RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals conclude a three-game series with the Houston Astros this afternoon at Daikin Park. The Cardinals won the first two games and are looking for their first series sweep of the 2026 season. **SWEEPSTAKES:** The last time the Cardinals swept an opponent was June 27-29, 2025 at Cleveland and the last time against the Astros was a two-game series in Houston (Aug. 16-17, 2016), three-game (Sept. 18-20, 2012 at Busch Stadium) and three-game in Houston (Apr. 20-22, 2004).

FLIGHT PATTERN: Following today's game, the Cardinals will fly to Miami for a three-game series with the Marlins (Apr. 20-22). The Cardinals enter today tied for 2nd place in the National League Central with Milwaukee, one half game back of first place Cincinnati. Every team in the N.L. Central is 11-9 or better and within 1.5 games of each other.

TAKING THE SERIES: The Cardinals have won 5-of-7 series to open the season, the first time since 2015 when they won 8-of-9 series to open the season en route to their 9th 100-win season and an National League Central title. The 2022 Cardinals started 5-1-4 in their first 10 series, but split two "winning series" with one game against Kansas City winning the single game twice.

WHAT'S SHAKIN' AT DAIKIN?: Masyn Winn, José Fermín and Alec Burleson each homered last night extending the Cardinals streak with at least one home run at Daikin Field to nine games (2013-26), tied for the longest active streak at the ballpark with the San Diego Padres (2021-25) and Athletics (2024-25). It's the longest streak by the Cardinals at the 27-year old ballpark. The Cardinals have hit 157 home runs (117 games) in the stadium, 3rd-most of any team all-time and most of any team not residing in Texas (Rangers 180 HR in 142 games).

HURTS SO GOOD: Rookie JJ Wetherholt was hit by pitch for the third consecutive game last night, one shy of the Cardinals record of four held by current coach Jon Jay (2012) and Joe Cunningham (1961). Wetherholt has also drawn a walk in each game he's been hit by pitch, which established a new Cardinals record and is one of seven players in MLB history to accomplish the feat, most recently by Isaac Paredes, across the way in the Astros dugout when he was with Tampa Bay. No player has ever had four.

ON BASE RACE: St. Louis batters have done a great job of getting on base in road games with a .361 on-base percentage, 3rd in Major League Baseball behind the Dodgers (.387) and Astros (.362). By comparison, the Cardinals rank 22nd in OBP at home (.308).

ASTRO-LADS: Masyn Winn's two-run home run gave him consecutive games with multiple RBI for the first time in his career. He's also recorded multiple RBI in three straight games at Daikin Field dating back to 2024. Winn has hit safely in all four games at his hometown ballpark with a pair of home runs. Nolan Gorman also enjoys playing at Daikin Park and recorded his first back-to-back multi-RBI games since he played here last in 2024.

HIT FIRST, HIT HARD: When the Cardinals score first, they are a perfect 8-0, the only unblemished mark in the league (three teams with one loss).

0.00'BRIEN: Cardinals relief pitcher Riley O'Brien is off torrid start in 2026 without allowing an earned run in his first 11 appearances (11.0 IP) and would all be scoreless if Major League Baseball did not allow free baserunners in extra inning games. O'Brien has closed down all six save opportunities and is tied with three other pitchers, including teammate JoJo Romero, as the only National League qualifying relievers with a 0.00 ERA. O'Brien has not allowed a hit since April 1 and has compiled an 0.36 WHIP leading the National League.

THE BIG STICK: Outfielder Jordan Walker extended his hitting streak to 13 games with a single last night. For Walker, it's his longest streak since a career-best 17 games as a rookie in 2023. He currently trails former Cardinals farmhand Ildemaro Vargas (ARI) with 14 and 17 dating back to 2025. Walker also leads the N.L. in home runs (8) and slugging (.662).

REHAB REPORT: Cardinals pitcher RHP Matt Pushard made his 2nd rehab appearance recording two scoreless outs with two walks for Memphis (AAA) against Gwinnett hitting his 21 pitch count before being removed. Cardinals RHP Hunter Dobbins (right knee surgery) will be making his 4th rehab start and first on five days rest when Memphis (AAA) hosts Gwinnett today.
