AHOY MATEY: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates play the third game of a four-game series tonight at PNC Park ... The Redbirds are playing their first four-game April series in the Steel City since April 10-13, 1987, a wraparound weekend series highlighted by **Brian Bartow's** first roadie as a PR pro and newly-acquired All-Star catcher **Tony Peña** breaking his left thumb against his former team.

BURIED TREASURE: St. Louis has won consecutive games in Pittsburgh for the first time since Aug. 23, 2023 and July 2, 2024 and first time in the same series since Sept. 10-11, 2022 when the Three Amigos **Yadier Molina**, **Adam Wainwright**, and **Albert Pujols** were active ... The last time the Cards won three in a row here at PNC was May 20-22, 2022.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 3.0 games back of first place Cincinnati ... Tonight's game is their 6th of a season-high 17 straight without an off day (2-3 record) ... The Cardinals (-9), Athletics (-11), and Diamondbacks (-16) are the only three MLB teams with winning records but negative run differentials.

THESE GO TO 11: The 11 Cardinals runs last night were their most scored in a game in Pittsburgh since an 18-4 St. Louis win on May 22, 2022 when **Albert Pujols** came off the bench and went yard twice.

• Last night also marked the first time St. Louis scored double-digit runs since a 12-2 win at Chicago's Rate Field on June 17, 2025, a span of 117 games for MLB's longest active streak ... It also was the 6th-longest streak in Cardinals history and their longest in the Live Ball Era (1920-present) since a 133-game span from April 18-Sept. 8, 1955.

CLEAR THE DECK: St. Louis holds the all-time PNC Park record for homers by a visiting team, going yard 212 times in 208 games, highlighted by 34 by **Albert Pujols** in a Cardinals uniform ... According to **Elias**, PNC Park is the 4th MLB stadium that has been built since 1900 where St. Louis boasts the most homers by a visiting team, with:

- New York City's **Polo Grounds** (428 HR from 1911-63)
- Brooklyn's **Ebbets Field** (305 from 1913-57)
- Boston's **Braves Field** (168 HR from 1915-52)

SPLASH: **Victor Scott II** hit the 85th homer into the Allegheny River last night, becoming the 53rd different player and 7th Cardinal to homer to do so, joining **J.D. Drew** (May 17, 2001), **Jim Edmonds** (May 26, 2002), **Colby Rasmus** (May 14, 2009), **Matt Carpenter** (Sept. 30, 2015-G1), **Matt Adams** (Sept. 6, 2016), and **Paul Goldschmidt** (July 22, 2019) ... St. Louis has the most splash homers at PNC Park than any visiting team.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Cardinals (7-8 home & 8-5 road), Nationals (3-10 home & 10-7 road), and Athletics (5-6 home & 10-8 road) are the only three MLB teams with winning road records, but below .500 records at home.

CARDIAC CARDS: The Cardinals share the Major League lead in last at-bat wins (6) and walk-off victories (3), while tying for the 3rd-most come-from-behind wins (10) ... St. Louis is an MLB-best 5-0 in extra inning affairs, its best start since the 2004 Cardinals started their season 6-0 in extras ... The Cardinals lead MLB in homers in both the 6th inning or later (22) and 7th inning or later (16), and share the Major League lead in blasts hit in the 8th inning or later (11).

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Victor Scott II grew up a fan of **Andrew McCutchen** and **Starling Marte** as a child...Scott's father was Pirates fan from Pittsburgh, although Victor II grew up a Braves fan as an Atlanta native.

Nathan Church (2018) and **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

JJ Wetherholt graduated from Mars Area (Pa.) High School and resides in Gibsonsia, Pa., but was born in Baltimore, Md., and grew up a fan of the Baltimore Ravens.

Justin Bruhl pitched in seven games for the Pirates in 2024.

Alec Burluson tallied his first career hit on Sept. 11, 2022 at Pittsburgh.

Lars Nootbaar smacked his first career home run on Aug. 12, 2021 at Pittsburgh.

Andre Pallante (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC) and Special Assistant to the President of Baseball Operations **Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004 at PNC) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

Marcell Ozuna played in 278 games for St. Louis from 2018-19 after the Cardinals acquired him in a trade with the Marlins on Dec. 14, 2017 in exchange for **Sandy Alcantara**, **Zac Gallen**, **Magneuris Sierra** and **Daniel Castano**.

Hunter Dobbins and **Mason Montgomery** were teammates at Texas Tech from 2019-20.

Evan Sisk was selected by St. Louis in the 16th round of the 2018 MLB Draft and pitched in the Cardinals minor league system from 2018-21 before St. Louis traded him along with **John Gant** to Minnesota in exchange for **J.A. Happ** and cash considerations on July 30, 2021.

Nick Yorke made his MLB debut at St. Louis on Sept. 16, 2024.

Pirates Color Analyst **Neil Walker** collected his first career hit vs. St. Louis on Sept. 6, 2009.

Pirates Dir. of Hitting Development **Tim McKeithan's** grandfather, **Jerry McKeithan Sr.**, played in the St. Louis minor league system, and his brother, **Aaron McKeithan**, was selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

Pittsburgh Special Advisor of Pitching Development **Dewey Robinson** coached at the University of Missouri from 1984-86...received his bachelor degree in finance from SIU Carbondale and was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2023.

