RAY REPORT —The Rays open a six-game, seven-day homestand against the Mariners
(3 to play) and Nationals (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Fieldyesterday, Tampa Bay
earned its second consecutive series victory and completed its nine-game, 10-day road
trip with a 5-4 record (1-2 at ATL, 2-1 at MIN, 2-1 at PIT)the Rays have won five of their
last seven games and seven of their last 12are 13-12 in their last 25 contests on the heels
of a season-high six-game losing streak from May 19-25prior to that stretch, Tampa Bay
posted an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 contests from May 3-18the Rays are 7-9 so far
during a stratch of 10 games in 20 days from June 7 24

posted an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 contests from May 3-18...the Rays are 7-9 so far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26.

Yandy Díaz took Paul Skenes deep on the first pitch of yesterday's game, an opposite-field shot off the right foul pole...it was the first time a Ray homered on the first pitch of a road game since Díaz himself on Aug. 26, 2022 at BOS...it marked his second leadoff homer on the first pitch this season, joining May 11 vs. NYY (Nestor Cortes), and third overall.

Tampa Bay held an opponent to one run or fewer for the first time since May 26 vs. KC (4-1)...it snapped a 23-game streak of allowing multiple runs, the longest stretch by a Rays club since June 10-July 6, 2019 (26G).

Per Elias, Tampa Bay has scored first in nine consecutive games for the first time since May 11-20, 2023 (9G)...it marks the third-longest streak in franchise history (12G: June 30-July 11, 2013 & 11G: Sept. 20-30, 2013).

Since June 13 (10G), the Rays have three victories when scoring three runs or fewer (June 13 vs. CHC, June 19 at MIN, June 23 at PIT)...they had one such victory (May 4 vs. NYM) in their previous 38 games dating to April 30.

TAJ THE TERRIFIC—In three starts since June 8, Taj Bradley owns a 1.50 ERA (18.0IP, 3ER) with 21 SO...min. 15.0 IP, it marks the fifth-lowest ERA in the AL during that stretch behind HOU Hunter Brown (0.47), HOU Ronel Blanco (0.90), SEA Logan Gilbert (1.19) and SEA George Kirby (1.35)...this, following Bradley's June 1 start at BAL in which he was tagged for a career-high nine runs (L, 3.1IP, 9H, 9ER, 4HR, 3BB, 3SO).

In 32 games since May 18, only two wins have been credited to a Rays starter: Ryan Pepiot (June 4 at MIA) and Bradley (June 13 vs. CHC).

Tampa Bay starters have a combined 14 wins on the season, third fewest in the majors, ahead of Colorado and Miami (both 13)...in comparison, Rays relievers have 24 victories, second most in MLB behind Milwaukee (27).

KEY MATCHUP—Seattle starter **Bryan Woo** utilizes either his four-seam fastball or sinker at a 78.9 pct. rate, limiting opponents to a .168 (17-for-101) average on the two offerings...**Randy Arozarena** is batting .316 (12-for-28) with 4 2B and 1 HR against all fastballs in June...he entered the month hitting .133 (13-for-98) with 5 HR vs. fastballs.

THE CHAMP IS HERE—Yandy Díaz has hit safely in a career-high 16 straight games, batting .366/.384/.493 (26-for-71) with 3 2B, 2 HR and 7 RBI...it marks the second-longest active streak in MLB behind PIT Bryan Reynolds (20G)...the 16-game run is the longest by a Ray since Austin Meadows (16G, Sept. 1-18, 2019).

With a hit tonight, he would tie Tommy Pham (Aug. 21–Sept. 14, 2018) and Aubrey Huff (Aug. 23–Sept. 10, 2002) for the fourth-longest hitting streak in franchise history...the only longer streaks are held by Jason Bartlett (19G: May 15–June 25, 2009), Wilson Ramos (18G: April 14–May 12-G2, 2018) and Quinton McCracken (18G: Aug. 18–Sept. 9, 1998).

Díaz also owns a career-high 25-game on-base streak, the second-longest active streak in MLB behind BAL Gunnar Henderson (29G)...he is the first Ray to reach base safely in 25 straight games since Wander Franco (43G: July 25–Sept. 29, 2021).

