NATIONALS NEWS

MOVING ON
The Washington Nationals and Houston Astros square off in the rubber match of this three-game series on Wednesday night...The Nationals are 9-5 in rubber games this season.

- Washington is 36-30 (.545) since April 25 and are 11-4-1 in their last 16 series since May 12.
- The Nationals have 47 wins, the most by a Nationals club prior to the All-Star break since the 2019 Nationals recorded 47 wins before the break...The next highest win total belongs to the 2018 Nationals (48 wins).
- Following tonight's game the Nationals will enjoy a day off on Thursday before welcoming the New York Yankees to Nationals Park for the final series prior to the All-Star break on Friday.

ALL STARS!
Nationals shortstop **CJ Abrams** and outfielder **James Wood** will represent the organization in the 2026 Major League Baseball All-Star Game in Philadelphia on July 14...Abrams was voted in by the fans and will start at shortstop for the National League, while Wood was selected through player voting...Both players will make their second career All-Star appearance...See boxes to the right for a summary of their rankings this season.

POP FROM THE TOP
James Wood is 13-for-32 (.406) with a .568 on-base percentage (12 BB, 6 SO) and a 1.000 slugging percentage (2 2B, 3B, 5 HR) in his last nine games...He's reached safely in 21 of his last 32 plate appearances (11 H, 10 BB, 1 SO)...He did not strike out in 26 consecutive plate appearances from July 1 through July 7.

- He clubbed his Major League leading eighth leadoff home run on Tuesday night...His eight leadoff homers are second most in a season in Nationals history (2005-pres.) behind only **Alfonso Soriano** (9 in 2006).

ELIAS SAYS
James Wood leads Major League Baseball with 83 runs scored, 19 runs ahead of the next player, Pittsburgh's **Bryan Reynolds** (64)...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*...

- The largest gaps in runs scored between No. 1 and No. 2 players in MLB at the All-Star break:
- 19-run difference in 1946: **Ted Williams** (82) and **Johnny Pesky** (63)
- 18-run difference in 1986: **Rickey Henderson** (83) and **Kirby Puckett** (65)
- 15-run difference in 1973: **Bobby Bonds** (85) and **Darrell Evans/Bob Watson** (70)
- 15-run difference in 1943: **Arky Vaughan** (66) and **Stan Musial** (51)

LUIS! LUIS!
Luis García Jr. ranks in the National League in RBI (T2nd, 65), slugging (.3rd, .559) and home runs (T10th, 19).

- He is 17-for-40 (.425) with four doubles, six homers, 16 RBI, two walks and nine runs in his last 10 games.
- He clubbed his career-high 19th home run on Sunday against the Pittsburgh Pirates.
- His 10 home runs in his last 17 games are the most in the National League (2nd in MLB) since June 19.
- Since May 24, García Jr. leads MLB with 43 RBI and a .762 slugging percentage...His 16 home runs are tied for the most, while his 1.119 OPS is good for second.

HOMER HAPPY
The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 93 home runs since May 6, ahead of the Phillies (82) and the Astros (80) and White Sox (80)...Washington leads in OPS (.796) and slugging (.467) over this stretch.

- The Nationals have hit 130 home runs this season, the second-most in MLB behind the New York Yankees (132) and the second most in team history (2005-pres.) through 92 games behind the 2017 Nationals (138 HR).

NAS (H)IM
Nasim Núñez is 25-for-64 (.391) with a double, two triples, one home run, eight RBI, nine walks, eight stolen bases and 13 runs scored over his last 21 games...He's 8-for-18 (.444) over his last five games.

- On the season, he leads Major League Baseball with 33 stolen bases and trails only **Trea Turner** (35 in 2017) for the most stolen bases prior to the All-Star break in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

THUNDER FROM DOWN UNDER
Curtis Mead is slugging .600 (3 2B, 3B, HR) with a 1.021 OPS over his last eight games...He's hit safely in seven of the eight and has reached base safely in all eight (.421 OBP)...He's 13-for-35 (.371) during this eight-game on-base streak and is 10-for-23 (.435) with two doubles, a triple and homer over his last five games.

