**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners wrap the 7-day, 6-game homestand (2-3) with the 3rd of 3 games against the Los Angeles Dodgers (0-2)...Seattle opened the homestand with a series win over the Los Angeles Angels (2-1)...following today's series finale vs. the Dodgers, the Mariners will embark on their final road trip of the season to Oakland (3 G, Sept. 18-20) and Texas (3 G, Sept. 22-24)...today's game will be televised live on ROOT SPORTS with Dave Sims and Mike Blowers on the call...the game will also be broadcast live on Seattle Sports (710 AM) and Mariners.com with Rick Rizzs and Aaron Goldsmith on the call.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners lost last night's game against the Dodgers by a 6-2 score in 11 innings...despite the loss, the Mariners are 18-12 over their last 30 games, 26-15 over their last 41, 28-16 over their last 44, 31-17 over their last 48, 34-19 over their last 53 and 43-25 over their last 68 games...the Mariners are 62-24 when scoring at least 4 runs and 19-43 when scoring 3-or-fewer...the Mariners are 41-32 at T-Mobile Park and 40-35 on the road this season...they are 27-25 in day games and 54-42 at night.

- **Long Division** - Of Seattle's 14 remaining regular season games, 12 are against AL West Division opponents (OAK 3, TEX 7, HOU 3).
- **Clemente Award Nominee** - Marco Gonzales was named Friday as the Seattle Mariners nominee for the 2023 Roberto Clemente Award...it's Gonzales' 2nd-consecutive year being nominated for the award, which is presented annually in recognition of a Major League player who best represents the game of baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field.
- **Standing Room Only** - The sellout crowd of 45,818 at yesterday's game was the Mariners 4th sellout of the season (also: 8/12 vs. BAL, 6/17 vs. CWS and 3/30 vs. CLE)...the Mariners are 20-13 (.606) when playing in front of 35,000+ fans at T-Mobile Park this season.
- **Brashty** - Matt Brash recorded his 101st strikeout of the season in yesterday's game...his 101 strikeouts are the 6th-most in franchise history by a reliever, trailing Edwin Diaz (124 in 2018), Bill Caudill (111 in 1982), Enrique Romo (105 in 1977), J.J. Putz (104 in 2006) and Paul Sewald (104 in 2021)...Brash's 73 appearances are also tied for the 4th-most by a pitcher in team history, trailing Ed Vande Berg's franchise record of 78 games in 1982.

**TEOSCAR HERNÁNDEZ'S ON-BASE STREAK TURNS 30**...Teoscar Hernández went 0-4 with 1 walk and 1 run in last night's game, extending his on-base streak to 30 games (8/15-c), longest active on-base streak (via H, BB or HBP) in the Majors and the longest streak by a Mariners player this season, surpassing Julio Rodríguez (27 G, July 1-Aug. 2)...Teo's 30-game on-base streak is Seattle's longest on-base streak since Robinson Canó's 34-game on-base streak from April 30-June 5, 2016, and the 28th streak of at least 30 games in franchise history...Hernández during his streak is batting .350 (43x123) with 17 runs, 8 doubles, 8 home runs, 29 RBI, 6 walks and 1 stolen base, while getting on base at a .385 clip and slugging .610 with a .995 OPS.

**WELCOME TO THE J-ROD SHOW**...Julio Rodríguez went 1-for-4 with 1 double and 1 walk (IBB) in last night's game...Julio has hit safely in 8 consecutive games, including multiple hits in 5 of 8 games during that span (9/8-c)...during the 8-game hitting streak, he is batting .441 (15x34) with 9 runs, 3 doubles, 3 home runs, 6 RBI and 2 walks (2 IBB), while reaching base at a .472 clip and slugging .794 with a 1.266 OPS...overall this season, Julio leads the American League in hits (174), ranking ahead of Marcus Semien-TEX (170)...Julio ranks 2nd in the AL in total bases (303) behind Shohei Ohtani-LAA (325), 3rd in RBI (99), 4th in extra-base hits (67), 7th in home runs (30), 5th in runs (95) and 3rd in stolen bases (36).

