RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a six-game homestand against the Giants (1-0, two to play) and Blue Jays (three to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...have won 14 of their last 19 games (April 10–pres.) on the heels of a 5-7 start and are 17-7 (.708) in their last 24 games since April 4, tied for the best in the majors with the Padres...began a span of 13 games in as many days last night (May 1-13), the final leg in a stretch of 28 games in 30 days from April 14–May 13...are tied for the sixth-best record in the majors and are 1.5 GB behind the AL East-leading Yankees for first in the AL...have spent six days occupying first in the AL East, 18 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth, including 18 straight days in first or second.

★ The Rays claimed the series opener, 3-0, against the Giants...it marked their second shutout of the season, both coming in their last three games...they have claimed six of their previous eight series openers since April 6, including four of five at Tropicana Field.

★ **Yandy Diaz** tallied his 104th home run as a Ray last night, tying **Carl Crawford** for seventh most in franchise history...the homer also registered his 300th career extra-base hit and his 283rd with the Rays, tying **Carlos Peña** for seventh most in club history — see "The Great Yandino" note below for more information.

★ **Shane McClellan** has earned the win in back-to-back starts for the first time since he won three straight starts between June 5-16, 2023...he tossed a season-high 6.0 innings with no runs, the first time he has had a scoreless quality start since May 19, 2023 vs. MIL (also 6.0IP).

★ Rays relievers have spun 12.0 scoreless innings dating back to June 26...they have gone four consecutive games (April 27–pres.) without allowing a run for the first time since June 10-17, 2025 (6G).
★ The Rays 19-12 start is the sixth-best record in franchise history through 31 games and the best since 2023 (25-6/806)...the club has won 20 of its first 32 on five previous occasions, with four of the five teams going on to make the playoffs (2023, 2020, 2019, 2010).

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Today, the Rays reinstated **LHP Garrett Cleavinger** (right calf tightness) from the 15-day IL and designated **RHP Yoendrys Gómez** for assignment...there are currently 39 players on the 40-man roster.

WHAT'S AT STAKE

- ★ Move to eight games above .500 for the first time since July 6, 2025 (49-41)...it would be the fifth-earliest date in club history to reach that mark (see table on the right).
- ★ Clinch their fifth series win in their last seven sets (April 10–pres.) and their fifth straight over the Giants (April 5, 2019–pres.).
- ★ Record their sixth straight win at Tropicana Field (April 22–pres.), their longest winning streak at home since Aug. 22–Sept. 4, 2025 (6G) and the longest at Tropicana Field since April 24–May 7, 2024 (6G).
- ★ Claim their first Interleague series win of the season after dropping each of their first five.

AN OPENING ACT—**Griffin Jax** will start tonight as an opener, with **Jesse Scholtens** scheduled to handle bulk innings in relief...Jax is set for his second start of 2026, his fourth as a Ray, and the 18th of his career...in his previous start on April 26 vs. MIN, he went 2.1 scoreless innings, his most since May 31, 2022 at DET...the Rays have used an opener on two occasions this season, with **Cole Sulser** making the other start on April 15 at CWS...since first introducing the concept on May 19, 2018 at LAA with **Sergio Romo** opening for **Ryan Yarbrough**, the Rays have gone 110-72 (.604) when using an opener and 556-444 (.556) in all other games.

★ With the exception of 2025 (0-1), they have produced a winning record when employing an opener in each season since 2018...the Rays went 6-5 with an opener in 2024, 12-9 in 2023 and 2022, 14-7 in 2021, 6-1 in 2020, 26-17 in 2019, and 32-23 in 2018.

THE GREAT YANDINO—**Yandy Díaz**'s home run last night tied him with **Carl Crawford** (104) for seventh-most home runs in club history and tied him with **Carlos Peña** (283) for the seventh-most extra-base hits franchise history...it marked his 32nd opposite-field home run in a Rays uniform, most in franchise history, doubling the total of second-ranked **Randy Arozarena** (16)...Díaz has nearly 10 pct. of all opposite-field home runs (348HR) in franchise history...he has 996 hits in his career, four shy of becoming the 20th Cuban-born player in major league history to reach 1,000 hits.

★ He has reached base safely in 23 straight home games dating back to Sept. 5, 2025, the longest such streak by a Ray since **Randy Arozarena** (33G, April 12–June 24, 2023)...going back to Sept. 19, 2024, he has reached base in 17 consecutive at Tropicana Field, the longest run since **Isaac Paredes** did so in 22 straight games (March 30–May 12, 2024) at the ballpark.
★ Since joining the Rays, Díaz has tallied 271 multi-hit games, fourth most in team history and one behind **Ben Zobrist** (272) for third most...he has also recorded 104 multi-RBI games, seventh most in team history and three behind **Aubrey Huff** (107) for sixth.

