game road trip against the Yankees (2-1, 1 to play) and Blue Jays (3 to play) this afternoon
at Yankee StadiumTampa Bay closed the first half of the season winning seven of its
last eight series for the first time in franchise historythe Rays 16-10 (.615) mark since
June 19 is second best in MLB behind the Astros (19-7/.731)they are 4.5 games behind
the Royals for the AL's third and final Wild Card spotper Elias, Tampa Bay has the
second hardest remaining schedule in the majors with a combined opponent winning
nct of 523 trailing only Cleveland (525)

Yesterday, Tampa Bay moved above the .500 mark for the first time since entering play on July 5 (44-43).

The Rays have 4 HR in back-to-back games for the sixth time in franchise history (last: April 29-30, 2023 at CWS)...they became the first team in the majors to accomplish the feat this season (last: Texas, 2G from Sept. 24-25, 2023). It marked the ninth time since 1901 that a club has hit 4+ HR in consecutive games against the Yankees (last: BOS, 2 games from July 25-26, 2019)...the only team to do so in three straight games against New York was the 1977 Red Sox (June 17-19). Richie Palacios recorded his first career leadoff homer yesterday...Yandy Díaz had been responsible for the Rays previous eight leadoff homers...prior to Díaz, the last Ray with a leadoff homer was Jonathan Aranda on Sept. 22, 2022 vs. TOR. Tampa Bay allowed 4+ SB for the sixth time this season, its most since June 12 vs. CHC (65B)...marked the fifth time in franchise history the Rays allowed 4+ SB to the Yankees and was the most since Sept. 16, 2012 (also 4SB).

The Rays rotation carries an 11.1 scoreless inning streak into today's game.

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:
Improve to 8-1-0 in series play dating to June 20, earning series victories over the Twins, Pirates, Mariners, Nationals, Royals, Guardians and Yankees (2x).
Move multiple games over .500 for the first time since entering play on May 20 (25-23).
Win three straight games for the first time since June 23-25.
Claim the season series over the Yankees, 7-6...it would mark their second straight season series win (8-5 in 2023) and fourth in the last five seasons since 2020.

REHABBING RAYS—Yesterday, Drew Rasmussen threw a scoreless inning with one strikeout in the first appearance of his rehab stint with Triple-A Durham.

On Saturday, Jeffrey Springs tossed 3.0 innings in his 11th rehab appearance, earning his eighth with Durham...Springs tossed a season-high 4.2 innings in his start on July 14 at Charlotte.

BIRTHDAY BOY—Jose Siri celebrates his 29th birthday today...playing on his birthday for the first time last season, Siri went 2-for-4 with a double and run vs. BAL...the last Ray to homer on their birthday was Christian Bethancourt last year (Sept. 2 at CLE).

RANDY LAND—Randy Arozarena is slashing .462/.462/1.308 (6-for-13) with 2 2B, 3 HR and 4 RBI during the current series...yesterday marked his 11th time homering in consecutive games, including the second this season (March 30-31)...he has never homered in three straight...his five extra-base hits this series are the most by a Ray since Manuel Margot (5) from June 12-15, 2023 at Oakland...the club record for a single series is six extra-base hits, held by four players (8x), most recently accomplished by Evan Longoria from May 6-9, 2013 vs. Toronto.

His 3 HR are the most by a Ray in a single series (3 or 4 games) since Luke Raley (3HR) during a four-game set at CWS from April 27-30, 2023...the last Ray with more home runs during a single series was Isaac Paredes (4HR) during a three-game home set against the Yankees from June 20-22, 2022.

He has reached base safely in 27 of his last 29 games since June 14, including hits in 25 of those contests, slashing .305/.393/.590 (32-for-105) with 9 2B, 7 HR, 15 RBI, 11 BB and 7 SB.

Arozarena has hit safely 20 of his last 22 road games since June 1, batting .342 (26-for-

11 BB and 7 SB.

Arozarena has hit safely 20 of his last 22 road games since June 1, batting .342 (26-for-76)...his 1.132 road OPS over that timeframe ranks fourth in MLB (min. 75PA) behind HOU Yordan Alvarez (1.423), NYY Aaron Judge (1.268) and NYY Juan Soto (1.178). Arozarena has 21 total bases against the Yankees in four games since July 11...he is the first player with 21+ total bases against the New York in a four-game period within a single season since Brandon Lowe (21TB) from July 27-Oct. 2, 2021. He is the first Ray with 1+ XBH in four straight games against the Yankees since Austin Meadows (4G, May 12-June 1, 2021)...with an extra-base hit today, he would match the franchise record, joining James Loney (2013-14), Evan Longoria (2x, 2013 & 2009) and Rocco Baldelli (2006).

