PREVIOUSLY ON...: Yesterday, the Mets fell to the Detroit Tigers, 3-2, at Clover Park...RHP Adrian Houser made his third start of the spring and retired all 10 batters he faced, including five via the strikeout...INF Mark Vientos put the Mets on the board with a solo homer in the second...C Tomás Nido went 2-2 with a solo homer in the ninth...RHP Adam Ottavino, LHP Jake Diekman and RHP Cole Sulser each threw 1.0 scoreless inning in relief.

VS. MIAMI: Today the Mets will play their fourth of seven Grapefruit League games against Miami...New York has won two of their first three spring matchups against Miami...Last season, the Mets went 9-4 against the Fish, their best record against a division foe...Mets pitchers posted a 2.51 ERA (32 ER/114.2 IP) against Miami last season, their second-lowest mark against a single opponent behind only Arizona (2.14)... This season, the Mets take on the Marlins at Citi Field from June 11-13 and August 16-18...New York will play at loanDepot Park from May 17-19 and from July 19-22.

SOUND THE TRUMPETS: Tonight, RHP Edwin Díaz is scheduled to pitch in his first Grapefruit League game of 2024...In 2023, Díaz missed the entire season due to a ruptured patella tendon...In 2022, Díaz was named the Trevor Hoffman National League Relief Pitcher of the Year after posting a 1.31 ERA (9 ER/62.0 IP) with 32 saves and 118 strikeouts...The right-hander became the 12th pitcher in major league history to strike out at least 100 batters, record 30 or more saves, and sport a sub-1.50 ERA...A two-time All-Star, Díaz has pitched to a 2.93 ERA (130 ER/399.1 IP) and has recorded 205 saves over seven major league seasons.

SPRING BREAKOUT: On March 15, the top prospects from the Mets will take on the top prospects from the Nationals at Clover Park in the inaugural edition of MLB Spring Breakout...First pitch is at 3:10 PM and will be televised on SNY, MLB Digital and ESPN+... After the game, players from both teams will sign autographs on the Clover Park concourses for an hour...As an effort to showcase the top minor league ballplayers, 16 Spring Breakout games will take place from March 14-17 in Arizona and Florida.

B.A.T.TER UP: The Baseball Assistance Team (B.A.T) named the New York Mets as the National League recipient of the Bobby Murcer Award for leading all NL clubs in donations during the organization's annual Spring Training Fundraising Tour...The award is named after former B.A.T. Chairman and All-Star outfielder Bobby Murcer who helped launch the tour...B.A.T raised a record \$4.3 million during their 2024 Spring Training Fundraising Tour thanks to contributions from 1,700 major & minor League players, coaches and front office staff members among all 30 MLB Clubs.

NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES: The 2024 Mets enter the season with several new players on the roster... These include: free agent signings OF Harrison Bader, LHP Jake Diekman, RHP Shintaro Fujinami, RHP Jorge López, LHP Sean Manaea, RHP Luis Severino, RHP Michael Tonkin and INF Joey Wendle; trade acquisitions RHP Adrian Houser, RHP Yohan Ramírez and OF Tyrone Taylor; waiver claims RHP Max Kranick and INF Zack Short; and minor league free agents: RHP Austin Adams, C Austin Allen, INF Rylan Bannon, INF Ji-Man Choi, RHP Kyle Crick, OF Ben Gamel, INF Jose Iglesias, OF Taylor Kohlwey, RHP Cam Robinson, INF Yolmer Sánchez, RHP Chad Smith, RHP Cole Sulser, OF Trayce Thompson, INF Luke Voit and LHP Danny Young.

POLAR POWER: Pete Alonso finished the 2023 season third in the majors in homers (46) and second in RBI (118)...He became the fifth player in major league history with three or more seasons of 40 or more homers in their first five years, joining Ralph Kiner (four), Ryan Howard, Albert Pujols and Eddie Mathews (three each)...His 192 career home runs are the most in the majors since his MLB debut in 2019 and are the third-most in major league history by a player in their first five major league seasons trailing Kiner (215) and Pujols (201)...Alonso currently ranks tied for fourth with Howard Johnson on the Mets all-time home run list...Mike Piazza is next (220).

ARMS APLENTY: Through 14 games this spring, Mets pitchers have posted a 2.64 ERA (35 ER/119.1 IP), the best mark in the majors...The staff's 1.19 WHIP is the second-lowest mark in the majors...Mets relievers lead the majors in bullpen ERA with a 2.72 (26 ER/86.0 IP) clip...Mets starters have posted a 2.43 ERA (9 ER/33.1 IP), the second-lowest such mark in the majors...Over the last five games, Mets starters have not allowed an earned run over 16.1 innings and have recorded 26 strikeouts during that span.

