FIRST WATCH

In the first inning, the Redlegs lead the Major Leagues in **HR** (26), **batting average** (.304, 113-372), **slugging percentage** (.575) and **on-base percentage** (.365).

RED HOT

Beginning **6/15**, **RF Yasiel Puig** has homered in **11** of his **last 24 apps**...since then, he leads all Major League players in **slugging percentage** (.826) while ranking T2nd in the majors in **HR** (Mike Trout 1st, 12), fourth in **batting average** (.372, 32-86) and T4th in **RBI** (23).

ALL-STARs

Named by his peers to the **National League All-Star** team, **RHP Luis Castillo** threw a perfect bottom of the fourth inning in Tue's 4-3 loss at Cle's **Progressive Field** (**Carlos Santana** struck out, **J.D. Martinez** struck out, **Alex Bregman** 4-3)...**Castillo** was joined by **RHP Sonny Gray**, who was added to the **NL All-Star** roster to replace Wsh's **Max Scherzer** but did not pitch...was **Gray's** second **All-Star** selection...he was an **American League All-Star** in 2015 but did not appear in the game at Cin's **Great American Ball Park**...**Castillo** and **Gray** are the first **Reds starting pitchers** named to the **All-Star** team since **Johnny Cueto** and **Alfredo Simon** in 2014.

ACE

RHP Luis Castillo in his **last 24 apps** beginning **9/1/18** is **12-4** and in that span leads all Major League starting pitchers with an **ERA** of **2.11**...this season **Castillo** ranks among the National League leaders in **wins** (T7th), **ERA** (4th), **strikeouts** (6th) and **strikeouts per 9 innings** (4th, 10.77)...since the distance from the pitching rubber to home plate was set at 60 feet, 6 inches in 1893, only 3 times in Major League history has a pitcher made 3 consecutive starts in a season with at least 8 strikeouts and no more than 2 hits allowed in each game (list below)...**Castillo's streak**, to open this season, was snapped in the 4-3 walkoff loss on 4/15 at LAD (5ip, 4h, 2er, 5bb, 7k)...no pitcher ever has done it in 4 consecutive starts.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (1-0) of a 3-game series vs **Brian Butterfield's** first-place **Cubs**, **Game 5** (2-2) of a 6-game road trip that included a **2-1 series loss** at Col's **Coors Field** and **Game 2** (1-0) in a stretch of **10 straight games** vs **NL Central Division** rivals (1-0 at Chi, 4g vs StL, 3g at Mil)...following tomorrow afternoon's game return to **Great American Ball Park** for a brief 4-game homestand vs the **Cardinals** before hitting the road again for a 3-game visit to Mil's **Miller Park**.

SERIES NOTES: The Reds have won the **first 3 series** of a season vs the Cubs for the first time since they won the **first 5 series** of 2013...over the **previous 4 seasons** (2015-2018), the Cubs' **.671 winning percentage** vs the Reds (51-25) was the best by any team against any division opponent...**Joey Votto** ranks third among all active players with **34 HR** and **114 RBI** against the Cubs, trailing in both categories only **Albert Pujols** (57-146) and **Ryan Braun** (38-133).

THE FRIENDLY CONFINES: The Reds and Cubs are meeting at **Wrigley Field** for the second of this season's 3 meetings...the Reds are **3-1 here** this season but have lost **22** of the **last 32 games** played in **The Friendly Confines**...since a 4-1 Reds win on **6/25/14** and beginning **9/15/14**, the Cubs have won **21** of the last **25 night games at Wrigley Field** between the teams...beginning **6/25/14**, **Joey Votto** has reached base safely in **40 straight games** at **Wrigley Field**, the longest streak by a visiting player since StL/LAD's **Wally Moon** reached in **47 consecutive apps** here from **8/30/1957 - 9/15/1962**...is the longest streak ever by a Reds player at **Wrigley Field** and the longest by any player since Chi's own **Mark Grace** reached safely in **45 straight games** here from **9/28/1996 - 7/22/1997**...during this current 40-game on-base streak at **Wrigley**, **Votto** is hitting .382 (55-144, 16 2b, 1 3b, 6hr, 20rbi, .632slg, .494obp)...his **118 career hits** here are the most by any active opposing player (118-358, .330, 16hr, 57rbi).

