**THE TWINS:** Have gone 5-4 through nine games on their 10-game, 11-day roadtrip, going 1-2 at Tampa Bay last week, 1-2 at Seattle last weekend and 3-0 against the A's...today, they will play the four-game series finale at Sutter Health Park...after today's game, the Twins will travel home to begin a six-game homestand with three against the Blue Jays this weekend, enjoy an off-day on Monday, then three against the Rangers from Tuesday-Thursday.  
✎ Twins are 27-12 in their last 39 games since April 22, tied with Detroit (27-13) for the most wins in baseball since that date...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.  
✎ Twins are now seven games over .500, matching their high water mark, previously done through their game on May 24, when they were 29-22.

**TWINS CONTINUE THEIR RIVER CITY RUN:** The Twins beat the A's last night at Sutter Health Park by a score of 6-1...Zebby Matthews (1-1) earned his second career win and first of the season, allowing one run on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with three walks and four strikeouts...the bullpen of Louis Varland, Griffin Jax, Brock Stewart and Jhoan Duran combined for 4.0 scoreless innings, with 10 strikeouts as Twins pitchers finished with 14 punch-outs on the evening...the offense recorded eight hits as Ryan Jeffers hit his fourth home run of the season and Harrison Bader hit his sixth of the season...the victory secured the series win, making the Twins 12-8-1 in series play this season, including 9-3-1 in their last 13.

**SLIM REAPER COMES KNOCKING:** The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher David Festa from Triple-A St. Paul...Festa, who was recently named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Month for May, has gone 2-1, 2.83 ERA (28.2 IP, 9 ER), four walks, 34 strikeouts and a 0.98 WHIP in six starts for the Saints this season...that includes posting a 1.26 ERA (14.1 IP, 2 ER) with two walks and 19 strikeouts in three May starts, while holding batters to a .160 average...Festa also made three starts for the Twins from April 11-24 (during López's IL stint), posting a 1.38 ERA (13.0 IP, 2 ER), with five walks and 15 strikeouts.  
✎ To make room on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed Pablo López on the 15-day IL with a Grade 2 right teres major strain...he was removed from his start on Tuesday in Sacramento prior to the start of the sixth inning with the injury...has gone 5-3, 2.82 ERA (60.2 IP, 19 ER), 14 walks, 61 strikeouts and a .225 opponent batting average in 11 starts for the Twins this season...this is his second stint on the IL this year, after missing 14 games from April 9-25 with a right hamstring strain.

**ONE MORE TIME FOR SACRAMENTO:** The Twins and A's are playing the fourth of seven games this season...Twins will host the A's for three games at Target Field from August 19-21.  
✎ Twins are 9-1 in their last 10 against the A's, 15-2 in their last 17 and 19-3 in their last 22, dating back to May of 2022.  
✎ A win today would secure the season series over the A's for the fourth consecutive season...they went 6-1 in 2024, 5-1 in 2023 and 5-1 in 2022.  
✎ Byron Buxton is hitting .364 (12-for-33) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, 13 RBI, a .606 slugging percentage and a .995 OPS in his last nine games against the A's.  
✎ Willi Castro is hitting .362 (17-for-47) with four doubles, three home runs and a 1.093 OPS in his last 12 games vs. the A's.  
✎ Trevor Larnach is hitting .326 (15-for-46) with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, three walks and an .867 OPS in 12 career games against the Athletics.  
✎ Royce Lewis has hit safely in 12 of 13 career games against the A's...in those 13, he is hitting .333 (16-for-48) with five doubles, four home runs, seven RBI and a 1.095 OPS.  
✎ Harrison Bader is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, seven RBI, a .564 slugging percentage and a .936 OPS in 12 career games against the A's.

**GOOD TRAVELERS:** The Twins have gone 12-5 in their last 17 road games, since May 3, after beginning the season 4-14 in their first 18, through May 2...below are their offensive (above) and pitching (below) comparisons this season:

**SWEEP SOUNDS:** Minnesota is seeking its fifth sweep of the season today...the other four came April 25-27 vs. Los Angeles-AL at Target Field, May 6-8 vs. Baltimore at Target Field, May 9-11 vs. San Francisco at Target Field and May 16-18 at Baltimore...Twins had five sweeps all of '24.

✎ Minnesota's last sweep over the A's came in four games at Target Field from June 13-16, 2024...that was also their last four-game sweep of any opponent...they swept two four-game series last season, the other was April 22-25 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field.  
✎ The last time the Twins swept the A's as the road team was July 14-16, 2023 in three games at the Coliseum...in fact, the Twins have swept the A's in four games in California twice, those two coming July 7-9, 1978 and August 13-15, 1993.  
✎ The Twins have seven times this season entered a series finale with a chance to sweep, going 4-3 in those instances...their three misses were the finales against Chicago-AL on April 24, at Milwaukee on May 18 and vs. Kansas City on May 25.

**PARDON MY FRENCH:** Ty France has reached base safely in 16-straight games, one short of his career-high of 17, done twice (2021 and '23)...during the streak, he is hitting .328 (20-for-61) with one double, one home run, 11 RBI, six HBP and a .388 on-base percentage.  
✎ Over his last six games, France has 10 hits in 23 at-bats (.435).

**GOOD WILLI:** In his last 16 games, Willi Castro is hitting .340 (18-for-53) with three doubles, five home runs, eight RBI, eight walks, 13 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .435 on-base percentage, a .679 slugging percentage and a 1.115 OPS...over that stretch, he has raised his batting average 48 points, from .213 to .261.  
✎ Since the start of the Seattle series, May 30, he has gone 10-for-23 (.435) with one double, four home runs, six RBI, eight runs scored and a 1.536 OPS in six games.

**ONE BIG CALIFORNIA BIRTHDAY CAKE:** Joe Ryan is celebrating his 29th birthday today and Royce Lewis is celebrating his 26th birthday...Royce has played one major league game on his birthday, coming last season at Yankee Stadium, going 1-for-4 with a home run off Dennis Santana...back in 2018 he hit a grand slam on his birthday while playing for Low-A Beloit.

**YOU RIP OFF THOSE BATTING GLOVES!!:** Did you know that Twins.TV analyst Trevor Plouffe hit one of his two career grand slams against the Athletics...his first grand slam was off Chicago-AL's John Danks on May 3, 2015 at Target Field and his second was on July 17, 2015 at the Coliseum, off Sonny Gray.
