BIRD WATCHING: The Cardinals continue their penultimate homestand of the season tonight (1-2 vs. BAL, PIT-3) with the series opener of a three-game divisional series against the Pittsburgh Pirates...the Cardinals avoided a series sweep by Baltimore yesterday afternoon with a 7-5 win that snapped their season-high 5 game losing streak...the Cardinals and Pirates have six head-to-head games remaining in the regular season...including tonight's game, the Cardinals have 27 regular season games remaining with 12 at home & 15 on the road.

DIVISION MATH: With a 22-21 mark in NL Central games, the Cardinals have matched the Milwaukee Brewers (22-11) for the most inter-division wins in 2026 followed by the Pirates (20-20), Cubs (19-17) and Reds (13-27)...the Cardinals are the all-time leaders in NL Central wins (1994-present) with a 1241-1029 mark - 101 wins more than the Cubs (1140-1139) who are the next closest...Pittsburgh is 1002-1275 all-time in NL Central games. **SIX PACKS:** The Cardinals six remaining games against the Pirates are their most against a single opponent along with their six upcoming games against the San Francisco Giants whom they have yet to play this season.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis entered play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 16.5 games behind 1st place Milwaukee; 2.0 games ahead of 4th place Pittsburgh and 5.5 games out of the final National League Wild Card position...the Cardinals are 3-7 in their last 10 games, 10-10 in last 20 and 14-16 in last 30...they are 35-38 vs. teams that are currently .500 or better and 32-30 vs. the sub .500 teams.

JORDAN ON INJURED LIST/SAGGESE RECALLED: The Cardinals placed INF **Blaze Jordan** (left ankle sprain) on the 10-day Injured List today and recalled INF **Thomas Saggese** (#25) from Memphis (AAA)...Saggese has appeared in 32 games for the Cardinals this season and was batting .258 with 10 HR & 33 RBI in 55 games for Memphis...Jordan keyed the Cardinals 7-5 win yesterday with a 3-run HR in the 2nd inning, his 1st career HR at Busch Stadium.

SO THIS IS ST. LOUIS: After making three consecutive road starts (at TOR, at CIN, at PHI) to begin his career, **Quinn Mathews** makes his Busch Stadium debut tonight...Mathews was the first Cardinals pitcher (6th all-time) to make his first three career starts on the road, with the last to do so being **Howie Pollet** in 1941. - *Elias*

STILL STREAKING: **Alec Burleson** extended his hitting streak to 13 games yesterday, the longest active hit streak in MLB...Burly is batting .367 (18-49) during the streak with 15 RBI & 13 runs scored...Burleson enters the weekend series with a 7-game hitting streak against the Pirates (.500; 13-26) including 2 HR & 9 RBI...he hit in a career & ream-best 17 straight games earlier this season (May 30-June 17)...the **Cardinals** have hit home runs in a season high 10-straight games, the longest active streak in the NL and their first 10-game HR streak since 2022.

BACKYARD BALLER: Mars, PA native & West Virginia Univ. alum **JJ Wetherholt** is batting .357 (10-28) with 3 HR & 1.223 OPS against Pittsburgh to begin his career with hits in 6 of 7 games...JJ has already established Cardinals rookie records with 17 HR as a lead-off batter & 15 HR as rookie 2Bman...he's 2 HR shy of matching **Johnny Mize** (19 in 1936) for 2nd all-time among Cardinals left-handed hitting rookies with **Chris Duncan** (22 in 2006) holding the franchise record for rookie LHB's.

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

JJ Wetherholt graduated from Mars Area (Pa.) High School and resides in Gibsonia, Pa., but was born in Baltimore, Md., and grew up a fan of the Baltimore Ravens...played college baseball at West Virginia University (2022-24).

Riley O'Brien's great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58)...his grandfather **Johnny O'Brien**, played part of four seasons with the Pirates (1953, 1955-57).

Brant Brown played in 130 games for the Pirates in 1999 before being traded to the Marlins for OF **Bruce Aven** (Dec. 13, 1999)...traded by the Cubs to Pittsburgh for RHP **Jon Lieber** (Dec. 14, 1998).

Justin Bruihl pitched in seven games for the Pirates in 2024.

Andre Pallante (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC) and Special Asst. to President of Baseball Ops. **Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004 at PNC) made MLB debuts vs. Pittsburgh.

Caleb Ferguson pitched in 45 games for the Pirates in 2025 before traded to Seattle for RHP Jeter Martinez (July 30, 2025).

Peter Strzelecki pitched in 16 games (1 start) for Indianapolis (AAA-Pirates) in 2025.

Nathan Church (2018) & **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, CA.

