YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles dropped the series opener to the Tigers, 1-0...Gunnar Henderson tripled with two outs in the ninth inning to break up Detroit's no-hitter...Zach Eflin tossed his 12th quality start of the season after completing 6.2 innings, allowing one run on five hits (1 HR) with one walk and three strikeouts...The lone run scored on a one-out first-inning homer from Kerry Carpenter.

(b) According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Henderson became the third Oriole to break up a no-no with two outs in the ninth inning, joining Jim Traber (1B) off Dave Stieb on September 30, 1988 at Toronto, and Davey Johnson (1B) off Blue Moon Odom on June 7, 1968 vs. Oakland; he's the third player in the expansion era (since 1961) to break up a no-hit bid with a triple with two outs in the ninth inning or later, along with Boston's Bobby Dalbec with no outs in the 10th inning on April 23, 2022 at Tampa Bay, and St. Louis' Bernard Gilkey with two outs in the ninth on September 25, 1995 at Chicago-NL.

(b) Henderson became the third player in MLB this season to end a no-hitter attempt with two outs in the ninth inning, along with Texas' Corey Seager (HR) off Framber Valdez on August 6 vs. Houston, and New York-NL's J.D. Martinez (HR) off Raisel Iglesias on May 11 vs. Atlanta; Max Fried (7.0 IP) and Joe Jiménez (1.0 IP) pitched the first 8.0 frames for the Braves.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The 0's have lost six of the last eight games since September 4...The team is 83-65 (.561) and 3.0 games behind the Yankees (.581, 86-62) in the AL East...Baltimore is 25-27 (.481) since the All-Star break and 30-34 (.469) since July 1...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 184-126 (.594), the second-best winning percentage in MLB behind the Dodgers (.605, 187-122) during that time.

Os An AL East winner has not finished the season with a record under .600 since 2015-17; Boston won the divison in 2017 and 2016, as did Toronto in 2015, with a 93-69 (.574) record.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles are second in MLB with 216 home runs behind the Yankees (218)...The Dodgers rank third with 205. The O's have hit 200 home runs in access facts 17th 17th HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles are second in MLB with 216 home runs behind the Yankees (218)...The Dodgers rank third with 205...The 0's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13th time in team history and the 216 are the most by the club since 2017 (232)...Baltimore is averaging 1.46 homers per game this season, which would be the third-best mark in team history behind 1996 (1.58), and 2016 (1.56).

6) Baltimore has an MLB-best nine players with at least 10 home runs: Anthony Santander (41), Gunnar Henderson (36), Colton Cowser (20), Adley Rutschman and Jordan Westburg (18), Cedric Mullims (15), Ryan Mountcastle and Ryan O'Hearn (13), and Ramón Urías (10); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.

6) Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 35 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (52) and Juan Soto (33); Baltimore did not have a player reach 35 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2016 that the team has had multiple players with 35+ home runs (Trumbo, 47; Davis, 38; Machado, 37).

6) The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and second in MLB this year behind the Phillies (14); Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one season by an Oriole behind Brady Anderson, who hit all 12 in 1996; Cowser (2) and Westburg (1) have the other three for the 0's in 2024.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson was named the AL Player of the Week on Monday...The award marked the second of his career, joining June 11, 2023...He slashed .417/.464/.833 (10-for-24) with one double, three homers, six runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games while ranking among AL leaders during the period in slugging percentage (1st), home runs (T-1st), total bases (T-1st, 20), OPS (2st), 1.297), batting average (T-2st), and hits (T-2st), home runs (T-1st), total bases (T-1st, 20), OPS (1st), home runs are the most by an Orioles shortstop in team history, surpassing the record of 34 held by Cal Ripken, Jr. (1991) and Miguel Tejada (2004).

(b) Henderson's 111 runs scored are tied for third in the AL and for fourth in MLB, and are the most by an Oriole since Jonathan Villar (111) in 2019; the last Oriole with 112 or more runs is Roberto Alomar, who set the club record with 132 in 1996; Henderson is the sixth player in 0's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining with Manny Machado (2, 2015-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Brian Roberts (3, 2007-09), Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).

(b) He's on pace to score 122 times; Alomar (132 in 1996), Frank Robinson (122 in 1966), and Ripken, Jr. (121 in 1983) are the only players in Orioles history (since 1954) to score at least 120 runs in a season.

