TONIGHT'S START-Drew Rasmussen will make his 17th start of the campaign and 12th at Steinbrenner Field...marks his 67th start (116G) of his career and his third start (4G) against the Athletics...ranks among AL leaders in WHIP (6th, 0.96), opp. OPS (6th, .560), ERA (7th, 2.45) and leaders in WHIP (6th, 0.96), opp. OPS (6th, .560), ERA (7th, 2.45) and opp. average (8th, .204)...signed a two-year contract extension through 2026 with a club option for 2027 on Jan. 7, 2025.

LAST TIME OUT-Earned his seventh win in his last eight starts after tossing five shutout innings on June 25 at Kansas City (W, 50IP, 2H, 0R, 2BB, SSO)...allowed one of his two hits (both singles) in the 1st inning on a first-pitch knock by **Maikel Garcia**...retired his next six batters, three via strikeout, before allowing one of two walks in the 4th...three batters later, **Vinnie Pasquantino** singled, but was one of two runners stranded after a fly out ended the inning...Rasmussen's fourth and final baserunner reached on a walk in the 5th, but he put away the next batter to get out of the frame and secure his major league-leading seventh scoreless start of the year.
