BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore allowed four unanswered runs in the seventh and eighth innings and lost to St. Louis, 7-4, last night to snap a season-high three-game winning streak...The Orioles and Cardinals will play a rubber game today to decide to the series...Following the team's first scheduled off day in 16 days tomorrow, the O's host the White Sox for a three-game set beginning Friday at Camden Yards.

⚾ The Birds are 3-5 in rubber games this season, having won two of the last three... Baltimore took the series finales at Los Angeles-AL on May 11 (7-3) and vs. New York-AL on April 30 (5-4), while losing vs. Kansas City on May 4 (11-6)...After splitting the first series of the year at Toronto (2-2), the Orioles lost the next three series in a row, all with a rubber game to decide the three-game sets.

⚾ **Ryan O'Hearn** ripped a go-ahead three-run homer in the fifth inning to give the O's a 4-3 lead...Five of his home runs have given the Orioles the lead, most on the team... He's homered twice in the last three games after going homerless in a season-high 17 straight games from May 6-24 (G2).

⚾ **Ryan Mountcastle** had a season-high three hits and tied a career high with two doubles (13x, last: 8/16/24 vs. BOS)...With his fourth-inning double, he became the 44th player in Orioles history (since 1954) with 600 hits...In his 613th career game, he's tied for the seventh-fastest Oriole to 600 hits with **Brooks Robinson**, behind **Manny Machado** (520 G), **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (532), **Nick Markakis** (537 G), **Eddie Murray** (543 G), **Brian Roberts** (548 G), and **Trey Mancini** (583 G).

⚾ **Tomoyuki Sugano** allowed three runs in 5.1 innings to finish May with a 3.48 ERA (12 ER/31.0 IP), a .222 opponent average (26-for-117), and a 0.97 WHIP (26 H, 4 BB) in five starts.

⚾ The Orioles have earned at least one walk in 132 straight games since July 2, 2024, the longest active stretch in the majors ahead of the Braves (75 G) and Blue Jays (64 G)... It's the second-longest such streak in franchise history behind a 155-game stretch from June 23, 1955-June 24 (G1), 1956.

FOLLOW THE LEADER: **Ryan O'Hearn** has reached safely in 27 of his last 28 games since April 24 while slashing .374/.466/.596 (37-for-99) with four doubles, six homers, 15 runs scored, 15 RBI, and 15 walks during that time...Over that period, his on-base percentage is just behind NYY's Aaron Judge (.46565 vs. .4655) for the AL lead, his batting average trails Judge (.378), and his OPS (1.061) is third in the AL behind Judge (1.223) and BOS' Rafael Devers (1.130).

⚾ O'Hearn has 16 hits since May 21, the most in a seven-game span in his career...He's tallied at least three hits in four of those games...He's the first Oriole with 16 hits in a seven-game stretch since 2019 (Mancini, 17 H, 9/17-24).

⚾ He's reached safely in a season-high 14 straight games, one game shy of tying his career high of 15 set from June 15-July 3, 2024.

⚾ Overall, he ranks among AL leaders with a .428 on-base percentage (2nd), .986 OPS (2nd), .340 batting average (4th), and .558 slugging percentage (3rd)...His batting average is the best by an Oriole through the first 54 team games since 2020 (Iglesias, .377), while his OPS is the best in that span by an Oriole since 2018 (Machado, .994).

⚾ O'Hearn is slashing .441/.500/.814 (26-for-59) in 16 games he's played when the O's win...The 1.314 OPS is the second-highest such mark in MLB (min. 50 PA) behind Judge (1.365).

RISPY BUSINESS: The O's registered 14 at-bats with runners in scoring position last night, the fourth time in the last seven games with at least 13...The Birds are batting .103/.206/.310 (3-for-29) with runners in scoring position over the last three games...For the season, the Orioles are hitting .208 (87-for-418) with runners in scoring position, second lowest in MLB ahead of the White Sox (.206 AVG)...That number falls to .177 (35-for-198) with RISP and two outs, second lowest in the majors ahead of the Rangers (.174 AVG).

⚾ Baltimore has registered 179 at-bats with runners in scoring position over their last 19 games since May 8, going 41-for-179 (.229)...The 179 at-bats are the most in the majors during that period, while the .242 average ranks 18th.

NOT SO PITCH PERFECT: The Birds have permitted 86 home runs, the highest mark in the majors ahead of the Athletics (79 HR)...The 86 long balls are the second most through the first 54 games of a season in team history (since 1954), ahead of the 2019 Orioles (114).

HOMEWARD BOUND: The Orioles have dropped nine of the last 10 home games since May 3, including eight straight from May 3-18, tied for the fourth-longest home losing streak in Oriole Park history (since 1992)...At 9-16 (.360), the O's have the third-lowest home winning percentage in MLB ahead of the Rockies (.214, 6-22) and Athletics (.321, 9-19)...Baltimore's worst home record in franchise history (since 1954) came in 2019 (.309, 25-56).

⚾ From 2023-24, the Orioles were 93-69 at home, the fourth-best record in the AL during that time behind the Rays (95-67), and Mariners and Rangers (both 94-68).

⚾ Baltimore has a 6.17 ERA at home, highest in the majors ahead of the Athletics (5.95 ERA)...The O's have never had an ERA at home above 6.00 since the team moved to Charm City in 1954.

ALL IN THE CARDS: Baltimore and St. Louis wrap up their only series of the regular season tonight...The Orioles were swept in a three-game series at Busch Stadium last year, snapping a streak of 106 consecutive regular-season series of at least two games (no ties) without a sweep...That was the third-longest such streak in MLB history behind the 1942-44 Cardinals (124) and 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115).

⚾ The O's are 9-14 (.391) against St. Louis since the clubs first met in 2003.

