**RAY REPORT**—Coming off a 2-5 homestand against the Orioles (0-4) and Cubs (2-1), the Rays kick off a 10-day, three-city road trip through Atlanta (3 to play), Minnesota (3 to play) and Pittsburgh (3 to play) tonight at Truist Park...have split their last 16 games (8-8) on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak from May 19-25...are 8-14 since May 19 after going 11-4 in their previous 15 contests from May 3-18...are 2-5 so far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26...the Rays have spent the entire season to this point within four games of .500.

In last night's 3-2 win over the Cubs, the Rays yielded only three hits, matching a season low (also April 29 at MIL)...it marked their first win when plating three runs or fewer since May 4 vs. NYM after losing each of their last 13 such contests. Since May 1, the Rays are 17-5 when scoring 4+ runs and 2-14 with three or fewer. **Taj Bradley** became the first Rays pitcher to record 7.0+ IP, 0 ER and 10+ SO in a start since **Zach Eflin** on May 4, 2023 vs. PIT...he earned the rotation's second win in its last 23 games since May 18...Rays starters combined for a 1.47 ERA (18.1IP, 3ER) in the three-game set against Chicago.

The Rays 12-5 (.706) mark in Interleague play is second best in the majors behind the Phillies (10-4/.714)...since the beginning of 2021, their .641 (66-37) Interleague winning pct. ranks second behind the Dodgers (.644/653).

Tonight, the Rays seek back-to-back series-opening wins for the first time since May 13-17...they are 7-6 in their last 13 series openers after a 1-8 start and have won four of their last five on the road.

Rays starter **RHP Zack Littell** has thrown three straight quality starts for the first time in his career...he looks to become the first Rays starter to turn the trick in four straight outings since **Tyler Glasnow** (5GS) from July 15 (G1)-Aug. 14, 2023.

**SOUTHPAW SUCCESS**—The Rays are 12-6 (.667) when opposed by left-handed starting pitchers, the fourth-best mark in the majors behind the Guardians, Orioles (both 14-5/.737) and Dodgers (18-7/.720)...they have won seven of their last eight such games after splitting their first 10 (5-5)...including tonight, they will have faced a starting southpaw in seven of their last 14 games since May 30...prior to that stretch, they were opposed by a lefty just twice in their previous 32 games from April 23-May 29.

The Rays are averaging 5.00 runs per game in 18 contests opposed by LH starters compared to 3.45 in 51 games vs. RH starters.

Since the start of 2023, the Rays are 36-17 (.679) in games against LH starters, the second-best record in MLB behind the Orioles (50-22/.694).

**Yandy Diaz** is batting .362 (17-for-47) vs. LHP over his last 50 games since April 17...he opened the season 4-for-24 (.167).

**Amed Rosario** is 6-for-16 (.375) with 2 2B against LHP in June.

**ROAD TRIPPIN'**—The Rays have won three consecutive road games and, with a win tonight, can match their longest road winning streak of the season (May 15-18)...they are 7-3 over their last 10 road contests following a 7-10 start and have won three of their last four road series (BOS, TOR, MIA)...their .700 road winning pct. in that span (since May 15) ranks second in MLB behind the Yankees (12-3/.800)...the Rays have played the fewest road games in the majors (27), two fewer than the next closest club (NYM - 29)...however, 15 of their next 21 games will be played in visiting ballparks.

**José Caballero** is batting .321 (27-for-84) on the road, third in the AL behind **HOU Yordan Alvarez** (.328) and **NY Y Juan Soto** (.322)...he owns a .200 (24-for-120) average at home—the 121-point discrepancy is the second largest between home and road averages in the AL behind **BAL Jordan Westburg** (.127; .345 home, .218 road).

**Isaac Paredes** is batting .320 (32-for-100) as a visitor, fifth best in the AL...he is riding a career-long 14-game road on-base streak.

**Amed Rosario** is 15-for-31 (.484) with 4 XBH during a seven-game road hitting streak.

**CARDIAC KIDS**—The Rays 19 comeback wins are tied with four other clubs (BAL, MIL, PHI, WSH) for second most in the majors behind the Yankees (20)...**Tampa Bay has come from behind in eight of its last nine wins, including four multi-run comebacks in its last five victories**...the Rays have held a lead entering the 7th inning just three times in their last 23 games since May 18, but have managed a 9-14 record over that span...overall, 57.6 pct. of their victories have been comeback wins, the highest percentage in the AL.

The Rays have scored first in just two of their last 11 games, but have gone 5-6 in that stretch...their 16 wins after conceding the opening tally are tied with the Mets for second most in the majors behind the Yankees (18).

