TODAY'S GAME: With a series win in the bag, the Giants look to get greedy Sunday afternoon in Washington and eye a sweep of the Nationals before flying back to the Bay.

- ▶ This is the third and final stop on the Giants' three-city, 11-day road trip through the east coast...SF is 4-4 on the trip so far, going 1-2 in both Baltimore (last weekend) and Cincinnati (earlier this week) before going 2-0 here in DC thus far...a win today secures a winning road trip.
- ▶ With yesterday's win, SF has now won four of its last five series in D.C., which is its second-best series record (4-1) at an NL opponent since 2022, behind only its 4-0 series record at Pittsburgh (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ The last time the Giants swept a series here in the District since 2022 when they swept a three-game series from April 22-24.

RAYGUN: LHP Robbie Ray aims to lead SF to a sweep today against the team that originally drafted him all the way back in 2010 in the 12th round out of Brentwood (TN) High School.

- ▶ Today's outing marks Ray's second start on this road trip after taking a tough-luck loss in Cincinnati on Tuesday in the Giants' 2-1 defeat...Ray allowed only two hits that unfortunately were both solo homers over 5.0 innings of work...he walked four and struck out six in the 94-pitch effort.
- ▶ The 34-year-old has worked at least 5.0 innings and allowed two or fewer runs in each of his first four outings of the campaign...he's averaging better than a strikeout per inning (24 in 22.1 innings) but he's also walked 10.
- ▶ Lifetime against the Nationals he's 3-5 with a 5.21 ERA (27er, 46.2ip) in nine starts but his teams have one each of his last three starts against the Nationals, including his lone start with SF against them last year here in DC...in that outing Ray allowed one run in 6.0 innings, didn't walk a batter and struck out seven in the Giants 3-2 win last May.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: Following SF's 10-run, 15-hit outburst on Friday, they followed it up with seven runs on 16 hits in yesterday's win.

- ▶ In two games in this series the Giants have scored a total of 17 runs on 31 hits...they scored seven runs on 22 hits in the three-game series in Cincinnati before coming here.
- ▶ **OF Heliot Ramos** has come alive in this series, going 4-for-9 with three runs scored, a go-ahead three run homer on Friday, a game-tying two-run homer yesterday, six total RBI and a pair of walks...he'd driven in seven runs in his first 18 games of the year.
- ▶ The offensive outburst has vaulted SF out of the lowest runs/game average in MLB (they entered this series averaging 3.05 runs/game) as they start to get hot...their 3.57 runs/game entering today is still 26th of 30 MLB teams but they're trending upward.

FIRESTARTERS: Every member of the Giants starting lineup has recorded at least one hit in each of the first two games of this series.

- ▶ **IF Luis Arraez** has hit safely in each of his 13 career games here at Nationals Park, going 28-for-59 (.475) with three homers, 10 RBI and 16 runs scored.
- ▶ He has reached base safely in 21 consecutive games against the Nationals regardless of venue dating to August 27, 2023...Arraez is slashing .389/.421/.500 with 19 runs, five extra-base hits, eight RBI, 19 runs scored and a .921 OPS over that span.
- ▶ Arraez is one of a few Giants starters to have some career success against today's Nats starter Miles Mikolas...he's 4-for-12 lifetime against Mikolas.
- ▶ **IF Matt Chapman** is 4-for-9 (.444) with a double and two walks vs. Mikolas while **IF Rafael Devers** is 5-for-7 (.714) with a homer and a walk

PEN TO PAPER: The Giants' bullpen has allowed just two earned runs over their last five games (0.93 ERA, 19.1ip, 23k, 7bb)...since April 7, the SF bullpen has a 2.16 ERA (8er, 33.1ip) over its last 10 games...opponents have hit .186 in that time with a .572 OPS.

- ▶ The 2.16 ERA in that span is second-best in MLB behind only the Reds (1.85).

HOMeward BOUND: On the east coast for 11 days, the Giants fly home after this afternoon's game to take a day of rest on Monday before opening up a six-game homestand Tuesday.

