**RAY REPORT**—The Rays continue their final road trip of the season against the Tigers (0-3) and Red Sox (3 to play) tonight at Fenway Park, their final night game of the season...are 5-4 in their last nine games and 7-6 in their last 13...are 24-29 since the July 30 trade deadline and 30-33 since the All-Star break...currently 2.0 GB of the Red Sox, the Rays need to sweep this series to secure an eighth consecutive top-three finish in the AL East standings and seventh consecutive .500+ season...have been eliminated from playoff contention, ending a streak of five consecutive postseason appearances from 2019-23 matched only by the Astros, Braves and Dodgers...have spent the entire season no more than five games below or three games above .500.

Yesterday's 4-3 defeat at Comerica Park marked the Rays first loss when leading through six innings (led 3-2) since June 12 vs. CHC (led 2-1, lost 4-3), snapping a 33-game winning streak...it tied the second-longest such streak in franchise history...on the season, only the Tigers (18) have more wins when trailing through six frames than the Rays (16) in all of MLB.

Tampa Bay has been held to three runs or fewer in 10 of its last 12 games, including six games with one or zero runs...a year after averaging a club-record 5.31 runs per game, the Rays 3.74 mark this season is the lowest in franchise history (prev. 3.78 in 2014) and second lowest in the majors, ahead of only the White Sox (3.10)...the 1.57 drop-off would signal the largest year-to-year decrease in Rays history, surpassing 2021 (5.29) to 2022 (4.11; -1.18).

Despite yielding 11 runs in their last two games (6.19 ERA), the Rays 3.20 ERA since the All-Star break ranks second in the majors behind the Tigers (3.07).

Tonight, the Rays look to avoid their first four-game losing streak since June 7-10 vs. BAL...they are one of three teams in the majors that has not lost 4+ games at any point since the conclusion of that sweep, joining the Astros and Diamondbacks.

In two career starts at Fenway Park, **Taj Bradley** is 2-0 with a 3.60 ERA (10.0IP, 4ER)...he is looking to become the third visiting pitcher to earn a win in each of his first three career starts at Fenway, joining CAL/NYY **Ed Figueroa** (5, 1974-76) and WSH **Monte Weaver** (3, 1932).

**SERIES STUFF**—Since a 10-1-2 run in series play from June 18-Aug. 4 the Rays are 5-8-3 over their last 16 sets...they are 1-5-2 in road series during that span, with the lone win coming from Sept. 6-8 at BAL...this marks the 10th time in their last 11 series the Rays have faced an opponent who entered with a winning record—the only exception in that span was a three-game sweep over Toronto (4/77) from Sept. 20-22...the Rays are 12-17-3 in series against clubs that entered with a .500+ record and 12-3-3 vs. below-.500 teams.

Tampa Bay is 20-31 (.392) in series openers, 13th in the AL/26th in the majors and its worst mark since 2016 (16-35/.314)...the club has lost eight of 11 and 12 of its last 16 series-opening contests...the Rays are 17-1-2 in series in which they won the opener, going undefeated (16-0-2) in their last 18.

**CLOSE SHAVES**—The Rays lead the majors with 12 one-run games in September (4-8), ahead of the Athletics (11)...five of six and six of their last eight games have been decided by one run...each of their last three wins have come by exactly one run, matching their longest streak of the campaign (also May 29-June 2)...their last longer streak was four games from June 18-25, 2022...on the season, Tampa Bay owns MLB's best record in games decided by two runs or fewer (53-34/.609) and the fifth-best mark in one-run games (29-22/.569) despite its 29 one-run victories being tied with St. Louis for second most in the majors behind Detroit (31).

The Rays 87 games decided by two runs or fewer pace MLB, ahead of the Brewers (84), and are third most in a season in club history (2015-94G & 2003-90G).