Nick Yorke made his MLB debut at St.x Louis on Sept. 16, 2024.

Luke Weaver was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (No. 27) of the 2014 MLB Draft...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2016-18) before packaged in a trade to Arizona for **Paul Goldschmidt** (Dec. 5, 2018)...2016 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

Pirates Dir. of Hitting Development **Tim McKee**...grandfather, **Jerry McKeithan Sr.**, played in the St. Louis minor league system, and his brother, **Aaron McKeithan**, was selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Manager **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Hunter Dobbins and **Mason Montgomery** were teammates at Texas Tech from 2019-20.

2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame Inductee **Bill Sherdel** made his MLB debut with St. Louis on April 22, 1918 vs. Pittsburgh.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER:

- Making his 4th career start, but first at Busch Stadium.
- Became the first Cardinals pitcher (6th all-time) to make his first three starts of the road. Most recent was **Howie Pollet** (Aug. 20-28, 1941). - *Elias Sports Bureau*
- Previously had been appointed the 27th player in each of his first three starts. Tonight is his first start after remaining on the roster.
- His 28.3% "Hard Hit" percentage is 2nd-lowest on the staff behind **Luis Gastelum** (25.4).
- Looking for his first Major League win.
- Cardinals 4th round draft pick out of Stanford University in 2023. Originally selected by the Rays in the 19th round in the 2022 MLB Draft.
- 2024 Cardinals and Baseball America Minor League Pitcher of the Year.
- Led the 2026 International League in strikeouts (111) and opponent BA (.170); and ranked in the Top 10 in ERA (3.13, 2nd), games started (19, 2nd), innings pitched (92.0, 5th) and WHIP (1.14, 4th) when he was first called up (Aug. 1).
- Since the beginning of 2024, ranks 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball with 437 strikeouts, trailing only the Mets **Jonah Tong** (457). Ranks 4th in qualifying ERA (3.19).
- Led all of Minor League Baseball with 202 strikeouts in 2024, T-7th most in a single season by any Cardinals minor league pitcher (since 1962).

LAST TIME OUT (Saturday, August 23 at Philadelphia): L, 12-3; 5.0 IP, 10 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO - 99 pitches

- Set single-game highs in hits (10), runs (7), and pitches (99) in a 12-3 loss at Philadelphia.
- Received 2 runs or fewer in all three starts.

2026 SEASON:

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Became the first Cardinals pitcher (6th all-time) to make his first three starts of the road. Previous was Howie Pollet in 1941 (Aug. 20-28). - *Elias Sports Bureau*

OH, CANADA!: Was the first Cards starting pitcher to make his Major League debut in Canada since **Rick Ankiel** on August 23, 1999 at Montreal's Olympic Stadium vs. the Expos.

HATCHED: Became the 8th Cardinal and 5th Cardinals pitcher to make his debut this season.

WALKING IN MEMPHIS: Began the season in the Memphis (AAA) rotation.

BULL-YING DURHAM: Struck out a season-high 10 batters over 7.0 innings in a 7-3 Redbirds win vs. Durham (7/24) the start before his MLB debut.

SUMMER LOVING: Since May 28, has a 4-1 record with a 1.99 ERA and 76 strikeouts over 63.1 innings pitched (10.8 K/9 IP) including a 1.01 WHIP.

SIX FOR THE FIX: Made four scoreless starts with three of them 6.0 innings or more with a season-high 7.0 IP, two-hitter at Gwinnett (Braves).

THREE HITS IN THE FOUNTAIN: Held his opposition to three hits or less in 15-of-21 starts.

PERSONAL (More info on Cardinals Media Guide Pages 145-148):

- Threw a 156-pitch complete game in the Stanford Super Regional win against Texas on June 11, 2023, striking out 16 batters.
- Has a strong interest in cryptocurrency and before baseball wanted to pursue a career as an investment banker.
- Boasts that he's the best player at any board game and is often seen playing pub trivia at Cardinals Spring Training.
- His older sister, Remy, played soccer at Rice University (2017-18).

MATHEWS vs. PITTSBURGH

- Faced Indianapolis (AAA-Pirates) on May 2 earlier this season on June 6, 2025.
- Pitched against Esmerlyn Valdez (1-3, double, strikeout), Billy Cook (2-2) and Nick Yorke (1-2, double) on the Pittsburgh active roster in those International League games.
- Made one other start against an N.L. Central opponent, holding the Reds to one run on two hits with a career-high 7 strikeouts over 4.0 innings in a no decision the Cardinals won 2-1.

- Boasts a 3.08 ERA (38.0 IP) at Busch Stadium.
