THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY
On this date in 1982, RHP Jim Palmer tossed the last of his four one-hitters by defeating the Minnesota Twins, 3-0, at Memorial Stadium...Palmer retired the first 17 batters before 3B Gary Gaetti hit a fifth-inning single...He walked two batters later in the game, but did not allow a runner to reach second base.



LET'S PLAY TWO: The Orioles and Yankees will play a doubleheader tonight with two seven-inning contests beginning at 5:05 p.m...The second game will begin approximately 45 minutes after the first game concludes...Tonight marks the second doubleheader of the season for Baltimore and first since August 5 when the Marlins and swept a twin bill at Oriole Park...Since the team moved to Baltimore in 1954, the Orioles are 170-147-294 (sweep-swept-split) in doubleheaders... At home, the O's are 103-69-171...On the road, they are 67-78-123...The records do not include May 19, 1957 and April 22, 1961, in which one of the games was a tie...The Elias Sports Bureau provided a few notes for tonight's seven-inning games:

⚾ Rule 9.17 regarding credit for a win to the starting pitcher still applies...If a pitcher pitches a complete game and does not allow a run in a game that was scheduled for seven innings, he will be credited with a shutout...No-hitters by teams and individuals shall not be credited in scheduled seven-inning games, unless the game goes to extra innings and the team (or individual in a complete game) pitches at least nine innings and does not allow a hit.

⚾ In 1991, Major League Baseball's special committee for statistical accuracy, chaired by Commissioner Fay Vincent, ruled that in order for a pitcher to be credited with a no-hitter "a pitcher or pitchers had to pitch a complete game of nine innings or more without allowing a hit"...Any game of fewer than nine innings in which a pitcher or pitchers do not allow a hit should be considered as a "notable achievement"...Those are noted as such in The Elias Book of Baseball Records.

A FULL PLATE: Tonight's Orioles-Yankees twin bill is one of five doubleheaders in the majors today, joining the Nationals-Braves, Red Sox-Blue Jays, Twins-Tigers, and Pirates-Reds...There are 20 games scheduled today in the majors...Should all of the games be played, it would mark the most games on a day since August 4, 1974 (20 games)...The Major League record for most games on one day is 21, which came on September 7, 1970, a day that featured nine doubleheaders (source: @theaceofspader).

THE MORE THE MERRIER: The Orioles have four different players (INF Hanser Alberto - 14, INF José Iglesias - 12, INF Renato Núñez - 10, and OF Anthony Santander - 10) who have recorded double digit multi-hit games this season...The four players rank as the most in the AL and are tied for the most in the majors (San Diego and Arizona)...Alberto's 14 multi-hit games are tied for second in the AL and are tied for the third-most in the majors.

⚾ INF José Iglesias has recorded a multi-hit game in a career-high seven-straight games, the longest multi-hit game streak in the majors this season.

⚾ Iglesias' seven-game multi-hit game streak is tied for the third-longest such streak in Orioles history and is the longest by an Oriole since Vladimir Guerrero also recorded seven-straight from May 14-21, 2011...The Orioles record is 10-straight multi-hit games, done twice (Rich Dauer, July 18-28, 1978 and Bob Nieman, May 4-22, 1958).

.400 HITTER: INF José Iglesias went 2-for-5 on Wednesday against the Mets and is now hitting .405 (34-for-84) through his first 22 games with the Orioles...Among players with at least 50 at-bats, Iglesias' .405 average leads the majors, while DJ LeMahieu (NYY) ranks second with a .382 average.

I SAN-TAN-DARE YOU: OF Anthony Santander went 0-for-5 on Wednesday, but has hit safely in 22 of his last 26 games...His recent hitting streak of 18 games marked a career high...Santander hit .329 (25-for-76) with eight home runs, eight doubles, a triple, and 20 RBI from August 5 [2]-23.

⚾ Santander's 11 home runs on the season lead the O's, are tied for sixth in the AL, and are tied for ninth in the majors...He ranks third in the AL and is tied for fourth in the majors with 32 RBI this season...25 of his 40 hits have been for extra-bases (13 doubles, one triple, 11 home runs), leads the AL and leads the majors with 25 extra-base hits.

THAT HANSER IS SO HOT RIGHT NOW: Since the start of the 2019 season, INF Hanser Alberto leads the majors with 100 hits off of left-handed pitching...In that time, he leads the majors with a .405 (100-for-247) average against lefties...This season, Alberto ranks sixth in the AL and 13th in the majors with a .321 (45-for-140) average against all pitchers.

SMALL BALL FOR ALL: The O's lead the majors with 12 bunt hits this season...OF Cedric Mullins leads the majors with seven bunt hits, while INF Hanser Alberto is tied for second in the majors with three bunt hits and INF/OF Andrew Velazquez is tied for fourth in the majors with two bunt hits.

CATCH THIS: The O's catching corps of Pedro Severino, Chance Sisco, and Bryan Holaday ranks among league leaders in many offensive categories...Severino ranks seventh in the AL with a .310 (31-for-100) overall batting average...O's catchers ranks (while catching):

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: The O's have been very successful swinging at the first pitch of an at-bat...They rank first in the majors in batting average (.410), rank third in OPS (1.109) and are tied for third in extra-base hits (24), lead the AL and are rank second in the majors in doubles (15), and lead the AL and are tied for sixth in the majors in hits (57) as a team on the first pitch.

INJURED LIST: Seven players are on the Injured List...RHP Alex Cobb is on the Injured List...RHP Shawn Armstrong (left SI joint inflammation; retroactive to 8/26), INF Chris Davis (left knee patellar tendinitis), and OF Austin Hays (non-displaced rib fracture), are on the 10-day Injured List...LHP Wade LeBlanc (left elbow stress reaction), INF/OF Trey Mancini (colorectal cancer recovery/treatment), and INF Richie Martin (right wrist fracture) are on the 60-day IL.

