LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 7-6 @ Rangers last night in 10 innings to snap a 3-game win streak.

- First time their first 5 hits of the game went for extra bases since Sept. 11, 2024 vs. Rangers (5 XBH in innings 1-2) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].
- Ninth time homering 4+ times in a game, tied for third in MLB with the Athletics and Tigers, behind the Yankees (13) and Cubs (13).
- First team to homer 3+ times off Nathan Eovaldi in a game this season (ninth career time)...last to do so was also the D-backs on Sept. 10, 2024 (3 HR).
- Corbin Carroll** hit his career-high 26th homer (solo in third inning) and has hit 4 homers in his last 5 games... was his second straight multi-hit game.
- Geraldo Perdomo** hit his 12th home run (2-run in third inning), doubling his previous career high (6 in 2023)...was his third straight multi-hit game.
- Tyler Locklear** hit his second homer and recorded his second career multi-hit game...was the second NL player to homer off Nathan Eovaldi in 2025 (last: Freddie Freeman on April 19).

SNAKE BITES: The D-backs have homered in 9 straight games (since Aug. 2)...tied for second longest active streak in the Majors with the Braves, behind the Mariners (11)...Arizona's season high is 12 straight games with a homer (June 23-July 5).

- In their last 4 games with runners in scoring position, the D-backs are hitting .400 (16-for-40)/.405 OBP/.675 SLG/1.080 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 homers, 22 RBI and 1 walk.
- Geraldo Perdomo** has hit safely in 8 straight games, including 4 multi-hit games...is hitting .438 (14-for-32)/.514 OBP/.625 SLG/1.139 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 5 walks (3 K).
- Corbin Carroll** has 1+ RBI in 5 straight games, tied for the longest active streak with Carlos Correa/HOU, and an extra-base hit in 5 straight games (4 HR, 1 2B), the second longest active streak, behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (6).
- Blaze Alexander** has 4 multi-hit performances in his last 8 games and hit safely in 9 of his last 10 games.
- Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 9 straight games since August 1, with a .390 OBP, 3 doubles, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 5 walks (4 K).

- TRENDING BATS:** Over his last 12 games (since July 29), **Geraldo Perdomo** is hitting .409 (18-for-44)/.500 OBP/.614 SLG/1.114 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 9 walks...has struck out 3 times in his last 54 PA.
- Blaze Alexander**, over his last 10 games since August 1, is hitting .371 (13-for-35)/.476 OBP/.686 SLG/1.162 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 8 RBI, 5 walks and 2 hit-by-pitches.
 - Corbin Carroll**, over his last 9 games, has a .778 SLG with 2 doubles, 5 homers and 11 RBI.
 - Alek Thomas**, over his last 8 games, is hitting .357 (10-for-28)/.387 OBP/.643 SLG/1.030 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 5 RBI, 1 walk and 1 hit-by-pitch.

ROAD ROLL: **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 6 straight road games, hitting .409 (9-for-22)/.481 OBP/.727 SLG/1.209 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 5 RBI and 4 walks...has not struck out in 27 straight road PA.

- Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 7 straight road games, hitting .320 (8-for-25)/.419 OBP/.680 SLG/1.099 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 2 homers, 5 RBI and 5 walks (4 K)...has recorded 1+ RBI in 4 straight road games.

INTERLEAGUE BATS: **Alek Thomas** has 4 straight multi-hit games in interleague matchups and has reached base safely in 6 straight games, batting .476 (10-for-21)/.522 OBP/.857 SLG/1.379 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 3 RBI and 2 walks.

- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 6 straight interleague games, batting .409 (9-for-22)/.481 OBP/.727 SLG/1.209 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 5 RBI and 4 walks (0 K).

VS. OPPOSING STARTERS: In their last 9 games vs. opposing starters, the D-backs have scored 44 earned runs in 41.1 innings (9.58 ERA) with a .335 AVG/.418 OBP/.606 SLG/1.024 OPS with 11 doubles, 1 triple, 11 homers and 21 walks...since August 2, their .335 AVG, .418 OBP, .606 SLG, 1.024 OPS, 42 runs and 21 walks vs. opposing starters rank best among NL teams.

