TODAY'S GAME: SF seeks to win a home series for the first time since taking two-of-three from the White Sox nearly exactly a month ago (May 22-24) with a win tonight following yesterday's victory.

- ▶ The Giants will see a left-handed starter for the first time in 10 days with LHP Gage Jump starting tonight for the Athletics...SF has won each of its last two games against lefty starters (June 14 vs. Chicago-NL and June 10 vs. Washington)...overall the Giants are 8-13 against left-handed starters this season.
- ▶ SF is also trying to win on consecutive days here at home for just the second time since the calendar turned to May, having done so once May 23-24 vs. the White Sox.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following roster moves prior to today's game.

- ▶ **RHP Tristan Beck** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **RHP Tyler Mahle** (#54) returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List.

VS. THE A'S: Last night's win brought the Giants to 9-2 over their last 11 games vs. the A's dating to August 18, 2024.

- ▶ The Giants are 10-3 (.769) vs. the A's here at Oracle Park since the start of the 2021 season...SF's .769 home winning percentage is its third best vs. any opponent over that time behind only its marks vs. Colorado (33-6, .846) and Philadelphia (14-4, .778).

BACK ON THE BUMP: **RHP Tyler Mahle** returns to the rotation and starts tonight after missing the last 23 games with a left hamstring strain.

- ▶ Mahle made one rehab start for Triple-A Sacramento last Tuesday in Oklahoma City, allowing a run on one hit over 3.0 innings...he walked five, however, and struck out three in the 63-pitch effort.
- ▶ In six starts here at Oracle, Mahle has a 3.90 ERA (14er, 32.1ip) compared to an 8.88 ERA (24er, 24.1ip) in five road starts...the Giants are 3-3 in his six home starts and are 3-8 overall in his 11 starts this year.
- ▶ He's facing the A's for a second time in 2026 after allowing five runs on 10 hits in 5.0 innings in West Sacramento on May 15 in SF's 5-2 defeat.

SCHMITTY CONNECTS: **IF/OF Casey Schmitt** has at least two hits in each of his last seven games, the first Giant with such a streak since **Marco Scutaro** also had seven consecutive multi-hit games from May 7-14, 2013...the last Giant with a longer streak was **Bill Terry** with an eight-game streak from May 30 (1)-June 6, 1934.

- ▶ Schmitt also rides a career-best eight-game overall hitting streak dating to June 13 into tonight's action...he's 16-for-31 (.516) during the streak with a .531 OBP and a .710 SLG.
- ▶ He leads the Giants in total bases (149), home runs (16), stolen bases (seven), slugging percentage (.530) and OPS (.857)...his 42 RBI are tied for the team lead.
- ▶ His .299 average is seventh-best in the NL (ninth-best in MLB) entering play today while his 149 total bases are tied for eighth-most in the NL.

JHL DELIVERS: With two more hits last night, **OF Jung Hoo Lee** is now hitting .460 (40-for-87) with 11 extra-base hits, 10 RBI, 20 runs scored and five steals in 22 game since coming off the IL on May 29...his .331 average entering play today is second-best in MLB behind MIA's Otto Lopez (.340).

- ▶ During this stretch, Lee has batted .417 (10-for-24) with two XBH against lefties...vs. righties during this span, Lee is batting .476 (30x63) with a 1.152 OPS.

NICE TO SEE: **RHP Logan Webb** and **LHP Robbie Ray** each finished 8.0 innings in SF's last two games...it's the first time the Giants have had consecutive 6.0+ inning outings from their starters since May 16-17 when **RHP Trevor McDonald** (6.2ip) and **RHP Adrian Houser** (6.0ip) did so against the A's in West Sacramento.

- ▶ The Giants have only had one instance of three consecutive starts of 6.0+ innings this season (April 5-7 with Webb, Houser and Ray).
- ▶ This month, Giants starting pitching has a 3.82 ERA (43er, 101.1ip), seventh-best in the Majors and fifth-best in the NL...this is on the heels of a 5.21 ERA (83er, 143.1ip) in May, which was 27th in MLB.

