RAYS REPORT—The Rays open a brief three-game homestand against the Athletics (three to play) tonight at Steinbrenner Field...marks their final home games before embarking on a 10-game road trip through Minnesota, Detroit and Boston leading into the All-Star break...are coming off a six-game road trip through Kansas City (3-0) and Baltimore (1-2)...have won six of nine, 11 of 16, 17 of 25, 26 of 37, 28 of 42, and 38 of their last 61 games following a 9-14 start...are 17-9 in June, second in the majors behind the Astros (19-7)...own the majors' best record since May 20 (26-11)...are 11-5 on a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 13–July 2...are third in the AL/fifth in MLB in run differential (+71)...have the 10th-easiest remaining schedule in the majors by opponent winning pct. (.493)...three of their four series before the All-Star break will come vs. sub-500 clubs (ATH, MIN, BOS)...are 1.5 GB the first-place Yankees (48-35) in the AL East and have been within 1.5 games for six straight and eight of the last nine days...gained five games on New York during their 11-5 stretch since June 13...have had sole possession of second for 16 consecutive days, and have been in second or third for the last 37 days...on the season, they have spent two days in first, 33 in second, 23 in third, 30 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ★ The Rays dropped Sunday's rubber match at Oriole Park, 5-1, snapping a four-series unbeaten run (3-0-1) with their first loss since June 9-11 at BOS...they are still 8-2-2 in their last 12 sets, 10-3-2 in their last 15 and 13-5-2 in their last 20
- ★ They were held to one or zero runs for the 19th time, tied with the Guardians for fourth most in the AL behind the Rangers (24G), White Sox (24G) and Royals (23G)...the Rays average 6.81 runs in wins (3rd in MLB) and 2.24 runs in losses (25th in MLB)...Tampa Bay is 16-5 (.762) over its last 21 home games since May 20 after a 12-18 start, the second-best home record in the majors in that span behind Houston (17-5/.773).
- ★ The Rays have won five straight, 10 of 11 and 14 of their last 17 games following a loss...they last dropped back-to-back games June 10-11 at BOS...their 7-1 record in games following a loss this month is tied for the best in MLB (HOU, MIL).
- ★ With a win tonight, the Rays would finish June 18-9, the third-most wins during the month in franchise history behind the 2004 (20-6) and 2009 (19-7) seasons...18 wins would mark their most in a calendar month since April 2023 (22-6).
- ★ Tampa Bay paces the majors with 152 runs in June, its most since August 2023 (152).
- ★ Rays 7-8-9 hitters lead the majors with 50 RBI in June, seventh most in a calendar month in club history and their most since April 2023 (53RBI)...the team record is 56 RBI, set in May 2005...the bottom-third is 26-for-76 (.342) with RISP this month.

OPENING ACT—Despite snapping a streak of 10 consecutive series-opening wins last series in Baltimore, the Rays 17-10 mark in series openers is still tied with three other clubs (CIN, NYM, PHI) for second in the majors behind the Tigers (21-6)...they are 12-3 in their last 15 openers on the heels of a 5-7 start...the Rays have won six consecutive series-opening games at Steinbrenner Field, their longest home streak since claiming 12 straight to open the 2023 season (March 30–June 9)...their last series-opening loss at home was May 19 vs. HOU.

- ★ The Rays are 3-1 when **Drew Rasmussen** starts the first game of a series...he has not allowed an earned run in those outings (20.1IP).

FAMILIAR FACES—The Rays will be opposed by two of their former southpaws this series: **Jacob Lopez** and **Jeffrey Springs**...both pitchers were traded to the Athletics on Dec. 14, 2024 in exchange for **RHP Joe Boyle**, **INF Will Simpson**, **RHP Jacob Watters** and a Competitive Balance Round A selection...if both Lopez and Springs start, it would mark the fourth series in Rays history they were opposed by multiple starting pitchers who appeared for them the previous season—the other three instances occurred in 2022, when BOS **Rich Hill** and BOS **Michael Wacha** started games against Tampa Bay in three separate series (April 22-24, Aug. 26-28, Sept. 5-7) after pitching for the Rays during the 2021 season (Stats Perform)...the Rays have won four straight and seven of their last nine games against left-handed starting pitchers...the four-game streak is their longest since May 3–June 5, 2024 (6G).