- **30/30 Club** - Julio (30 HR, 36 SB) is the 4th player age 22-or-younger with 30+ home runs and 30+ stolen bases in a season, joining Alex Rodriguez-SEA (1998), Mike Trout-LAA (2012) & Ronald Acuña Jr.-ATL (2019)...Julio, who wears #44, is the 44th individual to join the 30/30 club in MLB history.
- **Keeping It 100** - Rodríguez is 1 RBI away from a 100-RBI season...Julio would join Alex Rodriguez-SEA (1998) & Ronald Acuña Jr.-ATL (2019) to become just the 3rd player age 22-or-younger with a 30/30 season and 100 RBI in the same year...Julio would join Ken Griffey Jr. (2x, 1991-92) and A-Rod (2x, 1996, '98) as the only Mariners with 100+ RBI in age 22-or-younger seasons.

**PITCH PERFECT**...the Mariners pitching staff leads the Majors in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.60), walks-per-9 innings (2.53) and ERA (3.73), while ranking 2nd in fewest runs allowed (606), 2nd in fWAR (20.3), T2nd in WHIP (1.18), 2nd in FIP (3.80), 2nd in quality starts (69), 5th in opponent batting average (.236), 7th in strikeouts (1,343), 7th in strikeouts-per-9 innings (9.11).

**CAREER YEAR FOR CRAWFORD**...J.P. Crawford went 1-for-4 with 1 double and 1 walk in last night's game and remains 1 RBI shy of his career-high 54 RBI registered during the 2021 season...the Mariners shortstop this year has already tallied career-highs in home runs (15) and walks (83) and is on pace to set career-highs in on-base percentage (.376), slugging (.422) and OPS (.798).

**CATCHING ON**...Mariners catcher Cal Raleigh has 16 home runs over his last 49 games (7/22-c), leading Major League catchers with 28 home runs overall this season...with 2 more homers this season, #29 would become the 29th catcher in MLB history (min. 60% of games at catcher) with a 30+ home run season...Cal already has 57 career home runs in 298 games, ranking 7th-most in MLB history by a catcher over their first 300 games (min. 60% games as catcher)...he trails only Gary Sánchez (86 HR), Rudy York (77 HR), Mike Piazza (68 HR), Will Smith (62 HR), Earl Williams (60 HR) and Wilin Rosario (59 HR).

**THE INCREDIBLE WALTER**...Logan Gilbert is 13-5 with a 3.62 ERA (70 ER, 174.0 IP), 31 walks, a career-high 176 strikeouts and a 1.063 WHIP this season...among AL starters he ranks 11th in ERA, 5th in WHIP, 3rd in BB/9 (1.60), 9th in SO/9 (9.10), 3rd in SO/BB (5.68) and T-8th in fWAR (3.3)...since July 4, Gilbert is 8-0 with a 2.98 ERA (27 ER, 81.2 IP), 83 strikeouts and 12 walks in 13 starts, with the Mariners going 10-3 in those contests.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...Julio Rodríguez leads the American League with 174 hits this season, ranking ahead of Marcus Semien-TEX (170 H) and Bobby Witt Jr.-KC (165 H), and...**YOU MAY ALSO KNOW**...that if Julio finishes with the league lead in hits, he will become just the 3rd player in franchise history to lead the AL in hits, joining Alex Rodriguez (1998) and Ichiro Suzuki (7x, 2001, 2004, 2006-10), but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that Julio could become just the 9th player age 22-or-younger to lead the AL in hits?...he would join Ty Cobb-DET (3x, 1907-09), Dick Wakefield-DET (1943), Harvey Kuenn-DET (1953), Al Kaline-DET (1955), George Brett-KC (1975), Rickey Henderson-OAK (1981), Cal Ripken Jr.-BAL (1983) and Alex Rodriguez-SEA (1998)...Cobb, Kaline, Brett, Henderson and Ripken Jr. are all members of the National Baseball Hall of Fame.

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- The 26-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 30th start of the season and 1st against Los Angeles-NL...he will also make the 86th start of his MLB career and 1st career start against the Dodgers.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau.
- Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
- Was named the 2022 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.