LEFT SIDE, STRONG SIDE—The Rays are 17-8 (.680) against left-handed starters this season, the third-best clip in MLB behind the Guardians (20-6/.769) and Dodgers (25-10/.714).

Amed Rosario is batting .356 (16-for-45) with 6 2B off southaws since May 30, the third-highest mark in the AL (min. 40AB) behind CLE José Ramírez (.422) and CLE Steven Kwan (.388)...Randy Arozarena ranks fourth with a .349 (15-for-43) clip.

Isaac Paredes is slashing .351/.442/.730 (13-for-37) with 3 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 12 RBI and 6 BB vs. left-handers since June 4.

Jose Siri is 9-for-26 (.346) with 3 2B, 1 HR and 3 RBI vs. LHP since June 14...during that same stretch, he is 14-for-72 (.194) with 2 2B, 5 HR and 8 RBI vs. RHP.

Curtis Mead is a career .328 (21-for-64) hitter vs. southpaws compared to .198 (22-for-111) against righties.

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays own MLB's best record in games decided by two runs or fewer at 35-16 (.686)...their 17-9 (.654) mark in one-run games ranks third behind the Red Sox (12-6/.667) and Mets (19-10/.655).

Tampa Bay is also an MLB-best 19-10 (.655) in games decided by two runs or fewer on the road, including wins in 12 of its last 16 such contests.

RUNNIN' RAYS—The Rays have stolen a base in nine straight games, the longest active run in the majors...it matches their season-long streak from Opening Day-April 6...within a single season, they last stole a base in 10+ games from May 24–June 4, 2023 (11G)...they have stolen at least one bag in 14 of 15 games this month, going 18-for-23 (78.2%).

Josh Lowe's 8 SB since June 23 are tied for the AL lead with CWS Luis Robert Jr. and are tied for third most in MLB behind CIN Elly De La Cruz (11SB) and WSH Lane Thomas (9SB).

José Caballero, whose 25 SB are tied for the AL lead with BOS David Hamilton, joined Carl Crawford (2009, 2004) as the only Rays to lead the AL in steals at the All-Star break.

The Rays stole an AL-best 95 bags before the break, besting the Red Sox (88SB)... Tampa Bay paced the AL in steals at the break for the second straight season, accomplishing the feat for the second time in franchise history, joining 2008-09... according to Elias, the Rays are the first AL club to have the most steals before the break in consecutive seasons since the Astros in 2015-16.

RISP. BUT NO REWARD—Since July 5, the Rays are batting an MLB-worst .113 (11-for-97) with runners in scoring position...on the season, Tampa Bay's .222 RISP AVG is second lowest in the majors, ahead of only Chicago-AL (.210).

Tampa Bay's .222 RISP AVG would signal the lowest single-season mark in franchise history, surpassing the mark held by the 2011 Rays (.224).

TODAY'S START—The right-hander will take the mound for his team-leading 20th start and 10th on the road...is 1-4 with a 5.24 ERA (56.2IP, 33ER) in his last 11 starts (2-2/3.02 in first 8GS)...has allowed two runs or fewer in four of his last five starts. Leads the Rays with seven quality starts, but has not tossed one on the road since June 2 at BAL...is 1-2 with an 8.44 ERA (16.0IP, 15ER) and .361 (26-for-72) opp. average in his last four road starts.