FARM REPORT

FUTURES GAME
Shortstop **Eli Wilkits** and right-handed pitcher **Miguel Sime Jr.** have been selected to represent the Washington Nationals organization in the 2026 All-Star Futures Game in Philadelphia on Sunday, July 12...Wilkits is Washington's top prospect and the No. 3 prospect in all of baseball, according to MLB Pipeline.com...He leads Washington's system in OPS, runs and stolen bases...The 18-year old was the No. 1 overall pick in the 2025 First-Year Player Draft...Sime Jr. leads all of Minor League Baseball with 16.6 strikeouts per 9.0 innings this season. He has fanned 84 batters - second-most in Washington's system - in just 45.2 innings pitched between Single-A Fredericksburg and High-A Wilmington.

Lefty starter returns to Major League Baseball after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball...Was a first-round pick by the Kansas City Royals in 2014 and their Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017.

- Made his Major League debut with Kansas City on July 27, 2020, his 25th birthday.
- Became the third pitcher since at least 1901 to earn the win in his MLB debut on his birthday, joining Edwin Jackson (9/9/03 at ARI) and Zach Day (6/15/02 at MON).

LAST START

Griffin struck out six in 5.0 innings of one-run ball on four hits...He earned his ninth win of the season in the 9-5 victory over the Pittsburgh Pirates on July 3rd.

- He has not allowed more than one earned run in any of his last six starts.

vs. HOUSTON

Griffin is set to make his first career appearance against the Houston Astros.

1 IS THE LONLIEST NUMBER...UNLESS YOU'RE FOSTER GRIFFIN

Griffin has allowed one earned run or fewer in six consecutive starts, the longest active streak among starters (excluding openers) in Major League Baseball and the second-longest streak in MLB this season behind Milwaukee's **Jacob Misiorowski** (8 GS, May 1 to June 12)...The six-game streak is the second-longest in Nationals history (2005-pres.) behind **Stephen Strasburg** (7 G, May 11-June 21, 2013) and **Jordan Zimmermann** (7 G, June 27-July 28, 2012).

- During the six-start streak, Griffin is 3-0 with a 1.24 ERA (5 ER/36.1 IP) with 35 strikeouts and just five walks...Left-handed batters are 4-for-38 (.105) with 15 strikeouts and zero walks.

RANKINGS

Griffin ranks among National League pitchers in WHIP (4th, 1.04), opponents' on-base percentage (5th, .272), opponents' average (6th, .210), winning percentage (7th, .818), strikeouts-to-walk ratio (17th, 3.85), walks allowed per nine innings (8th, 2.26), innings pitched (18th, 103.1) and ERA (9th, 2.87).

TECHNICALLY, HE'S A ROOKIE

Although he spent three seasons in Japan, Griffin still qualifies as a rookie...Because of that, he leads qualified National League rookie pitchers in ERA (2.87), WHIP (1.04), wins (9), starts (18), innings pitched, (103.1) and ranks second in strikeouts (100) and opponents' average (.210).

- With nine wins in hand, Griffin has tied the Nationals record (2005-pres.) for most wins in a season by a rookie set by **John Lannan** in 2008 (9 wins).

LEFT ON LEFT CRIME

Griffin has held opposing left-handed batters to a .153 batting average (17-for-111) with 36 strikeouts and just six walks...His four-seam fastball (.053), sweep (.114), cutter (.160) and sinker (.188) have been particularly tough on left-handed hitters this year...In three starts from April 26 to May 8, lefties went 1-for-20 (.050) with six strikeouts and three walks against him.

KEPT IT 100

Griffin tossed at least 100 pitches in four consecutive starts from June 10 to June 27, the longest active streak in Major League Baseball at the time and the second-longest streak this season behind **Paul Skenes** (5) and **Chris Sale** (5)...It was the longest streak in Nationals history since **Max Scherzer** capped the 2020 season with five straight starts of at least 100 pitches.
