TODAY'S GAME: The Giants play their final road game of the season this afternoon as they face the Dodgers for the last of a four-game set...SF is looking to even out the series with a win today.

- The two teams are in the midst of a stretch where they play each other seven times in their final 10 games of the year.
- Last night's defeat put SF below .500 for a second time this series...the Giants haven't been more than two games under .500 since May 21 (22-24)
- The Giants have dropped seven of nine games on this road trip to Colorado (1-3), Arizona (0-2) and Los Angeles (1-2)...SF has been outscored by a 57-32 margin...the pitching staff has allowed 57 runs in that span (6.33 runs/game) but only 47 of those are earned...the bullpen has a 7.53 ERA (29er, 34.2ip)...SF's offense has averaged 3.6 runs per game.

THE RIVALRY: SF owns a slight 5-4 edge over LA this year with four more games remaining in the head-to-head matchup... both of these teams play next weekend at Oracle Park.

- The Giants have won four of their six games here at Dodger Stadium this year, outscoring LA 36-23 in the six contests.
- SF batters are averaging 6.0 runs per game here at Chavez Ravine despite slashing just .217/.320/.362...the pitching staff is posting a 3.33 ERA (20er, 54.0ip) here.

ROAD WOES: The Giants have dropped 27 of their last 33 road games since July 19...their 6-27 (.182) road record since then is the worst mark among all MLB teams and their worst stretch in any 33-game span on the road since 1996.

- The Giants have been outscored by a 191-107 margin on the road since July 19...they've scored two runs or fewer in 17 of those 33 games.
- Giants pitchers have posted a 5.67 ERA (171er, 271.2ip), the highest road ERA in the Majors since July 19.
- ▶ SF is plating just 3.24 runs per game in these last 33 road contests, fewest in MLB.
- SF's last road series win since was at Pittsburgh right after the All-Star Break, July 14-16 (three-game sweep).

A WILD RACE: Just seven games remain on the Giants' regular season schedule as they enter today 4.0 games behind the Cubs for the third and final Wild Card spot in the NL...the Giants also trail the Marlins by 3.0 games and the Reds by 1.5.

- The Giants had entered the start of this trip in Colorado last Friday in the third NL Wild Card spot, but losses in seven of nine games since has pushed SF to the fringes of contention.
- Entering play today, FanGraphs gives the Giants a 0.5% chance of making the playoffs.

HOMEBODIES: SF wraps up its final road game of the season today...the Giants have gone 34-46 (.425) on the road this vear.

- The 34 wins are SF's fewest in a full season since going 31-50 (.383) on the road in 2018...their winning percentage is also lowest since 2018.
- The Giants have 14 blown saves on the road this year, their most since blowing a franchise-worst 19 saves in 2021.

EL DE BEJUMA: IF Thairo Estrada has a career-best 41 extrabase hits this season (26 doubles, two triples, 13 homers). with his 22 steals, Estrada became just the fifth middle infielder in Giants history to record at least 40 extra-base hits and 20+ stolen bases in a single season.

He is the first Giants player of any position to reach those marks in a season since Hunter Pence in 2013 (67 XBH, 22 SB).

PATIENCE IS KEY: When reaching a full count this month, Giants hitters have a 32.9% chase rate...the mark is best in the NL and second-lowest in MLB behind the Rangers (28.6%).

- The Giants have drawn 49 walks in full counts this month, second-most in the Majors behind the Twins (57)...their 32 strikeouts in those counts are tied for seventh-fewest in the NL.
- ▶ In three-ball counts, SF batters are averaging a 25.7% chase rate, fourth-lowest in the Majors in September behind the Rangers (20.4), Cubs (25.2) and Twins (25.6).

THE LONG BALL: Giants hitters have homered 24 times in September, their most in a month since May (30)...SF finished June and July with 23 home runs and had 22 in August.

The Giants scored 43% of their runs via home run in this month.

LEADING OFF: SF leadoff hitters have a .360 on-base percentage and .802 OPS this season, their highest of any batting spot.

- > SF's .360 OBP from its leadoff hitters is sixth-best in the Majors, while their 11.8% walk rate ranks fourth behind the Dodgers (13.6), Phillies (13.2) and Twins (12.3).
- The Giants have had a variety of different players starting a game in the leadoff spot this season.