- ★ **Yandy Diaz** is 10-for-24 vs. LHP over his last 27 games, **Jonathan Aranda** is 8-for-17 (.471) in his last 20, and **Jake Mangum** is 6-for-13 (.462) over his last 19.

LESS DRAMA, MORE WINS—The Rays have played a club-record 15 straight games decided by three runs or more, going 10-5 in that span...it is one of 19 such streaks of 15 games or more in the modern era (since 1900), but marks the second-longest active streak in the majors behind the Tigers (17G)...the major league record is 21 games, shared by the 2003 Cardinals and 1890 Philadelphia Quakers (Stats Perform)...the Rays are 26-18 in games decided by three runs or more compared to 21-19 with a margin of two runs or fewer.

YANDY MAN CAN—**Yandy Diaz** is batting .424/.495/.652 (39-for-92) with 4 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR, 13 RBI, 11 BB, 13 SO and 14 multi-hit efforts during a 23-game on-base streak, the second-longest active run in MLB behind ATL **Matt Olson** (30G) and the second longest of his career behind a 29-game streak from May 26–June 28, 2024...Diaz, who has eight multi-hit efforts in his last 11 games (20-for-45/.444), has raised his average from .237 to .291 since the streak began on June 3...his .424 average during the streak is the highest by a Ray over any 23-game span (min. 75AB) since **Carl Crawford** went an identical 39-for-92 (.424) from July 25–Aug. 19, 2007...hitting an MLB-best .406 (39-for-96) in June, Diaz is looking to become the third Ray to bat .400 or better over a calendar month (min. 75AB), joining **Fred McGriff** in July 1999 (.422) and **Matt Joyce** in May 2011 (.414).

- ★ He is batting .375 or better against all three pitch categories in June: fastballs (.429/.21-for-49), breaking pitches (11-for-29/.379) and offspeed pitches (6-for-16/.375).

DAWG POUND—**Brandon Lowe's** career-best 16-game hitting streak is the longest active run in the majors and is tied for seventh longest in franchise history...it marks the longest streak by a Ray since **Yandy Diaz's** club-record 20-game streak from June 7-28, 2024...Lowe, who is 25-for-62 (.403) with 2 2B, 5 HR and 13 RBI during the streak, has homered three times in his last four games and has an RBI in four straight...he also has a career-high 18-game on-base streak, tied for the third-longest active run in the majors.

BAG BANDITS—MLB stolen base leader **José Caballero** (29SB) and rookie steals leader **Chandler Simpson** (22SB) are the first pair of Rays to reach 20 SB before July since **Carl Crawford** (28SB) and **B.J. Upton** (24SB) in 2010...they are one of two sets of teammates in the majors to accomplish the feat this season, joining CHC **Pete Crow-Armstrong** (25SB) and CHC **Kyle Tucker** (20SB)...with a steal tonight, Caballero could become the fourth-fastest player to reach 30 SB in Rays history...he would reach the mark in the Rays 85th game, trailing only Crawford in 2009 (48G) and 2004 (66G) and Upton in 2009 (83G)...his next steal will also mark the 100th of his career...Simpson's 22 SB are already third most by a rookie in club history, trailing **Rocco Baldelli** (27SB) in 2003 and **Randy Winn** (26SB) in 1998.

- ★ The Rays lead the majors with 108 SB, ahead of the Cubs (100SB).