He has recorded an RBI in five straight games, one shy of matching his career-high six-game streak (2x, last: June 12-27, 2019)...it is tied with TEX Wyatt Langford for the longest-active streak in the AL and tied for third in MLB behind LAD Shohei Ohtani (7G) and STL Brendan Donovan (6G).

AROZARENA ANSWERS—Randy Arozarena is batting .295 (18-for-61) with 5 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBI, 11 BB, 13 SO, 3 SB and 6 HBP over 20 games in June...his .443 on-base pct. this month is tied for fourth in the AL behind CLE Steven Kwan (.507), NYY Juan Soto (.494) and NYY Aaron Judge (.481).

He has reached base safely in a season-high nine straight games, his longest run since Sept. 6-16, 2023 (10G)...he owns a .487 OBP during the streak, reaching base in 19 of 39 plate appearances.

GOING, GOING, GONE!—The Rays have homered in seven of their last eight games, tallying 14 long balls during that stretch...Tampa Bay homered in four of its previous eight games (June 8-15), recording only 5 HR...yesterday, Yandy Díaz registered his franchise-best 14th leadoff homer, ahead of B.J. Upton (8HR) and Desmond Jennings (7HR).

Tampa Bay pitching has allowed an MLB-high 108 HR, with the next closest team being the Blue Jays (104HR)...the Rays have allowed 1+ HR in a season-high nine straight games, the longest active streak in MLB...it marks Tampa Bay's most consecutive games allowing 1+ HR since Sept. 11-22, 2023 (11G).

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays 15-7 (.682) record in one-run games leads MLB, ahead of the Mariners (17-8/.680)...their 27-12 (.692) mark in games decided by two runs or fewer also paces the majors, ahead of Philadelphia (20-11/.645)...since April 29, they are 18-6 in games decided by two runs or fewer and 7-18 in all other contests...Tampa Bay is 11-5 in its last 16 one-run games.

TROP TALK—Tampa Bay is 2-5 in its last seven games at Tropicana Field, batting .193/.248/.289 with 5 HR...the Rays are averaging 3.71 runs/game at home, the second-lowest figure in the majors ahead of only the White Sox (3.08)...Tampa Bay has allowed 4.76 runs/game at home, the third-highest mark in the AL, better than only Los Angeles-AL (5.35) and Oakland (4.78).

The Rays have stolen 1+ base in 26 of their 42 home games...it marks the second-most games with a stolen base by a team at their home ballpark this season, trailing Cincinnati (27G).

RALLY RAYS—The Rays 21 comeback wins are tied with the Yankees for second most in the majors behind the Nationals (22)...Tampa Bay has come from behind in 10 of its last 13 wins, including four multi-run comebacks in its last nine victories...the Rays rank among MLB leaders in wins when trailing after six (1st, 10), seven (1st, 7) and eight (T2nd, 4) implies

Tampa Bay's 12 wire-to-wire victories are fifth fewest in the majors, ahead of NYM/OAK (both 11), CWS (10) and COL (7).

MARINERS ON THE BAY—Tampa Bay and Seattle kick off a three-game set tonight at Tropicana Field...the Rays took four of seven games from the Mariners last season, including three straight from Sept. 8-10 at Tropicana Field...since a six-game losing skid to Seattle from June 17–Aug. 3, 2021, the Rays are 10-5 against the Mariners, including 24-2 marks them? a 6-2 mark at home.

TONIGHT'S START—The right-hander will make his ninth start of the season tonight, including his sixth at home...marks his 30th career start... has thrown three straight quality starts for the first time in his career, recording a 1.50 ERA (18.0IP, 3ER) in that span (since June 8), fifth lowest in the AL (min. 15.0IP)...owns a 0.53 ERA (17.0IP, 1ER) in his last three home starts...opened the season on the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain) before his May 10 reinstatement.

LAST TIME OUT—Despite allowing a baserunner in every frame, he limited the Twins to a pair of runs over 6.0 frames on June 19 at Target Field (ND, 6.0IP, 7H, 2ER, 2BB, 3SO, HR)...worked around a pair of hits in the opening frame, but back-to-back singles to open the 2nd allowed the Twins to push across a run via a double-play ball...yielded a two-out solo homer by **Royce Lewis** in the 5th, but tossed a scoreless 6th to conclude the outing...his 3 SO marked a season low.

