TODAY'S GAME: Having dropped two straight, the Giants will try and even up this series this afternoon in the second game of this three-game series with Miami.

- ▶ The Giants are 2-2 on this six-game homestand after going 2-1 vs. the Dodgers before losing last night's series opener to the Marlins.
- ▶ SF enters today having lost six consecutive home games to the Marlins dating to August 31, 2024, the club's second-longest home losing streak to Miami behind only a nine-gamer from July 29, 2010-June 21, 2013...during this current streak to the Fish, the Giants have been outscored 44-24 (-20 run differential) while being out-hit 68-46.
- ▶ This six-game streak is tied for the eighth-longest to a single team in the Oracle Park-era (since 2000).
- ▶ Since it's a Saturday, the Giants are also wearing their new Gigantes jerseys that were designed by local Bay Area artist Jesse Hernandez...for more info, see page three.

FROM A GIRAFFE TO A CAPTAIN, A BRANDON BELT STORY: The Giants are celebrating the career of **IF Brandon Belt** this afternoon with fans encouraged to be in their seats by 12:15 p.m. for pregame festivities..

◻ The two-time World Series Champion and 2016 All-Star spent 12 years of his 13-year MLB career in a Giants uniform from 2011-2022, posting a slash line of .261/.356/.458 (.814 OPS) as a Giant in 1,310 career games...he slugged 175 homers and drove in 584 runs in his Giants tenure...for more on Belt, see page two.

RAY OF LIGHT: LHP Robbie Ray makes his sixth start of the campaign this afternoon looking to bounce back from a pair of tough-luck losses during SF's last road trip.

- ▶ Over the two losses (at Cincinnati and Washington), Ray allowed five runs over 11.0 innings with 13 strikeouts and five walks...the Giants scored a total of one run of support for Ray in the two outings.
- ▶ Four of Ray's five starts this year have followed a Giants loss the previous night...in those starts he is 2-2 with a 2.42 ERA (6er, 22.1ip).
- ▶ In 11 career games (10 starts) against Miami, Ray is 4-5 but with a sterling 2.29 ERA (16er, 63.0ip) and 75 strikeouts...his 2.29 ERA is his third-lowest against any team in his career behind only his 1.37 ERA in four starts versus KC and his 2.20 ERA in seven starts versus the Cubs.

THE CHALLENGERS: Last night's game featured seven ABS challenges between both clubs (SF with four and Miami with three), tied for the most combined ABS challenges in any Giants game this season with the third game of the year vs. the Yankees (*TruMedia*).

- ▶ In fact, four of SF's top five games for combined challenges between both teams have come in the last five games (each of the games in the LAD series featured six combined challenges).
- ▶ For reference, the most in any MLB game this season has been 11, done twice: April 1 - Twins (9), Royals (2) and April 10 - Rockies (9), Padres (2).

PENMANSHIP: The Giants' bullpen has allowed just three earned runs over their last 10 games (0.79 ERA, 34.1ip, 34 strikeouts and 14 walks)...SF is 5-5 in those 10 games.

- ▶ Since April 7, the SF bullpen has a 1.68 ERA (9er, 48.1ip) over its last 15 games...opponents have hit .180 in that time with a .544 OPS...the 1.68 ERA in that span is best in the Majors, with the next closest team being the Reds nearly a full run higher at 2.59.
- ▶ Overall, the Giants' bullpen has a 3.12 ERA (30er, 86.2ip) for the season, fifth-lowest in MLB and fourth-lowest in the NL entering play today decimal points ahead of Miami's 3.12 bullpen ERA.

GLOVELY: Today also marks the annual tradition of the **Junior Giants Glove Drive**, an annual fundraising campaign led by the Giants Community Fund to provide brand new gloves to Junior Giants players who don't have their own.

- ▶ With more than 15,000 players in need this season, a \$30 donation helps ensure every child has the equipment they need to play ball – and feel like they belong... BRANDON BELT: FROM A GIRAFFE TO A CAPTAIN



A DIFFERENT KIND OF WAR HERO: IF **Brandon Belt** helped lead the franchise to a pair of World Series Championships in 2012 and 2014 and was also a major contributor to the orange & black's record-setting 107-win season in 2021.

