THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 23
2015 - The Astros turn a 5th-inning triple play to help secure a 3-2 win over the Tigers at Comerica Park in Detroit. The play goes 5-4-3 as 3B Jonathon Villar takes a ground ball right to the 3rd base bag by Ian Kinsler, tags 3rd base and relays to 2B Jose Altuve, who relays it to 1B Chris Carter. It was the Astros 1st triple play since Aug. 19, 2004 at PHI. Rookie starter Lance McCullers Jr. earns his 1st Major League victory.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros and Cubs will play the 2nd game of their 3-game set this afternoon at Wrigley Field...**RHP Kai-Wei Teng** (2-3) will start for the Astros as he takes on **RHP Colin Rea** (4-2).

IN THE DAYTIME: Today is the 3rd of 4 consecutive scheduled day games for the Astros...Wednesday's series finale at MIN had a 12:40 p.m. start and all 3 games this weekend at Wrigley Field will begin at 1:20 p.m...the last time that the Astros have played 4 consecutive day games was April 2-6 of last season (source: Elias).

ROADIES: Today is the 4th game (2-2 thus far) of a 10-game, 3-city road trip for HOU...HOU went 1-2 at MIN on the 1st stop of the trip...after this series in CHC, they travel back to Texas for a 4-game series vs. the Rangers at Globe Life Field (Mon.-Thurs).

VS. THE CUBBIES: The Astros took 2 of 3 vs. the Cubs in the only series between the two clubs last season (June 27-29 at Daikin Park)...prior to the current series, the Astros last visit to Wrigley Field was a 3-game series in April of 2024 (3-gm sweep by CHC)...the Astros are 8-5 vs. the Cubs since 2019...**All-Time:** The Astros are 386-338 all-time vs. the Cubbies...Their 386 wins vs. them are their 2nd-most vs. any opponent (404-455 vs. CIN)...**First Game Ever:** The very first official game of the Houston franchise was vs. the Cubs...on April 10, 1962, the Colt .45s defeated the Cubs, 11-2, at Colt Stadium, behind a CG win by **LHP Bobby Shantz**.

RARE VISIT TO WRIGLEY: The current series marks just the 2nd visit to Wrigley Field for the Astros since 2013...the 2013 season is when the Astros were moved to the American League.

ON THE KAI-WEI TO SUCCESS: **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** has had success as both a starter and reliever this season, posting a 2.61 ERA (9ER/31IP) in 16 apps. (3 starts)...his last app. was a start on May 16 vs. TEX, where he hurled 5.0 scoreless innings en route to a 4-1 win...Teng was acquired by HOU in January in an offseason trade with SF...a native of Taiwan, Teng is the 2nd Taiwanese-born player to appear with the Astros in their history, joining **RHP Chia Jen-Lo**, who made 19 relief appearances with the Astros in 2013

YESTERDAY'S RECAP: **RHP Spencer Arrighetti's** 5.0 scoreless innings helped lead the Astros to a 4-2 win over the Cubs in yesterday's series opener at Wrigley Field...**C Christian Vázquez** (2x4, HR, 2 RBI) led the way offensively for the Astros...Arrighetti line: 5 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 4 BB, 5 SO...**LHP Bryan King** recorded the final 4 outs to earn his 5th save...**Brice Matthews** added a PH RBI-single...**Long Time Coming:** Yesterday's win was the Astros' 1st at Wrigley Field since a 4-3 victory on June 22, 2013.

SPENCER'S GIFTS: Since making his season debut on April 15, **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** has been one of the top starters in the Majors...with yesterday's win, he is now 6-1 in just 7 starts with a 1.32 ERA (6ER/41IP) and a miniscule .169 batting avg. (24 H allowed in 41.0 IP)...since April 15, Arrighetti's 6 wins are tops in the AL in that span...**Model of Consistency:** Arrighetti has allowed 1 ER or less in 6 of his 7 starts and 2 ER or less in all 7 starts...in May, Arrighetti is 3-1 in 4 starts with an 0.78 ERA (2ER/23IP).

RECENT STROS: The Astros are 4-3 in their last 7 games and 5-4 in their last 9 games.

CLOSE CALLS: With yesterday's 4-2 win, the Astros are now 9-8 in 2-run games and 4-2 in 1-run games.

FOR STARTERS: The Astros 3 starters scheduled for this series have a combined ERA of 2.43 (29ER/107.1IP) with 105 K's in 107.1 IP (Arrighetti-1.32), Teng-2.61, Lambert-3.57).

THROWING SOME LEATHER: The Astros 19 errors as a club are T-2nd fewest in the AL this season...the Astros had the fewest errors in the AL prior to committing 2 errors in yesterday's 4-2 win.

THERE IS A SANTA: **RHP Alimber Santa**, who was selected by the Astros from Triple A Sugar Land yesterday, has been outstanding for Sugar Land this season...in his 18 relief appearances, Santa is 4-2 with a 1.42 ERA (3ER/19IP), allowing just 10 hits in his 19.0 innings of work for a .159 opp. avg...he had not allowed a run in his last 6 app. (5.2 IP).

PEN PALS: As a group, the Astros bullpen has had a decent run of success recently...since May 8, they have a combined ERA of 3.57 (18ER/45.1IP)...individually, several relievers are currently pitching well:

- RHP Bryan Abreu: 0.00 ERA in last 7 outings (6.2 IP, 0 R).**
- RHP AJ Blubaugh: 2.18 ERA in last 8 outings (12.1 IP, 3 ER).**
- LHP Bryan King: 1.54 ERA in last 10 outings (11.2 IP, 2 ER)**
- LHP Steven Okert: 7 K's in his last 3.2 IP (4 apps.)...3.68 ERA in his last 8 outings (7.1 IP, 3 ER).**

AIR YORDAN: **Yordan Alvarez** is batting .303 with 11 doubles, 15 HR, 31 RBI and a 1.017 OPS (.412 OBP/.605 SLG)...he currently leads the AL in TB (113), is 2nd in OPS and SLG, 3rd in OBP, 5th in HR and BA and T-9th in RBI (31).

