AT A GLANCE: The Yankees complete their homestand today with the final game of a rain-shortened series vs. Boston (0-1 thus far)...are 1-3 on the homestand after dropping two-of-three games vs. Cleveland and losing their series opener against Boston...their game on Saturday was rained out...after this homestand, will embark on a six-game road trip to Cleveland (Mon.-Wed.) and Toronto (6/12-14).

- ▶ Their 37-26 (.587) record is the second-best in the American League and the fifth-best record in the Majors.
- ▶ Are 7-4 in their last 11G (since 5/24) and 9-7 in their last 16G (since 5/18)...are 29-19 in their last 48G (since 4/13).
- ▶ The Yankees'+91 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the fourth-best in the Majors...have outscored their opponents, 66-40, over their last 11 games (since 5/24).

WHERE WE LEFT OFF: The Yankees fell to the Red Sox, 5-3, in their series opener on Friday at Yankee Stadium...LHP Ryan Weathers (6.0IP, 7H, 5R/ER, 1BB, 4K, 2HR, 1WP) started and suffered his fourth loss of the year...DH Ben Rice (2-for-3, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI, 1BB) reached base three times and hit his 18th home run of the season with a go-ahead solo shot in the first inning...RF Spencer Jones (3-for-3, 1 double, 1RBI) recorded a career-high 3H and hit an RBI double in the fourth inning...CF Trent Grisham (1-for-5, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI) hit his eighth HR of the year with a solo shot in the fifth inning...1B Paul Goldschmidt (0-for-4) had his season-high nine-game hitting streak snapped...Yankees relievers did not allow a hit over 3.0 scoreless innings...RHP Paul Blackburn (2.0IP, 2K) tossed 2.0 perfect innings of relief...RHP Camilo Doval (1.0IP, 2K) tossed a scoreless ninth inning, striking out 2-of-3BF.

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice reached base three times and hit his 18th home run of the season with a go-ahead solo shot in the first inning on Friday vs. Boston...eight of his 18HR this year have given the Yankees the lead, including five of his last 7HR and six of his last 9HR.

- ▶ 35 of his 64H this year have been XBH (15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR).
- ▶ Has hit .305/.398/.652 (64-for-210) with 47R, 15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR, 45RBI, 32BB/21BB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 58 games this season...has reached base safely in 45-of-54 starts.

GLOVE STORY: Yankees fielders have made only three errors over their last 17 games (since 5/17), posting a Major League-best .995 fielding percentage (3E/602TC) over that span.

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger is hitting .293/.388/.528 (36-for-123) with 19R, 10 doubles, 2 triples, 5HR, 26RBI, 21BB, 4SB and 3SF over his last 34 games (since 4/28).

- ▶ Since 5/1, is hitting .359/.422/.692 (14-for-39) with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 2HR and 5BB vs. left-handed pitching...as a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .330/.394/.576 (74-for-224) with 16 doubles, 3 triples, 11HR, 27BB and 1HP against left-handed pitching...ranks sixth in the Majors in OPS (.970, fifth in AL), eighth in BA (fifth in AL) and ninth in SLG (seventh in AL) over that stretch.
- ▶ Has hit .315/.382/.463 (17-for-54) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 26RBI, 9BB and 5SF with RISP this year.
- ▶ Has hit safely in 24-of-29 home games this year, batting .353/.440/.676 (36-for-102) with 19R, 11 doubles, 2 triples, 6HR, 26RBI, 19BB, 4SF and 3SB.
- ▶ According to FanGraphs and Sports Info Solutions, leads all Major Leaguers in DRS (15)...is tied for seventh in the Majors in go-ahead RBI (11, tied for fourth in AL).

GOOD AS GOLD: INF Paul Goldschmidt is batting .301/.368/.553 (31-for-103) with 17R, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 6HR, 20RBI, 9BB, 2HP and 1SB over his last 29 games (since 4/26).

- ▶ Has hit .385/.484/.808 (20-for-52) with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 5HR, 12RBI, 7BB and 3HP vs. left-handed pitching this season...ranks first in the Majors in OBP, SLG and OPS (1.292), fourth in BA (second in AL) and tied for fifth in XBH (11, first in AL).
- ▶ As a Yankee (since 2025), has batted .348/.430/.632 (70-for-201) with 19 doubles, 1 triple, 12HR, 24BB/51BB and 5HP vs. left-handed pitchers...ranks second in the Majors in BA (second in AL) and OPS (1.062, second in AL), third in SLG (third in AL) and sixth in OBP (fifth in AL).
- ▶ Has hit .375/.545/.708 (9-for-24) with 2 doubles, 2HR, 17RBI, 7BB and 2HP with RISP this season...as a Yankee (since 2025), has batted .323/.421/.451 (43-for-133) with 8 doubles, 3HR, 51RBI, 21BB/51BB, 3HP and 2SF with RISP.