Brant Brown played in 130 games for the Pirates in 1999 before being traded to the Marlins for OF **Bruce Aven** (Dec. 13, 1999)...traded by the Cubs to Pittsburgh for RHP **Jon Lieber** (Dec. 14, 1998).

Riley O'Brien's great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58)...his grandfather **Johnny O'Brien**, played part of four seasons with the Pirates (1953, 1955-57).

Yohel Pozo made his Cardinals debut on April 7, 2025 at Pittsburgh in front of approximately 15 family members based in Harrisburg, Pa.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julian Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956...played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** was the general manager of the Pirates from 1992-93.

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Manager **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Senior Director, Communications & Content **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a PR Specialist in the Cardinals Comm. dept.(2010-11).

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Making his 6th start of the 2026 season tonight as he completes the starting rotation's sixth time thru; it's his 67th career start (175th career appearance).
- His 175th career appearance tonight ranks 73rd all-time among Cardinals pitchers; He joins **Adam Wainwright** (478), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach 175 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 60 or more starts.
- Pitched 5.0 or more innings in each of his first five starts, longest streak by a Cardinals starting pitcher this season and since Sonny Gray ran off six to begin last season.
- Is making his 19th career appearance against the Pirates, matching his most against any MLB team (also Cincinnati).
- It's his 11th career appearance at PNC Park, his most outside of Busch Stadium. Holding opposing batters to a .176 BA in away games and .167 BA in night games.
- **Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (66), wins (26), innings pitched (485.1) and strikeouts (341).**
- Since moving into starting rotation in 2024 has four wins vs. NL Central clubs - three vs. CIN & one vs. PIT (4-0 on 9/16/24).
- His last win vs. NL Central team came on 6/20/25 vs. CIN; the Cardinals have lost each of his last seven games started vs, NL Central teams since that win.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), tied with **Lars Nootbaar** for most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, April 24 vs. Seattle): L, 3-2; 5.1 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 3 BB, 8 SO, 1 HR, 90 pitches.

- Fanned a season-high 8 batters, one shy of his career-high 9 vs. PIT on 9/16/24 - the most by a Cardinals pitcher this season.

2026 NOTES:

BETTER BABIP: Has a .253 Batted Ball In Play (BABIP) average to the begin the season, down from his .296 mark in 2025.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in all five starts this season, allowing 2 runs or less in three of those games.

TRI-DENT: Fanned 8 Mariners last Fri. (4/24) in his season-high 5.1 IP, but took the 3-2 loss after Josh Naylor's solo HR in the 6th snapped a 2-2 tie.

SPACE TRAVELER: Earned his 1st road win since 5/16/25 at Kansas City in a 7-5 Space City win over the Astros on 4/18 in Houston.

MARCH MADNESS: Made his 2026 season debut on 3/31 vs. NYM and gained a 3-0 win as he worked 5.0 scoreless IP, allowing just 3 hits.

2025 NOTES:

N.L. Rankings: Groundball Pct. (59.5%, 1st), Ground balls (316, 2nd), Groundball/Flyball Ratio (2.75, 5th), GIDP/9 IP (0.66, 10th), Wild Pitches (12, T-1st).

CAREER HIGHS: Established new single-season career highs in starts (31), quality starts (9), strikeouts (111), and innings pitched (162.2).

AT A LOSS: Suffered 15 losses, most by Cardinal since Kip Wells went 7-17 in 2007. Ended the season on an eight-game losing streak (Aug. 3-present), T-2nd longest active in MLB, and the longest by a Cardinal since Adam Wainwright dropped 10 straight decisions (June 24-Sept. 7, 2023). The Cardinals were 12-19 overall in his starts, including a 3-13 mark in his final 16.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Is 12-14 in his 33 career games started at Busch Stadium while the Cardinals have gone 16-17 in those games.
- Since his 2022 Major League debut, boasts the highest ground ball percentage (63.2%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 400.0+ innings pitched.
- As a starting pitcher (353.1 IP), Pallante's 59.7 career groundball pct. currently is the 8th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 350.0 IP as starter).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.

PALLANTE VS. PITTSBURGH

- Making his 6th career start (19th app.) vs. the Pirates. Last 5 are starts following 13 relief appearances.
- Has not registered a decision in 3 career starts (10 app.) at PNC Park, posting a 1.98 ERA over 27.1 IP with 13 strikeouts. Has not received more than 1 run in any of his 3 starts.
- Holding the Pirates to a .199 career BA, 4th lowest among all opponents behind Cleveland (.154), Los Angeles-NL (.163) and Miami (.198).
- Held the Pirates to one run or less in his first four starts including a 17-inning scoreless streak (7/22/24-7/1/25) before getting hit for eight runs (7 ER) both career-highs in an 8-3 loss at Busch Stadium (8/26/25).
- Prior to his last start, had not allowed more than two runs in any start or relief appearances in 17 career appearances vs. Pittsburgh; longest streak by a Cardinals pitcher which includes four starts or more in club history.
- **Faced Paul Skenes in two starts against the Pirates, out-dueling him in a 4-0 win with 7.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball with a career-high nine strikeouts at Busch Stadium on Sept. 16, 2024 & taking a no decision at PNC Park (7/1/25) with 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball in a 1-0 Cardinals loss.**
- Has a career record of 1-2 with a 3.33 ERA over his 18 appearances; Had an 0.67 ERA in his first four starts lowest ERA by a Cardinals starting pitcher in his first four starts vs. PIT since **Jaime Garcia** (0.64) from 2010-15.