TYLOR THE CREATOR: In three Grapefruit League outings (two starts), RHP Tylor Megill has posted a 1.13 ERA (1 ER/8.0 IP)...His 13 strikeouts this spring are tied for the fourth-most in the majors...Megill started the Mets Grapefruit League opener on February 24 vs. St. Louis and allowed one run over 2.0 innings... Over his last two outings, Megill has not allowed a run over 6.0 innings and has 10 strikeouts.

THE CREAM OF THE CROP: MLB Pipeline revealed their top 30 Mets prospects for the 2024 season... Several prospects on this year's edition began the spring major league camp...They are: INF Jett Williams (No. 1), OF Drew Gilbert (No. 2), INF Luisangel Acuña (No. 3), RHP Christian Scott (No. 5), C Kevin Parada (No. 9), RHP Mike Vasil (No. 11), RHP Dominic Hamel (No. 14), OF Alex Ramírez (No. 16) and LHP Nate Lavender (No. 24)...The following members from the club's 2023 Draft Class made the list: INF Colin Houck (No. 7), RHP Brandon Sproat (No. 13), TWP Nolan McLean (No. 19) and INF Boston Baro (No. 25).

WELCOME BACK: Former Mets INF Edgardo Alfonzo will be in camp from March 4 -13...Alfonzo played in Queens from 1995-2002 and was a National League All-Star in 2000...A 1999 Silver Slugger Award winner, Alfonzo slashed .292/.367/.445 with 120 home runs and RBI in 1,086 career games with the Mets...He was elected into the Mets Hall of Fame in 2021

MENDOZA LINES: Carlos Mendoza will begin his first season as the 25th manager in franchise history... The 44-year-old spent the previous 15 seasons with the Yankees organization, including the last four as the club's bench coach...From 2018-2019, Mendoza served as the Yankees' quality control coach...Prior to joining the big league coaching staff, Mendoza served as a manager and coach in the Yankees farm system...A native of Barquisimeto, Venezuela, Mendoza is the second full-time Venezuelan-born manager in big league history, joining Ozzie Guillén.

EXTRA EXTRA: This spring, Pete Alonso leads the majors with seven extra-base hits...Five of Alonso's seven extra-base hits have been doubles, tied for the second-most in the majors.

EXPECTED TO START

RHP TYLOR MEGILL: Will make his fourth outing of the spring tonight...In his last outing, March 5 vs. the Yankees, Megill started and threw 3.0 hitless innings with six strikeouts...Megill started in his 2024 Grapefruit League debut on February 24 vs. St. Louis and allowed one run over 2.0 innings...On February 29 at Houston, Megill threw 3.0 scoreless innings in relief and tallied four strikeouts...Last season, Megill went 9-8 with a 4.70 ERA (66 ER/162.1 IP) over a career-high 25 starts...The right-hander also established career highs in innings, strikeouts (105) and quality starts (six)...On April 7, the Mets home opener vs. Miami, Megill threw 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed three hits...Megill joined Tom Seaver (April 5, 1983) as the only other pitcher in franchise history to throw 6.0 shutout innings and allow three hits or fewer in a home opener...Courtesy of Elias...The 6-7, 230-pounder had a strong finish to the 2023 season, allowing three runs or fewer in each of his final eight starts of the season...During that span, Megill pitched to a 3.00 ERA (15 ER/45.0 IP), the fifth-best mark in the NL (Min. 45.0 IP)...In September, Megill posted a 2.76 ERA (9 ER/29.1 IP), the ninth-best mark in the NL during the month (min. 25.0 IP)...In his final start of the 2023 season, September 30 vs. Philadelphia, Megill tossed a career-high 7.1 innings.

MR. SMILE: Last season, Francisco Lindor became the Mets' fourth member of the 30-30 club (also, David Wright, Howard Johnson and Darryl Strawberry) as he established a career high with 31 stolen bases to pair with his 31 home runs...He joined Barry Larkin (1996), Alex Rodríguez (1998), Jimmy Rollins (2007), Hanley Ramírez (2008) and Bobby Witt Jr. (2023) as the only shortstops in major league history with a 30-30 season...The 30-year-old was among National League leaders in stolen bases (31, t-seventh), hit by pitches (12, t-13th), RBI, (98, 14th), home runs (31, 14th), extra-base hits (66, t-14th), total bases (283, 15th) and doubles (33, t-16th last season).

CLOVER PARK: The Mets will call Clover Park home for their 36th season...Opened in 1988, Clover Park seats 7,000 fans and also serves as the regular season home to the Mets Class-A affiliate St. Lucie Mets...The ballpark also donned the name Thomas J. White Stadium (1988-2004), Tradition Field (2004-2009, 2012-2016), Digital Domain Park (2010-2012) and First Data Field (2017-2019).
