FIFTH: O.....the team is in first place, leading the Cardinals by 3.5 games, Pirates by 6.5 games, Reds by 7.0 games and last-place Cubs by 8.5 games.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers are 17-11-3 in series play, including this series. Game 1: 15-16, Game 2: 18-13, Game 3: 18-11, Game 4: 3-2 Sweep Wins (4): at NYM (3q, 3/29-3/31), at STL (3q, 4/19-4/21), vs. CWS (3g, 5/31-6/2), vs. TEX (3g, 6/24-6/26)

AT HOME: The Brewers are 28-17 at home, going 10-4-1 in series play, inluding this series....the team has lost its last two home series after winning nine home series in a row.....the team has gone 24-10 in its last 34 home games after a 5-7 start.....the Brewers had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from May 29-June 10.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 26-25 on the road, going 7-7-2 in series play....the team has gone 13-21 in its last 34 road games after a 13-4 start.....the team had a season-high 4-game road winning streak from April 9-13.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing **Bud Black** in June (42-54).....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 22 replay challenges this season, going 13-9.....their last challenge (lost) came on 7/7 at Los Angeles-NL as a foul ball hit by Willy Adames stood.

REA AT A GLANCE: Colin Rea, 34, will be making his 19th appearance and 17th start of the season.....Rea last pitched on Tuesday vs. Pittsburgh and suffered a 12-2 defeat (5ip, 6h, 7r, 7er, 2bb, 3k, 1hr, 87 pitches).....he has gone 7-3 with a 4.01 ERA as a starter (89.2ip, 40er) and 1-0 with a 1.86 ERA in relief (9.2ip, 2er).....the team is 11-5 in his starts.... has has 6 quality starts.....opponents are batting .238 (91-for-382, 14hr).....Rea is signed through the 2024 season with a club option for 2025.....name is pronounced "RAY."

LAST SEASON: Rea went 6-6 with a 4.55 ERA in 26 games/22 starts during five stints with Milwaukee last season.....the team went 14-8 in his starts.....he had 4 quality starts.....opponents batted .235 [110-for-468, 23hr].....he set career highs in wins (6), games (26), starts (22), innings pitched (124.2) and strikeouts (110).

CAREER: Is 22-17 with a 4.50 ERA in 80 games/65 starts (378.1ip, 189er).....has pitched in the majors for San Diego (2015-16), Miami (2016), Chicago-NL (2020) and Milwaukee (2021, '23-24).....is 19-16 with a 4.63 ERA as a starter (342ip, 176er) and 3-1 with a 3.22 ERA in relief (36.1ip, 13er).....Rea was selected by San Diego in the 12th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Indiana State University.....he underwent "Tommy John" surgery on 11/11/16, causing him to miss the entire 2017 season.....Rea also pitched in Japan with the Fukuoka SoftBank Hawks in 2021 and 2022.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 7-6 with a 4.34 ERA in 24 games/21 starts [118.1ip, 57er].....is 5-2 with a 3.76 ERA in 9 starts this season [52.2ip, 22er].

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 10-7 with a 4.55 ERA in 36 games/26 starts (166.1ip, 84er)....is 3-1 with a 3.86 ERA in 9 games/7 starts this season (46.2ip, 20er).

CAREER vs. NATIONALS: His only career outing vs. Washington came with the Padres on 6/18/16 at Petco Park (6.1ip, 4h, 2r, 1er, 2bb, 6k, 1hbp).....had no decision in a 7-3 win.