TAPPING FOR SUCCESS: Astros batters lead the Majors in successful ABS challenges with 33...they are 33-for-57 (58%) in their challenges...individually, **Jose Altuve** is tied for 2nd in the Majors with 9 successful challenges (9-for-13, 69%).

ROAD WARRIORS: The Astros have been one of the AL's top hitting teams on the road in 2026...entering today's game, HOU leads the AL in road batting avg. (.267) and OBP (.336) while ranking 3rd in SLG (.409) and OPS (.745).

BRYAN'S SONG: After a slow start to his season, **RHP Bryan Abreu** has not allowed a run in his last 7 outings, covering 6.2 IP (3 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 5 SO)...in his last 9 appearances, Abreu has posted a 1.04 ERA (1ER/8.2IP) with 9 K's.

ON THE LEADER BOARD: As a club, the Astros currently rank 2nd in the AL in hits (431), TB (704) and SLG (.403), 3rd in batting avg. (.247), T-3rd in OPS (.724) and 4th in HR (61).

MONSTER SEASON: **C/1B Jason Schivavone**, who was recently promoted to Double A Corpus Christi, leads all of MiLB with 18 HR in just 38 games...Schivavone, who began the season at High A Asheville, has had a sizzling start to his season, with 18 HR, 43 RBI and 42 BB while slashing .277/444/.745 with a 1.189 OPS...Schivavone was drafted by the Astros in the 11th round of the 2024 MLB Draft.

LAST START, MAY 16 vs. TEX: Was stellar in 5.0 shutout innings of work vs. the Rangers, allowing just 2 hits, 4 walks with a HBP and a season-high 7 strikeouts...threw 76 pitches (46 strikes)...marked the 1st start of his career in which he allowed no runs...his 5.0 innings were also a season high and the most IP he has pitched in a game since a start with the Giants on Sept. 1, 2025 at COL (5.1IP).

ABOUT TENG: An offseason acquisition, Teng has transitioned to the Astros starting rotation after making 13 relief appearances...as a reliever, Teng has impressed with a 1-1 record and a 1.80 ERA (4ER/20IP) in 13 appearances...prior to moving to the rotation, he ranked 9th in innings (20.0), 7th in opponent batting average (.145) and 11th in WHIP (0.85) among AL relievers. (min. 15 IP)...of his 13 relief appearances, 9 were for multiple innings, including 6 appearances of 2.0+ innings.

HARD TO HIT: Has limited opponents to a .198 (22x111) opponent average, including a .161 (9x56) average to right-handed hitters...also owns a 1.10 WHIP.

AS A STARTER: Has made 10 career starts, 3 with the Astros this season and 7 with the Giants in 2025...has posted huge strikeout numbers as a starter, fanning 45 hitters in 35.2 innings pitched for 11.4 strikeouts per 9.0...has 2 career Major League wins as a starter, his most recent start on May 16 vs. TEX and another which came on Sept. 1, 2025 at COL (2ER/5.1IP).

VS. CHC: Is facing the Cubs for the first time in his career today...of the current Cubs roster, has only faced Michael Conforto before (0x1, K).

SAVANT SAYS: Has a Breaking Run Value of 7, which ranks in the 98th percentile of all Major League pitchers.

2025 SEASON: Went 2-4 with a 6.37 ERA (21ER/29.2IP) and 39 strikeouts across 8 games (7 starts) with the Giants...appeared in 26 games (4 starts) with Triple A Sacramento, going 3-2 with a 3.63 ERA, .197 BAA and 89 strikeouts across 57.0 innings.

THE TAIWANESE TENG: The Taiwanese righty was acquired from San Francisco on Jan. 29, 2026 in exchange for catching prospect **Jancel Villarroel**...has appeared in parts of 3 seasons with the Giants (2024-25) and Astros (2026) making 25 career Major League appearances (10 starts)...upon pitching for the Astros this season, he became the 2nd Taiwanese-born player to appear with the Astros in their history, joining **RHP Chia Jen-Lo**, who made 19 relief appearances with the Astros in 2013.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/22 at CHC): Walked 1 in 0.2 of a scoreless inning yesterday at CHC to record his 3rd hold of the season.

TIDES TURNING: Has gone 2-0-2 through 7 consecutive scoreless appearances (6.2 IP), dating back to May 3, also posting a .143 opponent average (3x21) and 1.05 WHIP over that span...prior to this streak, posted a 12.54 ERA (13ER/9.1IP) in his first 11 games of the season...his 7-appearance scoreless streak is the longest active streak (in terms of games) among Astros pitchers.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...ranks 7th all-time in appearances (335) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342) for 6th on that all-time list...also among Astros relievers, he ranks 4th all-time in strikeouts (469).

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: Reached 179.2 career innings pitched at Daikin Park with his outing on May 16 vs TEX, surpassing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for 4th-most by a reliever in the venue's history...his 244 career strikeouts at Daikin Park are also 3 away from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most by a reliever in the venue's history.

VS. THE CUBS: Has posted a 1.69 ERA (1ER/5.1IP) with 8 strikeouts and a .158 opponent average (3x19) in 4 career appearances vs. the Cubs.

CAREER: In 335 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.86 ERA (110ER/345.2P) with 469 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.21 K/9 and a 0.76 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