★ In March/April, he reached base safely 56 times to surpass **Tommy Pham** (52, 2019) for the most TOB before the calendar flipped to May in team history...he also tied **Jonny Gomes** (56, 2006) for the most TOB by any Ray through the club's first 30 games of a season...he has reached base 57 times this season, putting him on pace to reach safely 298 times in 2026 and break the franchise record for a single season (**Aubrey Huff**, 2003 - 259TOB).

THIS AINT A SCENE, IT'S AN ARMS RACE—Rays starting pitchers have gone 11-8 with a 3.32 ERA (157.1IP, 58ER), a .211 (124-for-588) opp. average, and 17 home runs...the staff's 3.32 ERA and .211 opp. average are each fourth best in the majors and second best in the AL...the 17 home runs have accounted for 28 out of the 65 runs they have allowed and are tied for the sixth-fewest home runs allowed by starters...Rays starting pitchers have allowed two earned runs or fewer in each of the last eight games (April 22–pres.) with four scoreless outings.

★ Rays pitchers have allowed three runs or fewer in eight consecutive games (April 22–pres.), tied for the fourth-longest streak in franchise history (4x, last: Sept. 15-24, 2024)...extending the streak to nine games tonight, would tie the third-longest streak in team history (May 22-30, 2019).

★ The bullpen has posted a 1.46 ERA (24.2IP, 4ER) in eight games since April 22, second best in the majors over that span behind the Guardians (1.44), and a 3.56 ERA (98.2IP, 39ER) in 24 games since April 4, fourth best in MLB...five different Rays have contributed a save this season, tied for second most in the majors behind the Cubs (6), with their 13 combined saves ranking first in MLB...their 12 saves in March/April were tied for the most in club history before the calendar flipped to May (also 2019).

★ The Rays staff has thrown changeups on 20.9 pct. of pitches in 2026, a jump from 11.7 pct. in 2025...the pitch ranks highly among all major league staffs in xBA (1st, .181), on-base pct. (1st, .203), slugging pct. (1st, .229), and batting average (2nd, .158/38-for-240)...the .158 opp. average is .061 below league average (.219) and the .229 OBP is .101 below league average (.330).

THE ART OF THE LONG BALL—**Junior Caminero** crushed his ninth home run of the campaign last night...at 432 ft., it marked his third home run of the year projected at 430 ft. or farther by Statcast...he is tied for the major league lead in 430-foot or farther blasts with LAA **Mike Trout**, COL **Mickey Moniak**, and CWS **Munetaka Murakami**...he is one of 19 Rays in the Statcast Era (2015–pres.) to have three home runs of 430 ft. or farther in a season and the first since **Jonathan Aranda** in 2025...the franchise record is 10 such home runs by **Steven Souza Jr.** in 2017.

GOING ARANDA BASES—**Jonathan Aranda**'s 25 RBI on the season are two behind **HOU Yordan Alvarez** (27) for most in the AL...he finished March/April with an RBI in 16 of 30 games, tied for the second-most contests with an RBI through the Rays first 30 games in franchise history (6x, last: **Brandon Lowe**, 2020)...he tied **Ben Zobrist** (2011) for the second-most RBI in club history through March/April, trailing only **Randy Arozarena** in 2023 (28)...it was also the most in a single month by a Ray since Arozarena's 28 in 2023...an AL-most 22 of his 25 RBI have come against right-handed pitching, third in the majors to CIN **Sal Stewart** (27) and MIA **Liam Hicks** (26)...he has three game-winning RBI this season, tied for the team lead with **Yandy Díaz** and tied for 10th most in the AL...Aranda is on pace for 131 RBI, which would best **Carlos Peña**'s franchise record (121) established in 2007.

BAY TO BAY—This series marks the fifth trip all-time the Giants have made to Tropicana Field, with the Rays holding a 3-1-0 record in the previous series...the Rays have won four straight series and six of eight all-time against the Giants...the Rays have held the Giants to four runs or fewer in 14 of their 26 all-time matchups, going 13-1 in those contests.

★ In 13 games against the Giants in his career, **Yandy Díaz** has hit .294 (15-for-51) with 2 2B, 3 HR, 10 RBI, 3 BB, and 5 R...he has a hit in six straight (April 13–pres.) and has recorded multiple hits in five of the 13.

TONIGHT'S OUTING—Jesse Scholtens will take the mound tonight after opener **RHP Griffin Jax** for his fifth appearance of the 2026 season and second consecutive outing following Jax...marks his first career appearance against San Francisco...was claimed off of waivers on Aug. 4, 2025 from the White Sox.

- ✦ The Rays are 2-0 when using an opener in 2026 (April 15 at CWS & April 26 vs. MIN) and 110-72 (.604) when using an opener since first introducing the concept on May 19, 2018 at Angel Stadium.
- ✦ As a reliever this season, Scholtens is 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA (14.0IP, 2ER) compared to 0-1 with a 7.94 ERA (5.2IP, 5ER) as a starter.
- ✦ All three of his career wins have come when a team uses an opener for him (also: April 25 at CWS & June 25, 2023 vs. BOS).
- ✦ Among AL pitchers age 30 and older with at least one start and 18.0 innings pitched this season, Scholtens' 1.12 WHIP ranks 10th, joining teammates **Drew Rasmussen** (2nd, 0.85), **Nick Martinez** (6th, 1.00), and **Steven Matz** (9th, 1.12).