CARDINALS UP NEXT: The Reds have won **10** of their **last 17 games** vs the Cardinals...are **3-1-2** in their last 6 series vs StL, including a **1-1 series split** in April in **Mexico at Estadio de Béisbol Monterrey**, home of the **Sultanes de Monterrey** of the **Mexican League**...the Reds finished the 2018 season with **3 consecutive series wins vs StL**, their first single-season **3-series winning streak** vs the Cardinals since a **4-series winning streak** from **4/20-7/19, 1979**...the **12 runs scored** in the 12-1 win on **4/26** was Cin's **third-highest** total ever at **Busch** and its most since a **15-2 win** there on **9/26/16**.

REHABBING: **LHP Alex Wood** yesterday threw a bullpen without issue in preparation for a rehabilitation start for Louisville tomorrow night in Pawtucket (4ip, 60-65 pitches)...he already made 2 rehab apps for Louisville, on **7/6 at Columbus** (1.1ip, 2h, 1er, 1bb, 2k, 31 pitches) and **Fri vs Toledo** (2ip, 4h, 3r, 2er, 0bb, 2k, 51 pitches)...has been on the Reds' injured list all season with a **lower back injury**...has been on the 60-day IL since **5/31**...made 1 start for the Reds in spring training, on **2/25 at Sea** (1ip, 2h, 3er, 1bb, 0k, 1hr)...rehabbing **LHP Amir Garrett** (left lat strain) has joined the team here in Chicago...**C Tucker Barnhart** (right oblique strain) is rehabbing in Cincinnati.

2-WAY PLAYER: **RHP Michael Lorenzen** has appeared in 58 of the Reds' 91 games so far this season, including 40 times solely as a **pitcher**, twice as a **pinch hitter/pitcher**, once as a **pitcher/LF** (6/2 vs Wsh), 3 times as a **CF**, 3 times as a **LF**, 6 times solely as a **pinch runner**, once as a **pinch runner/CF** (3/28 vs Pit, CF), once as a **pinch runner/LF** (5/9 at Oak) and once as a **pinch runner/RF** (5/24 at Chi)...**9 times** in his career, including twice this season (4/9 vs Mia, 4/15 at LAD), he entered games as a pinch hitter and remained in that game to pitch...5 times in his career came off the bench to produce a home run, including twice as a reliever and 3 times as a pinch hitter...**Lorenzen** this year became the **first player in Reds history**, whose primary position is pitcher, to appear in **each of the first 6 games of a season** (PR/CF, P, PR, P, PR, P)...is the first Reds player with more than 300 career innings pitched (375.2) to play center field since **Hal Jeffcoat** in **1958**...**Ron Mahay** was the last Major League pitcher with at least 300 innings also to play CF...**Mahay** played in 5g in CF for the Red Sox in 1995 and then pitched his 300th inning in 2006 for the Rangers.

BLACK & BLUE: **Derek Dietrich** has been hit by a pitch **18 times**, the most in the Major Leagues this season and including **6 times** in the 4-game series at Mil from **6/20-6/23** (2-10, .200, 1 3b, 1rbi, 1bb, 7r, .529obp)...he is the only player in **modern Major League history** to get hit by a pitch **6 times** in a series of any length...was hit by a pitch twice in that series opener vs the Brewers, a 7-1 Reds win...in the 11-7 win in Game 2 became the first Reds batter in the modern era to be **hit by a pitch** 3 times in a game, tying the **Major League record** accomplished many times, and the first Reds batter ever to be hit at least twice in consecutive apps...in 9 apps this season vs the Brewers, **Dietrich** has been **hit by a pitch 8 times**...he has been hit by a pitch **110 times in his career**...notes courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

150th CELEBRATION: During the 2019 season the Reds are celebrating the **150th anniversary** of professional baseball, which began with the formation of the **1869 Red Stockings**...this season, the team will wear **15 uniforms** from various periods throughout the team's history...the Reds already wore uniforms from **1902, 1911, 1912, 1919, 1935, 1936, 1939** and **1956**...on **Sun vs StL** will wear replica uniforms of the **1961 World Series** champions...the Reds are **2-6** wearing **throwback uniforms**...as part of the season-long celebration, the **Reds Hall of Fame and Museum** underwent a comprehensive modification, while the **1869 Pavilion** at the southwest corner of the ballpark was dedicated on **May 4**, the **150th anniversary of the Red Stockings'** 45-9 win over the Cincinnati Great Westerns in the first professional baseball game...more than **20 anniversary park benches**, featuring Reds mascots wearing the **15 throwback uniforms**, are on display at locations across **Greater Cincinnati** and **Northern Kentucky**.

