RAY REPORT—The Rays conclude a nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Mets (3-0), White Sox (2-1) and Yankees (1-1, 1 to play) today at Tropicana Field...despite dropping two of their last three games, the Rays have still won six of their last eight contests after a 2-8 stretch from April 21-May 5 dropped them to a season-high four games below .500... the Rays, who are a season-high 7.0 games back in the AL East standings for the second straight day, have been at or within one game of the .500 mark for seven consecutive days.

The Rays recorded a season-high six extra-base hits in yesterday's 7-2 win over the Yankees, their most since Oct. 1, 2023 at TOR (7)... the top four spots in the Rays lineup went a combined 8-for-14 (.571) with 4 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 1 BB and 0 SO... the 5-9 hitters went 0-for-16 with 4 BB and 8 SO.

Rays pitching has produced an AL-best 2.25 ERA (64.0IP, 16ER) in seven games since May 4, second lowest in the majors behind the Dodgers (1.59)...this comes on the heels of pitching to a 5.72 ERA (94.1IP, 60ER) in their previous 11 games from April 21-May 3.

However, offense has dictated the Rays success through the club's first nine games in the month of May...Tampa Bay has scored 40 runs in its six wins (6.7 R/G) compared to two runs in its three losses (1.5 R/G).

Following today's series finale, the Rays will commence a seven-game road trip through Boston (4) and Toronto (3), starting tomorrow night at Fenway Park...the Rays and Red Sox will meet seven times over the next 10 days as part of the Rays current stretch of 13 consecutive games against AL East opponents.

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:

Claim their third consecutive series victory, matching their longest streak of the season (also April 5-14), on the heels of an 0-4-1 stretch in series play.

Improve to 4-3 in rubber games, recording their first win in a series-deciding contest since April 14 vs. SF.

Win their fourth consecutive home series over the Yankees, avoiding their first home series loss to New York since June 20-22, 2022...it would mark their longest streak over the Yankees since winning five straight from Sept. 26, 2011–April 24, 2013.

Move above the .500 mark for the first time since entering play on May 8 (19-18).

1-2 PUNCH—In yesterday's win, Yandy Díaz and Randy Arozarena went a combined 5-for-7 with 3 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBI and 5 R...entering the contest, the 2023 AL All-Stars had not recorded multiple hits in the same game since March 29 vs. TOR.

Díaz, who has gone 5-for-7 with 2 2B, 1 HR, 2 RBI and 1 BB in the current series, is hitting .394 (13-for-33) with a 1.004 OPS in his last eight games on the heels of an 0-for-15 skid...during that stretch, his season average has increased from .211 to .250 while his OPS has gone from .556 to .650.

Arozarena is in the midst of an 8-for-52 (.154) stretch in his last 15 games, but all eight hits have gone for extra bases...according to Elias, it marks the longest such streak for the Rays since Brandon Lowe recorded eight straight extra-base hits from June 27-July 11, 2021...Arozarena has 6 XBH (2 2B, 4 HR) in his last eight games overall, posting a 1.086 OPS over that timeframe.

ON-BASE PAREDES—Isaac Paredes owns a 21-game home on-base streak dating back to March 30, tied with LAA Mike Trout (21G) for the second-longest active streak in MLB behind CHC Ian Happ (22G)...he is slashing .333/.449/.611 (24-for-72) with 5 2B, 5 HR and 12 RBI during the run, drawing more walks (13) than strikeouts (10)...it marks the longest streak by a Ray since Yandy Diaz (21G) from May 2–June 25, 2023...the last longer streak is owned by Randy Arozarena (33G, April 12–June 24, 2023)...Paredes has reached safely in 11 straight games overall, batting .395 (15-for-38) with 8 BB and 3 SO in that span.

RELIEF RENAISSANCE—Over eight games on the current homestand, the Rays bullpen has produced a 1.36 ERA (33.0IP, 5ER), holding opponents scoreless in 23.0 of 28.0 IP... since April 16, the bullpen's 2.94 ERA (88.2IP, 29ER) is third best in the AL behind the Yankees (2.35) and Red Sox (2.84)...over the same span, they also rank highly among AL bullpens in WHIP (2nd, 1.09), opp. average (2nd, 196), opp. OBP (2nd, 288), opp. OPS (3rd, 604), opp. SLG (4th, 316) and inherited runners scored percentage (T4th, 25.0%)...they entered that stretch with a majors'-worst 6.92 ERA (67.2IP, 52ER).