- ▶ That homestand begins with the first series of 2026 against the Los Angeles Dodgers Tuesday-Thursday...since 2022, the Giants are 18-40 against LA overall and 10-18 at home vs. LA in that time.

Randy Johnson took a no-hitter into the 7th inning and **combined with Bobby Howry and Brian Wilson** for a 2-0 victory over the Diamondbacks. It was Johnson's 296th win, but his first with the San Francisco Giants.

CY YOUNG: 2021 (W/TOR) | ☆ ALL-STAR: 2017 (W/AZ), 2025 (W/SF)

WITH THE GIANTS: The 2021 Cy Young Award winner is in his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors... the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

LAST START: Suffered a tough-luck loss in the Giants 2-1 loss to Cincinnati on April 14 at Great American Ball Park...tossed 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on two hits (both solo homers) and four walks with six strikeouts...it marked his first start on the road this year.

STARTING STRONG: Ray has gone at least 5.0 innings with at least four strikeouts while not allowing more than two runs in each of his first four appearances, which is the longest such stretch to start a season of his career...the last Giant with a longer such run to start a season was **LHP Madison Bumgarner** in 2013 (first five starts) (*Stats, LLC*).

AGAINST THE NATIONALS: Will make his 10th career start against the Nationals...is 3-5 with a 5.21 ERA over his nine career outings against Washington...however, he has faced them just twice since 2020 and gone 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA (2er, 12.2ip), 14 strikeouts and a 0.55 WHIP in those two games...he's made five career starts here at Nationals Park and posted a 1-3 record with a 4.88 ERA and .202 opponents average against...his team is 1-4 in those starts here.

LOOKIN' SHARP IN CACTUS LEAGUE: Made six starts in Arizona's Cactus League this spring and posted a 2-0 record with a 1.37 ERA (3er, 19.2ip)...he struck out 21 batters, allowed just five hits and posted a 0.86 WHIP overall his six outings...had a two-start stretch from March 9-15 where he did not allow a hit (9.0 total innings) hit one, walked four and struck out 12...his last start came on March 21 against Cleveland where he threw 5.0 innings and allowed one run on three hits with six strikeouts.

2025 RECAP: Was selected to the NL All-Star team for the second time in his career (also 2017 with the Diamondbacks), pitching the best first half of his 12-year MLB career, as he posted his lowest career ERA (2.65) before the break (min. nine starts)...overall he started 32 games for SF, finishing the year with a 11-8 record and 3.65 ERA after posting a 5.54 ERA in 12 starts after the break...the 3.65 season ERA was his lowest since his Cy Young season in 2021 (2.84) and fourth-lowest in his 12-year career.

LUCKY CHARM: The Giants won each of Ray's first nine starts in 2025, making him the first Giants starter to have the team win each of his first nine starts of a season since **Bill Swift** in 1992 (11 wins to start the season).

CHANGING THINGS UP: Last spring, he told reporters that he added a changeup to his pitch mix after connecting with 2024 AL Cy Young Tarik Skubal in the offseason to learn about his grip....Skubal sent Ray pictures, video and was available to chat with him about the pitch...Ray threw it 399 times (13.0% of the time) through 32 starts last year (all to righties), with batters going 17-for-73 (.233) with 16 strikeouts off the pitch.

LEFT ON READ: Left-handers slashed .188/.282/.318 off him last season...the .188 average was third-best in the National League, trailing LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (.174) and SD's Nick Pivetta (.185).

FAST AND FURIOUS: Batters hit .208 (75x361) off his four-seamer last season, his most used pitch (52.0%)...the pitch had a +9 run value, his highest of any pitch since 2022 (slider)...additionally, Ray's 108 strikeouts with a four-seamer were most in the NL and ranked second in the Majors behind only MIN's Joe Ryan (109).

GOOD LUCK CHUCK: The Giants were 22-10 in his starts last season...the .688 winning percentage ranked as the second-best record of any NL team behind the same starter, trailing only the Phillies 23-9 (.719) record with Cristopher Sánchez on the mound...it also tied NYY's Max Fried for the third-best team record among starters in MLB, (other: Boston's Garret Crochet at 23-9).

