MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons [2018-24] and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row.....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros [7], Braves [7], Dodgers [7] and Yankees [6].....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseaso eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

**BREWING CONSISTENCY**: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons [2017-24].....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 735 wins since 2017 [4th in MLB/2nd in National League].

# TONIGHT'S STARTER: #62 - LHP JOSÉ QUINTANA (16gs, 8-4, 3.50) 2025 Arsenal: Sinker (45.5%) - Changeup (21.8%) - Curveball (13.0%) - 4-Seam Fastball (10.8%) - Slurve (8.9%)

QUINTANA AT A GLANCE: José Quintana, 36, will make his 17th start of the season and first against the Braves.....he last started last Friday at Washington and earned a 16-9 win (5ip, 6h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 1hbp, 94 pitches).....the team is 11-5 in his starts.....he has 4 quality starts.....opponents are batting .250 (83-for-332, 12hr).....he was on the 15-day injured list from 5/14-5/31 with a left shoulder impingement, retroactive to May 11.....Quintana signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on March 5.....he is signed through the 2025 season with a mutual option for 2026.....name is pronounced "keen-TAH-nuh."

MR. COLOMBIA: Quintana, born in Arjona, Colombia, is his country's all-time leader in nearly every statistical category in the Major Leagues, including games (375), starts (349), wins (110), innings pitched (2057.0) and strikeouts (1,786)....he pitched for Colombia in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

BEEN THERE, DONE THAT: Quintana has made 349 starts since 2012 - his first season - trailing only Max Scherzer (364).....this includes nine seasons of 30+ starts.

CAREER: Is 110-107 with a 3.73 ERA in 375 games/349 starts [2057.0ip, 853er].....is in his 14th Major League season while pitching for Chicago-AL [2012-17], Chicago-NL [2017-20], Los Angeles-AL [2021], San Francisco [2021], Pittsburgh [2022], St. Louis [2022], New York-NL [2023-24] and Milwaukee [2025].....was an All-Star in 2016 as he finished 10th in American League Cy Young Award voting.....Quintana was originally signed by the Mets as a non-drafted free agent on 4/26/06.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 7-7 with a 4.25 ERA in 19 starts (103.2ip, 49er)....is 2-3 with a 4.91 ERA in 7 starts this season (36.2ip, 20er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 56-56 with a 3.73 ERA in 190 games/178 starts (1039.0ip, 431er)....is 6-1 with a 2.49 ERA in 9 starts this season (50.2ip, 14er).