MERRY GRISHMAS: OF Trent Grisham hit his eighth HR of the year with a solo shot in the fifth inning on Friday vs. Boston...has hit safely in 11 of his last 14 games (since 5/19), batting .346/.424/.538 (18-for-52) with 8R, 4 doubles, 2HR, 5RBI, 7BB and 1SB over that span.

- ▶ Has reached base multiple times in six of his last nine games (since 5/26) and nine of his last 14 games (since 5/19).

SCHLITTLER'S CREEK: RHP Cam Schlichter will make his 14th start of the season today...has gone 7-3 with a 1.89 ERA (76.1IP, 16ER) and 84K in 13 starts this year, holding opponents to a .191/.229/.285 (53-for-277) slash line.

- ▶ His 1.89 ERA is tied with Michael Pineda (also a 1.89 ERA in first 13GS in 2014) for the second-lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher through his first 13 starts of a season in the last 42 years (since 1985), trailing only Max Fried (1.78 ERA in first 13GS in 2025).
- ▶ Has allowed 3R-or-fewer in 12 of his 13 starts this season, including 1R-or-fewer in eight starts (including four scoreless starts)...his 12 starts of 3R-or-fewer are tied for the most in the AL and tied for the second-most in the Majors.
- ▶ Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in nine of his starts this season, including seven of his last nine starts (since 4/17)...his nine starts of 1ER-or-fewer are the most in the AL and tied for the most in the Majors.
- ▶ The Yankees are 9-4 in his starts...his nine team wins are tied for the sixth-most in the Majors this season (tied for fifth in AL).
- ▶ Has tossed at least 6.0IP in eight of his last 12 starts (since 4/1), including seven of his last nine starts (since 4/17).

TO THE LEFT, TO THE LEFT: The Yankees are 14-6 when facing a left-handed starter this season...have won 12 of their last 14 games when facing a left-handed starter (since 4/18) and 13 of their last 17 games (since 4/13).

FAST AND FURIOUS: Yankees baserunners have recorded 115B over their last five games (since 5/31)...their 62SB this season are the second-most in the AL and the fifth-most in the Majors.

- ▶ Their 62SB are their most through their first 63 games of a season in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) and most since recording 70SB in 2001...marks only the third time in the last 37 years (since 1990) the Yankees have recorded as many stolen bases through their first 63 games of a season (70SB in 2001 and 82SB in 1998).
- ▶ INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. (16SB) ranks sixth in the Majors in stolen bases and INF/OF José Caballero (15SB) is tied for seventh in the Majors...are only the fourth pair of Yankees teammates in the last 110 years (since 1917) to each record at least 15SB through the club's first 63 games of a season, joining Chuck Knoblauch (22SB) and Alfonso Soriano (18SB) in 2001, Rickey Henderson (23SB) and Steve Sax (17SB) in 1989, and Willie Randolph (23SB), Mickey Rivers (23SB) and Roy White (16SB) in 1976.

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 10 of their last 14 starts (since 5/20), posting a 2.82 ERA (83.0IP, 26ER) over that span...have allowed 1ER-or-fewer in eight of their last 13 starts (since 5/21).

- ▶ Have posted a 3.15 ERA (348.2IP, 122ER) and 339K in 63 starts this season...have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 51 starts this season, tied for the most in the AL and tied for the fourth-most in the Majors...marks their third-most in franchise history through their first 63 games of a season, trailing only their 55 starts in 2022 and 54 starts in 2024.
- ▶ Have tossed at least 6.0 innings in 11 of their last 14 starts.
- ▶ Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.336), rank second in ERA (3.15, first in AL), WHIP (1.10, first in AL), opponents' BA (.212, first in AL), opponents' OBP (.281, first in AL) and opponents' OPS (.617, first in AL), fifth in HR/9.0IP (0.90, second in AL), sixth in strikeout rate (23.9%, third in AL), seventh in innings pitched (348.2, fourth in AL) and BB/9.0IP (2.92, third in AL), and eighth in K/BB (3.00, fourth in AL) and strikeouts (339, fourth in AL).

ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. has hit .300 (6-for-20) with 1 double in his career vs. Boston's LHP Ranger Suarez.

- ▶ Is batting .309/.368/.529 (21-for-68) with 12R, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 3HR, 8RBI, 7BB, 1SF and 5SB over his last 18G (since 5/13).

SUPER ROSARIO: INF/OF Amed Rosario has gone 4-for-9 (.444) with 2HR and 1BB in his career vs. Boston's LHP Ranger Suarez...since 2025, has hit .287/.322/.500 (47-for-164) with 12 doubles, 1 triple, 7HR, 10BB and 3SF vs. left-handed pitchers.

- ▶ Has hit .296/.313/.630 (8-for-27) with 3HR, 14RBI, 2BB and 3SF with RISP this season.
- ▶ Over his last 15 games as a starter (since 4/18), has batted .288/.333/.558 (15-for-52) with 11R, 2 doubles, 4HR, 13RBI, 4BB and 1SF...has hit safely in nine of his last 12 starts (since 4/22).