HOMER STRETCH: Since August 1, the D-backs' 17 homers rank tied for fourth with the Mariners and Tigers, behind the Blue Jays (19), Brewers (18) and White Sox (18).

EARLY SCORING: The D-backs have scored 2+ runs within the first 3.0 innings in 8 straight games, the longest streak in MLB this season, and have scored 1+ first inning runs in 6 of their last 7 games (11 runs).

- Since the All-Star break, among MLB teams in the first 3.0 innings, the D-backs rank in, OBP (1st, .357), SLG (1st, .543), OPS (1st, .900), extra-base hits (1st, 33), runs (T-1st, 48 with Orioles) and AVG (3rd, .291).

ON-BASE MACHINE: **Geraldo Perdomo's** 70 times on base since July 1 rank atop the Majors, ahead of Nick Kurtz/ATH (68), Vladimir Guerreo Jr./TOR (66), Corey Seager/TEX and Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (64).

- Perdomo has reached base in 32 of his 35 games since July 1, hitting .344 (44-for-128)/.452 OBP/.484 SLG/.936 OPS with 7 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 20 RBI and 23 walks (13 K).

TAKING THE EXTRA BASES: The D-backs have added 7 extra runs by taking extra bases [bases advanced on fly balls, passed balls, wild pitches, balks, defensive indifference], tied for second most in the Majors with the Tigers, behind the Brewers (13).

- Corbin Carroll's** 6 extra runs by taking extra bases are the most in the Majors this season, ahead of Jarren Duran/BOS (5), Elly De La Cruz/CIN (5) and Trea Turner/PHI (4).

NEXT STARTER: RHP ZAC GALLEN (9-12, 5.31)

- Will face off against longtime teammate Merrill Kelly for the first time.
- Has won in back-to-back starts for the first time since July 1-7.
- Won his last start on Aug. 8 vs. Rockies after tossing 6.0 innings with 1 run on 4 hits and 3 walks with 6 strikeouts.
- In 4 career starts vs. Rangers, is 2-1 with a 2.78 ERA (7 ER in 22.2 IP) with 3 walks and 32 strikeouts.

AT A GLANCE: First season with the D-backs...signed as a Major League free agent on June 15.

- 12th season in the Majors along with Marlins (2014), Reds (2015-20, did not pitch in 2017), Giants (2021-23), Twins (2024, did not pitch due to injury).
- In 2024, acquired by the Twins on January 29, 2024, from the Mariners, but missed the entire season after suffering a right elbow strain in Spring Training that require forearm flexor tendon surgery.
- In 2021 with the Giants, set career bests with 13 wins, 3.17 ERA, .225 OPP AVG, .634 OPP AVG.

SNAKEBITES: Fourth start with the D-backs, second on the road...made his first road start on Aug. 1 @ Athletics (L; 4 ER in 2.1 IP).

- Made his first Major League start since July 18, 2023 on July 6 vs. Royals...in 4.0 innings, allowed 4 runs on 4 hits with 0 walks and 6 strikeouts.
- In his last Major League season in 2023 with the Giants, appeared in 19 games (18 starts), going 3-8 with a 4.88 ERA (59 R-54 ER), opponent .271 AVG (105-for-388)/.767 OPS, 20 walks and 79 strikeouts.

2025 OVERVIEW: Signed by the D-backs on June 15...released by the Yankees on June 12...signed by the Yankees on May 13.

- In 5 starts for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (NYY) from May 17-June 10, went 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA (11 R-10 ER in 20.0 IP), an opponent .300 AVG (24-for-80)/.796 OPS, 9 walks and 20 strikeouts.

LAST START: On Aug. 6 vs. Padres, tossed 4.1 scoreless innings on 3 hits with 0 walks and 4 strikeouts.

- Was his first scoreless start since May 2, 2023 @ Astros (0 ER in 8.0 IP, 0 BB, 3 K).
