milwaukee Brewers (17-1)...the only other clubs to do so are the 1984 Detroit Tigers (16-2), 1981 Oakland Athletics (17-1), 1955 Brooklyn Dodgers (16-2), 1918 New York Giants (17-1), and the 1911 Detroit Tigers (16-2).
- ✦ The Rays are 6-0 against the AL East, their longest winning streak against divisional opponents to a season...they are the second AL team to start a season 6-0 against their own division since 2004, joining the 2015 Tigers (7-0), according to Stats Perform.
- ✦ This marks the third time the Rays have won six consecutive games or more in 2026...they are responsible for three of the 10 total such streaks in MLB this season.
- ✦ **Griffin Jax** will start on the mound for the Rays this evening, his 19th career start and third of the campaign after being used as an opener on April 26 vs. MIN and May 2 vs. SF...across those two outings, he pitched 5.0 scoreless frames with a 0.80 WHIP.

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS—The Rays 8-1 record vs. left-handed starting pitchers is the best in the majors...they have won eight straight games when opposed by southpaw starters, their longest streak since Aug. 9-Sept. 6, 2020 (8G)...their last longer streak was a franchise record of 11 straight wins was set from May 30-July 11, 2015...the club has the lowest whiff rate against southpaws in the majors at 18.1 pct., missing on 132 of 731 swings.

- ✦ **Jake Bennett** threw his sinker at a 31.8 rate in his MLB debut on May 1 vs. HOU...the Rays are batting .335 vs. sinkers, second in the majors to the Cubs (.341).
- ✦ **Ryan Vilade** is 10-for-23 (.435) vs. LHP since April 11 to improve his season-long mark to .323 (10-for-31), 10th in the AL (min. 30AB).

THE RAY WAY—The Rays staff has yielded three runs or fewer in a franchise record 13 consecutive games...it marks the majors' longest single-season streak since the Astros (13G) from April 30-May 13, 2022 before they went on to win the World Series...extending the streak to 14 games tonight would mark the 15th time a club has done so in a single season the live ball era (since 1920) and the longest since the Giants had a 18-game streak between Sept. 5-24, 2010 en route to a World Series title...the Rays have permitted 17 runs during the streak, fewest over any 13-game stretch in franchise history...the fewest allowed over a 14-game span is 23 (July 19-Aug. 3, 2012)...the Rays have held opponents to one or zero runs 10 times, tied with the Tigers for most in MLB.

- ✦ Rays pitchers have yielded 1 HR in their last 78.0 IP...they have permitted one long ball in their last eight games, tied for their fewest over any eight-game span (13x, last: Aug. 5-13, 2014).
- ✦ The rotation's 3.10 ERA (182.2IP, 63ER) ranks third in the majors behind the Dodgers (2.97) and Yankees (2.98)...this includes an MLB-best 1.38 ERA (71.2IP, 11ER) in their last 13 outings (April 22-pres.).
- ✦ The Rays bullpen has tossed 17.1 consecutive scoreless frames and has yielded one run in the last 32.2 IP...the pen's 0.99 ERA (45.1IP, 5ER) over the last 13 games since April 22 is the best in MLB.
- ✦ The Rays have not blown a lead in any of their last 15 games...they led in each of their first five losses (Opening Day-April 3), but since have one blown lead loss in their last 29 games...they are the only team in the majors that has not lost a game when leading through five innings (18-0).

HERE'S JONNY—**Jonathan Aranda** went 11-for-19 (.579) with 12B and 4 RBI last homestand, including a career-high-tying four straight multi-hit games between May 2-5 (also: May 26-29, 2025)...min. 20 AB, it marked the third-highest average by a Ray in a single homestand behind **Yandy Diaz** (.591, Sept. 15-21, 2025) and **Greg Norton** (.588, Aug. 15-24, 2006) from Sept. 15-21, 2025 (Elias)...Aranda's 29 RBI are tied for the most in the AL with **NY Aaron Judge**...after leading the AL entering play on May 6, he became the fifth Ray (6x) to lead the AL in RBI at the end of play on any day after the calendar flips to May, joining **Austin Meadows** in 2021 (latest date: June 10), **Ben Zobrist** in 2011 (May 5), **Evan Longoria** in 2010 (May 22) and 2009 (June 9), and **Ty Wigginton** in 2006 (May 5)...he is pacing for 47 RBI by the end of May, which would mark the second-highest total in franchise history behind Longoria (55) in 2009...the Rays have won the last seven games in which he has driven in a run.

