THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MARCH 31
2013 - In a nationally televised season opener, the Astros defeat the Rangers, 8-2, in what was their first official game as an American League franchise...

TUESDAY'S TILT: The Astros and Red Sox will play the middle game of their three-game series tonight as Houston goes for their fourth straight win and a series victory...

ON THE HUNT: RHP Hunter Brown is making his second start of the season after tossing 4.2 scoreless innings against the Angels on Opening Day...

ASTROS VS. BELLO: The Astros are seeing RHP Brayan Bello tonight for the first time since facing him in back-to-back starts on Aug. 24 and Aug. 29, 2023...

RIVALRY VS. THE RED SOX: The Astros and Red Sox have developed a nice rivalry over the last 10 years, as the two clubs have seen each other in three different postseason series since the 2017 season...

YORDAN AND THE BABE: LF Yordan Alvarez has played 30 career games against the Red Sox, including six in the postseason, combining for a .404 (44x109) average with 11 doubles, nine homers, 29 RBI, a .481 OBP and a .771 SLG...

SUSTAINED SUCCESS: Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 11 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...

LAST NIGHT'S THROWBACK GAME: The Astros offense kept rolling last night in an 8-1 dominant, series-opening victory over the Red Sox...RHP Lance McCullers Jr. (1ER/7IP) was stellar in his start, fanning nine en route to the win...

VINTAGE MCCULLERS: RHP Lance McCullers Jr. was dominant in 7.0 innings last night, allowing just one run on four hits with a walk and nine strikeouts...this marked his longest outing since Sept. 21, 2022 at TB, when he also went 7.0 innings.

LEAGUE LEADERS: The Astros lead the Majors in doubles (14) and total bases (73), while ranking second in hits (44) and walks (25)...individually, 1B Christian Walker leads the Majors in doubles (4), while 2B Jose Altuve owns a share of the MLB lead with six runs scored.

JOSE, JOSE, JOSE, JOSE!: 2B Jose Altuve went 4x4 with four runs scored and a pair of homers last night, giving him 42 four-hit games since he debuted in 2011, which are by far the most in the Majors in that time frame (1B Freddie Freeman ranks second with 31)...

YORDAN'S UPCOMING MILESTONES: LF Yordan Alvarez (497 RBI) is three RBI shy of reaching 500 career RBI, a mark only 14 players in franchise history have reached...Alvarez also checks in with 172 career homers, which makes him just two homers shy of matching franchise icon OF George Springer (174HR) for seventh on the Astros all-time list.

GOIN' DEEP: LF Brice Matthews hit his first homer of the season last night, a 434' shot to left-center field...Matthews' homer was the longest of his career, the longest by an Astro this season (by 40 feet) and the fifth-longest in the Majors in 2026.

NEW FACES: The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing RHP Mike Burrows and RHP Kai-Wei Teng in trades and RHP Tatsuya Imai and RHP Ryan Weiss off the international free agent market...they also added a Rule 5 pick in RHP Roddery Muñoz, the Astros first Rule 5 selection since the 2017 Rule 5 Draft.

COLE SIDELINED: OF Zach Cole will be placed on the minor league IL today with a fifth toe fracture on his right foot...Cole began the season at Triple A Sugar Land, where he sustained the injury on a HBP on Sunday vs. Round Rock.

EXHIBITION SEASON OVER: The Astros went 11-14-3 (.440) in Grapefruit League play, which does not include their three exhibition game victories, in which stats do not count...Astros starting pitchers were great, as their Opening Day rotation combined for a 1.95 ERA (12ER/55.1IP) in official games...OF Joey Loperfido (.317, 13x41) and IF/OF Brice Matthews (10 RBI, 8 SB) had the best camps offensively with Loperfido leading the team in hits and Matthews leading the club in RBI and steals.

AT THE OPEN: The Texas Children's Houston Open completed play on Sunday at Memorial Park Golf Course in Houston with Gary Woodland riding a record-setting performance to his first PGA TOUR title since 2019 and fifth overall...Woodland finished at 21-under 259 (64-63-65-67), recording the lowest 72-hole score in Texas Children's Houston Open history...2026 represents the seventh year the Astros Golf Foundation has hosted this premier PGA TOUR event and sixth at its permanent home, Memorial Park Golf Course in the heart of Houston.

LAST START - 3/26 vs. LAA: Was the Astros Opening Day starter...allowed 4 hits and 4 walks with 9 strikeouts in 4.2 innings...didn't factor into the decision of the Astros 0-3 loss to the Angels...became the 4th pitcher in Astros franchise history to record at least 9 strikeouts on Opening Day, joining **RHP Justin Verlander** (9 SO - 2019), **RHP Mike Scott** (9 -1988) and **RHP J.R. Richard** (13 - 1980).

THE DIESEL: a 2025 All-Star, Brown finished third in the AL in Cy Young voting last season after turning in the best year of his career with a 12-9 record, a 2.43 ERA (50ER/185.1IP) and posting a 1.03 WHIP...the hard-throwing right-hander has pitched in parts of 5 big league seasons (2022-26), while going 36-31 with a 3.46 ERA (206ER/536IP) in 101 games (93 starts).