LAST TIME OUT-Took a no-decision in the Rays 4-2 home loss to the Guardians on July 13 (6.0IP, 6H, 2R, 1ER, 2BB, 3SO)...held Cleveland scorele through four frames after escaping a no-out, 2nd and 3rd jam in the 4th (SO, line out, fly out)...both of his runs allowed came in the 5th: an **Angel** Martínez solo HR and Andrés Giménez RBI-single...stranded multiple baserunners in 4 of his 6 innings (1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th), holding Cleveland to 1-for-9 with RISP...has a 3.05 ERA (41.1IP, 14ER) in his last seven home starts. YANKEE DOODLE—Littell is set for his third career start opposite New York, including his first at Yankee Stadium...he earned the win in each of his previous two outings, most recently on May 11 at Tropicana Field in a 7-2 Rays triumph (5.2IP, 4H, 2ER, 2BB, 3SO)...Littell has limited Yankees hitters to a .190 (8-for-42) average, but has permitted 3 HR (2.31 HR/9.0 IP)... today, he looks to become the first pitcher to earn a win in each of his first three career starts against the Yankees since ATL Max Fried (2020-pres.)... Chris Archer (4GS, 2013-14) is the only Ray to turn the trick.

The Yankees are batting .199 (101-for-508) against sliders, 28th in the majors...Littell's slider is his most thrown pitch (35.8% usage rate).

Littell is 2-1 with a 3.67 ERA (34.1IP, 14ER) in six starts against AL East opponents...his last two have been quality (June 2 at BAL; June 9 vs.

opponents...his last two have been quality (June 2 at BAL; June 9 vs. BAL)...he has permitted three runs or fewer in five of the six starts.

FIRST HALF RUNDOWN—Littell led the Rays in pre-All-Star break starts (19), innings (101.1) and strikeouts (T1st, 94)...yielded an AL-most 120 hits, most by a Ray before the All-Star break since David Price (137) in 2014... opened the season going 2-2 with a 3.02 ERA (44.2IP, 15ER) in his first eight starts, permitting two runs or fewer in six of them...has gone 1-4 with a 5.24 ERA (56.2IP, 33ER) in 11 starts since...excluding his starts on June 14 at Atlanta (6ER) and July 7 at Texas (7ER), he has recorded a 3.30 ERA (95.1IP, 195.1) his other 17 outlines.

He issued a walk in 10 of his final 11 starts leading into the break, but finished the first half ranking eighth in MLB with 1.69 walks per 9.0 IP.

WELL-RESTED—Littell will be starting on eight days' rest, with his last outing coming on July 13...according to STATS LLC, he is 3-3 with a 2.42 ERA (63.1IP, 17ER) in 11 starts with 5+ days of rest...he has allowed three runs or fewer in each of those outings, recording six of his seven quality starts...this, compared to his 0-3 record and 7.11 ERA (38.0IP, 30ER) across eight starts on four days' rest.

Littell will be starting on 5+ days' rest in consecutive outings for the first time since a three-start stretch from April 28-May 11...he posted a 2.55 ERA (17.2IP, 5ER) in those games.

PINPOINT PRECISION—Littell's 4.3 pct. walk rate ranks fourth in the AL/sixth in the majors...among AL hurlers, he trails SEA George Kirby (2.6%), Zach Eflin (3.0%) and MIN Joe Ryan (3.9%)...he has thrown 53.4 pct. of his pitches in the strike zone, the eighth-highest mark in the AL...according to Elias, his free pass to NYY Anthony Rizzo on May 11 snapped a 123 BF streak without a walk, fourth longest in Rays history behind Zach Eflin (165BF, 2024), Corey Kluber (150BF, 2022) and David Price (124BF, 2013)... from April 17–May 4, Littell recorded 6+ SO without issuing a walk in a club-record 4 straight starts.

A LITTELL HELP?—He has received two runs of support or fewer in 15 of his 19 starts, including 10 straight...his 2.96 run support average during the streak (since May 21) is fourth lowest in the AL (min. 40.0IP)...Littell has carried the load in Rays victories, pitching to a 2.81 ERA (48.0IP, 15ER) in wins (9) and a 5.57 ERA (53.1IP, 33ER) in losses (10).

He has departed a start in line for the win just once in his last 10 grapes when he garrend a victory on Lyly 2 of Kanaga City.

SLOW AND STEADY—Littell throws offspeed/breaking pitches 64.0 pct. of the time...his 36.0 pct. fastball usage rate is fourth lowest in MLB (min. 1,000 pitches thrown), higher than only DET Kenta Maeda (31.8%), BOS Tanner Houck (32.2%) and LAA Patrick Sandoval (33.4%)...Littell's slider has been his most effective pitch—opponents are hitting 6-for-28 (.214) with a .250 slugging pct. and 6 SO against it over his three starts in July.