MILESTONE WATCH—**Yandy Diaz** enters play tonight with 998 career hits, two shy of becoming the 20th Cuban-born player in major league history to reach 1,000...he has 104 HR with the Rays, tied with **Carl Crawford** for seventh most in franchise history...his 283 XBH as a Ray are tied with **Carlos Peña** for seventh most by a Ray...he has 271 multi-hit games across his tenure in Tampa Bay, one shy of matching **Ben Zobrist** (272G) for third in club history behind **Crawford** (444G) and **Evan Longoria** (375G).

- ✦ After his game-tying single in the 8th inning Tuesday vs. TOR, Diaz is batting an MLB-best .565 (13-for-23) in the 8th inning or later...min. 50 AB, his .366 (83-for-227) average in such situations since the start of 2024 is the best in the majors, ahead of **KC Bobby Witt, Jr.** (.358).

THE GREAT GREEN JEWEL OF THE COMMONWEALTH—The Rays and Red Sox begin a 13-game season series tonight, with the clubs meeting again in Boston after the All-Star break on July 17-19 (3G) and at Tropicana Field between June 8-10 (3G) and Sept. 18-20 (3G)...despite outscoring the Red Sox, 59-58, in their meetings last year, the Rays were 3-10 in those contests and 0-5 in one-run games.

- ✦ **Yandy Diaz** has tallied 102 hits against the Red Sox in his time with the Rays, third most by any Ray in club history behind **Evan Longoria** (184) and **Carl Crawford** (181)...he has also reached base at a .417 clip in his 83 career games against the club, third best in team history (min. 50AB), behind **Wade Boggs** (.422) and **Brandon Guyer** (.421)...Diaz has reached base in each of his last 14 contests (Sept. 28, 2024-pres.) against the Red Sox and has slashed .377/.468/.566 (20-for-53) over that span.
- ✦ **Taylor Walls** has hit safely in each of his last eight games against Boston (April 15, 2025-pres.), the longest active streak by a Ray...his nine-game on-base streak against the Red Sox is the second-longest active streak behind Diaz's 14-game streak.

WINNING IS CONTAGIOUS—Entering play today, the Rays have played 21 games against teams currently .500 or better this season, tied for fourth-most in the majors with the Rangers, behind only the Nationals (23) and Pirates (22)...their 10-11 (.476) record in such games is the third best in the AL, trailing the Tigers (8-7/.533) and Guardians (9-9/.500)...the AL-leading Yankees are tied for the fewest games against teams currently .500 or better with six (also: ATL & SD), while holding the third worst record in such games (1-5/.167)...the Rays hold a major league-best 14-1 (.933) record in games against teams currently below .500.

TONIGHT'S START—Griffin Jax will toe the rubber tonight for his third start and 14th appearance of the year, including his first start and ninth outing on the road...marks his third straight start after pitching out of the bullpen in each of his first 11 appearances...is the 19th start of his major league career and his 10th on the road, including his first since Sept. 10, 2025 at CWS...has thrown 5.0 scoreless frames across his two starts this season...acquired from the Twins for RHP Taj Bradley on July 31, 2025.

LAST TIME OUT—Worked a season-high 2.2 IP in his second start of the campaign on May 2 vs. SF (2.2IP, H, BB, 2SO)...retired six of seven batters through the first two innings, allowing only a Luis Arraez single in the opening frame...issued a leadoff walk in the 3rd ahead of a strikeout and lineup before giving way to bulk reliever Jesse Scholtens, who escaped the inning with a ground out.

★ He recorded a season-high eight swings-and-misses, his most since July 8, 2025 vs. CHC as a member of the Twins...held Giants hitters to 0-for-5 with four whiffs and 1 SO on his four-seam fastball.

BEANTOWN RUNDOWN—Jax is 0-1 with a 7.27 ERA (17.1IP, 14ER) in 14 career appearances (1 start) opposite the Red Sox...he made his seventh career start at Fenway Park on Aug. 24, 2021 and was tagged for career highs in runs (9) and homers (3) in an 11-9 Twins loss...excluding that outing, he has a 3.55 ERA (12.2IP, 5ER) and 0.95 WHIP in his other 13 appearances against Boston, striking out 18 without issuing a walk...this includes a 3.18 ERA (5.2IP, 2ER) in four appearances at Fenway since the start.

