BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues a stretch of 13 games in 13 days with the third of four games against the Mariners tonight at Oriole Park...The Birds and M's are in the midst of meeting seven times in an 11-game stretch with the O's traveling to Seattle for a three-game series from June 16-18...After falling a season-high eight games under .500 on May 21, the Orioles have gone 10-8 (.555), but have dropped four games in a row.

👉 Tonight, the Birds look to avoid a season-high-tying fifth consecutive loss (also 4/30 [G2]-5/4).

👉 During the current four-game losing skid, Baltimore is batting .129 (4-for-31) with runners in scoring position, including 1-for-11 in last night's defeat...The O's have left 10 men on base in each of the last two games, marking the first time they have left double-digit runners on base in consecutive game since a four-game stretch from August 18-22, 2025.

👉 The Orioles have lost each of their last three games when scoring 4+ runs after going 14-2 when scoring at least four runs from May 5-June 5.

YOUNG MONEY: Baltimore is 8-1 (.889) in games started by **Brandon Young** this season, the second-highest winning percentage in the majors (min. 5 GS) behind HOU's Spencer Arrighetti (9-1, .900).

👉 In five starts since May 11, Young has posted a 2.83 ERA (9 ER/28.2 IP) with the O's going 5-0 in those games.

👉 He has limited the opposition to a .134 (9-for-67) clip on his four-seam fastball this season...The .134 average off the offering is fourth lowest in MLB (min. 60 AB ending in pitch) behind PHI's Zack Wheeler (.106, 7-for-66), TEX's Jacob Latz (.127, 8-for-63), and KC's Cole Ragans (.133, 10-for-75).

SUCCESS AGAINST SEATTLE: Since the beginning of the 2023 season, the Orioles are 13-7 (.650) against the Mariners...The winning percentage is the second-highest mark by any club against Seattle during that period (min. 10 G) behind the Yankees (15-7, .682).

👉 **Gunnar Henderson** is 7-for-16 (.438) with two doubles and a home run against George Kirby, while **Pete Alonso** is 3-for-5 (.600) with one home run and three RBI.

INSIDE THE MATCHUP: Since May 1, **Pete Alonso** is 11-for-34 (.324) with six home runs off four-seam fastballs, while **Blaze Alexander** is 12-for-26 (.462) with one long ball.

👉 Over his last four starts since May 17, George Kirby has allowed opponents to slash .318/.348/.682 (7-for-22) with two doubles and two home runs of his four-seamer.

PITCHING PROWESS: Oriole starters have posted a 3.19 ERA (39 ER/110.0 IP) in 20 games since May 19, the fifth-lowest mark in the majors behind the Dodgers (2.28), Mariners (2.58), Yankees (3.00), and Nationals (3.09)...The club's rotation has surrendered two runs or fewer in 12 of those games...Prior to that stretch, Baltimore starters owned a 5.24 ERA, the second-highest clip in the majors ahead of the Rockies (5.62).

HOMER HAPPY: The Birds have hit 34 home runs since May 16, tied for the MLB lead along with the Athletics, Giants, Mariners, and Nationals.

👉 The O's have hit 44 home runs at home this year, tied for fourth in the AL and tied for seventh in the majors.

LEFTY MASHER: **Coby Mayo** is slashing .314/.364/.745 (16-for-51) with four doubles, six home runs, and 12 RBI off left-handed pitching this season.

👉 Since May 11, he is 10-for-18 (.556) with two doubles, four home runs, and seven RBI off southpaws.

👉 Overall, his .745 slugging percentage against left-handed pitching is second highest in MLB (min. 50 PA) behind NYY's Paul Goldschmidt (.800), while his 1.109 OPS is sixth highest behind Goldschmidt (1.300), CWS' Miguel Vargas (1.199), AZ's Corbin Carroll (1.152), MIA's Otto Lopez (1.142), and ATH's Shea Langeliers (1.118).

MOOVING ALONG: **Colton Cowser** is slashing .316/.375/.649 (18-for-57) with one double, six home runs, 12 runs, 15 RBI, and six walks in 21 games since May 17.

👉 Over his last 21 games, he is hitting .343 (12-for-35) with one double, three home runs, and a 27.0 percent strikeout rate on breaking and off-speed pitches...Prior to that period, he was 4-for-48 (.083) with zero extra-base hits and a 47.1 percent strikeout rate on such offerings.

👉 His six home runs this season have traveled an average distance of 418 ft., the furthest average home run distance in MLB (min. 5 HR) ahead of HOU's Cam Smith (417 ft., also 6 HR).

BLAZING THE TRAIL: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .367/.414/.544 (29-for-79) with six doubles, one triple, two home runs, 10 runs, 17 RBI, five walks (1 IBB), four stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 32 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

👉 His batting average since May 1 leads is second-highest majors (min. 75 AB) behind SF's Jung Hoo Lee (.370).

👉 Over his last 12 games (10 starts) at Camden Yards since May 13, he is batting .457/.513/.629 (16-for-35) with three doubles, one homer, seven runs, and 11 RBI.

CAMDEN CONFINES: The Orioles' .742 OPS at home ranks ninth in the majors, while their .691 OPS on the road ranks 17th in MLB.

👉 Birds pitching owns a 3.85 ERA at Camden Yards, compared to a 5.52 on the road...The home ERA ranks 14th in MLB, while the road ERA is second-highest in the majors ahead of the Twins.

👉 **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in 10 straight home games since May 13, drawing 10 walks against four strikeouts during that period.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3rd, 58), times on base (4th, 124), and on-base percentage (5th, .403).