M&M'S—Bradley made a pair of starts opposite the Mariners in his 2023 rookie season, yielding nine hits over 3.1 innings on July 2 at T-Mobile Park (3.1IP, 9H, 5ER, BB, 3SO, HR) before working 6.1 frames but permitting 3 HR on Sept. 8 in St. Pete (6.1IP, 6H, 4ER, 2BB, 5SO, 3HR)...the former ties the shortest start of his career (3x, last: June 1, 2024 at BAL)...in the latter, he

was tagged for a career-high six extra-base hits (3 2B, 3HR).

This marks Bradley's first start against an AL West opponent this season...he went 1-3 with a 6.50 ERA (36.0IP, 26ER) in eight starts against the division as a rookie, with the Rays going 4-4 in those games.

QUALITY IN QUANTITY—Bradley has turned in three consecutive quality starts after entering that stretch with one in his career (June 21, 2023 at BAL)...he is the first Ray to accomplish the feat in an age 23 or younger season since Jake Faria (7QS, 23 yrs.) in 2017...it matches the longest streak of quality starts by a Ray this season (Littell/Pepiot)...tonight, he could become the first Rays hurler to record four straight quality starts since Tyler Glasnow (5QS) from July 15 (G1)-Aug. 14, 2023.

He has thrown a total of 207 pitches over his last two outings (103, 104), most by a Rays pitcher over a two-game span since Ryan Yarbrough (212) from July 10-19, 2021.

SPLIT DECISION—His split-finger/four-seam fastball combination has keyed his run of three straight quality starts...during those outings, he has thrown a splitter or four-seamer 78.7 pct. of the time, holding opponents to a .179 (10-for-56) average with 20 SO on those offerings...over the same span, he has utilized his curveball and cutter only 21.3 pct. of the time, allowing a .333 (3-for-9) opp. average with only 1 SO...in his first five starts, he recorded a 37.3 pct. usage rate on his curveball/cutter.

DOME SWEET DOME—Bradley has turned in a 0.53 ERA (17.0IP, 1ER) across his last three home starts, producing a 0.76 WHIP and .123/.206/.175 (7-for-57) opp. slash line while yielding 1 XBH (HR)...5 of the 7 ER he has allowed at home came on May 20 vs. Boston—in his other four starts at Tropicana Field, Bradley has pitched to a 0.78 ERA (23.0IP, 2ER)

OFF THE MAT—On June 1 at Oriole Park, Bradley yielded a career-high 9 ER, including 4 HR, over 3.1 innings...it marked the most ER charged to a Rays including 4 HR, over 3.1 innings...it marked the most ER charged to a Rays pitcher since Luis Patiño (9) on Sept. 11, 2022 at NYY...in his next outing on June 8 at Tropicana Field, he limited Baltimore to one run across 5.0 frames... according to Elias, he became the third pitcher in Rays history to allow 9+ ER in a start and 1 ER or fewer in his next start, both against the same team...the previous instances involved Chris Archer (Sept. 26–Oct. 3, 2015 vs. TOR) and Casey Fossum (April 28–May 4, 2007 vs. OAK)...Bradley marked the 21st occurrence in MLB since ER became an official statistic in 1913.

Since allowing the 9 ER at Baltimore, Bradley has gone 1-1 with a 1.50 ERA (18.0IP, 3ER) over his last three starts.

Of his 20 ER this season, 14 came in two of his starts: May 20 vs. BOS (5) and June 1 at BAL (9)...he has allowed 2 ER or fewer in each of his other six outings, pitching to a combined 1.59 ERA (34.0IP, 6ER) in those games.

STRIKEOUT ARTIST—Bradley's 181 SO are fourth most in a pitcher's first 29 starts after joining the Rays, trailing Charlie Morton (209, 2019), Tyler Glasnow (188, 2018-20) and Drew Smyly (188, 2014-16)...Morton (219) also holds the mark through 30 starts, followed by Glasnow (197) and Smyly (180). But the Company of the (191)...Bradley's 181 SO are the most by a Ray in his first 29 career starts, outpacing Matt Moore (176, 2011-12).
