Responding

The Braves lost to the Nationals last night, 2-0...The team is attempting to avoid losing consecutive games for just the third time this season.

Atlanta endured three straight losses to the Arizona Diamondbacks (2) and the Los Angeles Angels (1) from April 4-6, and two straight losses to the Seattle Mariners and Los Angeles Dodgers from May 6-8.

Apart from those "streaks," the Braves' other 11 losses have all been followed by wins.

The club has played to a 13-3 (.813) record in games following a loss.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Nationals today conclude a three-game weekend series with the seventh of 13 games between the two teams this season...Atlanta and Washington are set to see each other next from July 30-August 2 at Truist Park for a four-game series.

A Atlanta is in the midst of its first of two three-game homestands this season...The team will host another from September 22-24, when it welcomes Cincinnati for three games, before finishing the regular season with three games at Miami.

A The Nationals stymied the Braves to the tune of a one-hit shutout last night...Atlanta hadn't been held to a single knock in over a year, last falling victim on March 30, 2025 at San Diego...The club hadn't been one-hit at home since April 25, 2021 versus Arizona...The Braves were held to a single hit across 14 innings of a doubleheader.

A The Braves struck out 15 batters and lost, their seventh time doing so since the beginning of the 2024 season, the most in MLB.

A Atlanta took three-of-four from Washington at Nationals Park earlier this season, April 20-23...The club went 9-4 against Washington last year, and has won the season set versus the Nationals in seven of the last eight seasons dating to 2018...The Braves are 81-49 (.623) in 130 total games against the Nationals in that span.

A LHP Foster Griffin will square off against Atlanta for just the second time in his big league career...He made his first appearance against the Braves on April 21 at Nationals Park, spinning a Quality Start via 6.0 innings pitched and three earned runs...He struck out three batters, tied for the second fewest in his 10 career starting nods...After posting a 2.12 ERA (11 ER/46.2 IP) in his first eight turns this season, Griffin owns a 13.50 mark (14 ER/9.1 IP) in his previous two outings.

THE SERIES: The Braves square off with the Nationals today with the series hanging in the balance...The team has yet to lose a home series this season.

A The club hasn't lost a home series since the conclusion of the 2025 regular season, when the Pittsburgh Pirates took two-of-three games here at Truist Park.

A Atlanta's seven wins and .875 winning percentage in rubber games are each the best marks in MLB this season...Its only loss in such a game came at the hands of the Seattle Mariners on May 6.

A The Braves have pitched to a 1.65 ERA (13 ER/71.0 IP) in rubber matches, by far the best mark in Major League Baseball...The Toronto Blue Jays rank second with a 2.50 ERA (15 ER/54.0 IP).

A Atlanta has averaged 6.75 runs per game in rubber matches, also tops in the majors...The club also leads in batting average (.285) and OPS (.827).

MARTÍN PÉREZ: Is set today to pitch his 11th game (7th start) as a Brave...In his last time out, the 35-year-old Venezuelan took a no-decision after pitching 5.0 innings and surrendering four earned runs at Miami.

A The southpaw struck out 10 of the 23 batters he faced, setting a new career high...He had previously struck out nine batters on four occasions for his career best, most recently on March 31, 2025 while with the Chicago White Sox.

A Pérez became just the second pitcher in baseball history (since 1893) to record his first career double-digit strikeout game in his 285th start or later, per Elias.

A The all-time record is held by Doyle Alexander, who logged his first double-digit affair in his 321st career turn for the Toronto Blue Jays on July 23, 1985.

A Pérez is the 17th-oldest pitcher all-time to log his first double-digit strikeout game, and the first 35-year-old to record his first since Colin Rea did so for Chicago-AL last season...Before Rea, knuckleballer R.A. Dickey was the last 35-year-old to do it on May 31, 2011.

FACING LEFTIES: The Braves are set to face left-hander Foster Griffin later this afternoon...The team enters play 16-4 (.800) against opposing left-handed starters this season...Those are the most wins and the third-best winning percentage in such games in the majors this year.

A The Tampa Bay Rays (12-2, .857) and Los Angeles Dodgers (9-2, .818) are the only clubs with higher winning percentages against southpaws this season.

A Dating even further to 2019, no team in baseball has been better against lefties...The Braves have gone 182-103 (.639) versus left-handers in that span.

A Since the start of May, Atlanta has faced 10 left-handed starting pitchers...The club has played to a 9-1 record in those games.

A The Braves beat southpaw Richard Lovelady in this series opener for their most recent victory off a left-hander.

HOMERS ALLOWED: Dating to May 21 at Miami, Atlanta's starters have yielded just six runs across 17.1 innings pitched, good for a 3.12 ERA...Each of the six runs have come off solo homers.

