ORIOLES NOTES

- The Orioles fell to the Yankees by a score of 3-2, dropping to 14-24 and 9-10 at home...Lost their sixth straight game; marks their longest losing streak this season...Baltimore's bullpen had their first scoreless outing since May 14 at Detroit, lowering their season ERA to 3.38 (58 ER/154.2 IP)...Fell to 5-7 in one-run games this season.
- RHP Jordan Lyles received his first loss at Oriole Park this season...Pitched 7.0 innings and gave up three runs (two earned) on five hits...Posted a season-high eight strikeouts...Three of his last four outings have been quality starts...Is 1-1 with a 2.10 ERA (6 ER/25.2 IP) at home this season...Retired the last 13 batters he faced...Threw a season-high 106 pitches, 70 strikes.
- RHP Jorge López has not allowed an earned run in 13 consecutive outings (15.2 IP).
- LF Austin Hays (3-for-4, 2-2B, RBI, R) snapped his 0-for-18 skid with a double in the first inning...Recorded two doubles, his second time this year with at least two doubles in a game (4/28 at NYY, 3-2B)...Posted his 13th career game with at least three hits, and first since a four-hit effort on 5/8/22 (G1) vs. Kansas City.
- **DH Trey Mancini** (1-for-4, RBI) is batting .375 (21-for-56) with two home runs and six RBI since May 3; entered play today tied for third in the Major Leagues with 20 hits during that span.

YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees defeated the Orioles by a score of 3-2, improving to 28-9 and 14-5 on the road...Are 21-3 in their last 24 games...Marks the fifth time in franchise history that the Yankees won at least 28 of their first 37 games...Have won each of their last nine completed series; marks their longest series winning streak since a 10-series winning streak from July 27-August 24, 2021...Yankees starting pitchers have allowed three earned runs or fewer in 35 of their 37 games this season.
- RHP Gerrit Cole earned the win after working 7.0 innings and gave up two runs on six hits with five strikeouts...Has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 41 of his 50 starts since 2020...Has not allowed more than three earned runs since 9/29/21 at Toronto...Has gone 4-0 with a 1.04 ERA (3 ER/26.0 IP) in his last four starts vs. Baltimore...Threw 97 pitches, 70 strikes.
- RHP Clay Holmes extended his career-long scoreless streak to 19.2 innings (since 4/9).
- **3B Josh Donaldson** (2-for-4, R) has reached base safely in each of his last 24 games, his longest on-base streak since a 26-game streak from 6/21-7/23/16...Is batting .379 (11-for-29) with three home runs, seven RBI, and four multi-hit efforts in his last seven games.
- **2B Gleyber Torres** (1-for-4, 2B, RBI, R) has hit safely in six of his last seven games; batting .385 (10-for-26) with one home run and six RBI.
