METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets defeated the Blue Jays, 2-1, yesterday at Citi Field...The Mets continue their first homestand of the season, a six-game stand against the Blue Jays (3-0) and the Marlins (three games)...Following this homestand, the Mets are off on Thursday before the start of a six-game road trip against the A's (three games) and Twins (three games).

LET'S GO STREAKING: The Mets are on a season-high four-game winning streak...The team has won five of their last six contests...New York is a season-high three games over .500.

IN THE CITI: The Mets moved to 3-0 at home this season...It is the first time the Mets have won their first three home games since 2015 when they won their first 10 home games of the season...The Mets have posted a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0 IP) at home this year...That is the best mark in the majors.

NINE IS FINE: The Mets have a major league-leading 1.91 ERA (17 ER/80.0 IP) through the teams' first nine games...Is the fourth-best mark in franchise history through the team's first nine games of the season behind the 1968 team (1.44), the 1971 team (1.58) and the 1985 squad (1.73)...Mets pitchers have recorded 84 strikeouts this season, the seventh-most strikeouts through the first nine games of a season in franchise history (98K in 2018, 96K in 2022, 94K in 2019, 91K in 2019 and 2021 and 85K in 2016).

THE PEN IS MIGHTIER: Mets relievers have combined to post a major league-best 1.29 ERA (5 ER/35.0 IP) this season...New York relievers have stranded 18 of 20 inherited runners (90 percent), tied for the best mark in the majors (min. five inherited runners)...The Yankees have stranded nine of 10 inherited runners (90%)...The 18 stranded runners are the most the majors...Max Kranick and Reed Garrett have both stranded all six inherited runners this season, that is tied for the most in the majors without allowing an inherited runner to score.

MAX POWER: Last night, Max Kranick earned his first win of the season after stranding three inherited runners in the fifth inning and tossing a perfect sixth...It marked his third career win and first since September 26, 2021 at Philadelphia...This season, he has stranded all six of his inherited runners, tying teammate Reed Garrett for the most inherited runners stranded in the majors...He extended his career-high scoreless inning streak to 12.0 IP (since: 5/7/22 at Cincinnati with Pittsburgh), including 7.0 innings pitched this season...He has retired 21 of 22 batters faced this season, holding his opponents to a .045 average.

A HIT'S A HIT: Francisco Lindor enters today with 1,497 career hits...He is looking to become the 24th active player with at least 1,500 career hits.

SENGA GENESIS: Tonight, Kodai Senga is set to make his first start at Citi Field this year...Senga appeared in one game at Citi Field in 2024...He earned the win on July 26 vs. Atlanta, allowing two earned runs on two hits with one walk and struck out nine over 5.1 innings...He left the game due to a left calf injury...In 17 career starts at Citi Field, Senga is 7-3 with a 2.47 ERA (27 ER/98.1 IP), 42 walks and 133 strikeouts.

MARLINS-METS NOTES: The Mets have not lost a season series against the Marlins since 2017...The Mets are 84-57 against the Marlins since Citi Field opened in 2009.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: Pete Alonso has 11 RBI in his last six games (since 3/31)... He is one of 11 players in franchise history to record at least 11 RBI through the team's first nine games of a season and is the only player in franchise history to do so multiple times (also: 2019, '22)...He has reached base three or more times in four games this season, tied for the second-most such games this season.

WE REMEMBER: The New York Mets announced that the team will wear a tribute uniform patch all season long to honor Mets Hall of Famer Ed Kranepool...Kranepool passed away on September 8, 2024, at age 79...Kranepool played for the Mets from 1962-1979, spending his entire 18-year career with the Mets...He was a member of the 1969 Miracle Mets, a 1965 All-Star and the club's all-time leader in games played...Kranepool remains in the Mets all-time top 10 in many statistical categories including plate appearances, hits, at-bats, total bases, doubles, RBI, walks and runs scored...He was inducted into the Mets Hall of Fame in 1990.

LAST TIME OUT: Senga made his season debut at Miami on April 1...Even though he received the loss he pitched five innings, gave up two earned runs, walked one and struck out eight Marlins.

