TODAY'S TRANSACTION: The Reds today transferred the rehabilitation assignment of **LHP Caleb Ferguson** (oblique muscle strain) to AAA-Louisville.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (0-1) of a 4-game series against **Joanna Schimmel's Cubs** and the fifth game (0-4) of a 7-game road trip that began with a 3-game series sweep at the hands of the **Pirates** at **PNC Park**.

- The Reds have lost a season-high 4 consecutive games and 6 of their last 8 since 4/25 vs **Det**.
- Following Thu's game at **Chc**, the Redlegs will return to **Cincinnati** for a 6-game homestand against the **Astros** (5/8-5/10) and **Nationals** (5/12-14).
- The Reds are coming off a 4-2 homestand in which they won 2 of 3 against both the **Tigers** and **Rockies**.

ROOKIE RECOGNITION: **INF Sal Stewart** on Mon was named **National League Rookie of the Month** for March/April...became the ninth Red to ever earn the monthly honor, which was introduced in 2001 (last: **Spencer Steer**, May 2023).

- In 31 games between March and April, **Stewart** slashed .281/.373/.570 with 9 homers, 6 doubles, 20 runs, 29 RBI, and 18 walks.
- Stewart** entered May leading MLB in RBI (29), while also ranking among National League leaders in home runs (T4th), extra-base hits (15, T5th), slugging percentage (6th), OPS (.943, 6th), and total bases (65, T7th).
- His 29 RBI were the most by a Red before May since the stat became official in 1920, surpassing the previous mark of 26 set by Reds and **National Baseball Hall of Famer Tony Perez** in 1970.
- The 29 RBI were also second-most by any Major League rookie before May since 1920, behind only **Jose Abreu** (32, 2014 w/CWS).

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS: The Reds have lost back-to-back games by 2 runs or fewer after opening the year on a 12-game winning streak in such contests... the 12-game winning streak in games decided by 2 runs or fewer matched the 1987 **Brewers** for the longest run by any team to begin a season since 1900.

- Their 12 wins in games decided by 2 runs or fewer this season rank second in MLB (**StL**, 14)...their 7 wins in 1-run games are tied for second-most in the majors, behind the **Phillies** (8).

ELLYTRICITY: **SS Elly De La Cruz** this season leads all Major League shortstops in homers (10), runs (27), slugging percentage (.547), and total bases (75)...is the second Red since 1900 with at least 10 homers & 8 stolen bases through the team's first 35 games of a season (also: **Eric Davis**, 1987).

- Of his 10 homers this season, 5 have come off left-handed pitching, tied with **Hou's Yordan Alvarez**, **NY Yankees Aaron Judge**, and **NY Yankees Ben Rice** for most among all Major League batters.
- Is 3 stolen bases shy of 150 for his career...is aiming to become the youngest Red (24 years, 114 days) since 1900 to reach the mark since 1900 (**Eric Davis**, 25 years, 82 days).
- De La Cruz is also 3 stolen bases shy of ranking among the fastest players since the live-ball era (since 1920) to reach 400 hits, 200 RBI, and 150 stolen bases for his career...he is currently at 456 hits, 231 RBI, and 147 stolen bases in 455 career games.

POWER SURGE: Cin has hit 24 homers over its last 12 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), tied with **Atl** for second-most in MLB during that time, behind only **NY Yankees** (25).

- The Reds' 46 home runs this season are tied with the **Cubs** for fourth-most in MLB, behind the **Yankees** (57), **Braves** (54), and **Dodgers** (47).

STATE OF THE REDS: At 20-15 (.571), the Reds sit in third place in the NL Central division standings, 3.0 games behind the first-place **Cubs** (21-12)...their 20-15 record is also the eighth-best mark in MLB this season.

- The Reds entered May in first place in their division for the ninth time in the divisional era (since 1969)...last did so in 2006, when they finished April tied with the **Cardinals** for the top spot in the NL Central.
- Of the 9 Reds teams to enter May atop their division, 3 qualified for Postseason play, including each of the last 2 World Series championship squads (1976, '90).

SERIES NOTES: The Reds and **Cubs** are meeting for the first time this season... last year, Cin went 8-5 vs **Chc** to secure its third straight season series victory.

- In their final meeting of 2025 (9/18-9/21), Cin swept the 4-game series at **Great American Ball Park**...it was its first 4-game sweep of **Chc** since 6/21-6/24, 2018 at GABP...in that set, recorded multiple 1-0 wins in a single series for the first time since 2002 at **Wrigley Field** (9/24, 9/26).
- The Reds led 5 of the 13 games of the 2025 season series by 4 or more runs (4-0 & 6-2 on 5/23, lost 13-6; 6-1 on 5/24, won 6-4; 8-3 on 5/25, lost 11-8; 6-0 5/30, won 6-2; won 5-1 on 8/5).
- The Reds are 196-191 vs **Chc** since 2003 and 93-109 since 2014...are 469-502 (.483) all-time here at **Wrigley Field**.

BRING 'EM ON: The Reds own a 15-8 record (.652) this season against opponents entering play with a .500-or-better winning percentage.

