**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**APRIL 13**  
**1975** - The Astros retire the No. 40 worn by **RHP Don Wilson**..Wilson compiled a 103-92 record in nine seasons with the Astros, posting a 3.15 ERA with 78 complete games and 20 shutouts...he was named to the NL All-Star team and named the Astros Team MVP in 1971..Wilson is also the only pitcher to throw two no-hitters in Astros history.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Astros will look stop a seven-game losing streak this afternoon as they play their final game of a 10-game road trip...**RHP Mike Burrows** will be on the mound for the Astros, opposite **RHP George Kirby** and the Mariners.

**TODAY'S ASTROS STARTER:** **RHP Mike Burrows** is set to make his fourth start of the season...in his last start on Tuesday, April 7 at COL, he allowed three runs on eight hits and one walk with three strikeouts in 5.1 innings...was acquired from the Pirates this offseason as part of a three-team, six-player trade in which the Astros sent **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays, while the Rays sent **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates...Burrows impressed this Spring, making five starts and posting a 1.50 ERA (3ER/18IP) while allowing a .200 opponent batting average with 17 strikeouts.

**SUSTAINED SUCCESS:** Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 12 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and posted the second-most wins in the Majors (982), trailing only the Dodgers (1,047).

**NEW FACES:** The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing **RHP Mike Burrows** and **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** in trades and **RHP Tatsuya Imai** and **RHP Ryan Weiss** off the international free agent market.

**AT THE HELM:** Manager **Joe Espada** is in his third season as the Astros skipper...in 2025, for the second consecutive season, Espada and his staff were forced to deal with an extremely high number of injuries...despite an ever-changing roster that often was missing key players, to his credit, Espada managed to navigate his club to an 87-75 record, finishing in a tie for the final AL Wild Card berth (lost tiebreaker to DET).

**UPCOMING HOMESTAND:** Following today's game in Seattle...the Astros will host the Colorado Rockies (three games) and St. Louis Cardinals (three games) for a six-game homestand...the Astros went 31-17 in Interleague play in 2025.

**ROAD TRIP:** Today is the final game of a 10-game road trip for the Astros...the Astros are 1-8 so far on this road trip...Houston went 41-40 on the road last season.

**AGAINST THE MARINERS:** The Astros and Mariners face each other today for the fourth of 13 scheduled matchups in 2026...the Astros went 5-8 against the Mariners in 2025, including 2-4 record at T-Mobile Park...Houston owns a 132-100 all-time regular season record against Seattle...the Mariners will travel to Daikin Park for the first of two road trips to Houston from May 11-14 for a four-game series.

**BOLTON INJURY:** Astros **RHP Cody Bolton** left yesterday's game at Seattle due to mid-back tightness.

**TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES:** The Houston Astros have made the following roster moves: placed **IF Jeremy Peña** on the 10-day IL due to a grade one hamstring strain (retro 4/12) and placed **RHP Tatsuya Imai** on the 15-day IL due to right arm fatigue (retro 4/12)...the Astros also optioned **RHP Jayden Murray** to Triple A Sugar Land following yesterday's game...to take their places on the active roster, the Astros have recalled **RHP J.P. France**, **LHP Colton Gordon** and **IF Shay Whitcomb** from Triple A Sugar Land.

**YESTERDAY'S GAME:** The Houston were defeated by the Seattle Mariners yesterday, 1-6 at T-Mobile Park...**RHP Cody Bolton** (1.0 IP, 1 H, 2 ER, 4 BB, 1 K) made the start for the Astros but left the game due to injury in the second inning...**2B Jose Altuve** (3x4, 2B), **3B Isaac Paredes** (1x4) and **C Yainer Diaz** (1x3, HR, RBI) each recorded a hit for the Astros yesterday.

**OFFENSIVE FIREWORKS:** The Astros lead the American League in runs (93), doubles (42), total bases (251), hits (152), SLG (.454), OBP (.369) and OPS (.823)...individually, **2B Jose Altuve** and **IF Carlos Correa** rank tied for fifth in the AL in runs (12)...**1B Christian Walker** ranks third in the AL in doubles (6) and fifth in RBI (13).

**TUVE VS. THE MARINERS:** **2B Jose Altuve** has hit .313 (246x787) with 49 doubles, 21 homers, 96 RBI and a .832 OPS in 193 career games against the Mariners...he already ranks third all-time in hits vs. SEA, trailing only **Cal Ripken Jr.** (261) and **Michael Young** (259), and ranks eighth all-time in games played vs. the Mariners.