2024 REWIND: He missed nearly the first four months of the 2024 season with a right shoulder capsule strain...Returned and made one regular season start on July 26 vs. Atlanta, throwing 5.1 innings and allowing two runs on two hits with nine strikeouts and one walk before exiting with an injury...Missed the rest of the regular season with a strained left calf...He made it back for the Postseason and he made his first career Postseason start on October 5 in Game 1 of the NLDS against the Phillies...Threw 2.0 innings allowing one run, a home run in the first inning, and recorded one walk and three strikeouts...Finished the Postseason making three appearances and pitching 5.0 innings while striking out four.

GHOSTING THE BATS: In 2023 Senga's "ghost fork" accounted for 110 of his 202 strikeouts...The pitch had a 59.5% whiff rate and a 28.2% put away rate...Opponents managed just 18 hits in 163 at-bats ending with the forkball, a .110 batting average...In his first start against Miami, he picked up six of his eight strikeouts on the "ghost fork" and he generated a 57.1% whiff rate.

FLOUNDERING FISH: In five starts against Miami, Senga is 3-1 with a 2.63 ERA (8 ER/27.1 IP) and 33 strikeouts...The Marlins are the only team that Senga has thrown more than 14.0 innings against or has more than two starts against and his 33 strikeouts are his most against any opponent.

SPRING TRAINING: Senga made three starts in Grapefruit League action and he finished with a 2.00 ERA (2 ER/9.0 IP) and nine strikeouts...His last spring outing was March 20 against the Nationals, and he struck out six batters over 3.2 innings of work.

SENGA GENESIS: Through Senga's first 31 career starts he has posted 219 strikeouts which is the 10th-most through a pitchers first 31 starts in major league history...He trails former Mets Dwight Gooden (First, 276), Matt Harvey (sixth, 234) and Noah Syndergaard (ninth, 221).

CRUISING AT CITI: In 17 career games at Citi Field Senga has a 7-3 record to go along with a 2.47 ERA (27 ER/98.1 IP) which is the seventh best in the history of the ballpark (min. 90.0 IP) ...He also has held batters to a .176 batting average (61-347) and has 133 strikeouts.

REMARKABLE ROOKIE: During his rookie campaign in 2023, Kodai Senga recorded 202 strikeouts and became the 18th rookie pitcher in the Modern Era (Since 1900) to have 200 or more strikeouts in a season...Senga's 202 punch outs were the second-most by a Mets pitcher behind only Dwight Gooden's 276 strikeouts in 1984...He joined Hideo Nomo (236), Yu Darvish (221) and Daisuke Matsusaka (201) as the only Japanese-born rookie hurlers to reach 200 strikeouts...Senga's 12 wins were tied with Ron Darling (1984) for the seventh-most wins in a single season by a Mets rookie and was the first Mets rookie to reach double-digit wins since Dillon Gee (13, 2011)...His 2.98 ERA (55 ER/166.1 IP) was the fifth-lowest in a single season by a Mets rookie behind only Jerry Koosman (2.08, 1968), Jon Matlack (2.32, 1972), Dwight Gooden (2.60, 1984) and Tom Seaver (2.76, 1967).

KODAI THE FRIENDLY GHOST: In 2023, Senga finished second in the NL and fifth in the majors among qualifiers in ERA...His 202 strikeouts were the tied for the eighth-most in the NL and tied for the 14th-most in the majors...Senga held opposing batters to a .208 average, the third-lowest mark among qualifiers in the NL and the fourth-lowest mark in the majors...His 10.93 K/9 rate was the fifth-best mark among qualified major league pitchers in 2023...He finished seventh in NL Cy Young voting.

HEY NOW YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: In 2023 Senga joined Pete Alonso (2019), Dwight Gooden (1984), Jerry Koosman (1968) and Tom Seaver (1967) as the only Mets rookies selected to an All-Star Game...He was the eighth Japanese-Born rookie ever to be selected to an All-Star Game joining Masahiro Tanaka (2014), Yu Darvish (2012), Kosuke Fukudome (2008), Hideki Okajima (2007), Hideki Matsui (2003), Ichiro Suzuki (2001) and Hideo Nomo (1995).

METS-JAPAN CONNECTION: Senga is the 14th Japanese-born player to appear in at least one game for the Mets, the most by any major league team...Prior to Senga, the last Japanese-born player to appear in a game for the Mets was OF Norichika Aoki in 2017.

- Got the final two outs and picked up the save in the Mets 6-5 win on April 2 at Miami...It was his first career save after not recording one in his first 118 career appearances.
- Pitched 2.1 scoreless innings on Opening Day (March 27) against Houston.
