Caleb Durbin was hit by a pitch last night for the 11th time this season, the most in the National League....only the Twins' **Ty France** (12) has more.

<u>U Da Man!</u> **Abner Uribe** is unscored upon in 28 of his 32 appearances this season. including 20 of his last 21 outings and in a row.....Uribe ranks among NL relief leaders in ERA (4th, 1.39) and strikeouts (T4th, 42). TODAY'S GAME: Is game 6 (2-3) of a 10-game homestand vs. San Diego (1-2), Atlanta (1-1) and St. Louis (4g)....is the team's longest homestand of the season....after an off day next Monday, the team takes a 6-game trip to Chicago-NL (3g) and Minnesota (3g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: LHP Nestor Cortes (left elbow), LHP Robert Gasser (left elbow), OF Garrett Mitchell (left oblique), OF Blake Perkins (right shin), LHP Connor Thomas (left elbow) and RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder) are on the injured ...Cortes, Gasser, Perkins and Thomas are on the 60-day injured list.

IN THE STANDINGS (85 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 10\*, SECOND: 19, THIRD: 42, FOURTH: 11, FIFTH: 3.....the Brewers are currently in third place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 5.5 games and second-place Cardinals by half a game (\*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing a game).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The team is 11-9-1 in series play. Game 1: 11-11, Game 2: 12-10, Game 3: 11-10, Game 4: 2-1 Sweep Wins [2]: vs. BOS (3g, 5/26-5/28) and at PHI (3g, 5/30-6/1) Sweep Losses [1]: at NYY (3g, 3/27-3/30)

AT HOME: The team is 20-13 at home, going 7-3-0 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The team is 16-19 on the road, going 4-6-1 in series play.....the Brewers are 6-1 in their last 7 road games.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

<u>COACHES</u>: Returning from 2024 is associate manager **Rickie Weeks** (2nd season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season) and third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role)....first base coach **Julio Borbón**, lead hitting coach **Al LeBoeuf** and hitting coach **Eric Theisen** are all in their first seasons on the staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made eight replay challenges this season, going 5-3....their last challenge (won) came on 5/28 vs. Boston as an out call at second base involving Sal Frelick was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row.....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees [6].....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24)....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 702 wins since 2017 (6th in MLB/3rd in National League).

PATRICK AT A GLANCE: Chad Patrick, 26, will be making his 15th appearance and 14th start of the season.....Patrick last pitched last Friday in a start vs. San Diego and took a 2-0 defeat (6ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 3bb, 6k, 98 pitches).....the team is 6-7 in his starts.....he has 5 quality starts.....opponents are batting .241 (63-for-261, 5hr).....he was on the Opening Day roster and made his Major League debut on 3/29 at Yankee Stadium, pitching in relief.....Patrick was acquired from Oakland on 11/15/23 for INF Abraham Toro.

PATRICK STAR: The Hebron, Indiana native was supported by 300+ guests for his first Major League start on 4/1 vs. Kansas City, including his parents, coaches, family friends and high school friends.....many of them returned to see his first Major League win on 4/6 vs. Cincinnati.

LAST SEASON: Patrick went 14-1 with a 2.90 ERA in 26 games/24 starts last season at Triple-A Nashville to earn International League Pitcher of the Year honors.....the 2024 International League All-Star led the league in wins, ERA, strikeouts (145) and WHIP (1.09) while ranking second in opponent batting average (.215).....he was added to the 40-man roster on Nov. 19

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Patrick has gone 23-14 with a 4.06 ERA in 68 games/60 starts while pitching in the Arizona (2021-23), Oakland (2023) and Milwaukee (2024) organizations.....he has produced 334 strikeouts in 312.1 innings pitched.....Patrick was selected by Arizona in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft.....he was traded by Arizona to Oakland on 7/31/23 in exchange for INF Jace Peterson, who is now a consultant to the Brewers' performance psychology department.

AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-3 with a 2.25 ERA in 8 starts (44ip, 11er).

ON THE ROAD: Is 1-2 with a 3.86 ERA in 6 games/5 starts (25.2ip, 11er).

RHP Jacob Misiorowski will be making his Major League debut.....Misiorowski, who entered the 2025 season as the third-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*, joins the Brewers from Triple-A Nashville, where he was 4-2 with a 2.13 ERA in 13 games/12 starts.... opponents batted .175 (38-for-217, 4hr).....he produced 80 strikeouts in just 63.1 innings pitched (11.37 K/9IP).....Misiorowski was selected by Milwaukee in the second round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Crowder (MO) College.....name is pronounced "miz-uh-RŎW-skee."
