LIBERTY, LIBERTY...LIBERTY: The Twins are playing the Phillies for the 28th, 29th and 30th times in their history this weekend...Twins are 15-12 all-time against Philadelphia, going 2-1 at Veterans Stadium (2002), 1-2 at the Metrodome (2004), 7-5 at Target Field in (2012, '13, '16 & '24), and 5-4 at Citizens Bank Park (2010, '19 and '23).

♣ Twins are 4-1 against Philadelphia in their last five, dating back to August of 2023.

♣ These two teams last met for a three-game series at Target Field, from July 22-24, 2024, as the Twins won games one and three...they outscored Philly 12-9 in the series.

♣ Minnesota last played in Philadelphia for three games, from August 11-13, 2023, as the Twins lost game one, but won games two and three.

♣ Christian Vazquez is hitting .456 (26-for-57) with seven doubles, three home runs, 14 RBI, a .508 on-base percentage, a .737 slugging percentage and a 1.245 OPS in 19 career regular season games against the Phillies...he has 12 hits in 28 at-bats in eight career games at CBP.

♣ Kody Clemens played parts of three seasons for the Phillies, from 2023-April of this season, playing in 97 games for Philadelphia...he was acquired by the Twins in exchange for cash considerations on April 26, shortly after Luke Keaschall went on the 10-day IL.

♣ Rocco Baldelli hit a game-tying solo home run for the Tampa Bay Rays in this ballpark in the seventh inning of Game 5 of the World Series, on October 27, 2008, off Ryan Madsen... the Phillies answered back and eventually won the game 4-3.

BUCK SHOTS: Byron Buxton hit two home runs yesterday, giving him three in his last two games and 34 on the season...34 are the most for a Twin since 2019, when Nelson Cruz hit 41, Max Kepler hit 36 and Miguel Sanó hit 34...34 home runs are tied for eighth-most in the AL, while his 14.09 at-bat-per-home run ratio ranks fifth...Buck has 22 home runs that either tied a game or game his team the lead, fifth-most in baseball, trailing Kyle Schwarber (26), Aaron Judge (26), Cal Raleigh (24) and Shohei Ohtani (23)...two home runs yesterday gave him 17 multi-homer games, moving into fourth place on the Twins all-time list, passing Kent Hrbek (16); he now ranks behind Harmon Killebrew (35), Justin Morneau (20) and Tony Oliva (18)...he now has 167 career homers, tying Brian Dozier for ninth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

♣ Prior to the July 31 trade deadline, Minnesota stole 55 bases, tied for 24th-most in baseball... since August 1, they rank second in baseball with 57 steals, trailing New York-AL (58).

♣ 17 different Twins have stolen a base this season, which ties the 2004 team for second-most in a season in Twins history (since 1961)...the team record is 18 separate players with at least one stolen base in 2001...active players on the 28-man roster that need a stolen base still are: Ryan Jeffers, Edouard Julien and Carson McCusker.

**STONE COLD AUSTIN**: Despite going 2-for-15 in his last four games. Austin Martin is hitting .319 (29-for-91) with seven doubles, 15 walks, just 17 strikeouts, a .421 on-base percentage and an .816 OPS in his last 27 games, dating back to August 26...since that date, he ranks fourth in the AL (6th in baseball) in on-base percentage and 11th in walks.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In **1965**, the Twins defeated the Senators 2-1 in Washington, clinching the first American League pennant in Minnesota history, as well as the first in overall franchise history (1901-present) since 1933...in **2019**, the Twins became the first team to reach 300 homers in a season, as Jonathan Schoop hit a seventh-inning homer off José Cisnero in a 10-4 victory over the Detroit Tigers...the Twins finished the season with an MLB-record 307 homers; the Braves tied the record in 2023.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss in Game 1 of the September 20 doubleheader vs. Cleveland, opposite Slade Cecconi, a 0-6 Minnesota defeat...allowed five runs (4 ER) on six hits, including a season-high four home runs, with two walks and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...allowed three solo home runs through the first two innings...fourth home run - also a solo shot - came in the fifth inning... that inning, Brayan Rocchio doubled, advanced to third on Steven Kwan's single and scored on an errant throw by catcher Johnny Pereda.

Thas allowed five-or-more runs in five of his last 10 starts...since the start of 2024 (53 games), Ryan has allowed five-or-more runs just eight times total.

Brought his season innings pitched total to 166.0, a new career high (161.2 IP in 2023).

TWO STARTS AGO: Started on September 13 vs. Arizona, opposite Ryne Nelson, but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-5 extra-inning loss...allowed two runs on four hits (1 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts over 4.0 innings of work...loaded the bases in the second via two singles and a walk, but escaped the jam with an inning-ending strikeout to Jake McCarthy...surrendered a double to Adrian Del Castillo to start the fourth, followed by a one-out, two-run home run by Alek Thomas.

### Marked just the second time in his career with consecutive outings of 4.0-innings or less (also July 26-August 2, 2023).

ON THE HO-RY-ZON: Below are some of Ryan's upcoming career milestones:

◆ With 13 wins this season, he needs one more to surpass his 2022 total (13) and set a new single-season career high.

◆ With 14 quality starts this season, he needs one more to surpass his 2023 total (14) and set

a new single-season career high.

◆ With 710 career strikeouts, he needs five more to tie Eric Milton (715) for the 15th most in Twins history (1961-present).

**JOE-TOWN PHILLY:** Is making his first career appearance against the Phillies, the only team other than the Twins that he has yet to face in his career.

AGAINST THE NL EAST: In six career starts against the National League East (ATL 2x, WSH, 2x, NYM 1x, MIA 1x), he is 1-4 with a 5.06 ERA (32.0 IP, 18 ER), six walks and 33 strikeouts...three of his four losses against the division have come this season while his lone win (and the Twins' lone win) came on May 21, 2024 at Nationals Park...in four starts against the division this season, he is 0-3 with a 4.91 ERA (22.0 IP, 12 ER), four walks, 22 strikeouts and a .250 (22-for-88) opponent batting average.

◆ In 12 Interleague starts this season, he is 5-4 with a 2.81 ERA (67.1 IP, 21 ER), eight home runs allowed, 12 walks, 78 strikeouts and a .212 (53-for-250) opponent batting average.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In 14 road starts this season, Ryan is 6-4 with a 3.46 ERA (80.2 IP, 31 ER), 17 walks and 82 strikeouts, compared to 7-5 with a 3.48 ERA (85.1 IP, 33 ER), 21 walks and 103 strikeouts in 16 home appearances (15 starts)...in 55 career road starts, he has gone 20-18 with a 3.96 ERA, a 4.71 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a .231 opponent batting average.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, lefties have slashed .245/.299/.458 with 20 doubles, 16 home runs, 20 walks and 79 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .190/.252/.322 with 12 doubles, nine home runs, 18 walks and 106 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .217/.277/.388 with 82 walks and 288 strikeouts (3.51 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .227/.274/.421 with 65 walks and 422 strikeouts (6.49 K/BB).

THE ARSENAL: Through 30 appearances (29 starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix...here