★ Jax is 3-6 with a 4.81 ERA (73.0IP, 39ER) in 61 career appearances (3 starts) against AL East opponents...however, he has turned in a 1.23 ERA (7.1IP, 1ER) and 0.68 WHIP across eight outings vs. the division since joining the Rays, working out of the bullpen in all eight times.

COUNTRY ROADS—Jax is 1-2 with an 8.53 ERA (6.1IP, 6ER) over eight relief appearances on the road this season, with half (3) of those earned runs coming on April 1 at MIL...opponents are batting .360 (9-for-25) against him on the road compared to .120 (3-for-25) at Tropicana Field...he is 2-2 with a 5.97 ERA (37.2IP, 25ER) across nine career starts away from home.

ROLE CALL—This marks the first time Jax has been a regular starter since his 2021 rookie season with the Twins, when he made his final 14 appearances as a member of the Twins rotation after his first four came in relief...he started two games for the Rays last season, working as an opener for Ian Seymour on Sept. 5 vs. CLE before starting a bullpen game on Sept. 10, 2025 at CWS...both starts lasted 1.0 scoreless frame...for his career, he is 3-5 with a 5.54 ERA (76.1IP, 47ER) in 18 starts compared to 21-28 with a 3.70 ERA (294.1IP, 121ER) in 294 relief appearances.

★ Jax spent his first five professional seasons (2016-19, 2021) as a starter...he first transitioned to a full-time relief role in 2022...from 2016-21, 50 of his 55 minor league appearances were starts.

MLB CAREER RECAP—Last season, made a career-high 73 appearances (2 starts), tied for sixth most in the AL, between the Twins (50G) and Rays (23G), going a combined 1-7 with a 4.23 ERA (66.0IP, 31ER)...also set career bests in strikeouts (99) and holds (28)...acquired at the July 31 trade deadline for RHP Taj Bradley...of his 99 strikeouts, 97 came as a reliever, fourth most in the AL behind HOU Bryan Abreu (105), CLE Cade Smith (104), and teammate Edwin Uceta (103)...min. 250 BF, ranked second in the majors in chase rate (38.1%) behind CIN Graham Ashcraft (38.3%) and was fifth in whiff rate (37.3%)...joined Abreu as the only pitchers in the majors to make 70 appearances or more each season from 2023-25...his 216 appearances in that timeframe ranked third to SF/NYM Tyler Rogers (226G) and Abreu (220G).

★ In 2024, received the Joseph W. Haynes Award as Twins Pitcher of the Year, as voted on by the Twin Cities chapter of the BBWAA...became the first Minnesota pitcher to record 10 saves and 20 holds in a season.

★ In 2023, made the Twins Opening Day roster for the first time and spent the year in the club's bullpen...tied for ninth in the AL with a team-leading 23 holds...led the majors with a 3.3 pct. barrel rate (min. 250BF).

★ In 2022, transitioned to a relief role for the first time after spending his first six professional seasons (2016-21) as a starter...led the Twins bullpen in innings (72.1), tied for the team lead in holds (18), and ranked second in appearances (65)...began the season with Triple-A St. Paul after spending spring training with the Twins...made one appearance before being recalled April 12 when Jorge Alcala was placed on the injured list, remaining with the big-league club through season's end.

★ Made his major league debut in 2021 across four stints with the Twins: June 5-16, June 24-July 7, July 19-20, and July 30-end of season...maintained a regular spot in the rotation during his season-ending stint with the club...named the recipient of the Bob Feller Act of Valor Award, given annually to the major leaguer who best embodies the spirit of the late Hall of Famer, both in terms of commitment to country and love for baseball.

CAPTAIN JAX—Jax is currently a Captain in the U.S. Air Force Reserve, earning the promotion in June 2021, and remains the only Air Force Academy graduate to play in the majors...after his graduation from the Academy in 2017, he made five starts with Class-A Cedar Rapids and Rookie-level Elizabethton during his 60-day leave ahead of his first active duty assignment, departing on July 22 to begin his role as an acquisitions officer working with civilian contractors such as SpaceX and Boeing...the following year, he was accepted into the Air Force World Class Athlete Program, which allows soldiers to train for the upcoming Olympic Games as their active duty job responsibility for a two-year period, allowing him to continue his baseball career while completing his active duty requirement...became eligible for the program when baseball was readmitted for the scheduled 2020 Tokyo Olympics.

★ He completed his active duty requirement and was admitted to the Air Force Reserve in November 2019...was notified of his promotion to Captain on June 5, 2021, the same day he was selected to the Twins major league roster ahead of his MLB debut three days later.
