THE GIANTS: Look to even out the series tonight after falling to the Rockies 8-6 in the series opener last night.

- ▶ SF suffered its fifth walk-off loss of the season yesterday...the five such losses are tied with the Yankees for second-most in the Majors, ahead only of the Tigers (seven).
- ▶ The Giants enter today 13 games under .500 for the first time since ending the 2018 season 16 games under (.73-89).
- ▶ SF's 22-35 record marks their worst start to a season since also starting the 1991 campaign at 22-35 through 57 games.
- ▶ The 22-35 (.386) record is tied with the Royals for the fourth-lowest winning percentage in MLB this season, ahead of only the Rockies (21-37, .362), Angels and Tigers (both at 22-36, .379).

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants have made the following roster moves prior to today's game:

- ▶ **OF Will Brennan** (#7) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **OF Harrison Bader** placed on the 10-day IL with left plantar fasciitis.

MAY FLOWERS: RHP **Adrian Houser** takes the hill for SF tonight to make his 11th start of the season...after a tough start to his Giants tenure, the right-hander has been excellent this month, going 2-1 with a 2.82 ERA (7er, 22.1ip) in four starts in May, with the Giants winning three of the four games.

- ▶ Houser has faced the Rockies seven times in his career and last pitched at Coors Field on July 4 of last season...the righty was awarded the win after tossing 8.0 innings with two unearned runs on four hits with six strikeouts.

GUESS WHO'S BACK: **OF Jung Hoo Lee** matched a career-high four hits last night in his first game back from the Injured List...Lee's two such games this season are tied for second-most in MLB, behind only BAL's Taylor Ward with three.

- ▶ Over his last 36 games, Lee is slashing .324/.356/.458 with a .813 OPS and just 13 strikeouts...Lee's .324 average since April 10 is eight-best in the Majors and fifth-best in the NL, just behind teammate **IF Luis Arraez** (.331)...his 8.7% strikeout rate ranks fourth.
- ▶ In fact, Lee has not struck out in his last 29 plate appearances entering play today, which ranks as the third-longest active such streak in MLB behind PIT's Spencer Horwitz (32) and SEA's Josh Naylor (30).

NO TROUBLE WITH THE DOUBLE: With another three doubles last night from Lee, **IF Casey Schmitt** and **IF/DH Bryce Eldridge**, the Giants now have 55 doubles this month...the 55 doubles are second-most in MLB, trailing only the Nationals (58).

- ▶ The last time the Giants had as many doubles in any single month was in 2021, when they recorded 65 doubles in September/October.
- ▶ It also marks SF's most in a single May since recording 61 doubles in 2018 (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ **IF Rafael Devers** leads all MLB players this month with 11 doubles...he's the first Giant with 11 doubles in a month since teammate **OF Jung Hoo Lee** also hit 11 on April/March, 2025...the last one to do so in May was **Andrew McCutchen** in 2018 (also 11).
- ▶ With another double this weekend, Devers could become the first Giants player in nearly a decade to record at least 12 doubles in a month...the last Giant to achieve the feat was **Brandon Belt**, who doubled 13 times in June 2016.

THE LONG BALL: With yesterday's loss, the Giants fell to 3-23 (.115) when they do not hit a home run, the worst such record in MLB...when they hit at least one homer, that record goes up to 19-12 (.613), 12th-best in the Majors and ranking seventh in the National League.

- ▶ Last night also marked just the third time this year that SF's pitching staff has surrendered three homers, tied for the second-fewest such games in MLB behind the Pirates (one)...they Giants are 0-3 in those games so far.

ONCE IN A BLUE MOON: SF has won 16 of their last 19 games against the Rockies dating to July 21, 2024 and are 6-2 here at Coors Field in that span.

- ▶ In their last six games here at Coors Field dating to June 11 of last season, SF is averaging 8.0 runs per game, with batters slashing .338/.407/.560 with 12 home runs and 48 RBI.
- ▶ The Giants' 120 all-time wins at Coors Field are second-most among all teams outside of the Rockies, trailing only the Dodgers' 147 wins.
- ▶ Overall, the Giants' 63-25 record (.716) vs. the Rockies since 2020 is best among all teams that have played Colorado at least 10 times in that span.

