**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles continue a six-game homestand and a stretch of 15 games in 14 days, which started with an April 30 doubleheader vs. the Astros, tonight against the Yankees... The club has its first scheduled off day this month on Thursday.

👉 **Coby Mayo** delivered a go-ahead three-run home run in the seventh inning last night... He had never hit a go-ahead homer after the fourth inning in his career entering last night and had never gone deep for the lead with his team trailing in his career.

👉 The Orioles were being no-hit through 6.0 innings yesterday before **Adley Rutschman** opened the seventh inning with a single...The Birds have been no-hit through six innings three times in the last 63 games (also 8.2 IP, 9/6/25 vs. LAD & 8.0 IP, 4/16/26 at CLE), but have won two of those games (last night and 9/6/25 vs. LAD).

👉 Baltimore won 3-2 last night, the second straight game allowing fewer than three runs after a stretch of 25 consecutive games surrendering 3+ runs from April 13-May 9.

👉 The O's have won consecutive days by one run after beginning the season 2-6 in such situations.

**20-SOMETHING:** The Orioles are one of nine teams in the majors this season with four players having at least 20 RBI...The Braves lead the league with six, while the O's are tied with the Angels, Twins, Phillies, Brewers, Cardinals, Yankees, and Pirates...**Pete Alonso** (22), **Gunnar Henderson** (21), **Jeremiah Jackson** (24), and **Adley Rutschman** (21) all have at least 20, while **Leody Taveras** (19) and **Coby Mayo** and **Samuel Basallo** (both 15) are close.

**GARCIA'S GREATNESS:** **Rico Garcia** has posted a 0.47 ERA (1 ER/19.0 IP) with one hit, seven walks, and 22 strikeouts across 20 appearances to begin the season...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

👉 His .018 (1-for-57) opponent average and 0.42 WHIP are the best among MLB relievers. Prior to Garcia's current run, the fewest number of hits allowed by an Oriole through their first 20 outings of a season was six (Jesse Orosco, 1997).

👉 He has not allowed a hit in each of his last eight outings, tied for the longest active run in the majors with SEA's Matt Brash.

👉 Garcia has yet to allow a hit in his first 10 home appearances to open the 2026 campaign, the only Oriole in team history to begin a season with such a stretch...It is tied for the fourth-longest such streak by an MLB pitcher since 1900 behind SF's Scott Eyre (15 G, 2004), OAK's Ryan Cook (14 G, 2012), and SEA's Jeff Nelson (11 G, 2001).

**BASALLO BREAKING OUT:** **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .397/.435/.638 (23-for-58) with six doubles, one triple, two home runs, eight runs, and 11 RBI over his last 17 games since April 20.

👉 During this period, he is 13-for-31 (.419) with three doubles, one triple, and one home run off fastballs.

👉 Basallo's 93.2 mph average exit velocity leads all primary catchers this season ahead of COL's Hunter Goodman (92.8) and ATH's Shea Langeliers (92.7).

**CAN'T WARD HIM OFF:** **Taylor Ward** leads the majors with 79 times on base (37 H, 41 BB, 1 HBP), 41 walks, and a .422 on-base percentage while his 13 doubles are tied for second in the majors with TOR's Ernie Clement and DET's Riley Greene, trailing ATL's Matt Olson (15), though he doesn't have a two-bagger since April 22 at Kansas City.

👉 His 79 times on base are tied for the third most in a players' first 41 games to begin his time with the Orioles with Albert Belle (1999), trailing Roberto Alomar (88 in 1996) and Frank Robinson (81 in 1966).

👉 Ward is the first player in Orioles history (since 1954) to draw 41 walks in his first 41 games with the club.

👉 According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in on-base percentage was Eddie Murray in 1984 (2<sup>nd</sup>, .410).

👉 Ward does not have an extra-base hit in a career-high 16 straight games since April 24.

**PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE:** The O's have drawn 170 walks this year, sixth in MLB behind the Cubs (191), Yankees (189), Guardians (184), Brewers (173), and Pirates (172)...The Birds are averaging 9.26 plate appearances per walk, fifth best in the majors behind the Yankees (8.39), Cubs (8.49), Brewers (8.55), and Guardians (8.83).

👉 **Taylor Ward** is averaging an MLB-best 4.56 plate appearances per walk, ahead of ATH's Nick Kurtz (4.76) and LAA's Mike Trout (4.89).

👉 Baltimore has 18 games with 5+ walks, tied with Milwaukee and New York-AL for second most in MLB behind Chicago-NL (22)...The 2025 Orioles had 34 such games.