**MOVIN' ON UP:** **LF Yordan Alvarez** recorded his 175th career home run on Fri. night at SEA...the home run moved into sole possession of seventh place on the Astros all-time home run list, passing franchise icon **OF George Springer**...next up on the Astros all-time list is **3B Alex Bregman** (191 HR).

**AIR YORDAN:** This season, **LF Yordan Alvarez** is batting .340 (18x53) with 12 runs, four doubles, six home runs, 14 RBI, 15 walks, and a 1.255 OPS (.500 OBP/.755 SLG)...in the Majors, he ranks tied for first in OBP, tied for first in walks, second in OPS, second in SLG, second in home runs and tied for fifth in RBI.

**YORDAN'S CYCLE:** On July 21, 2024 at Seattle, **DH Yordan Alvarez** recorded his first career cycle and the 10th cycle in Astros franchise history...it was the second cycle in T-Mobile Park history (also, **Miguel Tejada** on Sept. 29, 2001)...it was also the first cycle by an Astros left-handed hitter since **Luke Scott** hit for the cycle on July 28, 2006 vs. ARI...he also became the only DH to hit for the cycle in Astros history and ninth in MLB history (last, **Jake Bauers** on June 14, 2019).

**LAST START, APRIL 7 AT COL:** surrendered 3 runs on 8 hits and a walk across 5.1 innings with 3 strikeouts...tossed 87 pitches, including 58 for strikes...suffered the loss in a 5-1 Astros defeat.

**ABOUT BURROWS:** right-handed starter is in his first full Major League season...was acquired by the Astros via trade this offseason and performed so well in Spring Training that he began the year as the Astros No. 2 starter.

**SEASON DEBUT:** made his Astros and season debut in the Astros' second game of the season on March 27 vs. LAA (5ER/5.2IP)...tossed a career-high 94 pitches in the start, surpassing his previous high of 91 pitches from July 30, 2025 vs. SF as a member of the Pirates.

**SPRING TRAINING:** had a phenomenal Spring, posting a 1.50 ERA (3ER/18IP), a .200 opponent batting average, 1.06 WHIP and 17 strikeouts in 5 starts.

**VS. THE MARINERS:** making his second career start against the Mariners, his first as a member of the Astros...in his previous start against the Mariners as a Pirate on July 5, 2025 at SEA, he spun 5.0 shutout innings, giving up 3 hits and 4 walks with 6 strikeouts (85 pitches-53 strikes)...held **SEA Julio Rodriguez** and **Randy Arozarena** hitless on his night.

**THE TRADE:** after spending eight seasons (2018-25) in the Pirates organization, the Astros acquired Burrows this offseason in a 3-team, 6-player trade...as part of the deal, the Astros traded **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays...meanwhile, the Rays traded **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates, and Burrows got dealt to the Astros.

**2025 RECAP:** pitched most of the season with the Pirates, making 23 appearances (19 starts) and going 2-4 with a 3.94 ERA (42ER/96IP)...struck out 97 hitters in 96.0 IP...had two Major League stints on the year, from April 24-25 and from May 21 thru the end of the year...recorded a strong second half with the Pirates, posting a 3.27 ERA (20ER/55IP) in 13 games (10 starts)...in that span, allowed 1-or-fewer runs in 7 of his last 8 appearances, posting a 2.22 ERA (7ER/28.1IP) in those games, which spanned from Aug. 16 thru the end of the year...did not allow a homer over a 26.1-inning span from Aug. 16-Sept. 21...finished tied for third in the NL in strikeouts by a rookie (97).

**THE JOURNEY:** a native of Waterford, CT, Burrows was committed to the University of Connecticut out of high school...the Pirates selected him in the 11th round of the June 2018 draft and signed him to an over-slot bonus to sign and forgo his commitment to UConn...spent 6 seasons (2018-23) in the Pirates minor league system before finally debuting in 2024 with a single appearance...pitched the majority of the 2025 season at the Major League level and flashed potential before the Pirates flipped him to Houston this offseason.

**CONNECTICUT CONNECTION:** Burrows is in a small fraternity of Major Leaguers from Connecticut...only four other Connecticuter's have played for the Astros in their franchise history: **C Brad Ausmus** (1259g), **OF George Springer** (795g), **RHP Bill Dawley** (157g) and **RHP Josh Zeid** (48g).