ADRIAN HOUSER RHP #12

2026 RECORD: 2-4, 5.30 ERA

YO ADRIAN: Is in his first season in a Giants uniform and 10th overall in the Majors...the 33-year-old signed a two-year contract (with a club option for 2028) with the Giants this past offseason and is making his 11th start of the season tonight.

LAST TIME OUT: Received a no-decision against his former team, the White Sox, pitching 4.2 innings and allowing three earned runs on seven hits, no walks, and five strikeouts...it was his first start without allowing a walk since September 9 of last season as a member of Tampa Bay, which also happened to come against the White Sox.

VS. COLORADO: Will be Houser's eighth career game (seventh start) against Colorado...he's 2-0 with a 4.37 ERA (17er, 35.0ip) and a 1.20 WHIP in his matchups with the Rockies...he's been strong in four career games (all starts) at Coors Field, sporting a 2.35 ERA (6er, 23.0ip) and a 1.00 WHIP...both of his wins against the Rockies have come in Denver, including his last time out at Coors on July 4, 2025, where he tossed 8.0 inning without allowing an earned run as a member of the Brewers.

SPRING HOUSE CLEANING: After struggling through his first six starts of 2026 (0-3, 7.12 ERA, 1.71 WHIP over 30.1 IP), Houser has been much better over his four starts in May, as he's 2-1 with a 2.82 ERA (7er, 22.1ip) and a 1.16 WHIP this month.

SINK IN: The big difference recently is Houser, a career-long sinker-baller, has found his trademark pitch over four starts in May...this month, he's thrown the sinker 51.6% of the time and opponents are just 5x38 (.158) against it...opponents were hitting .323 off his sinker in April (20x62) while he was throwing it 41.5% of the time.

FAST AND FURIOUS: In fact, Houser's approach has shifted to a heavy reliance on the hard stuff over his breaking pitches... he's using his sinker and four-seam fastball as his top two pitches this month in terms of usage, which he hasn't done since May of 2025...the sinker and four-seamer are being thrown a combined 67.9% of the time this month and opponents are just 9x58 (.155) against them, compared to a 54% combined usage rate in April and a .316 BAA (24x76)... he's throwing fewer offspeed pitches in general, especially his changeup, which went from a 22.6% usage rate last month to a 12.8% rate this month...opponents have a combined .342 average (26x76) against his changeup, slider and curveball this season with nine doubles and three home runs.

MIDDLE MAN: Has been at his best this season in the middle innings of his outings...in innings 2-4 this season, he has in 3.00 ERA with a 1.10 WHIP and .220 BAA, which has shrunk to a 1.50 ERA, .167 BAA and 0.83 WHIP over his starts in May...however, in innings 1 and 5 he has an ERA of 8.10 and 10.13, respectively.

LEFT ON READ: Lefties are slashing .350/.436/.642 with 15 doubles, a triple, six homers and a 1.077 OPS in 120 at-bats compared to righties slashing .204/.278/.482 with a double, two homers and a .482 OPS in 90 at-bats...amongst pitchers with at least 50.0 innings pitched this season, Houser's 1.007 OPS vs. left-handed batters is third-highest in MLB, behind only COL's Michael Lorenzen (1.240) and STL's Matthew Liberatore (1.093)...on the other hand, his .482 OPS against right-handed batters is seventh-lowest in the Majors.

RAMBLIN' MAN: Has been more comfortable on the road than at home this season, sporting a 4.22 ERA (15er, 32.0ip) over six road starts versus a 6.97 ERA (16er, 20.2ip) in four starts at Oracle Park.

UPS AND DOWNS: Houser has a 13.2% strikeout rate this season, which is the third-lowest in the Majors (min. 50.0ip), ahead of only WSH's Zack Littell (12.8%) and COL's Tomoyuki Sugano (12.8%).

EARLY BIRD: Has 7.52 ERA (17er, 20.1ip) with a .329 BAA in night games compared a 3.90 ERA (14er, 32.1ip) and a .250 BAA in day games this season...his 7.52 ERA at night is sixth-highest in the Majors.