LAST TIME OUT—On April 26 vs. MIN, pitched behind an opener for the second time this season, tossing 4.1 innings and giving up two runs on three hits (HR) and three walks while striking out one to earn his second win in his last three outings (April 15-pres.)...has two wins through his first four outings of a season for the first time in his career.

JESSE & THE GIANT PEACH—The Giants are one of 10 teams that Scholtens has yet to face (AZ, HOU, LAD, MIA, NYY, PHI, SD, SF, STL, and TB).

- ✦ In his lone appearance against an NL West club, Scholtens was dealt the loss on Aug. 19, 2023 at COL (w/CWS)...he spun 3.0 innings and surrendered five runs on five hits and a career-high five walks against two strikeouts in the loss.
- ✦ In Interleague games, Scholtens is 0-3 with a 6.67 ERA (29.2IP, 22ER) through nine appearances (three starts).

THE LIFE OF A SWINGMAN—The right-hander has made 32 career appearances and 12 starts in the majors, with 18 of the 32 being 4.0 innings or more...as a starter in his career, he is 0-7 with a 6.07 ERA (59.1IP, 40ER) and 44 strikeouts compared to a 3-4 record with one save, a 3.69 ERA (53.2IP, 22ER), and 40 strikeouts as a reliever...in those 12 career starts, he has received three runs of support or more on two occasions (2.73 RSA)...as a reliever, he has a 5.37 RSA (53.2IP, 32RS).

SPLIT CITY—Scholtens has posted reverse splits through four appearances this season, limiting left-handed batters to a .167 (6-for-36) average compared to a .263 (10-for-38) mark against righties...has followed a similar pattern over his career, holding LHB to a .229 (47-for-205) clip and RHB to a .317 (78-for-246) average.

- ✦ Among AL right-handed pitchers (min. 15.0IP) in 2026, Scholtens' .167 opp. average vs. LHB is tied for the 10th lowest.

LET'S STOP AT THE TROP—Three of Scholtens' four outings this season have come at Tropicana Field, where he is 1-1 with a 4.30 ERA (14.2IP, 7ER) and 11 strikeouts.

- ✦ Has made at least one appearance in 16 different ballparks, with Tropicana Field being one of two in which has recorded a win (also: Rate Field, 2-2).
- ✦ At home over his career, he has gone 2-4 with a 5.11 ERA (49.1IP, 28ER) and 38 strikeouts, compared to 1-7 with a 4.81 ERA (63.2IP, 34ER) and 46 strikeouts while on the road.

CAREER RECAP—Began the year in the White Sox organization in 2025, making his season debut May 6 with Triple-A Charlotte in his first appearance post-Tommy John surgery after suffering a rehab setback during spring training...made eight appearances (6 starts) with the Knights, but was designated for assignment Aug. 3 before being claimed off waivers by the Rays Aug. 4 and optioned to Triple-A Durham...made seven starts with the Bulls before he was recalled Sept. 20 and finished the year in the majors.

- ✦ Made two appearances with the Rays out of the bullpen...on Sept. 20 vs. BOS, worked 3.0 IP with 1 ER allowed in his first major league outing since Sept. 20, 2023 at WSH...on Sept. 25 at BAL, collected a career-high 9 SO over 5.1 IP of relief, generating a career-high 17 whiffs, most by a Rays reliever in the pitch-tracking era (since 2008)...tied **Ryan Yarbrough** (May 31, 2018 at OAK) for the most strikeouts by a reliever in franchise history.
- ✦ Had a 34.2 pct. whiff rate, 31.6 pct. strikeout rate and 32.1 pct. chase rate...his 12 SO marked the most in team history through a pitcher's first two relief appearances with the Rays, surpassing **Cooper Criswell** (10) in 2023.
- ✦ Across 17 outings (15 starts) between Triple-A Durham (7 starts), Triple-A Charlotte (8G/6GS), and Class-A Winston-Salem (2 starts), went 2-2 with a 4.72 ERA (68.2IP, 36ER)...allowed 3 ER or fewer in 14 of the 17 appearances.
- ✦ Missed the 2024 season after suffering a torn right UCL during spring training that required March 1 Tommy John surgery, performed by Dr. Keith Meister in Arlington, Tx. ...placed on the 60-day IL on Feb. 27 and spent the year rehabbing at the White Sox training complex in Arizona.
- ✦ Broke into the majors in 2023, appearing in 26 games (11 starts) after the White Sox selected his contract on April 7...was in the majors from April 7-13, May 22-June 1, and June 16-end of season...made his final appearance on Sept. 20 at WSH and was placed on the 15-day IL on Sept. 24 with a left calf strain.