MATCHING UP: The Yankees are 3-1 vs. Boston this season and 6-2 in their last eight games against the Red Sox (since 8/24/25).

- ▶ Yankees pitchers have posted a 1.75 ERA (36.0IP, 7ER) vs. Boston this year...have held the Red Sox to a .100/.143/.100 (2-for-20) slash line with RISP this season.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP CAM SCHLITTLER (7-3, 1.89 ERA)

RHP Cam Schlittler will make his 14th start of the season in today's series finale vs. Boston...the 25-year-old will pitch on regular four days' rest...made his 13th start of the season on Tuesday vs. Cleveland, recording the loss after allowing 5R/4ER over 4.1IP (5H, 0BB, 3K, 1HR, 1HP)...has gone 7-3 with a 1.89 ERA (76.1IP, 53H, 19R/16ER, 13BB, 84K, 4HR) in 13 starts this season...has also allowed 1ER-or-fewer in nine of his starts, including seven of his last nine starts (since 4/17)...made his first career Opening Day roster...**over his last 21 Major League starts (since 8/20/25), has gone 10-4 with a 2.03 ERA (119.2IP, 80H, 30R/27ER, 30BB, 138K, 6HR)**...saw his first Major League action in 2025 with the Yankees, going 4-3 with a 2.96 ERA (73.0IP, 58H, 24R/ER, 31BB, 84K, 8HR) in 14 starts...in 27 career Major League starts, has gone 11-6 with a 2.41 ERA (149.1IP, 111H, 43R/40ER, 44BB, 168K, 12HR)...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in 24-of-27 career starts, 2R-or-fewer in 20 starts and 1R-or-fewer in 15 starts...according to **Elias, his 2.41 ERA is the fourth-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through their first 27 career starts** (ignoring relief appearances and excluding openers), trailing only Stan Bahnsen (2.21 ERA in first 27 career starts from 1966-68), Bill Stafford (2.29 ERA in first 27 career starts from 1960-61) and Hank Thormahlen (2.37 ERA in his first 27 career starts from 1917-19)...**also marks the lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher whose first 27 career appearances were all starts and the fourth-lowest by a pitcher since 1913** (when ER became an official stat), trailing only Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (2.12 ERA), Miami's José Fernández (2.23 ERA) and New York-NL's Matt Harvey (2.25 ERA)...**his 168K through his first 27 career games are the third-most in franchise history**, trailing only Masahiro Tanaka (186K) and Orlando Hernández (169K)...**his 43R allowed are the fewest by a Yankees pitcher through their first 27 career starts**...**has posted a .204 opponents' BA over his first 27 career starts...according to Elias, marks the seventh-lowest opponents' BA by a Yankees pitcher through their first 27 career starts** (ignoring relief appearances), trailing only Tommy Byrne (.176), Luis Gil (.179), Al Downing (.184), Russ Ford (.187), Spec Shea (.196) and Dave Righetti (.203)...the Weymouth, Mass., native was selected by the Yankees in the seventh round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Northeastern University (Mass.).

LAST TIME OUT: Made his 13th start of the season on Tuesday vs. Cleveland, recording the loss after allowing 5R/4ER over 4.1IP (5H, 0BB, 3K, 1HR, 1HP)...his 5R marked a career high (his 4ER matched his career high - also 4ER on 9/5/25 vs. Toronto and 9/16/25 at Minnesota)...snapped his season-opening 13-start streak of 3R-or-fewer allowed.
 ✦ Allowed a two-run home run to Kyle Manzardo in the fourth inning...had not allowed a home run at Yankee Stadium in his previous nine starts from 8/13/25-5/20/26.

2026: In 13 starts this season, has gone 7-3 with a 1.89 ERA (76.1IP, 53H, 19R/16ER, 13BB, 84K, 4HR)...has held opponents to a .191/.229/.285 (53-for-277) slash line...**see Major League rankings at right.**

- ✦ **His 1.89 ERA is tied with Michael Pineda (also a 1.89 ERA in first 13GS in 2014) for the second-lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher through his first 13 starts of a season in the last 42 years (since 1985), trailing only Max Fried (1.78 ERA in first 13GS in 2025).**
- ✦ **Joins Ron Guidry (1.57 ERA and 86K in first 13GS in 1978) as the only two pitchers in franchise history to post a sub-2.00 ERA and record at least 80K through their first 13 starts of a season.**
- ✦ **Has allowed 3R-or-fewer in 12 of his 13 starts this season, including 1R-or-fewer in eight starts (including four scoreless starts)...**his 12 starts of 3R-or-fewer are tied for the most in the AL and tied for the second-most in the Majors...**had allowed 3R-or-fewer in each of his first 12 starts of the season from 3/27-5/26, tied for the fourth-longest streak in franchise history**, trailing only Clarke Schmidt's 15-start streak to begin the 2024 season, Ron Guidry's 15-start streak to begin the 1978 season and Jordan Montgomery's 13-start streak to begin the 2022 season (Jim Bouton also had a 12-start streak to begin the 1966 season).