2026 RECORD: 3-1, 2.38 ERA

- ▶ Led SF to a pair of wins on the road trip, going 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1er, 12.0ip) and 10 strikeouts.
- ▶ No-hit the Reds through five innings last Thursday in Cincinnati before giving up a hit to start the sixth...worked 6.0 scoreless innings in SF's 3-0 win.
- ▶ Will face LA for a fifth time in his career, third time as a starter...in his last start vs. LA on July 12, 2025 he took a tough-luck loss (6.0ip, 7h, 2r, er, bb, 8k) in a 2-1 SF loss.

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 4/18 at WSH; 0.1ip, k (6 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-14 (.143) with two walks and five strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .180 clip (69-for-383) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 7-for-14 with three XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 4/15 at CIN; 2.0ip, 2h, bb, 2k (28 pitches)

- ▶ Three of his eight appearances thus far have been 2.0 innings.
- ▶ Has allowed runs in one of his eight games and has issued at least one walk in six of eight contests (eight walks in 10.1ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 9-for-25 (.360) with three XBHs off him while lefties are 1-for-12 (.083).
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13, 2025 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 4/18 at WSH; 1.0ip (6 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed a homer to James Wood on Friday night, the first homer he'd allowed in 41.0 MLB innings dating to June 11, 2023...bounced back with a scoreless inning yesterday, throwing only six pitches.
- ▶ Has appeared in 10 of SF's 21 games, tossing 9.1-innings.
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by **RHP Dan Otero** in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/18 at WSH; W, 2.0ip, bb, 2k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Earned his first MLB win with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief yesterday...stranded the free base runner in both the 11th and the 12th.
- ▶ Allowed one run on two hits in 10.0 innings with 14 strikeouts and six walks in 10 games.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.

#60 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 4/18 at WSH; 1.0ip, 2k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Struck out three batters in the 9th Thursday at Cincinnati to record his first career save...struck out another two in Saturday's win.
- ▶ Has appeared in eight of SF's 21 games, allowing four runs in 7.0ip.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 52.1 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the fourth-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

#46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter

Last Game: 4/17 at WSH; 1.0ip, hbp (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in five of his six outings (2er, 8.0ip) and posted a 0.75 WHIP.
- ▶ Recalled on April 2 with **RHP José Buttó** being placed on the IL...logged his first career save in his Giants debut that night pitching against the Mets, the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Pitched one game for Triple-A Sacramento on March 29, drawing the start vs. El Paso while spinning 2.2 hitless/shutout innings.
- ▶ Played for Giants **MGR Tony Vitello** while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft and joined SF at last year's deadline alongside **RHP José Buttó** and **OF Drew Gilbert** in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.

#74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 4/18 at WSH; BS, 2.0ip, 3h, r, er, 2bb, 2k (26 pitches)

- ▶ Blew his first save of the season yesterday in the 9th, but was able to throw a scoreless 10th inning by stranding the free base runner.
- ▶ Has appeared in nine of SF's first 21 games.
- ▶ Batters are 3-for-17 in ABs that end with his slider and 6-for-18 in ones that end with his sinker...last season, batters hit .277 (41x148) off his sinker and .207 (18x87) off his slider last season.
- ▶ In 24 save opportunities last season, he owned a 7.06 ERA (17er, 21.2ip)...in his 44 non-save situations games he had a 2.50 ERA (11er, 39.2ip)...has the most experience as a closer of any player in this current bullpen group.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 4/16 at CIN; 1.0ip, 2k (12 pitches)

- ▶ Seven of his nine appearances this year have been scoreless.
- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the 'pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.
- ▶ Overall, was 1-1 with a 8.49 ERA (22er, 23.1ip) in 14 games (three starts) with Triple-A Sacramento in 2025.

- ▶ Is 15-for-46 (.326) in his last 11 games with 10 of the 15 hits going for extra-bases.
- ▶ Overall, 13 of his 22 hits this year have been for extra-bases (10 2B, three HR)...the 10 doubles are tied for second-most in MLB behind Baltimore's Taylor Ward (11).
