## AROUND THE HORN

**HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY!:** Today, the D-backs are honoring and celebrating all Moms with an exclusive giveaway Mother's Day Jersey, courtesy of Dignity Health, for the first 15,000 in attendance.

**PRESIDENT'S CIRCLE GRANTS:** During a special pregame ceremony last night, **Derrick Hall** and the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation celebrated the 63 Arizona nonprofits awarded with \$309,000 in Derrick Hall President's Circle Grants at the end of 2025... established in 1998 and renamed in 2024 in honor of Derrick Hall, whose long-standing leadership has helped expand the club's statewide community impact, the program has awarded a total of \$7.3 million in grants.

**HERE'S THE STORY:** With a win, the D-backs will seal the season series vs. Mets (4-2) and their first home series win vs. Mets since May 31-June 2, 2019 (2-1).

- The D-backs have won or split 4 of their 6 home series (won 3-0 vs. Tigers, split 2-2 vs. Braves, won 2-1 vs. Blue Jays, lost 1-2 vs. White Sox, split 1-1 vs. Padres in Mexico City, lost 1-2 vs. Pirates).
- The D-backs' .550 home win pct. (11-9 record) is tied for fifth in the NL (also: Pirates and Reds), behind the Cubs (.783, 18-5), Braves (.667, 12-6), Dodgers (.650, 13-7) and Brewers (.600, 12-8).
- The D-backs are 13-4 (.765) when leading after 5.0 innings, including 8-1 (.889) @ home.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 2-1 vs. Mets last night behind **Merrill Kelly's** 7.0-inning performance (1 ER, 3 H, 3 BB, 6 K).

- Down 1-0 with 2 outs in the third, 4 straight batters reached to manufacture the go-ahead runs... **Corbin Carroll** single, **Geraldo Perdomo** single, **Adrian Del Castillo** walk (on a 3-2 count) and **Ildemaro Vargas** 2-RBI single.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt** recorded 8 outfield putouts in his first career outfield start.
- **Taylor Clarke** (1.0 IP) tossed his fifth straight scoreless outing.
- **Paul Sewald** (1.0 IP) recorded his eighth save (8-for-8) in a perfect ninth inning with 2 strikeouts.

**WALDSCHMIDT IN THE HISTORY BOOKS:** **Ryan Waldschmidt's** 8 putouts on May 8 vs. Mets were the most all-time by a D-back in their first MLB outfield start (prev: Chris Young's 5 on Aug. 18, 2006 @ Padres) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

- Since 2000, Waldschmidt is 1 of 3 MLB players with 8+ outfield putouts in their first MLB outfield start, joining Randal Grichuk/STL (9 on April 29, 2014 vs. Brewers) and Josh Hamilton/CIN (8 on April 10, 2007 @ D-backs) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

**LOGGING INNINGS:** D-backs starters have logged 5 straight starts of 6.0+innings, the longest active streak in the Majors...last time with 5+ straight was from Sept. 1-7, 2025 (6 straight).

- For the first time since 2021, D-backs pitchers have posted back-to-back starts of 6.0+ innings, 1 or fewer runs, 3 or fewer hits and 6+ strikeouts...the D-backs have never had 3 straight such bids.

- All-time, the D-backs have 2 streaks of 3 straight games with starts of 6.0+ innings, 3 or fewer hits and 1 or fewer runs allowed (April 15-18, 2008 by Micah Owings, Brandon Webb and Dan Haren, and July 6-12, 2019 by Robbie Ray, Alex Young and Ray).

**ROLLIN' NOLAN:** **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 14 of his last 16 games, hitting .375 (18-for-48)/1.078 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 8 walks, including 7 games reaching base 2+ times.

- Since April 21, leads MLB third basemen [min. 50 PA] in OBP (1st, .472) and OPS (1st, 1.078), and ranks among third basemen in AVG (2nd, .375), SLG (3rd, .604), hits (T-3rd, 18), runs (T-4th, 11), homers (T-5th, 3) and total bases (T-4th, 29).

**¡BRAVO MORILLO!** **Juan Morillo's** 16-game home scoreless streak (14.0 IP) since June 30, 2025 is the longest active streak in the Majors.

- During the streak, is 1-0 with an opponent .149 AVG/.388 OPS, 0.64 WHIP, 2 walks and 15 strikeouts.

**PEN SPOTLIGHT:** In their last 8 games, since May 1, the D-backs' 1.54 ERA (5 R-4 ER in 23.1 IP) ranks best in the NL, ahead of the Padres (1.72), Dodgers (1.76) and Brewers (1.98)...second in MLB to the Rays (0.56).

- In their last 8 games, the D-backs' bullpen owns a MLB-best opponent .130 AVG (10-for-77)/.428 OPS and 0.73 WHIP with 7 walks and 19 strikeouts.
- The bullpen, in its last 6 home games, has a 1.06 ERA (3 R-2 ER in 17.0 IP), opponent .138 AVG (8-for-58)/.391 OPS, 1 walk and 13 strikeouts.

**HITTING AT CHASE:** **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 9 straight home starts, hitting .483 (14-for-29)/1.307 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 4 RBI and 6 walks.

- Has reached base in 12 of his last 14 home starts, hitting .400 (18-for-45)/1.113 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Ildemaro Vargas** in his 17 home games, is hitting .328 (21-for-64)/1.010 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 triples, 5 homers, 19 RBI and 1 walk.

**VS. METS:** The D-backs are 9-7 in their last 16 games since June 1, 2024.

**ON DECK - RANGERS:** The D-backs are 9-5 vs. Rangers in their last 14 matchups and have won 3 straight series, including their last on the road from Aug. 11-13, 2025 (2-1).

- Has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 5 of his 7 starts.
- Took the loss in a 1-0 defeat on May 6 vs. Pirates (1 ER in 6.1 IP, 7 H, 2 BB, 6 K).
- In 4 night starts (vs. DET, @ PHI, vs. TOR, vs. PIT), is 3-1 with a 2.63 ERA (7 ER in 24.0 IP), opponent .233 AVG, 5 walks and 31 strikeouts.
