PITTSBURGH PIRATES (5-10) vs. CINCINNATI REDS (7-8)

April 13, 2025 - Great American Ball Park - Cincinnati, OH - 1:40 EDT - Game #16/Road #10 RHP Carmen Mlodzinski (1-1, 5.19 ERA) vs. RHP Hunter Greene (1-1, 1.31 ERA)

THE PIRATES: dropped their second game in a row with a 5-2 loss on Saturday against the Reds...Will wrap up their brief, three-game road trip this afternoon...Are in the final game of a six-game stretch against N.L. Central foes (took two of three from St. Louis at PNC Park from April 7-9 before dropping the first two games of this series at Cincinnati)...

Will resume their stretch of 13 out of 16 games being played at PNC Park with a seven-game homestand against Washington (Monday-Thursday) and Cleveland (April 18-20)...Went 3-3 on their first homestand of 2025 (1-2 vs. New York-AL, 2-1 vs. St. Louis).

HEADING HOME: The Pirates will return to PNC Park to begin a seven-game homestand tomorrow night, starting with four games against the Nationals...Pittsburgh has won each of the last three season series against Washington, going 13-8 in that span (4-3 in 2024)...Dating back to the beginning of the 2021 season, the Pirates have won 10 of their 15 games vs. the Nationals at PNC Park.

<u>CARMEN'S ELECTRIC</u>: Carmen Mlodzinski will get the start for the Pirates in today's series finale...He earned his first Major League win as a starter in his last outing on April 7 at PNC Park after allowing one run and striking out a career-high six batters over a career-best 5.0 innings against the Cardinals...Today is also Mlodzinski's sixth career appearance (first start) against Cincinnati... Four of his five outings against the Reds have come here at Great American Ball Park, including on September 23, 2023, when he earned the only save of his Major League career in the team's 13-12 comeback win (the Pirates trailed 9-0 after three innings).

OH-SOLO-METO: Prospect Anthony Solometo punched out five batters and allowed one run on only one hit and one walk over 5.0 innings in Double-A Altoona's game at Akron last night...The 22-year-old Solometo, who is considered one of the Pirates' top prospects (No. 14 by MLB Pipeline / No. 15 by Baseball America), has posted a .067 batting

average against (2-for-30) with one run allowed in his first two starts of the season (10.0ip).

33 BUCS: With Henry Davis and Kyle Nicolas each making their season debut in Saturday's game at Cincinnati, Pittsburgh has now used 33 different players through the first 15 games of the season, most in all of Major League Baseball (Atlanta and Seattle have each used 32).

WALK THIS WAY: Pittsburgh has drawn 59 walks through its first 15 games of the season, sixth-most in all of Major League Baseball...In the 21st century, only the 2024 (68), 2016 (68), 2010 (62) and 2011 (61) Pirates had more walks through their first 15 games of a campaign.

LEAN ON THE LEFTIES: Andrew Heaney (6.0ip) and Tim Mayza (1.2ip) cobmined to toss 7.2 of Pittsburgh's 8.0 innings last night...It was the third game this year in which the Pirates have gotten 7.2-plus innings from lefties, tied with Philadelphia for most in MLB...Pittsburgh's 61.2 innings and 57 strikeouts from its lefties rank second and tied for fourth, respectively, in MLB.

CUTCH 22: Andrew McCutchen has 35 career home runs and 101 RBI against the Reds, both of which rank first among active Major League players...Thirty of his 35 home runs against Cincinnati have come as a member of the Pirates...The only three Pirates players to go deep more times against the Reds than McCutchen are Willie Stargell (41), Roberto Clemente (40) and Ralph Kiner (34).

FERGALICIOUS: Caleb Ferguson, who grew up a Reds fan and is a 2014 graduate of West Jefferson High School in the Columbus, OH, area, pitched a scoreless inning on Wednesday vs. St. Louis and has made seven consecutive scoreless appearances to begin the season...Ferguson is one of two left-handed relievers in all of Major League Baseball (min. 7.0ip) to not allow a run yet this season, along with Kansas City's Daniel Lynch IV (also 7.0ip)...He has a 0.93 ERA (9.2ip/1er) in his last 11 outings dating back to September 16, 2024 (when he was with Houston)...Hitters are 4-for-23 (.174) against Ferguson this season.