- ☑ The Lufkin, TX native was an All-Star in 2016 in a season that saw him slash .275/.394/.868 while posting a 3.9 bWAR in 156 games...he hit 17 homers and drove in a career-best 82 runs that season as a 28-year-old.
- 🌟 He spent 12 years of his 13-year MLB career in a Giants uniform from 2011-2022, posting a slash line of .261/.356/.458 (.814 OPS) as a Giant in 1,310 career games...he slugged 175 homers and drove in 584 runs in his Giants tenure.
- ☑ Belt appears all over the Giants' SF-era leaders in numerous offensive categories (see below)...his 1,192 games at first base are second-most in SF history behind only **Willie McCovey** (1,775).
- 🌟 His 37 career postseason games are tied for fifth-most by a Giant all-time and are the most by a Giants first baseman in team history.

THE BABY GIRAFFE: Belt was drafted by the Giants in the fifth-round of the 2009 draft out of the University of Texas and played one full season in the minors in 2010 when he reached Triple-A.

- 🌟 In a now famous clip from *The Franchise*, a show that chronicled the 2011 season with the Giants that aired on Showtime, Belt was told that he was making the club's Opening Day roster at the end of Spring Training during the club's exhibition games in SF...the emotional moment was captured on camera and you can watch the clip by clicking [here](#).
- 🌟 Belt made his Major League debut on Opening Day in 2011 (March 31), batting seventh and playing first base...he went 1-for-3 with a walk in his first game...his first hit was a single in his first at-bat off Clayton Kershaw.
- 🌟 His first homer came a day later off Chad Billingsley.
- 🌟 The first of his nicknames, the Baby Giraffe, was coined in August 2011 when **Duane Kuiper** quipped on air that Belt looked like a giraffe while tracking down a fly ball in left field in Milwaukee.
- 🌟 Kuiper would later tell Giants beatwriter Henry Schulman "First flyball in the outfield in Milwaukee. He looked like he just fell out of the mama giraffe."

ONE SHINING MOMENT: One of Belt's signature moments in a Giants uniform took place in Game 2 of the 2014 NLDS at Washington.

- ☑ With the game tied at 1-1 in the 18th inning, Belt drove the first pitch he saw from Tanner Roark over the wall in right field to give the Giants a 2-1 lead that they'd hold on to for the victory.
- 🌟 The win put SF up 2-0 in the series against the heavily-favored Nationals and SF wound up winning the series in four games en route to winning its second World Series title in three years.

BLACKJACK: On April 22, 2018 Belt locked into a battle with Angels RHP Jaime Barria at the plate, seeing 21 pitches in the at-bat before flying out...the at-bat took 13 minutes.

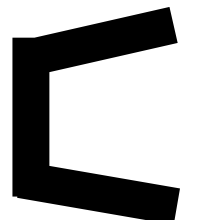
- 🌟 The 21 pitches are the most pitches seen by any player in an at-bat in the pitch-tracking era (since 1988).

I AM THE CAPTAIN NOW: Belt was a significant contributor to the Giants franchise-record 107-win season in 2021 as he set a career-best in homers with 29 at the age of 33...he would have most certainly had a chance at eclipsing the 30-homer mark had it not been for his 54 games lost to the IL.

- ☑ He also posted career-bests (min. 95g) in slugging % (.597) and OPS (.975) despite playing in only 97 games.
- ☑ 18 of Belt's 29 homers came after the All-Star break when he was homering every 8.61 at-bats...that ratio was the third-best in the SF-era by any Giant after the break behind two seasons from **Barry Bonds** (6.38 HR/AB in 2001 and 8.36 in 2004).
- ☑ His 29 homers were the most by a Giants primary first baseman since **Will Clark** hit 29 in 1991.
- ☑ In the midst of his torrid second-half run, Belt gave himself the title of "captain" on September 10 at Wrigley Field as the Giants were playing the Cubs...when Belt appeared on the field for the game he had a letter 'C' taped on his jersey with electrical tape...he went on to go 2-for-3 that day with a double, a homer, two RBI and two walks.
- ☑ **Evan Longoria** was actually the one who taped the makeshift 'C' on Belt's jersey pregame, thinking there was no way he'd actually wear it for the game.
- ☑ The nickname stuck and at the Opening Day ceremonies in 2022, Belt rode in to throw out the first pitch in a boat while donning a captain's hat (see photo above).

GIGANTES JERSEYS



The San Francisco Giants officially unveiled their new Gigantes jerseys on March 18 and are wearing them on-field for the first time for tonight's game versus the Sultanes. This iteration of the Gigantes uniform features a jersey and cap designed by Bay Area artist Jesse Hernandez. First worn on the field in 2005, Gigantes is a symbol of pride, culture, community and a recognition of the Giants rich Latino heritage with more than 200 players representing nine Latin American countries.