**LHP Garrett Cleavinger has not allowed a hit in his last nine outings, the longest streak by a Rays reliever since Jason Adam (9G) from April 10-May 2, 2022 and tied for the second-longest streak in the majors this season behind WSH Kyle Finnegan (11G)...the single-season Tampa Bay record of 11 straight hitless relief appearances is held by Scott Aldred (April 8-May 1, 1999).

**RHP Phil Maton has pitched to a 1.04 ERA (8.2IP, 1ER) and 0.46 WHIP in his last 10 games since being tagged for a career-high-tying five runs on April 15 vs. LAA.

**RHP Jason Adam owns a 0.64 ERA (14.0IP, 1ER) in his last 14 appearances.

ON THE OFFENSIVE— With a season-high six extra-base hits yesterday, the Rays snapped a 39-game streak recording 5 XBH or fewer, the second-longest season-opening streak in franchise history behind 2008 (43G)...on the season, their 92 XBH are still second fewest in the AL, ahead of only the Mariners (91).

The Rays have drawn 44 walks in May, second most in the majors behind the Athletics (45)...they entered the month tied for the third-fewest walks in MLB (79), drawing more free passes than only the Orioles (76) and Marlins (73).

The Rays are batting .328 (22-for-67) with RISP over their last eight games...they went 1-for-21 (.048) in the four games preceding this stretch (April 28-May 1).

On the season, the Rays rank among AL leaders in stolen bases (1st, 47), infield hits (3rd, 51), singles (3rd, 232), sacrifice hits (3rd, 5) and batting average (5th, .244).

KEY TO SUCCESS—The Rays are 17-5 when out-hitting an opponent or hits are even compared to 3-15 when they are out-hit...they have won each of the last seven games in which they out-hit their opponent since their last loss on April 27 vs. CWS...they have lost each of their last eight games with a negative hit differential since their last victory on April 18 vs. 1.6.4on April 18 vs. LAA.

YANKEE DOODLE—The Rays and Yankees meet for the sixth of 13 matchups in 2024 today at Tropicana Field, wrapping up the second of four individual series...it marks the first of two series between the teams in St. Pete—New York will return to Tampa Bay from July 9-11 as the clubs wrap up the season series with seven games in a span of 13 days from July 9-22...the Rays have lost three of five meetings with the Yankees despite recording a 1.84 ERA (44.0IP, 9ER) in those games...the Rays are 10-8 against the Yankees since the beginning of last season, going 5-3 at home.

** The Rays have won three of the last four season series since 2020, posting the best record vs. New York by any AL team over that span (37-29/.561)...they went 38-57 (.400) from 2015-19.

** Yandy Díaz has reached base safely in 26 of his last 27 games against the Yankees, batting .330 (34-for-103) with 7 2B, 5 HR, 19 RBI and a .959 OPS. YANKEE DOODLE-The Rays and Yankees meet for the sixth of 13 matchups in 2024

- The Yankees have hosted Spring Training in Tampa Bay since 1996...their spring ballpark, Tampa's George M. Steinbrenner Field, is also home to their Class-A affiliate, the Tampa Tarpons... previously, New York had three stints hosting Spring Training in St Patershur; 1925.43 stints hosting Spring Training in St. Petersburg: 1925-42, 1946-50 and 1952-61.
- Manager Kevin Cash received a World Series ring from the Yankees in 2009 after appearing in 10 games in May while Jorge Posada was on the injured list.
- Hitting coach Chad Mottola was selected fifth overall by the Reds in the 1992 First-Year Player Draft, one spot before the Yankees drafted Derek Jeter.
- **OF Richie Palacios** is a Brooklyn native who grew up rooting for the Yankees.
- C Ben Rortvedt appeared in 32 games for the Yankees last season and spent Spring Training with them before being traded to the Rays on March 27.
- RHP Zack Littell began the 2017 season in the Yankees minor league system before being dealt to the Twins at the trade deadline.
- Bally Sports Sun announcer Dewayne Staats was the Yankees lead play-by-play announcer from 1990-94.
- Triple-A Durham manager **Morgan Ensberg** concluded his MLB career with the Yankees in 2008.
- Yankees RHP Luke Weaver pitched at Florida State University from 2012-14...he resides in Tallahassee during the offseason.
- Yankees LHP Caleb Ferguson served as an opener for RHP Ryan Pepiot three times last season while both pitchers were with the Dodgers.