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: **RHP Luis Castillo** was the National League's **Pitcher of the Month** for **March/April**...in 7 starts he went **3-1**, **1.45** while ranking second in the National League and third in the Major Leagues in **ERA**, second in the NL and sixth in the majors in **strikeouts** (50) and third in the NL and T6th in the majors in **innings pitched** (43.1)...is the first Reds player to win a monthly award since **2B Scooter Gennett** won it in **May 2018**.

Tonight's Pitcher - #28 Anthony DeSclafani, RHP

RED HOTS

Anthony DeSclafani's last name is pronounced DEE-sclafani...tonight is making his 103rd career appearance and 95th career start...tonight is making his 12th career start and third of the season vs the Cubs, his seventh career start at Wrigley Field...in the 7-2 loss on 7/6 vs Cle allowed only a pair of solo HR, both to Francisco Lindor (leadoff, 5th inning)...has allowed 3 leadoff HR (Pit's Adam Frazier, Chi's Kyle Schwarber, Cle's Francisco Lindor)...in his last 6 starts is 3-1, 3.06 (32.1ip, 11er)...in the 7-5 loss on 6/23 at Mil, became the second Major League pitcher this season to record 9 strikeouts through his first 3 innings (Mil's Corbin Burnes, 3/31 vs StL) and the only Reds pitcher to do it since at least the 1920s, since such research is available...retired his first 6 batters via strikeout, tying the franchise record for strikeouts to begin a game (Robert Stephenson, 8/25/17 vs Pit)...that streak was snapped by Travis Shaw's HR leading off the third inning...struck out the side in the third inning but in between strikeouts allowed 6 hits and 5 runs, tying his career high for runs allowed in an inning (9/20/15 at Mil, 5th)...missed the entire 2017 season with a sprained ulnar collateral ligament in his right elbow and the first 2 months of the 2018 campaign with a left oblique strain suffered in his third spring training appearance...in 38 starts since he returned from those injuries is 12-12, 4.64 (201.2ip, 104er).

Sonny Gray is a **2019 National League All-Star**...is approaching 1,000 career innings (998.0)...tomorrow will make the fourth start of his career and third of the season vs the Cubs...will be his first career appearance at **Wrigley Field**...in Fri's 3-2 loss at Col, left the game with a 2-1 lead but **David Hernandez** allowed solo HR in the eighth inning to **David Dahl** and **Daniel Murphy**...his strikeout of **Charlie Blackmon** to end the fifth inning was the **900th strikeout** of his career.

 - Leads the team in hits and stolen bases, is tied with Eugenio Suárez for the team lead in HR and is 1 RBI behind team leader Suárez.
 - His single-season career highs for HR and RBI are 28 and 74, both in 2017.
 - Beginning 6/15 has homered in 11 of his last 24 apps (32-86, .372, 23rbi)...since then, he leads all Major League players in slugging percentage (.826) while ranking T2nd in the majors in HR (Mike Trout 1st, 12), fourth in batting average (.372, 32-86) and T4th in RBI (23).

 - Is the only player in franchise history, and 1 of only 21 players in Major League history, to produce 3 HR in his first 4 Major League apps.
 - Went hitless on 6/2 vs Wsh, snapping a 9-game hitting streak (14-41, .341, 5 2b, 1hr, 5rbi, .378obp) and a 20-game on-base streak (26-86, .302, 6 2b, 2 3b, 1hr, 8rbi, 4sb, .358obp)...is the longest hitting streak by any Reds batter this season and ties Joey Votto's for the longest on-base streak by a Reds hitter.
 - On 5/3 was promoted from Louisville and that night vs SF made his Major League debut, started in CF and batted second in the order (1-5, 2bb, 1r).
 - Recorded his first career hit in his Major League debut (single off Tony Watson), his first HR in his second appearance (solo off Dereck Rodríguez), his first stolen base in his third game and his first career leadoff HR (off Drew Pomeranz) & first career 2-homer game in his fourth appearance.
 - Began the season on Louisville's injured list with a right ankle sprain suffered on 3/25 during a spring training game in Goodyear...came off the IL on 4/23 and in 8 apps for the Bats prior to his 5/3 promotion hit .257 (1 2b, 1hr, 2rbi).

 - Leads the team in games, runs, total bases, extra-base hits and RBI...is tied with Yasiel Puig for the team lead in HR.