ATHLETIC ACHIEVEMENTS—The Rays and Athletics open a six-game season series tonight, with the clubs also meeting from Aug. 11-13 in Sacramento on the third leg of a four-city, West Coast road trip (Aug. 4-17)...the Rays have won three straight season series over the Athletics since 2022, the longest streak in franchise history, and have won five of the last seven season sets since 2017 (clubs did not meet in 2020), going 29-20 in that span, including 12-5 in the last 17 matchups...last season, the Rays took four of seven games, scoring the winning run in the 7th inning or later in each victory, including back-to-back walk-off wins May 29-30...they averaged 2.3 runs against the Athletics in 2024, the lowest mark in team history...the Rays have not lost a series to the Athletics since April 11-14, 2022 at Tropicana Field, going 2-0-2 since that set...their .43192 (92-121) all-time winning pct. against the Athletics is their second lowest vs. any AL opponent, narrowly better than their mark against the Yankees (.43191/203-267).

DOWN ON THE FARM—RHP **Brody Hopkins**, the Rays No. 7 prospect (MLB.com), was named the organization's lone representative on the AL squad for the 2025 Futures Game earlier today...the 23-year-old is 4-4 with a 3.64 ERA (71.2IP, 29ER) over 15 starts for Double-A Montgomery, leading the Southern League with 85 strikeouts...several current Rays have represented the club in past Futures Games: **Shane Baz** (2021), **Tai Bradley** (2022), **Curtis Mead** (2022), **Junior Caminero** (2023) and **Chandler Simpson** (2024).

- ★ Montgomery OF **Colton Ledbetter** was named Southern League Player of the Week for June 23-29, hitting .522 (12-for-23) with 3 2B, 1 HR and 4 RBI in six games.
- ★ Class-A Charleston RHP **Trevor Harrison** earned Carolina League Pitcher of the Week honors after retiring 18 of 19 batters over six hitless innings on June 25 vs. Lynchburg (W, 6.0IP, OH, OR, BB, 8SO)...Rays farmhands have collected 18 weekly awards, tied with the Giants for the most in baseball.

TONIGHT’S START—Drew Rasmussen will make his 17th start of the campaign and 12th at Steinbrenner Field...marks his 67th start (116G) of his career and his third start (4G) against the Athletics...ranks among AL leaders in WHIP (6th, 0.96), opp. OPS (6th, .560), ERA (7th, 2.45) and opp. average (8th, .204)...signed a two-year contract extension through 2026 with a club option for 2027 on Jan. 7, 2025.

LAST TIME OUT—Earned his seventh win in his last eight starts after tossing five shutout innings on June 25 at Kansas City (W, 5.0IP, 2H, OR, 2BB, 5SO)...allowed one of his two hits (both singles) in the 1st inning on a first-pitch knock by **Maikel Garcia**...retired his next six batters, three via strikeout, before allowing one of two walks in the 4th...three batters later, **Vinnie Pasquantino** singled, but was one of two runners stranded after a fly out ended the inning...Rasmussen’s fourth and final baserunner reached on a walk in the 5th, but he put away the next batter to get out of the frame and secure his major league-leading seventh scoreless start of the year.

- ✦ The right-hander has now thrown five frames or more in 15 of his 16 starts and has pitched into the 6th inning on six occasions.
- ✦ He has yielded two runs or fewer in seven of his last eight starts.

GREEN AND GOLD—Rasmussen is 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA (13.0IP, 1ER) and 0.38 WHIP over three career appearances (2GS) against the Athletics...in his last start against them on April 9, 2023 at Tropicana Field, he threw seven innings of one-hit ball in an 11-0 victory, the ninth of 13 straight wins during the Rays modern era-record-tying 13-game, season-opening winning streak...min. 10.0 IP, it marks the fourth-lowest ERA vs. the Athletics among active AL pitchers, trailing BOS **Tanner Houck** (0.00), NYY **Jonathan Loáisiga** (0.00) and LAA **Hunter Strickland** (0.44)...Rasmussen has held Athletics hitters to a 3-for-43 (.070) clip with 14 strikeouts and two walks, allowing only one extra-base hit (2B).

- ✦ He is 1-0 with a 0.90 ERA (10.0IP, 1ER) in two starts vs. AL West clubs this season, both coming against Texas (April 6 & June 3)...Rasmussen is 8-3 with a 2.51 ERA (71.2IP, 20ER) over 17 career appearances (13GS) opposite the division.