Jr. (IZ1 in 1983) are the only players in unions instury (since 1997, to 30010 at 1993. In a season. He ranks fourth in the AL and tied for fourth in MLB with 7.4 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr. set the club record with 10.6 in 1991; eight Orioles (13 occurrences) have finished a season with at least 7.0 fWAR; in a season; he's also among AL leaders in walks (3rd, 72), total bases (3rd, 312), home runs (T-4th, 36), extra-base hits (T-5th, 70), hits (6th, 163), on-base percentage (7^{rh}, 366), OPS (7th, 904), and slugging percentage (7^{rh}, 538). Henderson has hit 30 of his home runs as the leadoff hitter, the second player in Orioles history to do so, along with **Brady Anderson** (35) in 1996; he's batting .316/.374/.694 (31-for-98) with seven doubles and 10 home runs when leading off the game...His 1.068 OPS to begin a game is the best such mark in MLB this year and the second-best such OPS by an Oriole in team history, behind Anderson (1.256) in 1996 (min. 55 GS).

MASHED TATERS: Anthony Santander launched his 40th home run of the year on Monday, becoming the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to do so and the first since Mark Trumbo in 2016 (see chart at right)... He's the eighth switch-hitter (12th occurrence) in MLB history to hit at least 40 homers in a season, along with New York-NL's Carlos Beltrán (2006), Houston's Lance Berkman (2: 2002, 06), Texas' Mark Teixeira (2005), Atlanta's Chipper Jones (1999), New York-NL's Todd Hundley (1996), San Diego's Ken Caminiti (1996), and New York-AL's Mickey Mantle (4: 1956, 58, 60-61)...Mantle is the only switch-hitter in MLB history to hit 50 homers, when he did so in 1956 (52) and 1961 (54).

O: He's five RBI shy of 100 for the season; no Oriole has reached that mark since Jonathan Schoop (105) in 2017; the last Baltimore switch-hitter to do so is Bobby Bonilla (116) in 1996.

O: Santander has hit 32 home runs since the start of June, tied with New York-AL's Aaron Judge, trailing Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani (33) for the most in MLB during that time; his 41 home runs rank third in MLB behind New York-AL's Aaron Judge (52) and Ohtani (47).

O: His 102 home runs since the start of 2022 rank sixth in MLB during that time and second in the AL, behind only Judge (151).

O: He's the ninth player in 0's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining Manny Machado (3, 2015-17), Chris Davis (4, 2012-13, 15-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Rafael Palmeiro (4, 1995-98), Eddie Murray (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), Boog Powell (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), Frank Robinson (3, 1966-67, 69), and Jim Gentille (2, 1961-62).

O: Santander is 13th in team history with 152 home runs, six behind Melvin Mora for 12th.

HOLY COWSER: Colton Cowser leads AL rookies and is tied for second among MLB rookies with 20 home runs with Milwaukee's Jackson Chourio, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (23)...He's the 10th rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since Gunnar Henderson (28) last year...He also has 21 doubles, the ninth rookie in 0's history to record 20 doubles and 20 homer runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-2B, 28 HR) in 2023...Among rookies, Cowser is second in the AL and fourth in MLB with 3.5 fWAR, trailing New York-ALs Austin Wells and PIT's Paul Skenes (3.6), and San Diego's Jackson Merrill (4.5)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1st, 70), extra-base hits (2nd, 44), total bases (2nd, 196), doubles (T-3nd, 21), RBI (3nd, 62), and OPS (4th, .759).

Oh His 11 Outs Above Average are more than all other 0's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders; Detroit's Riley Greene is the next closest left fielder with four OAA.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Baltimore's penultimate road trip began in Boston on Monday...Yesterday, the Orioles opened a three-game set in Detroit following a scheduled off day on Thursday...Despite losing 16 of the last 27 road games, the Orioles are 41-32 (.562) away from Oriole Park, tied with the Mets for the fourth-best road record in MLB this season, trailing the Brewers (.566, 43-33), Padres (.589, 43-30) and Yankees (.600, 45-30)...The Birds are 93-61 (.604) on the road since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road winning percentage above .600 in that time.

AGAINST THE TIGERS: The Orioles and Tigers continue their first series of the year tonight at Comerica Park...The two teams face off for three games in Detroit over the weekend before meeting for three more in Baltimore next weekend...The 0's won the season series against Detroit in 2023, going 6-1, including a three-game sweep in Baltimore from April 21-23...The 6-1 record last season marked Baltimore's first time winning more than five games in a single season against Detroit since the 2004 club swept the six-game season series...The Birds went 3-1 at Comerica Park in 2023 after going 5-12 in 17 games from 2017-2022...Baltimore currently holds the AL's top Wild Card spot while Detroit is 2.5 games back of the Twins for the final spot.

<u>THE SKIPPER:</u> Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...He is two wins away from 400 for his career, all with Baltimore...Four previous managers have won 400 games at the helm of the Orioles: **Earl Weaver** (1,480), **Buck Showalter** (669), **Paul Richards** (517), and **Hank Bauer** (407).

