Cincinnati Reds (7-5-2) vs Cleveland Guardians (4-9-1)

TODAYS GAME: Is the second of **4** spring meetings between the **Reds** and their **Goodyear neighbors**... during the regular season the **Ohio Cup rivals** will meet **6/11-6/12** at **Cin** and **9/24-9/25** at **Cle**.

 The Reds are 26-24-7 vs Cle in the Cactus League (1-0 in 2024) and 58-73 all-time during the regular season vs the Guardians, including 13-23 over the last 8 seasons.

DESERT DANDIES:

- Reds pitchers have issued just 35 walks through the team's first 14 games, the fewest by any Major League team...the staff's FIP (3.29, 3rd), WHIP (1.24, 5th), HR allowed (12, T5th), and Strikeouts per 9 innings (10.09, 5th) also rank among all Major League leaders.
- Reds baserunners have 23 stolen bases, the second-most in the Majors behind LAA (29).
- SS Elly De La Cruz (8-for-20, 1 2b, 1 3b, 1hr, 7r, 4rbi, 5bb, 3sb) leads the Reds with 8 hits though the team's first 14 Cactus League games...he's hit safely in each of his last 5g.
- 1B Christian Encarnacion-Strand, OF Stuart Fairchild, and C Tyler Stephenson lead the team with 2 HR apiece...Encarnacion-Strand has 2 triples.
- Including Fri's rainout at LAD, RHP Nick Martinez has allowed 1 unearned run over 9.0 innings (2h, 1bb, 13k).

RAINED OUT: Fri's cancellation in the middle of the fifth inning at LAD was the Reds' 10th rainout in 15 years in Arizona, their first Cactus League rainout since 3/15/23 vs Chc at Goodyear Ballpark.

CRUZ MISSILE: SS Elly De La Cruz on Sat at Col belted a 470-foot home run off RHP Cal Quantrill.

- De La Cruz and NYY's Spencer Jones (2/24 off Det's RHP Mason Englert) are the only 2 players
 on record this spring to hit home runs measuring at least 470 feet...Jones' HR off Det's RHP Mason
 Englert on 2/24 also traveled 470 feet.
- Sat's 470-foot homer is the longest HR on record of De La Cruz's career...In 2023, while with Cin, he hit 4 HRs that traveled at least 450-feet, including a 467-foot blast on 9/26 off Cle's Xzavion Curry... he hit 3 HRs last year with AAA-Louisville that met or eclipsed the 450-foot mark.

- 2/17: RHP Levi Stoudt was claimed off waivers by the Seattle Mariners.
- 2/24: signed to minor league contracts and invited to Major League Spring Training camp INF Mike Ford (#38) and INF/OF Tony Kemp (#12).
- 3/7: reassigned to minor league camp RHP Julian Aguiar, INF Edwin Arroyo, INF Tyler Callihan,
 OF Blake Dunn, LHP Jacob Heatherly, RHP Rhett Lowder, RHP Zach Maxwell, C Mat Nelson,
 RHP Chase Petty, LHP Reiver Sanmartin, C Michael Trautwein, and C Daniel Vellojin.
- 3/8: reassigned to minor league camp and optioned to AAA-Louisville RHP Casey Legumina, RHP Christian Roa, RHP Carson Spiers, OF Rece Hinds and OF Jacob Hurtubise...INF Noelvi Marte received an 80-game suspension for testing positive for a performance-enhancing substance in violation of Major League Baseball's Joint Drug Prevention and Treatment Program.
- 3/9: reassigned to minor league camp and optioned to AAA-Louisville RHP Lyon Richardson...
 INF/OF Jose Barrero was claimed off waivers by the Texas Rangers.

SPRING FORWARD: At 2:00 a.m. ET this morning, Cincinnati moved 3 hours ahead of Goodyear as Daylight Saving Time began...in the spring of 1918, DST was enacted by the U.S. government as a way to save coal during World War I and was meant to exist only during wartime...although the practice technically ended later that same year, many regions continued to follow DST until the government put the measure back in place in 1966...in 2007, Daylight Saving Time was expanded to about 65% of the year because it reportedly saves energy, cuts down on traffic accidents and reduces crime...Hawaii and most of Arizona (including Goodyear) do not observe DST and thus did not "spring forward" 1 hour at 2:00 a.m. local time today, nor did the islands of American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico or Virgin Islands...according to news reports, 26 states are considering making Daylight Saving Time permanent, which would require approval by Congress.

OUT OF OPTIONS: The 8 players on the Reds' 40-man roster out of options include: INF Jeimer Candelario, OF Stuart Fairchild, RHP Buck Farmer, RHP Ian Gibaut, C Luke Maile, RHP Nick Martinez, RHP Frankie Montas and RHP Lucas Sims.

SPRING ROSTER: The Reds' Spring Training roster is currently at **44** players, including **22** pitchers, **4** catchers, **11** infielders, **7** outfielders, **32** players on the **40-man roster** and **12** non-roster invitees... The Reds began Major League camp with **62** players...Most recently, the Reds invited to Major League camp **65** (2023), **69** (2022), **60** (2021), **61** (2020), **63** (2019), **62** (2018), **65** (2017), **62** (2016), **64** (2015), **60** (2014), **58** (2013), **58** (2012), **54** (2011), **59** (2010), **63** (2009), **65** (2008), **58** (2007), **63** (2006), **55** (2005), **56** (2004), **64** (2003), **70** (2002), **58** (2001), **72** (2000), **54** (1999), **51** (1998), **55** (1997) and **59** (1996) players.

THE SKIPPER: David Bell is in his sixth season as a Major League manager (333-375, .470, 2020 Wild Card)...was hired on 10/22/18...on 9/22/21, the club announced a 2-year contract extension through 2023...on 7/28/23, the club announced a 3-year contract extension through 2026.

- David and his father, Buddy, comprise 1 of 5 father-son duos to serve as Major League managers, joining George & Dick Sisler, Bob & Joel Skinner, Bob & Aaron Boone and Felipe Alou & Luis Rojas... Buddy managed Det (1996-1998), Col (2000-2002) and KC (2005-2007).
- David previously spent 4 seasons in the Reds organization's player development department as a manager, at Class AA Carolina from 2009-2011 and at Class AAA Louisville in 2012.