👉 Ward has seen 1,324 total pitches this season, second most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (1,344).

👉 He has seen 452 of those pitches in a 3-2 count, second in MLB behind LAA's Mike Trout (485).

QUICK HITS: Young is set to make his 10th start of the season and the 22nd of his career tonight vs. Seattle...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23 and made his second start of the season on April 24 vs. Boston... Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his fourth victory on June 5 at Toronto, allowing three runs on seven hits (1 HR) and zero walks over 6.1 innings pitched with four strikeouts...Marked his career-high third straight quality start since May 24 (G1), over which he holds a 2.29 ERA (5 ER/19.2 IP) with three walks to 15 strikeouts...Threw 85 pitches, 64 strikes.
 ⚡ Marked the fourth time in his career allowing zero walks (last: 8/15/25 at HOU).
 ⚡ Earned his second career win vs. the AL East (also 4/24 vs. BOS) and now holds a 3.60 ERA (12 ER/30.0 IP) over five career starts against the division.

NEW TEAM, WHO DIS?: Young is scheduled to make his first career start against Seattle tonight...He's 1-5 with a 7.62 ERA (24 ER/28.1 IP) over six career starts opposite the AL West and has thrown 4.0 innings or fewer in four of those outings...The 7.62 ERA marks his highest ERA against any division behind the NL East (6.52 ERA).
 ⚡ However, Young is 3-2 with a 3.20 ERA (18 ER/50.2 IP) over a combined nine career starts against the AL East and AL Central.

VELO UPTICK: Young's average fastball has climbed to 93.9 mph in 2026, up 1.4 miles per hour from 2025 (92.5 mph)...The 1.4 mph increase is the fifth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB this season, trailing LAA's Ryan Zeferjahn (+2.0 mph), SD's Adrian Morejon (+1.8 mph), ATH's Hogan Harris (+1.7 mph), and CWS' Sean Newcomb (+1.5 mph).
 ⚡ His .134 (9-for-67) opponent average on his four-seamer is the third-lowest mark in MLB (min. 65 AB ending in the pitch) behind PHI's Zack Wheeler (.106) and KC's Cole Ragans (.133).
 ⚡ His four-seam fastball has a run value of seven, which is the seventh-best mark in the American League and tied for the 11th-best mark in MLB.

HERE, THERE AND EVERYWHERE: Young's 35.7 percent chase rate is a 7.9 percent increase from 2025 (27.8%) and the eighth-best mark in MLB (min. 200 BF) behind PHI's Christopher Sánchez (38.3%), PHI's Zack Wheeler (37.5%), ATL's Chris Sale (36.6%), CHC's Shota Imanaga (36.4%), PIT's Braxton Ashcraft (36.4%), TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (36.1%), and LAD's Emmet Sheehan (36.1%).

THEM CHANGES: Young is averaging 83.0 mph and 1,329 revolutions per minute (RPM) on his split finger over his last three starts since May 24, during which opponents are hitting .176 (3-for-17) with no extra-base hits on the pitch...Over his first six starts of the season his splitter averaged 87.7 mph and 1,501 RPM, with opponents hitting .476 (10-for-21) off it with three doubles.
 ⚡ Last season opponents hit .281 (18-for-64) off his split finger with six doubles and five home runs...Threw the pitch 17.8 percent of the time in 2025 compared to 20.2 percent this season, marking a 2.4 percent increase in usage.

SPLITS: Young has thrown two consecutive quality starts at home for the first time in his career and holds a 3.49 ERA (11 ER/28.1 IP) over five total home starts this season compared to his 8.72 mark (31 ER/32.0 IP) over seven starts at Oriole Park in 2025... In nighttime games, he is one of four starters in MLB with at least four wins and zero losses, along with WSH's Foster Griffin (6-0), AZ's Eduardo Rodriguez (4-0), and HOU's Spencer Arrighetti (4-0).

CLEAN SHEET: On July 8, 2025 vs. New York-NL, Young threw an immaculate inning in the fifth frame, becoming the fifth pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to accomplish the feat, joining Kevin Gausman (4/23/18 vs. CLE, 7th inn.), B.J. Ryan (9/5/99 vs. CLE, 6th inn.), Mike Mussina (5/9/98 vs. TB, 9th inn.), and Jimmy Key (4/14/98 vs. CWS, 2nd inn.).

HOMECOMING: On August 15, 2025 at Houston, the Lumberton, Texas native earned his first career win, tossing a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit with zero walks and six strikeouts...He was perfect through 7.2 frames before Ramón Urías tallied an infield single, marking the longest perfect-game bid by an Oriole since Mike Mussina threw 7.2 perfect innings on August 4, 1998 vs. Detroit.

LAST TIME OUT: Bradish suffered the loss on June 6 at Toronto after permitting five runs on nine hits (1 HR) and three walks in 4.0 innings pitched with three strikeouts...The 4.0 innings tied a season low (3x, last: 5/2 at NYY) while the five runs tied a season high (also 5/2 at NYY)...Threw 81 pitches, 51 strikes.

vs. SEATTLE: Bradish is 1-0 with a 3.06 ERA (6 ER/17.2 IP) over three career starts against the Mariners...Has allowed two runs or fewer in each of those outings, during which the Orioles are a perfect 3-0...Hasn't faced Seattle since earning a quality start on August 13, 2023 at T-Mobile Park (ND, 6.0 IP, 2 R, 5 H, BB, 7 K).