Tampa Bay has recorded 10 wins after trailing by multiple runs, tied for second most in MLB behind Minnesota (11), per Elias...it has faced a multi-run deficit at some point in five straight and 10 of its last 12 games.

The Rays rank among MLB leaders in wins when trailing after six (1st, 9), seven (1st, 7) and eight (T2nd, 4) frames.

**DOWN TO THE WIRE**—The Rays own the best record in the majors in both one-run games (13-5/.722) and games decided by two runs or fewer (23-10/.697)...they are 14-4 in their last 18 games decided by two runs or fewer and have won seven of eight and nine of their last 11 one-run contests.

**THE CHAMP IS HERE**—**Yandy Díaz** is riding a season-high 16-game on-base streak, batting .286/.361/.349 (18-for-63) with 2 2B, 1 3B, 5 RBI, 8 BB and 9 SO during the run...it marks the fifth-longest active streak in the AL and seventh longest in the majors...it signals his longest streak since a career-high-tying 22-game run from April 27-May 28, 2023...**Isaac Paredes** (18G, April 28-May 19) owns the longest on-base streak by a Ray this season.

**Díaz's** has six multi-hit efforts in his last nine games since June 4, tied with three others for the most in the majors over that span.

**HOMER (UN)HAPPY**—The Rays have allowed 91 HR, tied with the White Sox for the most in the majors...they are 14-3 when holding the opposition homerless compared to 19-33 when yielding 1+ HR...Rays batters have recorded 53 HR, tied with the Nationals for the fewest in MLB...the club is 26-15 when out-homer the opponent or homers are even and 7-21 when being out-homered.

The Rays have collected 13 wins without the benefit of hitting a home run, tied with the Brewers and Giants for the most in MLB.

**IN THE ATL**—The Rays and Braves meet for their lone series of 2024 this weekend...the clubs have split their last 12 meetings (6-6) since 2020...this marks Tampa Bay's fourth series at Truist Park since the ballpark opened in 2017, earning a series win and two splits in the previous sets...the Rays have not played in Atlanta since July 16-18, 2021, when they won the series opener and rubber match...the Rays claimed the first game in extra innings and overcame a 3-0 deficit to win the finale.

The Rays are 16-26 (.381) all-time against the Braves...it marks their second-worst winning pct. against a single opponent, ahead of a 7-14 (.333) record against the Reds...the Rays went 0-7 from the start of their inaugural season through July 16, 2000, but have gone 16-19 in the last 35 games...the 42 all-time meetings are their second most against any NL opponent behind Miami (137).

**Yandy Díaz** is 12-for-29 (.414) in eight career games against Atlanta and 7-for-17 (.412) with 2 2B and 1 3B against Braves starter **LHP Chris Sale**.

- Braves **LHP Chris Sale** is a native of Lakeland, FL and attended both Lakeland High School and Florida Gulf Coast University.
- C Alex Jackson** was traded to the Braves in 2016 and made his MLB debut with them in 2019 after progressing through their farm system...he appeared in 19 games with Atlanta over three seasons before being dealt to the Marlins for **OF Adam Duvall** at the 2021 trade deadline.
- RHP Taj Bradley** grew up in Stone Mountain, GA rooting for the Braves...he is friends with Braves **OF Michael Harris II**, who also hails from DeKalb County.
- RHP Matt McWilliams**, uncle of **LHP Garrett Cleavinger**, played for Short-A Eugene in the Braves system in 1995.
- Rays **LHP Colin Poche** and Braves **OF Brian Anderson** were teammates at the University of Arkansas from 2013-14.
- Rays **INF Brandon Lowe** hit his first career home against the Braves on Aug. 28, 2018 (**Julio Teheran**).
- Braves **RHP Hurston Waldrep** pitched at the University of Florida in 2023.
- Braves **RHP Charlie Morton** pitched two seasons for the Rays, making one of his two All-Star appearances in 2019 before helping the club to a World Series appearance in 2020.
- Braves **RHP Jimmy Herget**, who is currently on the 15-day IL, hails from Tampa and is a University of South Florida product.
- Atlanta **C Travis D'Arnaud** appeared in 92 games for the Rays in 2019.
- Braves **C Sean Murphy** attended Wright State (OH) University, the same school as Bally Sports Sun announcer **Brian Anderson**...Wright State has produced eight major leaguers in its history, including former Ray **Carlos Peña**.