**RACE TO THE FINISH**—The Rays need to sweep the Red Sox this weekend to finish with a .500+ record for a seventh consecutive season, which would surpass 2008-13 (6) for the longest streak in franchise history...they were last under the mark in 2017 (80-82)...the Rays are one of four teams to post a .500+ record each season from 2018-23, joining the Braves, Dodgers and Yankees...Tampa Bay also needs to sweep this series to avoid finishing fourth in the AL East, which would mark its lowest standing since a last-place finish in 2016 (68-94).

Since becoming the Rays in 2008, the club has finished with a winning record in 12 of 16 seasons, second most in MLB behind the Yankees (16) and Dodgers (15).

**LET'S GET IT STARTED**—Rays starters have allowed 3 ER or fewer in 19 consecutive games, their longest single-season streak since a 25-game run from May 2-31, 2019...they have posted a 2.03 ERA (93.0IP, 21ER) and .186/.247/.295 (63-for-339) opp. slash line since the current streak began on Sept. 6—all marks lead the majors...currently 10th in the majors with a 3.86 ERA, decimal points ahead of the 11th-ranked Cubs (3.86), the rotation is seeking a third consecutive season finishing with a top-10 ERA...they have accomplished the feat in six of the last seven seasons since 2017 (14th in 2021).

**RUNNIN' RAYS**—The Rays 178 SB lead the AL, ahead of the Guardians (147), and rank fourth in MLB behind the Nationals (217), Brewers (208) and Reds (205)...it marks the second-highest total in club history behind 2009 (194)...the Rays are looking to lead the AL in steals for the first time since 2011...however, they are just 1-for-4 on stolen base attempts over their last six games and have gone four games without a steal, matching their longest streak of the season (6x, last: Aug. 27-31).

**José Caballero** leads the AL with 44 SB, four ahead of CLE **José Ramírez** (40SB) with three games remaining for both players...he looks to join **Carl Crawford** (2003-04, 2006-07) as the only players in franchise history to pace the AL in steals...Crawford last accomplished the feat outright in 2006 with 58 SB.

**KELL YEAH**—Kevin Kelly (23.1IP) holds the longest active scoreless streak in the majors...it marks the fourth-longest single-season streak by a Ray, trailing runs by **J.P. Howell** (27.1, 2012), **Alex Cobb** (24.2, 2014) and **Taj Bradley** (24.0, 2024)...Kelly has not permitted an earned run in 25 straight outings, the longest active streak in the majors and second longest in Rays history behind **Pete Fairbanks** (30, 2022-23)...Kelly's run is the longest single-season streak in club history, surpassing Howell (24) in 2012.

**STUCK IN NEUTRAL**—Tampa Bay is one of six teams all-time to have held a .500 record at least 33 times, joining the 2011 Blue Jays (33), 2010 Athletics (33), 1993 Cubs (33), 2009 Twins (34) and 1959 Cubs (35)...the Rays would need to sweep the Red Sox this weekend in order to become the third team to reach .500 at least 34 times.

**SHIPPING UP TO BOSTON**—With the 13-game season series tied, 5-5, the Rays need to win this series to claim a sixth consecutive winning season against Boston dating back to 2019...their .644 (58-32) winning pct. vs. the Red Sox over that span is the highest in the AL, outpacing the Astros (20-12/.625)...Tampa Bay has a -1 (39-38) run differential against Boston this year, winning three of the first four matchups before dropping four of the last six.

**Min. 200 PA, Brandon Lowe's 641 SLG vs. Boston is fourth highest all-time behind Babe Ruth (.683), Frank Robinson (.652) and Lou Gehrig (.644)...min. 75 PA, his 1.256 OPS at Fenway Park is the highest in the history of the venue, ahead of HOU Alex Bregman (1.240)...however, Lowe does not have an extra-base hit in his last six games at Fenway despite going 5-for-17 (.294) in that span.**

**Yandy Díaz's** career .406 OBP vs. the Red Sox is the highest among active players (min. 250PA)...he is hitting .367 (22-for-60) in his last 14 games at Fenway.

