NATIONALS NEWS

WELCOME HOME

Following another winning road trip and a day off on Thursday, the Washington Nationals open their longest homestand of the season on Friday night against the Pittsburgh Pirates...This nine-game homestand features three-game series against the Pirates, Houston Astros and New York Yankees.

- Washington is 34-27 (.557) since April 25, the sixth-best mark in Major League Baseball over this stretch and are 11-3-1 in their last 15 series since May 12.

PITCHING IN

Washington's starting rotation (regardless of opener) has pitched to a 2.43 ERA (15 ER/55.2 IP) over the last 11 games...They've combined for 67 strikeouts, just nine walks and only six home runs allowed.

- Foster Griffin** - who ranks ninth in the NL with a 2.93 season ERA - has allowed just one earned run in 14.1 innings (0.63 ERA) with 18 strikeouts and two walks in two starts during this stretch.
- Cade Cavalli** has 20 strikeouts and just one walk to go along with a 1.38 ERA (2 ER/13.0 IP) in his last two starts.
- Andrew Alvarez** is 1-1 with 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP) and 17 strikeouts with four walks during this stretch.
- Zack Littell** tossed 5.0 innings of two-run ball on June 28 vs. Baltimore to earn his seventh win of the season.
- Miles Mikolas** has not issued a walk over his last two starts (10.1 IP).

JAMES WOOD LUMBER COMPANY

James Wood is 7-for-16 (.438) with a double, two homers, six RBI, four walks and five runs scored over his last four games...He's reached safely in seven of his last 10 plate appearances (5 H, 2 BB).

- In addition to his league rankings found in the box to the right, Wood is the only player in baseball with at least 20 home runs and at least 10 stolen bases this season.

RBI MACHINES

CJ Abrams (T3rd, 60) and **Luis García Jr.** (5th, 59) each rank at the top of the National League in RBI.

- Abrams is looking to top **James Wood's** Nationals record (2005-pres.) of 69 RBI prior to the 2025 All-Star break...Wood recorded 69 RBI in 95 games before the break last season.
- García Jr. leads all of Major League Baseball with 37 RBI since May 24.

SPEAKING OF LUIS...

Reigning National League Player of the Week **Luis García Jr.** ranks fourth in the NL in slugging percentage (.537).

- He is 10-for-20 (.500) with three doubles, three homers, 10 RBI, one walk, just one strikeout and five runs scored in his last five games.

HOMER HAPPY

The Nationals rank second in Major League Baseball with 80 home runs since May 6, behind the Phillies (81) and ahead of the White Sox (76)...Washington ranks second in slugging (.454) and in OPS (.777) over this stretch.

- The Nationals have hit 117 home runs this season, the fourth-most in team history (2005-pres.) through 88 games behind the 2017 Nationals (125 HR), 2019 Nationals (123 HR) and 2016 Nationals (122 HR).

GOING RIGHT AGAINST LEFT

The Nationals lead Major League Baseball in OPS (.783) and are second in on-base percentage (.347) and batting average (.269) against left-handed pitching this season.

- Washington is 18-11 (.621) against left-handed starters, the sixth-best winning percentage in MLB

NAS (H)IM

Nasim Nuñez is 18-for-50 (.360) with a double, two triples, one home run, eight RBI, eight walks, seven stolen bases and 10 runs scored over his last 17 games.

- On the season, he leads Major League Baseball with 32 stolen bases and trails only **Trea Turner** (35 in 2017) for the most stolen bases prior to the All-Star break in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

ROLLIN' RUIZ

Keibert Ruiz leads Major League catchers (min. 120 PA) with a .345 batting average, is second with a .955 OPS and a .575 slugging percentage in 33 games since May 7.

- He's hitting .345 with 11 doubles, five home runs, 24 RBI, six walks, two stolen bases and 22 runs since that date.

CREWSIN'

Dylan Crews is hitting .333 (16-for-48) with three doubles, a homer, three RBI, four walks, one hit by pitch, three stolen bases and nine runs scored over his last 12 games...He's hit safely in nine of the 12...He has a .396 on-base percentage and a .458 slugging percentage over this stretch.

- Crews has nine infield hits this season, tied for third-most on the club despite playing in just 38 games so far and tied for fifth-most in MLB since he was recalled on May 19.

SAVES ON SAVES

The Washington Nationals have had 10 separate pitchers record at least one save this season, second-most in Major League Baseball behind the Minnesota Twins (11) and Cincinnati Reds (11) and the second-most in Nationals history (2005-pres.) behind the 2017 Nationals (11).

- Clayton Beeter** (6), **Gus Varland** (6), **Richard Lovelady** (4), **PJ Poulin** (3), **Orlando Ribalta** (2), **Andrew Alvarez** (1), **Brad Lord** (1), **Mitchell Parker** (1), **Paxton Schultz** (1) and **Justin Lawrence** (1) have all recorded saves.

CAREER

Lefty starter returns to Major League Baseball after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball...Was a first-round pick by the Kansas City Royals in 2014 and their Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017.

- Made his Major League debut with Kansas City on July 27, 2020, his 25th birthday.
- Became the third pitcher since at least 1901 to earn the win in his MLB debut on his birthday, joining Edwin Jackson (9/9/03 at ARI) and Zach Day (6/15/02 at MON).

LAST START

Griffin tossed 7.0 innings of three-hit, shutout ball with nine strikeouts and no walks in Washington's 4-3 win on June 27 at Baltimore.

- It was his second consecutive start of at least 7.0 innings...Over these last two starts, he's allowed just one earned run in 14.1 innings (0.63 ERA) with 18 strikeouts against just two walks.

vs. PITTSBURGH

Griffin is set to make his second career appearance against the Pittsburgh Pirates...He allowed four earned runs on eight hits and a walk with seven strikeouts in his first appearance against Pittsburgh on April 16 at PNC Park.

REGENCY BIAS

Over his last five starts, Griffin is 2-0 with a 1.15 ERA (4 ER/31.1 IP) with 33 strikeouts and just four walks...Left-handed batters are 4-for-33 (.121) with 14 strikeouts and zero walks over this stretch of games.

RANKINGS

Griffin ranks among National League pitchers in winning percentage (4th, .800), WHIP (5th, 1.04), opponents' average (6th, .210), opponents' on-base percentage (6th, .210), strikeouts to walk ratio (8th, 3.92), innings pitched (8th, 98.1), ERA (9th, 2.93) and walks allowed per nine innings (10th, 2.29).

SPEAKING OF LEFTIES...

Griffin has held opposing left-handed batters to a .160 batting average (17-for-106) with 35 strikeouts and just six walks...His four-seam fastball (.053), sweep (.125) and sinker (.188) have been particularly tough on left-handed hitters this year...In three starts from April 26 to May 8, lefties went 1-for-20 (.050) with six strikeouts and three walks against him.

TECHNICALLY, HE'S A ROOKIE

Although he spent three seasons in Japan, Griffin still qualifies as a rookie...Because of that, he ranks among qualified National League rookie pitchers in wins (1st, 8), starts (1st, 17), WHIP (1st, 1.04), innings pitched (2nd, 98.1), ERA (2nd, 2.93), opponents' average (2nd, .210) and strikeouts (3rd, 98)

KEEPING IT 100

Griffin has tossed at least 100 pitches in four consecutive starts, the longest active streak in Major League Baseball and the second-longest streak this season behind **Paul Skenes** (5) and **Chris Sale** (5).

- It's the longest streak in Nationals history since **Max Scherzer** capped the 2020 season with five straight starts of at least 100 pitches.