HOME COOKING—The Rays have won four of Rasmussen’s last five home starts after going 1-5 across his first six...he is 3-1 with a 1.27 ERA (28.1IP, 4ER) in that span, pitching to a .168/.240/.189 (16-for-95) opp. slash line with a 0.81 WHIP and three quality starts...he has not allowed a home run in any of those five outings since yielding multiple long balls in back-to-back starts from May 6-11...on the season, Rasmussen has permitted three runs or fewer in each of his 11 home starts...his 2.16 home ERA (58.1IP, 14ER) ranks ninth in the AL.

RAS ON A ROLL—He has gone 6-1 with a 1.62 ERA (44.1IP, 8ER) over his last eight starts since May 17, posting a 0.88 WHIP with 37 SO and 10 BB while holding opponents to a .190/.248/.261 (29-for-153) line...he owns the fourth-best ERA, fifth-best WHIP and seventh-best opp. average in the majors over that span...four of the eight starts have been quality.

FROZE HIM—Rasmussen is tied for fifth in the majors with 32 called strikeouts, behind NYY **Will Warren** (39), STL **Sonny Gray** (36), CLE **Tanner Bibee** (35) and HOU **Hunter Brown** (34)...over his last six starts, 15 of his 29 strikeouts have been looking, and seven have come via his sinker...his 17 looking strikeouts on sinkers lead the AL.

HEAT CHECK—In 31 appearances (19GS) since the beginning of the 2024 season, Rasmussen has thrown fastballs (cutter, sinker, four-seamer) 90.6 pct. of the time...min. 500 pitches, only relievers PHI **José Alvarado** (98.6%), NYY **Tim Hill** (95.1%), TOR **Jacob Barnes** (94.9%) and BOS **Kenley Jansen** (92.0%) have higher fastball usage rates over that span.

- ✦ Opponents are hitting .201 (56-for-278) against his fastballs in 2025, including a .157 (14-for-89) clip against his cutter.

GOING STREAKING—Rasmussen’s 23.0 scoreless inning streak from May 17–June 3 was tied for the fifth-longest single-season run in club history, trailing runs by **J.P. Howell** (27.1IP, 2012), **Alex Cobb** (24.2IP, 2014), **Kevin Kelly** (24.1, 2024) and **Taj Bradley** (24.0IP, 2024)...only Cobb’s and Bradley’s streaks came as starting pitchers...Rasmussen tallied five scoreless innings or more in a franchise-record four consecutive starts during the streak.

BEST OF THE BEST—Min. 300.0 IP, Rasmussen’s 2.66 ERA (362.2IP, 107ER) since debuting with the Rays on June 19, 2021 ranks second in the majors behind NYY **Max Fried** (2.59)...over that timeframe, he also leads the AL in opp. slugging pct. (.318) and opp. OPS (.582), is third in WHIP (1.01), opp. on-base pct. (.264) and FIP (2.99), and eighth in opp. average (.216).

- ✦ Rasmussen (2.85 ERA/395.0IP, 125ER) is one of 11 active major league pitchers with 300.0 IP or more and an ERA of 2.85 or better in his career...he is one of three to accomplish the feat while starting in at least half of his appearances, joining TEX **Jacob DeGrom** (2.49) and LAD **Clayton Kershaw** (2.51).
- ✦ Rasmussen did not yield an extra-base hit in 21.2 IP from March 31–April 24...per Stats Perform, his streak with 0 XBH was the longest by a starting pitcher to begin a season in Rays history, and tied for second longest by any Rays pitcher with **Kyle Farnsworth** (21.2IP) in 2012, trailing only **J.P. Feyereisen** (24.1IP) in 2016...it marks the fourth-longest streak by a Rays starter at any point in a season.

WALK LIKE AN EGYPTIAN—In 47 of his 66 career starts, he has allowed one walk or fewer...across those 47 starts, he is 20-5 with a 2.28 ERA (232.2IP, 59ER) and a .193 (162-for-838) opp. average...he also has an 7.43 strikeout-to-walk ratio (192SO, 25BB)...his teams are 32-15 in starts when he walks one or fewer batters and 8-11 in starts with multiple free passes.