ROBBIE RAY LHP #38

2026 RECORD: 3-6, 4.60 ERA

- ▶ Did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 24 vs. the White Sox...threw 4.0 innings and allowed four runs on two hits with a career-high seven strikeouts...it marked the third straight start that Ray has not made it past the 5th inning.
- ▶ Will make his 23rd career start against the Rockies, the second-most starts he's made against any team in his career behind the Dodgers (26GS)...posted a 6-6 record with a 5.24 ERA over his 22 career outings vs. COL.
- ▶ Has received one or zero runs of support in six of his 11 outings...the Giants are 5-6 over his 11 starts.

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 5/26 vs. AZ; 2.0ip, 2h, r, er, 2bb, k (35 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed runs in nine of his 20 appearances (4.15 ERA).
- ▶ Has a 1.93 ERA at home, compared to a 5.84 ERA on the road.
- ▶ Lefties are 6-for-37 (.162) with four walks and 10 strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .180 clip (73-for-406) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties are 17-for-45 (.378) with seven XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 5/25 vs. AZ; 3.0ip, h, bb, k (35 pitches)

- ▶ Has tossed 3.0 scoreless innings in each of his last two outings...has allowed just one earned run over his last 9.2 innings, covering five games (0.93 ERA) and posted a 0.83 WHIP.
- ▶ Has a 0.75 ERA (1er, 12.0ip) in nine road games...has a 4.70 ERA (8er, 15.1ip) in nine games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in 11 of 18 contests (4.94 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .311 off him with runners on base, compared to a .185 average with no one on base.

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 5/29 at COL; 0.2ip, h (6 pitches)

- ▶ Gage's 27 appearances this year are tied for fourth-most in MLB.
- ▶ Has surrendered six runs (five ER) in 23.0ip this year (1.96 ERA).
- ▶ Has allowed only nine of his 24 (37.5%) inherited runners to score.
- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-31 (.065) against him this season, and 19-for-114 in his career (.167).
- ▶ His 27.7% hard hit rate ranks in the top 3% of MLB while his 85.2 mph average exit velo is in the top 5%.
- ▶ Opponents are just 2-for-16 (.125) off his changeup and 3-for-22 (.136) off his four-seamer.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

Last Game: 5/25 vs. AZ; 0.2ip, h, bb, ibb, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has made seven appearances with SF, logging 6.1-scoreless innings, allowing just two hits and six walks with eight strikeouts.
- ▶ Righties are 0-for-11 off him.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 10.
- ▶ Is pitching in the Majors for the first time since July 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/29 at COL; L, BS, 0.2ip, 5h, 5r, 5er, 2hr, k (20 pitches)

- ▶ Gave up season-high five runs and five hits on two homers in 9th inning last night...marked his first career outing at Coors Field.
- ▶ Has allowed 12 runs (10 earned) in 11.0 innings this month...had allowed one run in 14.0 innings in 13 March/April games.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 9-for-50 (.180) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 8-for-39 (.205) with five homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 5/29 at COLP 1.0ip, h, k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed just one home run in his last 61.1 innings pitched, dating back to August, 2024.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 16 after missing 14 games with a low back strain.
- ▶ Has allowed 13 walks in his 16.1ip (7.16 BB/9.0).
- ▶ Right-handers are 5-for-30 (.167) off him while left-handers are 5-for-29 (.172).
- ▶ Holding opponents 0-for-20 off his slider and 5-for-31 (.161) off his sinker.

#63 JOEL PEGUERO ▶ RHP

(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 5/29 at COL; 0.2ip, h, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has tossed 10.0 innings since returning from the IL, allowing four runs (three earned) on eight hits in 10 games (2.70 ERA).
- ▶ Activated on May 5 after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento...missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Batters are 4-for-17 with four singles off his sinker thus far, which he's thrown 34.3% of the time and are 3-for-8 (.429) off his slider.
- ▶ Averaging 99.8 mph with his four-seam and 98.9 mph with his sinker

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 5/29 at COL; 1.1ip, 2h, 2r, 2er, hr (18 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed pair of runs on a two-run homer to Tovar last night.
- ▶ Leads SF with 11 holds, which is tied for the fourth-most in MLB.
- ▶ 19 of his 25 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.45 ERA).
- ▶ Opponents are just 15-for-88 (.170) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 6-for-47 (.128) with 17 K's off his splitter.
- ▶ His 85.6 mph average exit velocity ranks in the top 7% of the league while his 26.9% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 4%.