TODAY'S START—Alexander will take the mound for his eighth appearance of the season this afternoon, including his fifth start...he is 1-1 with a 3.47 ERA (23.1IP, 9ER) in his last five appearances (3GS) after posting an 8.68 ERA (9.1IP, 9ER) in his first two (1GS)...this marks his fifth appearance at Tropicana Field this season, including his second straight start after serving as a bulk reliever in each of the first three outings.

LAST TIME OUT—He did not factor into the decision on May 6 vs. Chicago-AL...worked 4.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits, one walk, one home run and a season-high seven strikeouts.

He worked around two singles in the first two innings to remain

scoreless...struck out Paul DeJong and Nicky Lopez to open the 3rd frame, but walked Robbie Grossman before Tommy Pham's two-

EVIL EMPIRE—Alexander has made four career appearances (2GS) against the Yankees, going 0-1 with a 2.03 ERA (13.1IP, 3ER)...he has thrown 6.1 scoreless innings in the two starts while posting a 3.86 ERA (7.0IP, 3ER) in the two relief appearances.

In his lone start against the Yankees this season on April 19 in the

Bronx, Alexander tossed 5.1 scoreless innings, scattering two hits and one walk with four strikeouts...it marked his third career start working 5.0+ scoreless innings, including his first since Sept. 19, 2022 at Baltimore (7.0IP, 2H, 0R, 2BB, 4SO). He has made 22 career appearances (11GS) against the AL East, going 2-3 with a 3.44 ERA (86.1IP, 33ER).

ROUNDING INTO FORM—In his last five appearances (3GS) since April 14, Alexander is 1-1 with a 3.47 ERA (23.1IP, 9ER) while limiting opponents to a .239 (21-for-88) average...in his first two appearances (1GS), he posted an

8.68 ERA (9.11P, 9ER) with a .333 (14-for-42) opponent average.

He struck out a season-high seven batters in his last outing, his most punch outs since April 1, 2023 at TB (also 7SO).

FIRST THINGS FIRST—Alexander has recorded a career-high 74.3 pct. firstpitch strike rate, up from 72.4 pct. last season...min. 100 BF, it signals the second-highest mark in the majors, trailing AZ Brandon Pfaadt (74.4%)... however, to this point, he has had the most success in hitter's counts, holding opponents to a .100 (2-for-20) average when he is behind in the count compared to .279 (17-for-61) when ahead...opponents are 16-for-49 (.327) against him in even counts, including 5-for-15 (.333) on the first pitch.

LEFT SIDE. BEST SIDE—Alexander is holding left-handed hitters to a .162 (6-for-37) clip and .576 OPS, but three of the six hits have gone for extra bases (2B, 2HR)...right-handed hitters are batting .312 (29-for-93) against him with an .854 OPS—they had gone 18-for-47 (.383) in his first three outings, but are 11-for-46 (.239) in his last three.

SWINGMAN—Of his 127 career appearances, 47 (37.0%) have come as a starter while 80 were in relief...his 41 relief appearances of 2.0+ IP since 2020 are tied for sixth most in the majors—he has gone 7-3 with a 3.51 ERA (110.1IP, 43ER) in those outlings.

In his three starts this season, Alexander has produced a 4.58 ERA (17.2IP, 9ER)...in three outings working behind an opener, he has recorded a 5.40 ERA (15.0IP, 9ER).
For his career, he is 4-21 with a 4.69 ERA (216.2IP, 113ER) in 47 starts vs. 8-3 with a 4.06 ERA (157.1IP, 71ER) in 80 relief appearances.

-Alexander has posted a career-low 88.5 mph average exit velocity...he has allowed only one home run across his last four outings after yielding 5 HR in his first three...keeping the ball in the field of play is key for Alexander, whose career-high 33.0 pct. fly ball rate is seventh highest in the AL (leader: **Ryan Pepiot** – 37.5%).

BOTTOMS UP—The 7-9 spots in the opposing order are a combined 17-for-45 (.378) with a 1.066 OPS against him...he has held 1-6 hitters to a .212 (18-for-85) average and .677 OPS.
