PITTSBURGH PIRATES (5-8) vs. CINCINNATI REDS (5-8)

April 11, 2025 - Great American Ball Park - Cincinnati, OH - 6:40 EDT - Game #14/Road #8
LHP Bailey Falter (0-1, 8.10 ERA) vs. RHP Brady Singer (2-0, 2.25 ERA)

THE PIRATES: had the day off yesterday...Went 3-3 in their first homestand of the season against the Yankees (1-2) and Cardinals (2-1)...Are in the fourth game of a six-game stretch against N.L. Central foes (took two of three from St. Louis at PNC Park from Monday-Wednesday) that was preceded by six straight games against A.L. East opponents (Tampa Bay and New York-AL)...Will resume their stretch of 13 out of 16 games being played at PNC Park with a seven-game homestand against Washington (April 14-17) and Cleveland (April 18-20).

SETTING UP THE SERIES: Pittsburgh has won each of the last three season series against Cincinnati, going a combined 28-17 Win that span (12-9 at Great American Ball Park since the beginning of 2022)...It's the first time the Pirates have won three straight season series against the Reds since 1964-66...Since the start of the 2022 season, Pittsburgh pitchers have posted a 3.89 ERA (398.0ip/172er) against Cincinnati, including 22 games of allowing three runs or fewer.

WALKOFF WEDNESDAY: The Pirates ended their first homestand with a 13-inning walkoff win Wednesday against the Cardinals...The Pirates have been involved in five walkoffs this season (two wins, three losses)...The last MLB team to have at least five of its first 13 games of a season be decided by a walkoff was the Reds in 2012 (also five)...Courtesy of OptaStats.

PUNCH 'EM OUT IN BUNCHES: Pittsburgh pitchers combined to strike out 10 St. Louis batters in Wednesday's win, marking the fourth straight game in which the staff has combined to strike out 10-plus batters (since Sunday vs. the Yankees)...The last time Pittsburgh struck out 10-plus batters in at least four straight games came from August 19-23, 2024, when it did so in five consecutive games (the final two games of that streak were against the Reds, in which Pirates pitchers combined to strike out 23 Cincinnati batters).

AND THE WHIFF: Pittsburgh's pitching staff has recorded 116 strikeouts through 13 games this season...According to OptaStats, that is tied for the second-most the team has thrown through 13 games since 2000 (130 in 2019).

A PIRATES LIFE FOR ME: The Pirates have 21 stolen bases this season, which ranks second in MLB...That is Pittsburgh's most through the first 13 games of a season since the 1983 season (also 21)...Courtesy of OptaStats.

JOEY BARRELS: Joey Bart delivered a walkoff single in Pittsburgh's 2-1, 13-inning win over St. Louis at PNC Park on Wednesday...It was the first walkoff hit of Bart's career...He's hitting .455 (5-for-11) over his last three games, having recorded at least one RBI in each of those contests...It's the first time he's posted at least one RBI in three consecutive games since August 14-18, 2024.

FAST TIMES AT PNC PARK: Wednesday's 13-inning game between the Pirates and Cardinals took 3:23 to complete...It was the shortest Major League game of 13-plus innings since May 18, 2015, between the Diamondbacks and Marlins in Miami (3:11), and Pittsburgh's shortest game of 13-plus innings since May 16, 1979, vs. the Mets at Three Rivers Stadium (3:19)...In that game, which went 13 innings, Mike Easler hit a walkoff solo home run off Skip Lockwood.

FERGALICIOUS: Caleb Ferguson, who grew up a Reds fan and is a 2014 graduate of West Jefferson High School in the Columbus, OH, area, pitched a scoreless inning in Wednesday's win and has made seven consecutive scoreless appearances to begin the season...Ferguson is one of just two left-handed relievers in all of Major League Baseball (min. 7.0ip) to not allow a run yet this season, along with Kansas City's Daniel Lynch IV (also 7.0ip)...Dating back to September 16, 2024 (while he was with Houston), Ferguson has pitched to a 0.93 ERA (9.2ip/1er) across his last 11 appearances.