Oulck Hits: Scheduled to make his 30th start of the season tonight against the Tigers...Will be the third straight season of at least 30 starts, joining 2023 (32) and 2022 (33), both previously with Milwaukee...Has set a career high with 13 wins and tied a career high with 13 wins and tied a career high with 16 sees (2022 & 2023)... Started for the AL in the 2024 All-Star Game in Arlington, becoming the fifth 0's pitcher to start a Midsummer Classic... Placed on the Paternity List on June 28 for the birth of his twin daughters, Charlotte and Harper...The 0's are 18-11 in his starts this year, but have lost four of the last five... Has allowed a career-high 41 stolen bases this season, most in MLB, and the most by an Orioles pitcher in team history... A four-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his eighth loss of the year, tying a career high (2022 & 2023), after allowing two runs on seven hits (1 HR) and two walks with three strikeouts in 6.0 innings on September 8 vs. Tampa Bay...Surrendered a two-run homer in the sixth inning to Johnny DeLuca after a leadoff walk...Marked his 20th quality start of the year...Has lost four times in his last five appearances for the first time in his career, including a career-high three-game losing streak from August 16-28...Threw 93 pitches, 62 strikes.

AGAINST THE TIGERS: Scheduled to make his fourth career appearance (3 GS) against Detroit...Is 1-0 with a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP) with eight hits (1 HR) and three walks with 20 strikeouts vs. the Tigers in his career...Last faced the club on May 31, 2021 (6.0 IP, 6 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 7 K) and has pitched one previous time at Comerica Park on September 9, 2020 (W: 7.0 IP, H, 11 K); had a perfect game through 4.1 innings before allowing a triple to Willi Castro.

AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL: Will be making his 24th appearance (21 GS) against the AL Central...Is 11-1 with a 3.08 ERA (43 ER/125.2 IP) against the division in his career, including 3-0 with a 4.28 ERA (13 ER/27.1 IP) in five starts this season...Last pitched against an AL Central opponent on September 2 vs. Chicago-AL (W: 5.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, ER, BB, 4 K).

STEAL MY SUNSHINE: Burnes has allowed a career-high 41 stolen bases, the most in MLB this season and the most by an Oriole in team history...It's the most by a gain or leaguer since New York-NL's Noah Syndergaard (42) in 2019; Syndergaard also surrendered 48 in 2016...Since 1901, the highest total is 60 by New York-NL's Dwight Gooden in 1990.

HIGH OUALITY: Burnes has tallied 20 quality starts this season, second most in his career behind 2022(21)...Is one of five pitchers with 20 quality outings this year, along with Zack Wheeler (23), Logan Gilbert (22), and Tarik Skubal and Seth Lugo (21)...His 78 quality starts since 2021 are the second most in MLB behind Wheeler (80)...He's the first Oriole with 20 quality outings since Wei-Yin Chen in 2015; Chris Tillman is the last Oriole with more than 20, tossing 21 in both 2013 and 2014...Burnes tossed a career-high 10 consecutive quality starts from April 26 to June 16, the longest such streak by an Oriole since Jeremy Guthrie in 2007(10, 5/8-6/26).

SUPPORT SYSTEM: Burnes received no runs of support in his last start for sixth time this year, and the 0's were shut out for the fifth time when he starts this season...The five such starts this year are the most by an Orioles hurler since Wade Miley in 2017; the most in one season for an Oriole is six by Dave McNally in 1973...Despite this, his 123 runs of support are second most in MLB behind Tarik Skubal (128) and his 6.31 RS/9 would be the seventh best by an Oriole since it was first measured in 1974, and the best since Dylan Bundy (6.37) in 2017 (min. 11P/team 6).

MR. RELIABLE: With his start tonight, Burnes will have made 30 starts in a season for the third straight year...He'll be one of four pitchers to do so entering today, along with Dylan Cease, Aaron Nola, and Logan Webb; José Berrios and Patrick Corbin are scheduled to start for their teams today and would also reach the feat...Burnes' 738.0 innings in that time are titled for third in MLB with Zack Wheeler, behind Nola (760.2 IP) and Webb (750.1 IP)...His 834 strikeouts since the start of 2021 are tied with Nola, behind only Cease (882).

STREAK SNAPPER: His start on August 4 at Cleveland snapped a streak of 17 straight games going at least 6.0 innings, the longest such run in MLB since 2022...Marked the longest such stretch by an 0's pitcher since Mike Mussina's 19-gamer from June 17 to September 22, 1998...He did not allow more than four earned runs during that time; the 17-game run of at least 6.0 innings and no more than four earned runs was the longest stretch in 0's history.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Selected to his fourth consecutive All-Star Game and made his first start...Became the fifth Orioles pitcher to start the Midsummer Classic, joining Steve Stone (1980), Jim Palmer (1978, 1977, 1972, 1970), Milt Pappas (1965), and Jerry Walker (1959)...Pitched a scoreless first inning, allowing a walk to Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani and a double to Philadelphia's Bryce Harper; left both runners stranded in scoring position...Caught by Adley Rutschman, the first all-Oriole starting battery in an All-Star Game.