HISTORIC SEASON: In 2025, Brown held opponents to a career-low .201 average and posted 206 strikeouts in 185.1 innings pitched...his 2.43 ERA ranked 10th all-time among Astros starters and was the second-lowest by an Astros starter in the last 20 seasons (since 2005)... among AL starters, he ranked first in opponent SLG (.318) and second in ERA (2.43)...lastly, by reaching 206 strikeouts, he became the 18th pitcher in club history to reach 200 strikeouts in a season.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU: By finishing third in the AL Cy Young voting in 2025, the Astros were granted a compensation pick immediately after the first round of the 2026 draft...the Astros earned the pick through the Prospect Promotion Incentive (PPI), which was ratified into the latest CBA...the PPI rewards teams for promoting their best prospects to the big leagues at the start of the season, having them accrue one full year of service time and then having them factor into a major award that season or prior to qualifying for arbitration.

MIXING IT UP: Has changed his repertoire over the course of his career, which resulted in a huge turnaround over the last 2 seasons...many coaches and teammates have worked with Brown, none more so than former teammate **Alex Bregman**, who suggested Brown incorporate a running sinker into his arsenal to keep right-handed hitters from leaning out over the plate... while the sinker does not grade out analytically as well as his other offerings, it compliments his offerings perfectly...prior to the change, Brown owned a 5.10 ERA in 41 games, since the change Brown has posted a 2.61 ERA (102ER/352.1 IP) in his last 60 appearance, since April 16, 2024.

FOLLOWING HIS FOOTSTEPS: Born and raised in Detroit, Brown went to grade school, high school and college in his hometown...he grew up a Tigers fan and a fan of Justin Verlander, who he modeled his pitching delivery after...Brown met Verlander as a fifth-grader at St. Isaac Jogues Catholic School in Saint Clair Shores, MI, a suburb of Detroit...Verlander, fellow Tiger Carlos Guillén and others visited the school as part of a radio promotion, won by one of Brown's classmates...the two later were teammates for three years (2022-24) and became close friends...now Brown is the Astros Opening Day starter, a position Verlander held for three seasons (2018-20).

SPRING TRAINING: made 4 official Spring Training starts, working to a 2.84 ERA (4ER/12.2IP)...struck out 20 in his 12.2 innings, while allowing just 6 hits and 7 walks for a 1.03 WHIP...also pitched an intrasquad sim game, which did not factor into his Spring Training stats... turned heads on March 8 at WSH, fanning 9 hitters in 4.0 innings of hitless ball against the Nationals.

VS. THE RED SOX: Is set to face the Boston Red Sox for the 4th time in his career...in his previous 3 starts, he's recorded a 1.89 ERA (4ER//19IP) with 19 strikeouts, 6 walks, a 1.11 WHIP and a .227 opponent batting average...made his last against the Red Sox on Aug. 13, 2025 at Daikin Park, where he allowed 1 run on 6 hits and 3 walks with 4 strikeouts in 6.2 innings.

2025 SEASON: was a workhorse out of the Astros 'pen in 2025, going 3-4-7 with a 2.28 ERA (18ER/71IP), a .196 opponent average (51x260), 1.15 WHIP and 13.31 SO/9IP in a team-leading 70 appearances...led AL relievers with 105 strikeouts.

CAREER: is on his 6th consecutive Opening Day roster (2021-26) and has appeared in the Majors with Houston in each of the last seven seasons (2019-25)...owns a 16-12 record with 16 saves, a 2.75 ERA (101ER/331IP) and 451 strikeouts in 331.0 Major League innings... among relievers in club history, ranks fourth in strikeouts (451), seventh in appearances (319) and 12th in innings (331.0).

OPENING DAY: made his 1st career Opening Day roster this season...pitched on Opening Day vs. LAA, tossing 2.1 innings of 1-run ball, allowing his only run on a solo homer by Mike Trout...dazzled hitters with an uptick in velocity, including throwing a 98.8 mph 4-seam fastball on a strikeout of Yoan Moncada...marked the hardest pitch thrown in his career.

SPRING TRAINING: was a non-roster invite at Astros Spring Training...made 1 appearance for the Astros on Feb. 22 vs. STL (1ER/0.2IP)...was reassigned to minor league camp on March 2.

ABOUT BOLTON: Right-handed reliever has pitched in each of the last 3 Major League seasons with the Pirates (2023), Mariners (2024) and Guardians (2025)...has combined to go 1-0 with a 5.79 ERA (27ER/42IP) in his 34 career appearances, all coming in relief...joined the Astros by signing a 2-year minor league contract on July 24, 2025...finished his 2025 season at Triple A Sugar Land.

LAST APPEARANCE: made his 3rd appearance of the season on Sunday vs. LAA and picked up the save after entering the game with 1 out and 2 runners on in the 9th...recorded both of his outs via the strikeout...marked his 3rd career save.

MILESTONE WATCH: his next appearance will mark the 100th of his career...since making his debut in 2024, he ranks third among Astros relievers in appearances, behind only RHP Bryan Abreu (150) and LHP Josh Hader (119)...is also 3.0 innings away from reaching 100.0 for his career.

SPRING TRAINING: posted a 5.40 ERA (3ER/5IP), with 6 strikeouts in 6 Spring Training games...held opponents to a .176 average.

2025 SEASON: appeared in a career-high 68 MLB games, notching a 2.78 ERA (21ER/68IP) with 69 strikeouts, a 1.04 WHIP and a .233 opponent average in 68.0 IP...also led AL relievers in walks-per-nine innings (1.46)...stranded 23 of his 24 inherited runners in 2025...stranded all of his first 23 inherited runners before allowing one to score in his final outing on Sept. 26 at LAA.