A The Braves' starting staff has given up 28 solo shots this season, tied for the third most in baseball behind the Athletics (33) and Chicago Cubs (30)...Their 36 homers surrendered overall are tied for 15th in MLB.

A Forty-two percent of the runs allowed by Atlanta's starting staff have come via the home run...In addition to the solo homers, it has allowed six two run homers and two three-run homers.

Today's Game

- Makes his seventh start of the season and 286th of his career today in the finale of a three-game series against Washington at Truist Park.
- Is 1-2 with a 6.20 ERA (17 ER/24.2 IP) in six career appearances, four starts, against the Nationals...Did not factor in the decision in his lone outing against them this season, allowing two runs over 3.0 innings of relief on April 22 at Washington.
- Has not started against the Nationals since April 4, 2024 at Washington, when he earned the win over 6.2 innings in a 7-4 victory with the Marlins.
- The 6-foot, 210-pound Venezuela native enters with a 2-2 record and a 2.85 ERA (13 ER/41.0 IP) over 10 total appearances - six starts and four relief outings - with 38 strikeouts against 13 walks.
- Worked a no-decision in his most recent start on May 19 at Miami, allowing four runs on five hits over 5.0 innings with two walks and a career-high 10 strikeouts on 78 pitches in the Braves' 8-4 win at loanDepot park...The lone home run was a leadoff shot by Xavier Edwards in the first inning.
- Set a career high with 10 strikeouts in that outing, eclipsing his previous high of nine, and recorded his first career game with 10-or-more strikeouts.
- Right-handed batters are hitting .186 (19-for-102) with four homers off Pérez this season, while left-handers are batting .209 (9-for-39) with one homer...Owns a career 3.58 ERA (146 ER/367.1 IP) against same-handed hitters and a 4.59 ERA (663 ER/1,300.1 IP) against righties.

2026

- Received a no-decision in his most recent start on May 19 at Miami, working 5.0 innings with two walks, a career-high 10 strikeouts and a home run on 78 pitches in the Braves' 8-4 win at loanDepot park...Set a career high in strikeouts and recorded his first career 10-strikeout game.
- Logged his first career 10-strikeout game in his 285th start on May 19 at Miami, the second-most starts before a first career 10-or-more strikeout game among pitchers to debut since 1893, trailing only Doyle Alexander (321st start, July 23, 1985)...At 35 years, 45 days, Pérez is the 17th-oldest pitcher to record a first career 10-strikeout game dating to 1893, and the first to do so at age 35-or-older since Colin Rea (35 years, 79 days) on September 18, 2025 (per Elias).
- Tossed a perfect inning of relief on May 16 vs. Boston, striking out a pair on 14 pitches...Did not factor in the decision in the Braves' 3-2 loss at Truist Park.
- Worked a perfect inning of relief on May 13 vs. the Cubs, striking out two on 12 pitches in Atlanta's 4-1 win at Truist Park.
- Took the loss in his start on May 6 at Seattle, allowing two runs on five hits over 5.2 innings with one walk, five strikeouts and a home run on 84 pitches in a 3-1 defeat at T-Mobile Park...The home run was a solo shot by Julio Rodríguez in the sixth.
- Earned his second win as a Brave on April 28 vs. Detroit, working 5.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball with four walks and five strikeouts on 91 pitches in the 5-2 victory at Truist Park.
- Tossed 3.0 innings of relief on April 22 at Washington, allowing a pair of solo home runs in a span of three batters in the sixth inning, but did not factor in the decision in the 8-6 win.
- Earned his first win as a Brave on April 17 at Philadelphia, holding the Phillies to four hits over 6.0 scoreless innings with two walks and four strikeouts on 94 pitches in the 9-0 victory at Citizens Bank Park.
- Took the loss in his second start with Atlanta on April 11 vs. Cleveland, allowing one run on two hits over 5.0 innings with three walks, two strikeouts and a home run on 86 pitches in a 6-0 defeat...The lone run came on a solo home run by José Ramírez in the fourth inning.
- Allowed four earned runs on five hits over 5.0 innings in his first career start as a member of the Braves on April 5 at Arizona, walking one with one strikeout on 75 pitches...Did not factor in the decision in Atlanta's 6-5 loss in 10 innings.
- Made his first appearance with the Braves on March 31 vs. the Athletics, tossing 4.1 scoreless innings of relief...Allowed just two hits with no walks and three strikeouts on 47 pitches (31 strikes) in the 5-2 loss.
- Had his contract selected by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on April 17... Originally had his contract selected on March 30 before being designated for assignment on April 12, outrighted to Gwinnett on April 14, and re-signed to a minor league deal on April 15.

- Has converted 26 consecutive save opportunities since July 28, 2025, one behind Aroldis Chapman (BOS) for the longest active run in the majors and tied with Craig Kimbrel for the best by a Brave since 2014.