LAST START: Made his sixth Major League start (13th appearance) and second start of the season on 8/13 at PHI...Earned the win after tossing 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits (one home run) with two strikeouts...Since his last start on 8/13, he has made four appearances out of the bullpen, with his last coming on 9/1 vs. NYM, when he was credited with his third win of the season after surrendering two runs on two hits (one home run) through 1.0 inning of work...Has earned the win in each of his last two outings (9/1 vs. NYM and 8/23 vs. BOS).

CAREER VS. NEW YORK-AL: This will be Eshelman's third career appearance (first start) against the Yankees...He has gone 0-0 with a 4.76 ERA (3 ER/5.2 IP) with two strikeouts in his first two relief outings...His 4.76 ERA is his lowest mark against any AL East opponent.

START IT UP: Eshelman has started six career games, with his other 11 career outings coming in relief...In his six career starts, Eshelman has posted a 1-2 record with a 6.26 ERA (19 ER/ 27.1 IP), nine home runs, six walks, and 19 strikeouts...Has gone 1-0 with a 4.00 ERA (4 ER/9.0 IP) and four strikeouts in his two starts this season.

HOME NOT-SO-SWEET HOME: Eshelman has pitched in 10 games (two starts) at Oriole Park in his career, posting a 3-2 record and 5.83 ERA (19 ER/29.1 IP) with 17 strikeouts through these outings, compared to a 1-0 record and 4.94 ERA (15 ER/27.1 IP) in seven games (four starts) on the road.

OH, THE RELIEF: As a reliever, he has allowed five hits (5-for-38) in 11.2 IP this season...Did not allow a run or a hit in his outing on 8/23 vs. BOS (earned his third career win); was the longest scoreless outing of his career (in a start or relief) at 4.1 innings...Eight of his 11 career appearances out of the bullpen have been 2.0-or-more innings.

LEFT IS RIGHT: Eshelman held opposing left-handed batters to a .241 (14-for-58) average with two doubles and four home runs with the Orioles last season, while right-handers batted .359 (33-for-92) with four doubles and eight home runs against him...Between Triple-A Norfolk and Triple-A Lehigh Valley, Eshelman held International League left-handed batters to a .237 average (31-for-131) in 2019.

2019 HIGHLIGHTS: Made his Major League debut with the Orioles on 7/1 at TB, taking a no-decision (5.0 IP, 6 H, 2 ER, BB)...He did not record a strikeout in his debut, making him just the third pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) with at least 5.0 innings pitched in their Major League debut without a strikeout...Struck out his first career batter on 7/14 vs. TB, striking out INF Willy Adames in the second inning and set a career-high with seven strikeouts in the start...Earned his first career win on 8/4 vs. TOR, tossing 5.0 innings in relief...Made 10 appearances for Baltimore, pitching to a 1-2 record with a 6.50 ERA (26 ER/ 36.0 IP) and 22 strikeouts...Made 17 appearances (16 starts) across three different minor league affiliates (Double-A Reading, Triple-A Lehigh Valley, and Triple-A Norfolk), going 3-5 with a 4.65 ERA (48 ER/ 93.0 IP).

QUICK HITS: Was acquired by the Orioles from Philadelphia in exchange for International Signing Bonus Slots on 6/9/19...Was acquired by Philadelphia from Houston along with RHP Vince Velasquez, RHP Mark Appel, LHP Brett Oberholtzer and RHP Harold Arauz in exchange for SS Harold Arauz and RHP Ken Giles on 12/12/15...Was originally selected by the Houston Astros in the 2nd round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Cal State Fullerton.

GAME 2 STARTER - RHP JORGE LÓPEZ (0-0, 7.53 ERA)

López will be making his second start (sixth appearance) of the season...In his last outing, his first start of the season, López worked 4.2 innings, allowing three runs on three hits with three walks and three strikeouts on 8/30 at TOR; did not factor in the decision as the O's fell 6-5...This will be his third career start against New York-AL, having gone 0-1 with a 10.13 ERA (9 ER/8.0 IP) in his first two starts...His last start against the Yankees came last year, on May 25 in Kansas City, when he allowed five runs in 1.0 inning of work.

LAST START: Made his first start of the season on 8/30 at TOR and took a no-decision after allowing three runs (earned) on three hits and three walks, while striking out three over 4.2 innings...Will be his fifth outing with Baltimore after starting the year in Kansas City...Was claimed off waivers from Kansas City on 8/9 and made his Orioles debut on 8/16 vs. WSH...His last relief appearance came on 8/25 at TB, where he tossed a scoreless inning in the bottom of the eighth, allowing one hit and one walk.

CAREER VS. NEW YORK-AL: In two career starts against the Yankees, Lopez is 0-1 with a 10.13 ERA (9 ER/8.0 IP) and seven strikeouts...His last start vs. NYY came on 5/25/19 at Kauffman Stadium, where he took the loss after allowing five runs on six hits in just 1.0 inning of work...Matched the shortest start of his career (also 1.0 inning on 9/20/18 at DET).

FACING THE AL EAST: In his career, Lopez has made 13 appearances (eight starts) against the AL East, and holds a 2-3 record with a 5.96 ERA (32 ER/48.1 IP) and 38 strikeouts...AL East opponents are batting .270 (50-for-185) with seven home runs against Lopez in his career.

FOR STARTERS: Lopez is 6-13 with a 6.40 ERA (96 ER/135.0 IP) in 28 career starts...Is 1-6 with a 7.26 ERA (46 ER/57.0 IP) in 12 career home starts, compared to his 5-7 record and 5.77 ERA (50 ER/78.0 IP) in 16 career road starts...