GUIDING THE SHIP: With Pittsburgh's next win, skipper Derek Shelton will earn his 300th managerial victory...He would become one of 12 managers in franchise history to win at least 300 games as the team's skipper, joining Fred Clarke (1422), Danny Murtaugh (1115), Jim Leyland (851), Clint Hurdle (735), Chuck Tanner (711), Frankie Frisch (539), Pie Traynor (457), Bill McKechnie (409), George Gibson (401), Lloyd McClendon (336) and Billy Meyer (317).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 13, 2015: Josh Harrison became the third player in team history to lead off a Home Opener with a home run, taking Detroit's Anibal Sánchez deep on the first pitch of the first inning in Pittsburgh's 5-4 win over the Tigers. He joined R.J. Reynolds (1986) and Billy Cox (1947) on that list. Corey Hart notched the 1000th hit of his career with a pinch-hit home run in the seventh inning.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in Comp. Balance A round (No. 31) of the 2020 Draft.

STARTING OFF: Last name is pronounced ma-JINSK-ee...This was Mlodzinski's first season as a member of the team's Opening Day roster...The 26-year-old righthander is in his third season with the Pirates...Mlodzinski was drafted as the team's Competitive Balance Round A selection (31st overall pick) in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE: In his last start on April 7 against St. Louis at PNC Park, Mlodzinski set career highs with 5.0 innings pitched and six strikeouts while earning his first Major League victory as a starter in Pittsburgh's 8-4 win...The six strikeouts were his most in a game at any level since also striking out six for Double-A Altoona at Erie on September 10, 2022...Ít also marked the first time Mlodzinski pitched 5.0-plus innings in an appearance since tossing 5.0 innings for Altoona on September 16, 2022 vs. Reading.

VS. CINCINNATI: Mlodzinski will be making the sixth appearance (first start) of his career against the Reds...He has not allowed a run in four career appearances (5.1ip) at Great American Ball Park, including two scoreless outings (3.1ip) here last season.

SAVE IT: Mlodzinski has one save in his MLB career, which came on September 23, 2023, here in Cincinnati...The Pirates rallied from being down 9-0 after three innings, staging their largest come-from-behind win in 137 seasons of National League play.

AS A STARTER: Today will be Mlodzinski's eighth career Major League start...He opened a total of four times in 2024, where he went 0-1 with a 1.42 ERA (6.1ip/1er). His start of 3.2 innings in his 2025 debut on March 31 at Steinbrenner Field against the Rays marked the first time he pitched more than 2.0 innings in a Major League start.

He spent his first two professional seasons as a starter from 2021-22, making 36 starts in that time between High-A Greensboro and Double-A Altoona... Mlodzinski also started 14 of 26 games in college at South Carolina (2018-20).

FINISHING 2024 STRONG: Mlodzinski posted a 1.98 ERA (13.2ip/3er) over his final 12 appearances of the 2024 season...He went 3-0 with a .167 batting average against (8-for-48) during those 12 outings, all of which came in the month of September.

2023 IN REVIEW: Mlodzinski reached the big leagues for the first time in 2023, making his Major League debut on June 16 at Milwaukee...In total, he appeared in 35 games (one start), posting a 3-3 record with 11 holds, one save, 2.25 ERA (36.0ip/9er), 34 strikeouts and 18 walks...He held opponents scoreless in 24 of his 35 outings.

AS A PROSPECT: Mlodzinski entered the 2022 season rated by Baseball America as the No. 10 prospect in Pittsburgh's minor-league system...He began the 2021 season ranked by MLB Pipeline as Pittsburgh's 10th-best prospect...At the end of the 2020 season, he had the "best changeup" in Pittsburgh's system, according to MLB Pipeline.