**LAST TIME OUT**...ND in 29th start of the season against LAA on 9/11, tossing 7.0 innings and allowing 3 runs on 6 hits (2 HR) and 1 walk with 5 strikeouts.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY**...is set to make his 16th career start against an interleague opponent and his 12th this season...in 15 career interleague games Logan has a 2.84 ERA (29 ER, 92.2 IP) with 22 walks and 103 strikeouts...in his 11 interleague starts this season Logan is 7-1 with a 2.79 ERA (22 ER, 71.0 IP) and has allowed 9 walks while striking out 82 batters.

**DECISIONS, DECISIONS**...has won 8 straight decisions dating back July 4...his 18 decisions on the season ranks 3rd on the team behind **Luis Castillo** (20) and **George Kirby** (19).

**WHIP IT**...Gilbert currently ranks 6th in the majors among qualified starting pitchers with a 1.063 WHIP...three Mariners pitchers make up the top 6 with **Luis Castillo** and **George Kirby** also ranking in the top 6 in the Major Leagues.

**FINDING HIS GROOVE**...over his last 13 starts (July 4-c) Gilbert has a 2.98 ERA (27 ER, 81.2 IP) with 12 walks and 83 strikeouts...in that span he has recorded 8 quality starts and has allowed 2-or-fewer runs in 9 of those 13 starts...his 2.98 ERA over that span ranks 7th in the American League.

**K MORE WALK LESS**...his 5.68 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranks 4th in the Major Leagues and 2nd on the Mariners among qualified pitchers...he trails only **George Kirby** who currently leads the Major Leagues.

**QUALITY AND QUANTITY**...has recorded 17 quality starts this season which ranks tied 1st on the team with **Luis Castillo** and **George Kirby** (17)...had 16 quality starts in 2022 were the 3rd most among Mariners starting pitchers and tied 16th in the AL with Dylan Cease-CHW and Shohei Ohtani-LAA ...he trailed only **Marco Gonzales** and **Robbie Ray** who each had 18.

**ALL I DO IS WIN**...with his win in outing at Cincinnati on 9/6 Logan earned his 13th win of the season which matches his career-high that he set last season...his 13 wins are tied for the 10th most in the Major Leagues and tied 4th most in the American League.

**WINNING NUMBERS**...owns a 1.85 ERA (18 ER, 87.1 IP) in games where he gets the win this season...opponents are batting just .186 (58x312) against him when he earns the win...Logan has pitched one complete game this season, a shutout on July 4 at San Francisco.

**GOING THE DISTANCE**...pitched his first career complete game shutout on 7/4 against San Francisco...this was the Mariners second complete game thrown this year...**George Kirby** threw his first career complete game on 4/27 at Philadelphia.

**7 STRAIGHT STRIKEOUTS**...he struck out 7 consecutive batters from the 2nd-4th innings on 5/8 against Texas...the streak of strikeouts **tied a franchise record** shared by Mark Langston (6/15/84) and **Luis Castillo** (9/7/22)...Logan finished the game with a season-high 10 strikeouts which is 1 off from his career-high.

**FOURTH TIME AROUND**...had a perfect game through 6.0 innings during his outing on 5/8 at Texas before allowing a leadoff single in the 7th...became the 4th Mariners pitcher this season to carry a no-hitter into the 6th inning...he joined **Luis Castillo**, **Bryce Miller**, and **Easton McGee**.

**KEEPING THE BASES CLEAN**...has allowed 190 baserunners through his 29 starts this season which is the fewest in the Major Leagues among pitchers who have made at least 29 starts this season...his 190 baserunners allowed are the fewest through a pitcher's first 29 starts in a season in franchise history.

**ON A ROLL**...Logan's 176 strikeouts so far this season ranks second among Mariners starting pitchers...he trails only **Luis Castillo** (199)...he recorded 39 strikeouts in May which is a new career-high for the month...his 34 strikeouts in March/April were also a career high to start the season.

**AMONG MARINERS GREATS**...in Logan's first 80 starts in his career he recorded 455 strikeouts...this is the 4th most strikeouts in franchise history in a player's first 80 career starts...he ranks behind Erik Hanson (448).

**MARINER MILESTONES**...Logan currently ranks 16th in franchise history with 478 strikeouts...he moved into the top 20 after striking out 2 batters on 6/11 at LAA...he ranks behind Jim Beattie (563).
