LHP Colton Gordon was recalled from Triple-A Nashville today.....the team optioned **RHP Garrett Stallings** to Nashville.....Gordon is the 58th player (34th pitcher) to appear on the active roster this season.

Making a Habit of It

The Brewers have qualified for the postseason for the eighth time in the last nine seasons and for the fourth season in a row.....the team has won the NL Central for the fifth time in the last six seasons and fourth season in a row.....Milwaukee became the first team ever to win the NL Central in four straight seasons.....the division was formed in 1994 and the Brewers joined the division in 1998.

Bye Bye Bye

The Brewers' magic number to clinch a first round postseason bye is 4.....any combination of Brewers wins and Braves losses totaling 4 will do it.

They're Out of Our League

The Brewers are 131-74 (.639) since 2022 during Interleague Play, which is just percentage points behind the Dodgers (133-75, .639) for the best record in the majors.....the team has gone 29-16 (.644) this season, which trails only the Pirates (28-14, .667) and Dodgers (31-17, .646).

Joey Bats

In his last 55 games, **Joey Ortiz** is batting .341 (58-for-170) with 7 HR and 27 RBI.....during this stretch, he has a .384 OBP/.553 SLG/.937 OPS.

Say It Ain't Joe!

Joey Ortiz is on a career-high-tying 8-game hitting streak during which he is batting .419 (13-for-31, 1hr, 4rbi) with a .438 OBP/.581 SLG/1.018 OPS.

20/20 Vision

With 9 games remaining in the 2026 season, **Jackson Chourio** (23hr/17sb) and **Brice Turang** (19hr/19sb) have a chance to be the second duo in franchise history to produce 20/20 campaigns in the same season.....Chourio (21hr/22sb) was joined by **Willy Adames** (32hr/21sb) in 2024.

THIS EVENING'S GAME: Is the fourth game (2-1) of a 9-game, 10-day road trip to Pittsburgh (2-1), Baltimore (3g) and Philadelphia (3g).....following this trip, the Brewers conclude the regular season with 3 games against St. Louis at American Family Field.

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: RHP Grant Anderson (right biceps), LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Bryse Wilson (low back), RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the injured list....Fitzpatrick, Priester, Woodruff and Zerpa are on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy (477g, 285-192, .597) is in his third season as Brewers manager.....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025.....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25).....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval** (1st season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez** (1st season), hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** (1st season), first base coach **Spencer Allen** (1st season), third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role).

IN THE STANDINGS (176 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 138, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7.....the Brewers are in first place, leading the second-place Cubs by 10.0 games.....the team has held first place for the last 122 days.

AT HOME: The Brewers are a National League-best 52-26 (.667) at home, going 20-4-1 in series play.....the team has won its last 11 home series.....after a 7-7 start, the Brewers have gone 45-19 (.703) at home.....the team has had three season-high 5-game home winning streaks (4/30-5/12, 5/25-6/2 and 9/7-9/12).

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 43-32 on the road, going 14-8-2 in series play.....the team has had season-high 5-game road winning streaks from 5/31-6/8 and 6/21-7/3.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 39 replay challenges this season, going 27-12.....their last challenge (lost) came on 9/8 vs. Chicago-NL as a hit by pitch involving Miguel Amaya stood.

BREWING SUCCESS: Including 2026, the Brewers have qualified for the postseason eight times in the last nine seasons and four seasons in a row.....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in 10 straight seasons (2017-26), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by only a single game.....Milwaukee has won the NL Central for the fifth time in the last six seasons and fourth season in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last nine full seasons (2017-26).....the Dodgers' streak is since 2012.....this does *not* include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 858 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (946), Astros (883) and Yankees (876).

MAY AT A GLANCE: Dustin May, 29, will be making his 29th start of the season and first against the Orioles.....it will be his eighth start for the Brewers.....May last started last Friday vs. Cincinnati and earned a 20-0 win (6ip, 2h, 1bb, 6k, 84 pitches).....he was acquired from St. Louis on August 3 with LHP JoJo Romero for OF Alexander Frías and OF Josiah Ragsdale.....his teams are 13-15 in his starts (3-4 w/MIL).....he has 13 quality starts (3 w/MIL).....opponents are batting .253 (132-for-522, 11hr).....May has gone 2-2 with a 4.91 ERA in 7 starts with the Brewers (29.1ip, 27h, 16r, 16er, 11bb, 27k, 4hr).....he has a mutual option for 2027.

CAREER: Has gone 26-29 with a 4.05 ERA in 99 games/85 starts (462.1ip, 408h, 224r, 208er, 159bb, 430k, 51hr).....has pitched for Los Angeles-NL (2019-25), Boston (2025), St. Louis (2026) and Milwaukee (2026).....has three World Series rings with the Dodgers (2020, 2024 and 2025).....he missed the entire 2024 season while recovering from “Tommy John” surgery and an esophageal tear.....it was his second “Tommy John” surgery (also 5/11/21).....May was selected by the Dodgers in the third round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft from Northwest (TX) High School.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-3 with a 5.00 ERA in 6 starts (27ip, 15er).....is 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA in 5 starts this season (25.1ip, 14er).....he took a no-hitter into the eighth inning against the Brewers on May 27 but took a 2-1 loss.

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 12-15 with a 4.58 ERA in 48 games/40 starts (206.1ip, 105er).....is 2-4 with a 5.50 ERA in 12 starts this season (52.1ip, 32er).

CAREER vs. ORIOLES: Is 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in 2 games/1 start (8ip, 9h, 2r, 2er, 3bb, 7k, 1hr).....his only career outing at Oriole Park came with the Dodgers out of the bullpen on 9/11/19 (2ip, 1h, Or, 1bb, 2k).....his other appearance vs. Baltimore came in a start and 6-3 loss with the Red Sox on 8/18/25 at Fenway Park (6ip, 8h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr).

ODDS & ENDS: Prior to being drafted by the Dodgers was committed to Texas Tech University.....he resides in Justin, TX.....is married.....wife's name is Millie.
