THE TWINS: Completed their six-game roadtrip with a record of 3-3, going 1-2 in Cleveland last weekend, followed by a 2-1 series win in Detroit this week...tonight, the Twins will begin a short three-game homestand, with the first of three against the Royals through the weekend...after Sunday afternoon's series finale, Minnesota will travel to New York for a short three-game roadtrip with three games at Yankee Stadium from Monday-Wednesday.
✦ Twins seeking their first three-game winning streak tonight since June 25-27, when they took two vs. Seattle at Target Field, following by a win in Detroit.

TWINS BATS THROW DOWN IN MOTOWN: The Twins beat the Tigers on Wednesday afternoon at Comerica Park by a score of 9-4, winning the three-game series and recording back-to-back wins for the first time since July 11-12 vs. Pittsburgh...Pierson Ohl was the starter and was piggy-backed by Thomas Hatch, making his Twins debut...Hatch pitched 4.1 scoreless innings, with two hits allowed, one walk and three strikeouts...the offense recorded 11 hits and scored at least one run in six different innings...Brooks Lee hit his 11th home run of the season as Alan Roden and Austin Martin each hit their first home runs of the season, both the second of their respective careers.

TAMING THE TIGERS: Twins took two of three from the Tigers this week, losing game one on Monday by a score of 6-3, but winning games two and three by scores of 6-3 and 9-4...it marked their first series win post-All-Star break and first series win since taking two of three vs. Pittsburgh, from July 11-3...marked their first road series win since taking three of four, from June 2-5 at the Athletics.
✦ The pitching staff struck out 26 Tigers in 26.0 innings, while issuing just three walks.
✦ Twins homered eight times in the series and averaged 6.0 runs-per-game...eight home runs were their most in a series all season.
✦ They also struck out just 14 times over the three games, their fewest in a series all season.
✦ 15 extra-base hits in the series also most in a series for 2025.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed catcher Christian Vázquez on the 10-day Injured List with a left shoulder infection...Vázquez has played in 61 games for the Twins this season, hitting .174 (31-for-178) with seven doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI, 12 runs scored, 16 walks and a .251 on-base percentage...this marks Vázquez's first trip to the Injured List in three seasons with Minnesota.
✦ To replace Vázquez on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled catcher Jhonny Pereda from Triple-A St. Paul...Pereda, who was claimed off waivers from the Athletics on July 22, played in six games for the Saints, hitting .333 (7-for-21) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, three RBI, seven runs scored and four walks...the 29-year-old has appeared in 39 career major league games with the Miami Marlins (2024) and Athletics (2025), hitting .293 (16-for-79) with two doubles, seven RBI and six walks.

ROYALTY CHECK: The Twins are playing the eighth of 13 games against the Royals this season...Minnesota is 3-4 against the Royals, going 1-3 at Kauffman and 2-1 at Target Field.
✦ These two last met for three games at Target Field from May 23-25 as the Twins won games one and two but failed to sweep in game three.
✦ Twins are 20-4 in their last 24 home games against the Royals.
✦ Twins are 31-19 in their last 50 overall against the Royals, dating back to April of 2022.
✦ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 59-41 vs. Kansas City...59 wins are tied for his most against any opponent (Chicago-AL - 59-40).

KEA TO SUCCESS: Luke Keaschall has now hit safely in each of his first eight games with an at-bat to start his career...also has reached base safely in all nine...below are Twins (since 1961) best on-base streaks to begin their career (above) and best hitting streaks to begin their career (below):

COOL HANDS LUKE: Luke Keaschall has six extra-base hits (5 2B, 1 HR), five stolen bases and five walks in just nine career games...he is the first player in AL/NL history with 6+ XBH, 5+ SB and 5+ BB before their 10th career game.

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has hit safely in a season-high nine-straight games...his career-high is 14, done July 15-August 9, 2023...a hit tonight and Jeffers will be the second Twin with a double-digit hitting streak this season...the high for a Twin in 2025 was Brooks Lee's 19 (May 28-June 20).
✦ Over his last 21 games, Jeffers is hitting .355 (27-for-76) with seven doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, three walks, a .395 on-base percentage, a .526 slugging percentage and a .921 OPS.

HOUSTON, WE HAVE A SIGNING: Twins first round pick (16th overall) Marek Houston is in the building tonight, touring Target Field, taking BP, throwing out the first pitch, etc...Houston has already played in six games for the Low-A Fort Myers Mighty Mussels, hitting safely in all six, while hitting .370 (10-for-27) with one double, four RBI and two walks.
✦ The 6-foot-3, 205-pound infielder hit .354 (86-for-243) with 14 doubles, 15 home runs, 66 RBI, 46 walks, 19 stolen bases, 61 runs scored, a .458 on-base percentage and a 1.055 OPS in 61 games for Wake Forest in 2025, leading the team in hits, runs scored, home runs, RBI and total bases (145), while ranking tied for second in doubles and third in OPS...over three seasons at Wake Forest, Houston hit .302 (206-for-682) with 35 doubles, two triples, 27 home runs, 134 RBI, 118 walks, 27 stolen bases, 156 runs scored, a .409 on-base percentage and an .887 OPS.
✦ The Nokomis, FL native helped lead the Demon Deacons to the 2023 College World Series while playing in a program-record 65 games as a freshman...he was also a 2023 All-ACC Academic Team selection and a 2024 Third Team All-ACC selection, after hitting a team-best .326 (72-for-221) with 16 doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 39 RBI, four steals, 38 walks, 57 runs scored and a .949 OPS in 54 games.