In 2026, Gigantes gets a bold redesign. Off the field, Fiesta Gigantes will expand beyond the traditional single-gameday celebration, coming to life every Saturday home game with live music, cultural performances, themed festivities, specialty food and beverage items and giveaways. Forever Giant and World Series Champion **Sergio Romo** will serve as the Gigantes ambassador, reflecting his strong connection to the Giants, passion for baseball and pride of Latino culture. Additional Latino-focused events these Sultanes de Monterrey exhibition games on March 23 and 24 and the Fuerza Regida concert on June 20.

WITH THE GIANTS: The 2021 Cy Young Award winner is in his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors... the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

LAST START: Suffered his second straight loss last Sunday in Washington in the Giants 3-0 loss to the Nationals...threw 6.0 innings, allowing three runs on seven hits with seven strikeouts...his five strikeouts with his 4-seam in his last start was a season high.... he threw his changeup only 9% of the time in the start, the one at-bat that ended with one was a home run (SIS).

HOME SWEET HOME: Has posted a 2-1 record with a 2.08 ERA (4er, 17.1ip) and 0.98 WHIP over his three start at Oracle Park this year.

AGAINST MIAMI: Is slated to make his 12th career appearance (11th start) against the Marlins today...has pitched very well against them over his career posting a 4-5 record with a 2.29 ERA (16er, 63.0ip), 75 strikeouts and a 1.05 WHIP...seven of his 10 career starts against Miami have been quality outings...he's tossed 6.0+ innings and allowed one run or less in six of his last eight starts against the Marlins...he has never faced Miami at Oracle Park.

2025 RECAP: Was selected to the NL All-Star team for the second time in his career (also 2017 with the Diamondbacks), pitching the best first half of his 12-year MLB career, as he posted his lowest career ERA (2.65) before the break (min. nine starts)...overall he started 32 games for SF, finishing the year with a 11-8 record and 3.65 ERA after posting a 5.54 ERA in 12 starts after the break...the 3.65 season ERA was his lowest since his Cy Young season in 2021 (2.84) and fourth-lowest in his 12-year career.

LUCKY CHARM: The Giants won each of Ray's first nine starts in 2025, making him the first Giants starter to have the team win each of his first nine starts of a season since **Bill Swift** in 1992 (11 wins to start the season).

CHANGING THINGS UP: Last spring, he told reporters that he added a changeup to his pitch mix after connecting with 2024 AL Cy Young Tarik Skubal in the offseason to learn about his grip....Skubal sent Ray pictures, video and was available to chat with him about the pitch...Ray threw it 399 times (13.0% of the time) through 32 starts last year (all to righties), with batters going 17-for-73 (.233) with 16 strikeouts off the pitch.

LEFT ON READ: Left-handers slashed .188/.282/.318 off him last season...the .188 average was third-best in the National League, trailing LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (.174) and SD's Nick Pivetta (.185).

FAST AND FURIOUS: Batters hit .208 (75x361) off his four-seamer last season, his most used pitch (52.0%)...the pitch had a +9 run value, his highest of any pitch since 2022 (slider)...additionally, Ray's 108 strikeouts with a four-seamer were most in the NL and ranked second in the Majors behind only MIN's Joe Ryan (109).

GOOD LUCK CHUCK: The Giants were 22-10 in his starts last season...the .688 winning percentage ranked as the second-best record of any NL team behind the same starter, trailing only the Phillies 23-9 (.719) record with Cristopher Sánchez on the mound...it also tied NYY's Max Fried for the third-best team record among starters in MLB, (other: Boston's Garret Crochet at 23-9).

TOMORROW'S STARTER LANDEN ROUPP RHP #65

2026 RECORD: 4-1, 2.28 ERA

- ▶ Will be making his first career start against Miami and second career appearance, as he tossed a scoreless inning in relief versus Miami on September 1, 2024.
- ▶ Has earned the win in each of his last three starts, which is the longest streak of his career...his three-game win streak is tied for third-longest in the majors.
- ▶ His 2.28 ERA is the lowest mark for a Giant pitcher through their first five starts of a season since Jordan Hicks had a 1.98 ERA through his first five starts in 2024.

- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-18 (.111) with two walks and six strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .178 clip (69-for-387) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 9-for-18 with five XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.