**TONIGHT'S START**—The right-hander will take the mound for his 14th start of the season, including his sixth on the road...has recorded a 4.22 ERA (53.1IP, 25ER) in his last nine starts compared to a 2.14 ERA (21.0IP, 5ER) in his first four...has thrown 5.0+ IP in 10 straight and 12 of his 13 starts overall...is seeking his first victory since May 11 vs. New York-AL.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Took the loss on June 9 vs. Baltimore...earned his sixth quality start of the season, allowing three runs on seven hits and one walk with three strikeouts across 6.0 innings.

Was scoreless through the first two frames...**Gunnar Henderson** doubled with one out in the 3rd inning and **Adley Rutschman** followed with an RBI-single...**Anthony Santander** led off the 4th inning with a solo homer...with two outs in the 6th frame, **Jordan Westburg** doubled and was followed by **Colton Cowser**, who recorded an RBI-triple.

**BATTLING THE BRAVOS**—Littell is set to face the Braves for the 10th time, but will be making his first career start against them...in his nine previous relief appearances, Littell is 1-0 with a 6.43 ERA (14.0IP, 10ER).

He faced Atlanta twice last season, once with Boston (May 9) and once with Tampa Bay (July 9)...in the July 9 outing at Tropicana Field, he worked 2.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits with no walks and one strikeout.

**QUALITY IN QUANTITY**—He has recorded three straight quality starts, matching **Ryan Pepiot** (April 18-29) for the longest streak by a Ray this season...the last Tampa Bay hurler with four straight quality starts was **Tyler Glasnow** (5QS, July 15:G1-Aug. 14, 2023).

**NO SPIN ZONE**—Littell's split-finger, an offering he utilizes 22.0 pct. of the time, produces an average spin rate of 790 revolutions per minute...min. 250 pitches thrown, it marks the sixth-lowest average spin rate any pitch thrown in MLB...SD **Matt Waldron's** knuckleball registers 248 rpm, followed by splitters from NYM **Taylor Megill** (658), SEA **Logan Gilbert** (678), CHC **Mark Leiter Jr.** (774) and BAL **Dean Kremer** (777).

**PINPOINT PRECISION**—Littell's 3.8 pct. walk rate is sixth lowest in the majors behind teammate **Zach Eflin** (1.4%), SEA **George Kirby** (2.1%), CIN **Nick Martinez** (3.1%), DET **Jack Flaherty** (3.6%) and ATL **Chris Sale** (3.7%).

According to Elias, his free pass to NYY **Anthony Rizzo** on May 11 snapped a 123 BF streak without a walk, fourth longest in Rays history behind **Zach Eflin's** active 153 BF streak, **Corey Kluber** (150BF, 2022) and **David Price** (124BF, 2013)...five of his 12 walks have come in a total of two frames: the 1st inning on April 10 at LAA (3BB) and the 2nd on May 11 vs. NYY (2BB)...excluding his statistics in those two frames, he has produced a 2.3 pct. walk rate (6BB/257BF) in all other innings.

From April 17-May 4, he recorded 6+ SO without issuing a walk in a club-record four straight starts...the four such starts are tied for second most in the majors behind PIT **Jared Jones** (5).

**STREAKS TO SEE**—He has worked 5.0+ innings in each of his last 10 starts, the longest single-season run by a Ray since **Tyler Glasnow** (13GS) from June 25-Sept. 11, 2023...**Zach Eflin** had an 18-game streak from Aug. 19 (G2), 2023-May 18, 2024.

Littell has allowed 1 HR in each of his last five starts, matching his career-high streak (also 5GS, Aug. 10-Sept. 2, 2023)...of the eight home runs he has surrendered this season, seven have been solo shots, with the lone outlier being a three-run homer by OAK **Miguel Andujar** on May 28.

He has issued a walk in a career-high six straight outings since May 11.

**BEND, DON'T BREAK**—Littell has yielded 10.17 hits/9.0 IP, the fourth-highest mark in the majors behind WSH **Patrick Corbin** (11.22), COL **Ryan Feltner** (10.83) and MIN **Chris Paddack** (10.60).

His success has stemmed from his lack of walks coupled with a career-best 37.1 pct. hard-hit rate, which has dropped 4.8 pct. compared to his 41.9 pct. hard-hit rate last season.

Littell has thrown 54.2 pct. of his pitches in the strike zone, the seventh-highest percentage in the AL/11th highest in MLB...opponents have swung at 52.8 pct. of his total pitches, fifth in the majors behind CHC **Shota Imanaga** (55.5%), PIT **Jared Jones** (54.7%), SEA **George Kirby** (54.0%) and CIN **Nick Martinez** (53.1%).