**DEUCES WILD:** Baltimore pitching has allowed a .762 opponent OPS with two outs, the fifth-highest mark in the majors ahead of Houston (.808), Chicago-AL (.793), Cincinnati (.775), and Texas (.769).

👉 With two strikes, the opposition owns a .552 OPS, fifth highest in MLB ahead of Colorado (.608), Washington (.584), Houston (.573), and Philadelphia (.560).

**YANKEE DOODLES:** The Orioles and Yankees are meeting this week for the second of four series this season...New York swept a four-game set in the Bronx from May 1-4...The Yankees return to Camden Yards from August 18-20 before the clubs wrap up the regular season at Yankee Stadium from September 25-27.

👉 The Birds snapped a nine-game losing streak against the Yankees, the longest against the club since dropping a team-record 19 straight to New York from April 4, 2019-September 4 (G1), 2020.

👉 Since 2023, **Gunnar Henderson** has 43 hits against the Yankees, tied for second most in the majors during that time with SF's Rafael Devers and TOR's George Springer, behind TOR's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (45).

**'PEN PALS:** **Grant Wolfram** has not allowed a home run in 34.0 consecutive innings dating to July 21, 2025...He has allowed two long balls in 39.2 innings since his MLB debut on April 26 (G2) at Detroit, with both home runs coming on July 18, 2025 at Tampa Bay.

👉 The O's 15.1 percent inherited runners scored rate (8 IRS/53 IR) is second lowest in the majors behind the Mariners (12.2%; 5 IRS/41 IR).

👉 The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

**QUICK HITS:** Rogers is scheduled to make his seventh start of the season and 109<sup>th</sup> of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) prior to tonight's game...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole... He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered the loss on April 25 vs. Boston after working 1.2 innings, allowing three runs on four hits and two walks with two strikeouts...Threw 62 pitches, 38 strikeouts.

⚡ The 1.2 innings were tied for the second fewest in a start in his career (also 4/16/22 vs. PHI), trailing his 1.0 inning on September 1, 2022 at Washington.

⚡ Has suffered three consecutive losses, one shy of matching his career long run of four, done twice: April 23-May 10, 2024 and July 6-25, 2022.

**CONCRETE JUNGLE:** Rogers has made four career starts against New York-AL, going 1-1 with a 4.60 ERA (8 ER/15.2 IP)...In his lone career start opposite the Yankees at Camden Yards on September 15, 2025, he earned the win after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings, scattering one hit, two walks, and one hit batter with seven strikeouts.

⚡ Rogers became one of four Orioles (five occurrences) in franchise history (since 1954) to throw 6.0+ scoreless innings while allowing one or zero hits against the Yankees at home, joining Adam Loewen (8/5/06), Hoyt Wilhelm (2x, 5/22/59 & 9/20/58), and Joe Coleman (9/9/54).

**UNDER THE HOOD:** Rogers' hard-hit rate is down 16.8 percent from 2025, going from 48.4 percent to 31.6...The 16.8 percent decrease is the fourth largest year-over-year decrease among all qualified MLB pitchers, trailing SD's Mason Miller (-21.6%), TB's Bryan Baker (-21.5%), and MIN's Taylor Rogers (-18.0%).

⚡ Opponents are 14-for-47 (.298) with four doubles and one home run off his four-seamer after going 22-for-139 (.158) with two doubles, one triple, and three homers off the offering in 2025.

**BEST OF THE BEST:** Since making his 2025 season debut on May 24 (G2) at Boston, Rogers' 2.44 ERA (38 ER/140.0 IP) is fifth lowest in MLB (min. 125.0 IP), trailing PIT's Paul Skenes (1.90), DET's Tarik Skubal (2.11), PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (2.25), and NYY's Cam Schlichtler (2.28).

**LIMITING THE LONG BALL:** Since making his MLB debut on August 25, 2020, Rogers has allowed 0.83 home runs per nine innings, the seventh-lowest mark in the majors (min. 500.0 IP), trailing SF's Logan Webb (0.62), NYY's Max Fried (0.66), DET's Framber Valdez (0.72), PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (0.73), BOS' Ranger Suarez (0.78), and LAD's Blake Snell (0.80).

⚡ Since making his season debut in 2025, Rogers has permitted nine home runs over 140.0 innings, three of which came in last year's season finale at New York-AL.

**MAKING HISTORY:** During the 2025 campaign, his 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of **Dave McNally** (1.95 ERA, 1968) and **Jim Palmer** (2.07 ERA, 1972)...His .180 opponent average (70-for-388), .263 opponent slugging percentage, and .503 opponent OPS were the lowest marks by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), while his .240 opponent on-base percentage ranked second behind McNally (.232 OBP, 1968).