**Josh Lowe** is 16-for-44 (.364) with 3 2B, 4 HR, 6 RBI and a 1.121 OPS in his last 12 games against Boston dating to Sept. 26, 2023.

**TONIGHT'S START**—Bradley will toe the rubber for his 25th and final start of the campaign, including his 12th on the road...has allowed three earned runs or fewer in three straight starts after allowing 4+ ER in six of his previous seven...has issued multiple walks in four of his last five starts...opened the season on the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain) before his May 10 reinstatement.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Earned the victory on Sept. 21 vs. TOR (5.0IP, 6H, 1ER, 2BB, 4SO), snapping a career-long seven-decision losing streak...worked around two singles in the 1st inning...issued a leadoff walk in the 2nd frame, but retired the next three batters...worked around two more singles in the 3rd inning...his lone run allowed came in the 5th frame, when a two-out, swinging-bunt single off the bat of **Spencer Horwitz** plated Toronto's first run, snapping the Rays 23-inning scoreless streak.

**BRADLEY AND BOSTON**—He is 3-1 with a 4.91 ERA (22.0IP, 12ER) in four career starts against Boston, including a 5.25 ERA (12.0IP, 7ER), despite a 0.92 WHIP, in two starts this season, both coming over a six-day span from May 15-20...Bradley made his MLB debut opposite Boston on April 12, 2023 at Tropicana Field (W, 5.0IP, 5H, 3ER, 1BB, 8SO).

He has a 0.78 ERA (23.0IP, 2ER) in his last four starts vs. AL East opponents.

**EBBS AND FLOWS**—Bradley ended a career-long seven-decision losing streak in his last start on Sept. 21 vs. TOR...it was the longest streak by a Rays starter since **Ryan Yarbrough** (10) from Sept. 15, 2019–April 30, 2021...he allowed 1 ER in the outing, marking his first time yielding 1 ER or fewer since July 25 at TOR (6.0IP, 2H, 0R, 1BB, 7SO)...he owns a 3.52 ERA (15.1IP, 6ER) over his last three starts following a seven-start stretch in which he posted an 8.92 ERA (35.1IP, 35ER).

In nine starts from June 8–July 25, he went 5-1 with a 0.82 ERA (55.0IP, 5ER), the lowest over a 10-start span in franchise history...however, in 10 starts since, his 7.28 ERA (50.2IP, 41ER) is the highest in MLB (min. 50.0IP), with the next closest being **AZ Brandon Pfaadt** (7.02).

**SPLITTING HAIRS**—During his dominant nine-start stretch from June 8–July 25, opponents slashed .129/.164/.186 (9-for-70) with 33 strikeouts off Bradley's splitter, whiffing 33.3 pct. of the time on the offering while striking out at a 44.6 pct. clip.

In 10 starts since, however, opponents have slashed .349/.408/.556 (22-for-63) with 18 strikeouts...his 32.8 pct. whiff rate remains in line from the previous stretch, but his 25.4 pct. strikeout rate has fallen by 19.2 pct.

**MERRY-GO-ROUND**—On the heels of a career-long 35.0 homerless inning streak, he has permitted 12 HR across his last 10 starts (2.13 HR/9.0IP), yielding multiple home runs in five of those outings...however, he has not allowed a home run in each of his last two starts.

Bradley has issued multiple walks in 17 of his 24 starts, posting a 4.15 ERA (91.0IP, 42ER) in those outings...he owns a 4.61 ERA (41.0IP, 21ER) in starts when allowing one or zero free passes.

**YOUNG BLOOD**—Bradley joined **Scott Kazmir** (4x) and **Joe Kennedy** (2x) as the only pitchers in club history to make 20+ starts in multiple seasons before turning 24...his 275 SO as a starter are second most in club history through a pitcher's first 45 career starts, trailing **Shane McClellan** (299).