- Their 15 wins in such games are most among all Major League teams this season...their .652 winning percentage against opponents that entered with a .500-or-better winning percentage ranks fourth in MLB, behind **StL** (12-3, .800), **Atl** (9-3, .750), and **NY Yankees** (7-3, .700)...the 2025 Reds went 44-42 (.512) against teams that finished the year at or above .500.

EL CABALLO DE HIERRO: **SS Elly De La Cruz** has appeared in each of Cin's last 253 games, beginning 7/30/24...it's the fourth-longest consecutive games played streak by a Red since 1970.

BIG ROAD MACHINE: The Reds' .588 road winning percentage this season is tied with the **Dodgers** for the sixth-best mark in MLB, behind **Atl** (.722), **StL** (.688), **NY Yankees** (.667), **Wsh** (.632), and **SD** (.600)...the Reds have produced 2 series sweeps on the road in 2026, tied with the **Braves**, **Cardinals**, and **Yankees** for most in MLB.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: The Reds own a 13-3 record (.813) when scoring first this season...their .813 winning percentage in such games ranks fourth among all Major League teams, behind only the **Cardinals** (.882), **Yankees** (.870), and **Rangers** (.846).

- Have scored 27 runs in the 1st inning this season, fifth-most in MLB... only the **Nationals** (32), **Yankees** (29), **Phillies** (29), and **Astros** (29) have scored more in the opening frame.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first win of the season on Thu, 4/30 in the 6-4 victory vs Col (6.0ip, 5h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 5k, 1hr, 86TP)...was his second quality start of the season, his first since Opening Day vs Bos (3/26).

- Averaged 14.3 pitches per inning, his lowest mark since 3/26...his previous 3 starts was averaging 22.3, 20.8, and 23.7 pitches per inning.
- Gave up just 1 extra-base hit, a 2-run homer to Tyler Freeman in the 1st inning...followed the 1st inning with 5.0 scoreless frames (4h, 4k, 1bb, 68 pitches).

APRIL 24 vs DET: In his first career appearance vs Det, did not factor in the decision in the 9-8 win on Fri, 4/24 at GABP (4.0ip, 6h, 5r/5er, 2bb, 4k, 2hr, 89TP)...opposed Framber Valdez.

- Was his third straight start in which he failed to reach 5.0 innings.
- His 1st-inning strikeout of Kevin McGonigle marked the 400th of his career...became the sixth-fastest Reds pitcher by appearances (81) to reach the 400K mark since 1893.
- Allowed a season-high 2 HR, 5 flyballs, 6 hard-hit balls, and a 92.6 mph average exit velocity.

APRIL 18 at MIN: Did not factor in the decision in the 5-4 win at Min on Sat 4/18 (4.2ip, 6h, 4r/3er, 3bb, 3k, 0hr, 97TP)...opposed Taj Bradley.

- His 97 pitches marked a season high.
- Pitched into the 5th inning where he allowed the leadoff batter to reach (single), followed by 2 flyouts and a walk before turning it over to Sam Moll...Moll allowed 1 of those 2 inherited runners to score (RBI-single by Brooks Lee).

APRIL 12 vs LAA: Suffered the 9-6 loss on Sun 4/12 vs LAA (3.0ip, 8h, 7r/7er, 2bb, 1k, 1hr, 71TP)...opposed José Soriano.

- His 7 runs allowed tied a career high (also: 8/23/25 at AZ).
- His 3.0 innings marked the second-shortest start of his career (2.1ip, 9/27/23 at Cle).
- His 8 hits allowed were his most since 9/5/25 vs NYM (9).
- Allowed a season-high 10 base runners, his most since 9/5/25 vs NYM (11).
- Averaged 23.7 pitches per inning, his highest mark since 9/16/23 at NYM (24.8).

APRIL 7 at MIA: Did not factor in the decision in the Reds' 10-inning, 6-3 win at Mia on 4/7 (5.1ip, 6h, 2er/2er, 2bb, 2k, 0hr, 91TP)...squared off against Sandy Alcantara.

- Gave up both his runs in the 4th inning (double, single, 2 ground outs, single, flyout).
- Pitched into the 6th inning and was 2 outs from a quality start...turned it over to Pierce Johnson with the bases loaded and 1 out...Johnson produced a groundout and a strikeout to end the threat and keep the score at 2-0.

ACCOLADES: Was recognized as a finalist for the 2025 All-MLB Team and received votes in 2025 for National League Cy Young Award and Rawlings Gold Glove Award.

HE EARNED IT: His 3.61 ERA through his first 82 career starts is the lowest by a Reds starting pitcher in that span since RHP Mario Soto (3.22, 1977-82).

PERSONAL: Graduated from Halifax County High School (South Boston, VA), the same school attended by All Elite Wrestling champion "Hangman" Adam Page and Major League pitcher Jeremy Jeffress...was named 2017 Gatorade Virginia Player of the Year...was a 4-year member of the Halifax swim team...at the University of Virginia became only the second pitcher in school history to record at least 300 strikeouts.