WELCOME TO SF: Is in his 10th season in the Majors and his first in a Giants uniform...the 31-year-old inked a one-year deal with SF on January 5.

HAPPY & HEALTHY: Mahle is making his first start (12th overall this season) since May 26 versus Arizona, as he was placed on the 15-day Injured List following that start with a left hamstring strain.

LAST TIME OUT: Made one rehab appearance with Triple-A Sacramento last Tuesday in Oklahoma City...worked 3.0 innings in that game and allowed only one run on one hit...he did also walk five and strike out three in the 63-pitch effort.

TOUGH STRETCH: Over his last four starts prior to hitting the IL, Mahle was 0-3 with a 7.84 ERA (18er, 20.2ip), 1.55 WHIP, .317 (26x82) opponents' batting average and a .929 opposing OPS...in his three starts prior (April 22-May 3), he had a 2.60 ERA (5er, 17.1ip), .206 BAA and a .510 OPS.

AGAINST THE A'S: Will face the Athletics for the fourth time in his career (all starts), against whom he's 0-3 with a 3.71 ERA (7er, 17.0ip)...over those previous three starts, he's only received two total runs in support...clashed with the A's in Sacramento earlier this year on May 15 and took the loss after allowing five earned runs on 10 hits over 5.0 innings pitched.

HOMEBODY: Has been pitching much better at home this season...in six starts at Oracle Park, the righty has a 3.90 ERA (14er, 32.1ip), a .227 BAA and a .701 opponents' OPS...in five starts away from home, he is 0-4 with a 8.88 ERA (24er, 24.1ip), a .356 opposing average and a 1.001 OPS...Mahle's -4.98 difference between his road and home ERA represents the third-largest ERA differential in the Majors this season (min. 55.0ip)...last season, Mahle had a 0.84 ERA in 10 starts at home and 4.36 ERA in six road starts.

FAST AND FURIOUS: Over his last seven starts, opponents are 11-for-63 (.175) with 20 strikeouts in at-bats ending with his four-seamer...Mahle is throwing his four-seam fastball 48.3% of the time this year, averaging 92.2 mph with batters hitting .247 off the pitch.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Is throwing the first pitch of an at-bat for a strike just 54.8% of the time, the lowest of his career and 10% lower than his 64.8% mark last season...his 54.8% first pitch strike rate this season ranks as the ninth-lowest in MLB (min. 11 starts) and third-lowest in the National League.

ANTI-AGGRESSION: Despite his low first-strike rate, opponents are still 11-for-21 (.524) with a double, triple and two home runs against Mahle on the first pitch of an at-bat.

PUT IT IN REVERSE: Has been putting up reverse splits this season, with right handers slashing .343/.424/.539 (.963 OPS) off him while lefties are .237/.287/.441 (.727 OPS)...among right-handed pitchers, his .343 BAA and .963 OPS versus right-handed hitters are both highest in the Majors (min. 55.0 innings pitched).

THE SPLIT: Batters are hitting .284 (19x67) with four doubles and three homers off his main secondary pitch, his split finger...Mahle has thrown it 24.6% of the time...last year, Mahle's splitter was his most valuable pitch, accumulating a +5 run value...he used the pitch 27.7% of the time last year, with opponents hitting just .196 off his split-finger with 25 strikeouts (24.0% whiff rate).

LANDEN ROUPP RHP #65

2026 RECORD: 5-7, 4.15 ERA

- ▶ Received a no decision in his last start despite a solid outing in Miami on June 19...allowed two runs on seven hits (one homer) and a walk while striking out seven over 6.0 innings.
- ▶ Will be making his second career start vs. the A's (also May 17, 2025 vs. ATH)...threw 6.0 shutout innings in that start, striking out five while allowing five hits and two walks.
- ▶ Has not earned a win since April 26...is 0-6 with a 5.40 ERA (27er, 45.0ip), 52 strikeouts and a 1.60 WHIP over his last nine starts...has two quality starts in that span.