GUIDING THE SHIP: With Pittsburgh's next win, skipper Derek Shelton will earn his 300th managerial victory...He would become one of 12 managers in franchise history to win at least 300 games as the team's skipper, joining Fred Clarke (1422), Danny Murtaugh (1115), Jim Leyland (851), Clint Hurdle (735), Chuck Tanner (711), Frankie Frisch (539), Pie Traynor (457), Bill McKechnie (409), George Gibson (401), Lloyd McClendon (336) and Billy Meyer (317).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 11, 2008: Paul Maholm held the Reds scoreless for 5.1 innings before leaving the game in the sixth inning following a rain delay of over an hour. When play resumed, Jason Bay crushed a 3-2 offering from Jared Burton into the seats in left field in the bottom of the sixth, giving Pittsburgh its only run in a 1-0 win vs. Cincinnati. Matt Capps pitched a perfect ninth to earn the save.

HOW ACQUIRED: From Philadelphia in deal for INF Rodolfo Castro on 8/1/23.

STARTING OFF: The 27-year-old lefty is in his third season with the Pirates after being acquired from the Phillies at the trade deadline on August 1, 2023 in exchange for infielder Rodolfo Castro...He's in his fifth Major League season after debuting in 2021... He was selected by Philadelphia in the fifth round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Falter lost a 10-4 decision at the hands of the Yankees on April 5 at PNC Park, when he struck out five and allowed seven runs over 4.0 innings of work.

AGAINST CINCINNATI: Falter has made eight appearances (six starts) against the Reds in his career, going 0-3 with a 7.02 ERA (33.1ip/26er) and 24 strikeouts...He faced Cincinnati three times in 2024, going 0-2 with a 6.19 ERA (16.0ip/11er), including an outing of 7.0 innings (two runs) in a 2-1 loss at PNC Park on June 18...He has an 11.05 ERA (14.2ip/18er) in four games (three starts) at Great American Ball Park...His last start here came last June 24, when he allowed five runs (four earned) over 4.0 innings.

ALL GOOD THINGS COME TO AN END: In his last start on April 5, Falter had his streak of plate appearances without hitting a batter snapped at 1124 (began on August 20, 2022) when he hit the Yankees' Jazz Chisholm Jr. leading off the second inning...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, the last pitcher with as long of a streak without hitting a batter was Yusmeiro Petit (1205 plate appearances) from April 21, 2017 to June 6, 2021.

2024 IN REVIEW: Falter spent his first full season in the big leagues while going 8-9 with a 4.43 ERA in 28 starts with the Pirates in 2024...He was on an Opening Day roster for the third straight season after also doing so with the Phillies in both 2022 and 2023.

MARVELOUS MAY: In the month of May last season, Falter pitched a career-best 19.2 consecutive innings without allowing a run from 5/12 to 5/24...Overall, he posted a 2.23 ERA (32.1ip/8er) across his five starts that month...Among National League pitchers in the month of May, Falter ranked ninth in innings pitched and 12th in ERA.

STAYING IN THE PARK: Falter surrendered 11 home runs in 68.1 innings (1.45 per 9.0 innings) in his first 12 starts of the 2024 season...In his last 16 starts beginning on 6/12, he surrendered six home runs across 74.0 innings, averaging just 0.73 per 9.0 innings.

JUST LIKE SANDY: Growing up in Chino Hills, California, Falter's father, Darwin, taught him to idolize fellow left-handed pitcher Sandy Koufax...Bailey would do reports on Koufax at school and even had a framed picture of the Dodgers southpaw hanging above his childhood bed...To this day, his delivery on the mound mimics that of Koufax...In 2024, he ranked in the 98th percentile in extension (per Baseball Savant).

BACK HOME IN CALIFORNIA: Attended Chino Hills High School, where he was classmates with NBA players Lonzo and LaMelo Ball...Falter had committed to play collegiately at the University of California, Santa Barbara prior to being drafted by and signing with Philadelphia in 2015.