⚾ The Birds are 5-12 against the NL this year, including 0-5-0 in series play...Baltimore has lost six consecutive series in Interleague play dating back to September 17-19, 2024 vs. San Francisco (1-2).

⚾ Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** was born in St. Louis in 1930 and played several minor league seasons in the Cardinals system before his illustrious managerial career with the Orioles from 1968-86.

⚾ Baltimore Assistant Pitching Coach/Interim Bullpen Coach **Mitch Plassmeyer** was born in St. Louis.

⚾ Cardinals minor league infielder **JJ Wetherholt**, rated the No. 20 overall prospect by *MLB.com*, was born in Baltimore.

THIS DATE IN O'S HISTORY

May 28, 1978 - Jim Palmer becomes the first and still only 200-game winner in Orioles history, shutting out the Indians, 3-0, at Memorial Stadium. It's the second of three consecutive shutouts in a nine-day span and the 48th of 53 career shutouts for Palmer.

May 28, 1996 - Cal and Bill Ripken both homer in the ninth inning as the Orioles beat the Mariners, 12-8, at Seattle's Kingdome. It's the third home run of the game for Cal, one of which was a grand slam, as he drives in eight runs. It's the second time for the pair and the sixth time in MLB history that brothers have homered in the same inning. Cal's final blast also ties Eddie Murray for the Orioles' all-time home run lead with 333.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his 10th start of the season and the 26th of his career... Threw a career-high 103 pitches on May 6 at Minnesota...At 25 years, 46 days old, is the youngest Orioles pitcher and third-youngest player on the active roster behind Jackson Holliday (21-175) and Gunnar Henderson (23-333)...Was the first Oriole pitcher to make his major league debut in 2024 when he started on June 6 at Toronto, and became the first Oriole to throw at least 100 pitches in his MLB debut since Wei-Yin Chen on April 10, 2012 vs. New York-AL...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Yennier Cano, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Núñez from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022...Originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (No. 98 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision on May 23 at Boston after allowing a season-low-tying one run on four hits and three walks with six strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Has tossed three consecutive starts of 5.0+ innings for the second time in his career (also 9/15-27/24, 3 G)...Snapped a three-game streak of allowing a home run, which was the second-longest stretch of his career (4 G, 6/24-7/12/24)...Threw 98 pitches, 58 strikes.

CARDS ON THE TABLE: Set to make his first career start against St. Louis and the second of his career against an NL Central opponent...In his sole start against the division on April 18 vs. Cincinnati, was dealt the loss after allowing a season-high seven runs on six hits (3 HR) and give walks with four strikeouts in a season-low 3.1 innings.

📈 In his career, he is 1-2 with a 5.40 ERA (15 ER/25.0 IP) and 27 strikeouts against nine walks in Interleague play...Did not factor in the decision in his last start against an NL opponent on May 16 vs. Washington after allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) and two walks with a season-high nine strikeouts in 5.1 innings.

ROCK THE HOUSE: Povich is 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA (17 ER/22.2 IP) in five home outings compared to 1-2 with a 3.04 ERA (8 ER/23.2 IP) in three starts on the road...Seven of his 17 runs allowed at home came in his April 18 start against Cincinnati, which marked a career high at Oriole Park.

📈 Has gone 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA (37 ER/72.2 IP) through 14 career home starts.

📈 This season, Povich has yet to work 6.0 innings in a home outing...His last quality start at Oriole Park came on September 3, 2024 vs. Chicago-AL, when he spun 7.1 scoreless innings on five hits with a career-high 10 strikeouts.

RIGHTY TIGHTY, LEFTY LOOSEY: Right-handed batters are batting .295/.355/.489 (41-for-139) with six doubles and seven home runs against him, compared to lefties slashing .200/.260/.333 (9-for-45) with one double, one triple, and one home run... Has held righties to a .197 average (14-for-71) through his last five starts since April 24 after allowing a .397 average against (27-for-68) to right-handers across his first four.

FOUR AND UP: Through the first three innings, Povich has compiled a 6.00 ERA (18 ER/27.0 IP) with an opponent slash line of .310/.363/.504 (35-for-113)...However, from the fourth inning onward, he holds a 3.26 ERA (7 ER/19.1 IP) and a .211/.282/.366 (15-for-71) slash line...Ten of his 28 total runs allowed have come in the third inning.

FIRE IN THE HOLE: This season, batters in the seventh to ninth holes are slashing .269/.345/.288 (14-for-52) with a double and six walks while batters one through six are slashing .273/.326/.515 (36-for-132) with 15 extra-base hits (6 2B, 1 3B, 8 HR) and 11 walks (1 IBB)...All of his home runs on the year have come against the top six hitters.

2024 NOTES: On June 12 vs. Atlanta, became the 11th Oriole in team history to throw at least 6.0 scoreless innings in his first career home start and first since Mike Wright Jr. on May 17, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-AL (7.1 IP)...At 24 years, 61 days old, became the youngest O's left-hander to toss 6.0+ shutout frames since Zack Britton (23-249) on August 28, 2011 (G1) vs. New York-AL (7.0 IP)...On September 3 vs. Chicago-AL, became the second-youngest Oriole (24-144) with 10 strikeouts and no walks in a game behind Dennis Martínez (24-081) on August 3, 1978 vs. Milwaukee and the youngest to do so in a nine-inning game.

vs. CHICAGO-AL: Set to make his fifth career start (sixth appearance) against the White Sox...Has gone 2-1 with a 2.88 ERA (8 ER/25.0 IP) and 18 strikeouts in his career against the club...Last faced the Sox on May 7, 2024 at Tropicana Field, earning the win after tossing 7.0 innings of one-run ball on six hits (1 HR) with three strikeouts.
