ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Giants dropped game one of this fourgame series to the Rockies last night, losing 3-2 on a throwing error...it snapped a streak of five consecutive wins against the Rockies and eight-straight wins at Coors Field.

- The Giants collected just two hits, matching their fewest ever in a game at Coors Field (also Sept. 5, 2016, two hits).
- The Giants had been no-hit for 8.0 innings last night before J.D. Davis' leadoff double in the 9th.
- This week in baseball there had been three no-hit bids broken up in the 9th inning or later in the last six days Giants/ Rockies last night, A's/Astros on Wednesday and Brewers/ Yankees last Sunday...according to Elias, that's the shortest span in at least the expansion era (1961) for three no-hit bids to be broken up in the 9th inning or later.

IT'S GONNA BE A LONG DAY: The Giants and Rockies play a doubleheader today, with game one being the rescheduled game from Thursday night.

- It's the Giants' first doubleheader of the season.
- The last time the Giants took both ends of a doubleheader against the Rockies in Denver was July 15, 2019.
- The Giants have never lost both games of a doubleheader to the Rockies in Denver.

SOLID AS A ROCK: The Giants have won eight of their 10 matchups against the Rockies this year and 16 of their last 18 dating back to last August.

- Since the start of the 2021 season, SF is 37-11 (.771) with a +119 run differential against Colorado.
- According to Stats, LLC, the Giants' eight sweeps of the Rockies since 2021 are the most by a team against any opponent.

200-INNING PLATEAU: RHP Logan Webb reached the 200-inning mark for the first time in his career...he's the first Giants pitcher to reach that mark since **LHP Madison Bumgarner** threw 207.2 innings in 2019...Webb's 201.0 innings this season leads all MLB pitchers.

A WILD RACE: Entering today at 75-72 (.510), the Giants currently sit 1.0 game behind the Reds and Diamondbacks for the third and final Wild Card spot in the NL...the Giants are also 0.5 game back of the Marlins.

 Entering today, FanGraphs gives SF a 31.0% chance of making the postseason.

OUR HAPPY PLACE: A handful of Giants have found a lot of success here at Coors Field throughout their careers.

- ▶ IF Wilmer Flores has a .441 career OBP here at Coors Field... the mark is the second-highest among active players trailing only Starling Marte (.460)...Flores' .365 average here is tied for third-best.
- ▶ IF Brandon Crawford has played 99 career games here at Coors, his most at any visiting ballpark...Crawford has collected 77 RBI here, his most at any other ballpark by a wide margin (Chase Field is second at 38).
- Crawford's 77 RBI at Coors are tied for second-most by any visiting player...Adrián González is first with 88.
- ▶ IF Thairo Estrada owns a .356/.415/.661 slash line in 16 games here at Coors Field.

BLOW OUT THE CANDLES: RHP Jakob Junis celebrates his 31st birthday today.

ROAD WOES: The Giants enter today having lost each of their last seven games on the road...in fact, SF has lost 21 of their last 25 road games since July 19, the worst road record of any team in the Majors in that span.

- The Giants have been outscored by a 137-77 margin on the road since July 19.
- They've been held to two runs or fewer in 13 of their last 25 road games.
- The Giants' last road series victory was a three-game sweep at Pittsburgh right after the All-Star Break, July 14-16.

WHAT'S LEFT?: Just 15 games remain on the Giants' regular season schedule...following this series in Denver the Giants continue this 10-game road trip with two in Arizona followed by a four-game set against the Dodgers in Los Angeles...the Giants' final homestand is a six-game set against the Padres (three games) and Dodgers (three games).

YAZ MAN: SF's offense has vastly improved since welcoming **OF Mike Yastrzemski** back from the IL on August 30...the outfielder, who's hitting .350 with a 1.147 OPS in 14 games since returning, has played particularly well over his last eight games, going 11-for-25 (.440) with a .500 OBP.

His .655 SLG at Coors Field is third-best among active players, trailing Jake Cronenworth (.696) & Christian Walker (.673)...his 1.039 OPS is fourth-best behind Cronenworth (1.124), Walker (1.062) and Bryce Harper (1.056).

GIANT LEADER: IF Thairo Estrada currently paces the team in both hits (118) and stolen bases (21)...if he were to lead the team in both those categories at the end of the season, he'd become just the seventh Giants player to lead his team in hits and stolen bases in back-to-back seasons.

WITH THE GIANTS: In his first year at the Major-League level for SF...was selected by the Giants in the fifth round (136th overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Iowa Western Community College.

BACK IN THE FOLD: This marks Winn's third game and second start since being recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on September 1...today will also be Winn's fourth career MLB start, and second straight against the Colorado Rockies.

LAST OUTING: Winn lit up the strike zone in his last start, earning his first career win on September 10 vs. the Rockies...the rookie struck out a career-high nine in the game...Winn allowed all three runs, and three of his five hits, in the 2nd inning.

VS. COLORADO: His last start was against the Rockies in which he allowed three runs on five hits (one being a two-run triple by **IF/OF Hunter Goodman**) while striking out nine in 6.0 innings... Winn told the media postgame that Colorado "likes to swing the bat a lot, and a splitter is designed for teams like that...I felt like I threw a lot."

STRIKING IT RICH: Winn threw 62 of 80 pitches for strikes in his last start vs. Colorado...he is the only pitcher in the Majors this season to throw that many strikes with fewer than 81 pitches...he is also just one of five Giants to throw at least 60 strikes in a game in which he threw fewer than 81 pitches.

WINN THE DAY: Despite this being Winn's fourth career MLB start, the rookie has pitched at least 3.0 innings in all seven career outings...he's twice thrown 6.0 innings, including in his last start September 10...he is just one of three Giants rookies since 2010 to pitch at least 3.0 innings in each of his first seven career games (others: Andrew Suárez in 2018 and Shaun Anderson in 2019).

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Winn and LHP Kyle Harrison (11 strikeouts on August 28 vs. CIN) are the first Giants rookie duo to each strike out nine or more in a game in the same season since 2003: Jesse Foppert (10 strikeouts on June 11 at CWS, 10 strikeouts on July 20 vs. COL) and Jerome Williams (nine strikeouts on August 1 at CIN).

KEEPING IT GROUNDED: The rookie relies on ground-balls to get outs, with a 60.2% ground ball-rate...the 60.2% ground ball rate ranks 12th in MLB (min. 30.0 innings)...Colorado had seven ground-ball outs against Winn on September 10, and has a season ground-ball rate of 41.6%, which is 21st in MLB.

MEET THE ROOK: One year prior to being drafted and signing with SF, Winn was selected by the Giants in the 20th round of the 2017 MLB Draft...he opted to return to college...Winn missed two years of MiLB action, first with the 2020 season cancellation, and next by missing the entire 2021 season recovering from Tommy John surgery...he is currently the Giants' No. 16 prospect on MLB.com.

IS THIS HEAVEN?: The rookie told the media prior to his MLB debut that he had never been inside an MLB stadium before...his first Major League stadium would be the Cardinals' Busch Stadium, earning the save while striking out two and allowing one run in 4.0 innings of relief on June 13.

IT'S IOWA: Winn grew up in Ollie, Iowa, which had a population of 201 people in the 2020 census...over 30 friends and family members drove four-plus hours from Ollie to St. Louis to see Winn's debut on June 13.

SAVE YOUR TEARS: He became the third MLB pitcher since 1969 (when saves became an official stat) to pitch at least 4.0 innings and earn the save in his MLB debut (*Elias*)...the other pitchers to achieve the feat were St. Louis' Zack Thompson (June 3, 2022) and Boston's Bob Stanley (April 16, 1977).
